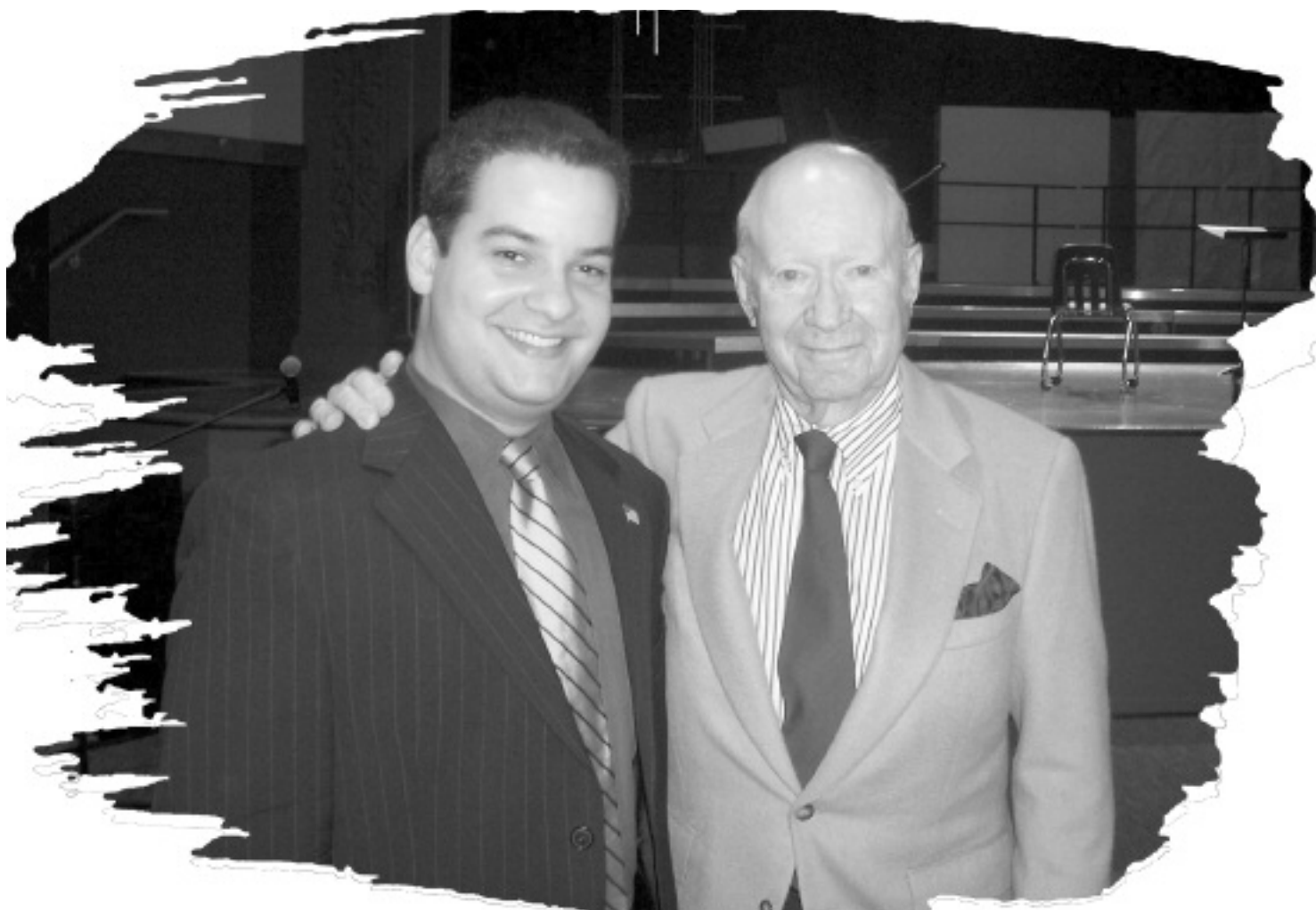

Board of Education Inducts New Officers

Newly elected members say 'Thank you'

Tears, laughter and appreciation speeches were expressed on Tuesday at the Board of Education meeting. Newly elected members Steven Fenton and Brian Goldberg, along with incumbent Myra Lurie were sworn-in to the Beverly Hills Board of Education.

All three expressed gratitude to the community and their relief that the Board of Education election was over.

Before the oath of offices were given, Beverly Hills Education Association President Chris Bushee took the podium to acknowledge the work of outgoing Board of Education President John Millan, who unexpectedly dropped out of the race in August, and member Alissa Roston, who did not win re-election to a third term.

Bushee congratulated Fenton and Goldberg, and reached out to Superintendent Kari McVeigh.

"I extend my hand to the new Board of Education and to the Superintendent," said Bushee. "We hope to see the resolution to old issues, open honest communication, and a bright tomorrow."

Millan took the podium next to say his farewells and community appreciation. He

expressed his discontent with how he believes certain members of the community have expressed what he claims is a racist attitude in opposing additional permits for out-of-district students

"I understand that Beverly Hills schools should be for Beverly Hills residents," said Millan. "But I can't believe the hate and racism expressed by neighbors."

Lurie, returning for a second term, was the first to take the oath of office, and was sworn in by Vice Mayor Barry Brucker.

"Thank God this election is over," said Lurie. "It's been my pleasure to have served with the [old Board]. The work as a school board member is painstaking work and at times unappreciated."

She addressed Fenton and Goldberg by saying she respects their "willingness to take on the responsibilities as [Board of Education members]."

Lurie believes the district is on the right track.

"It's been debated [how we should] bring back the good old days that we should turn back the clock and bring back former [employees]," said Lurie. "This is 2008 and the world has changed, our fund-

ing has changed, our neighboring districts have changed. We owe it to the children to help them succeed in this changing world. We can do better, should do better, and will do better."

Beverly Hills Councilmember and former Board of Education member (1983-91) Frank Fenton inducted his son Steven.

Fighting back tears Fenton, took the oath of office and addressed the audience by saying, "I grew up in this room, ladies and gentleman. I was 13 when my dad was elected to the Board of Education."

Fenton placed first in the race with 2,718 votes.

"To all the kids," said Fenton, "I am here for you. I will always be here for you."

Before the installation of officer's ceremony, Goldberg expressed his enthusiasm and understanding of his new responsibilities.

"It feels good and a little overwhelming," said Goldberg. "There is a lot that I need to catch up on and I want to do the

best job that I possibly can. I am excited to be part of the solution and to obtain a better understanding of the district."

With his children and wife beside him, Goldberg was sworn in by former Mayor

State Office of Traffic Safety "grants" Beverly Hills 3 Wishes for the Holidays

The California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS), through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) granted the city of Beverly Hills three grants to help monitor the roads during the holidays.

The first grant will provide additional funding for Police Officer overtime salaries for sobriety checkpoints, patrols for driving under the influence (DUI) violations, speed abatement operations and enforcement of seatbelt laws. The \$141,845 grant was also awarded for a variety of sobriety enforcement operations. The first of this series was held on November 23rd as a DUI "saturation patrol" fielding a group of specially trained officers to look for intoxicated drivers.

The second grant project for \$14,564 will support two sobriety and driver's license checkpoints, under the OTS "mini-grant" program. These events will target the Holiday periods which correlate to a rise in alcohol-involved crashes. The first will be held on Friday, December 21st, at Sunset Blvd and Sierra Dr. The second will occur next summer around Labor Day.

The Traffic Re-education Against Drunk Driving program was awarded \$305,000 in overtime and safety equipment to the city. Each of these OTS programs provides reimbursable funding, which requires a review by city staff and approval by the City Council

before operational money is appropriated.

ond was the Traffic and Parking Commission's recommendation to change the no parking restriction on the north side of Olympic from 7 - 9 a.m. to 7 - 10 a.m. That item was passed after midnight. They were independent of each other.

Mayor Delshad's quotes dealt with the Los Angeles DOT 3 phase plan to eventually change and permanently re-stripe Olympic Blvd into 4 lanes westbound and 2 lanes eastbound and eliminating all parking on Olympic and the opposite for Pico Blvd.

Phase one is to extend the No Parking times during peak hours on both streets; phase two is to change the signals to favor the predominate traffic direction (west on Olympic/east on Pico) and decrease the frequency of north-south signals; then finally, re-stripe to a 4 and-2 lane configuration with no parking at all.

The Beverly-Roxbury Homeowners association is very concerned about these plans. If implemented, they would have major increases in thru-traffic in our residential ,create difficulties getting to or from the high school and/or Beverly Vista from the south side, as well as eliminate any parking for apartment residents along Olympic in an area already bereft of sufficient parking.

We look forward to participating with the Traffic & Parking Commission as well

as the City Council to determine what is in the best interest of our residential neighborhoods and our businesses along Olympic. We believe that the primary concern should be for what is best for Beverly Hills.

Editors Note: In the article "Community Divided Over 'No Stopping' Parking Regulation," it is stated that the Beverly Hills City Council decided not to vote on the "no stopping" parking regulation from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Late on Wednesday, December 5 the Council did in fact vote (5-0) on the Olympic Boulevard "no stopping" regulation and extended the parking hour restriction from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Based on recommendations from the Beverly Hills Traffic and Parking Commission the amendment will only affect morning peak hours on the north side of Olympic Boulevard.

Goldberg thanked the audience and community for taking a risk and giving him the opportunity to serve on the Board.

"I'm looking forward to putting the election behind us and to work together with the other Board members to help move our district forward," said Goldberg.

Goldberg called himself a lifetime student.

"Everyday I learn more, but I will look to the Council and the community for advice," said Goldberg. "I will continue dialogues with teachers, parents, and continue to have an open mind to different perspectives."

Goldberg garnered 1,815 votes defeating Roston in the final count by 20 votes.

Roston was first elected to the Board of Education in 1999. Prior to running for the Board, Roston served as a Beverly Vista PTA president.

Board of Education members Myra Demeter was elected President and Nooshin Meshkaty to Vice President of the Board.

Demeter said the night was to serve as a recommitment to the success of each child.

"Our success [as a district] is not measured by test scores, but what type of human beings we send out," said Demeter.

High Drama at Board of Education Meeting

and a surprise at a fund raiser

We interrupt our two part review of Beverly Hills restaurants to let you sink your teeth into some news morsels you may have missed.

With the writer's strike crippling television, the Beverly Hills Board of Education meetings could become the most interesting fare available on the tube.

Shot before a live audience, this Tuesday's show had all the ingredients of a hit series: New characters ready to challenge the serenity of the previous plot line.

Unfortunately, the live audience left before the first dissonant notes were heard. But if you watched on KBEV, you saw the quick rapier like response to the first suggestion on process made by newly elected board member **Steven Fenton**. It's coming.

Tuesday's "organization" assemblage generally followed the script. As always, the board meeting opened with a holiday musical offering of the Madrigal Singers.

Side plot: The excellent if enigmatic leader of this fine choral group, **Joel Pressman**, often appears sans choir to criticize the board on issues affecting the teachers.

Following the carefully ecumenical selections of the Madrigals, the board began the traditional tributes to departing members, their farewell comments, the swearing in ceremonies and closing words from the continuing and reelected.

One member, President **John Millan**, who chose not to seek a second term, made the most jarring comments of the evening. The usually laid back, quiet consensus builder warned of an underlying current of "racism" that was unleashed during the recent election campaign's discussion on out of district school permits. Millan called for a community wide effort to address the issue, but said he did not place responsibility for this on any of the recent candidates.

Returning board member, and a past board president, **Myra Lurie** warned the board and the community not to try to turn back the clock to restore education policies of the past and to move to address the new challenges the schools faced. She also rejected suggestions of bringing back former administrators as an effort to look back and not forward.

As for the actual swearing in ceremonies, they were predictable and mostly expected, except for the appearance of former Mayor **Robert K. Tanenbaum** who inducted newly member **Brian Goldberg**. Draw your own conclusions of what, if any, message Goldberg was sending by inviting the former Mayor turned community maverick to do the honors. To his credit, Tanenbaum was very low key and businesslike.

The real emotional highlight of the evening came when former school board president, now councilmember **Frank Fenton**, provided the oath for his son, Steven Fenton. Fenton, fighting tears, called his father a "wonderful role model."

There was some history here too that was not included in the evening's script. Steven Fenton had the strong support of the teacher's union. But when Frank served on the board the union angered the Fenton family and some in the community

by picketing outside the Fenton home. Another side bar: BHEA, the teacher's union, through their president **Chris Bushee**, made a very conciliatory and gracious statement at the beginning of the board meeting, even paying tribute to departing members **Alissa Roston** and **John Millan**.

Millan also delivered another message to the new board members: Your only "authority" is as a board member, and not individually. He actually read from the manual of the state association of school boards warning members that their powers derive from board actions. Meaning: Don't try, as single members, to give orders or direction to staff, as one example, but bring issues to the board for decision making.

Vice Mayor **Barry Brucker** swore in both Myra Lurie and **Nooshin Meshkaty**, who was elected board vice president. Superintendent **Kari McVeigh** installed Myra Demeter as board president.

Now, here is when the plot became really interesting. With the ceremonial part of the meeting over and most of the guests exiting for the post-induction party, there was some routine business to conduct, a few money matters that were quite crucial, including awarding of bids.

As frequent readers know, this column has, quite unsuccessfully, urged the board to not do voice votes, but "call the roll," the process used by most elected bodies: Just more business like, and less likely to create doubts in record keeping, however, not as swift.

After several voice votes, Steven Fenton made a most unusual request. To honor his father, the younger Fenton asked that he not be called by his last name, but instead by Steven at all meetings.

The response was rapt like and instantaneous: Said new board president Demeter, "we will continue to call members Mr, Mrs, Miss, Member or Doctor and by their last name." A stunned Steven made no response.

Actually, Fenton did have recourse. The swift reaction of Demeter could be overturned by a majority vote of the board. I tried but can not resist: This could make it even-Steven.

However, with two Myra's on the board, it would be a cumbersome process to use first names. What would we do, call one Dr. Myra and the other Lawyer Myra?

Most substantive talk? Myra Lurie's outlining of priorities. Mrs. Roston was very gracious and generous, Mrs. Meshkaty more personal and Goldberg frank and deliberative. However, the best was the brief comments of the student body ex-officio board member **Zachary Kahn**.

Now, a word about a recent national magazine rankings of the "best" high schools. It didn't take long for the list to be discredited. US News and World Report had to admit a major error in its methodology, based mostly on math test scores. Their own math failed when the ranking of a Vermont high school had to be removed because of faulty addition: Embarrassing both the school and the magazine

Why do some schools make the list and not Beverly Hills? Test scores and rankings are complicated and seldom reflective of school realities. Magnet schools, one very dominant culture communities, always test higher than more diverse populations. The test criteria often do not reflect composite achievements, meeting goals or teaching excellence. If this were not true, why would so many knowledgeable and concerned parents strive to afford to live here or even seek out of district permits?

What should concern us is the lack of interest reflected in election turn outs.

Even after a vigorous, highly visible political campaign, fewer than 20 percent of eligible voters bothered to cast ballots. Yes, this could mean that most residents have no issues with the present leadership, but it is not a healthy sign of democratic involvement which will be very important when the district turns to the community for support of a crucial bond issue.

Since this is a national and not just a Beverly Hills issue, maybe its time for drastic reforms. A young Australian friend recently said she had to rush to her country's consulate to vote. I had no idea she was that interested in politics. Not the reason for her concern. Australia has a negative poll tax. If you don't vote, you pay a fine or tax.

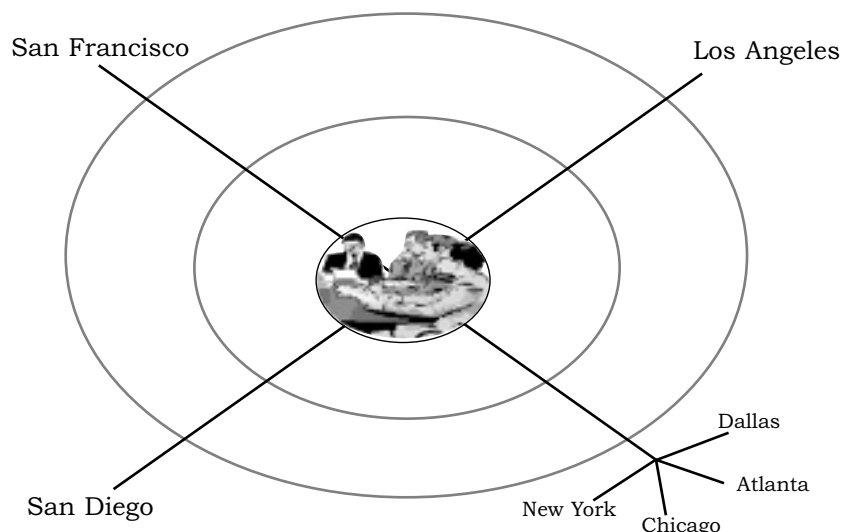

BEVERLY HIGH SPREADS 80 YEARS OF HOLIDAY CHEER

465 Albion Street Elementary students to receive gifts

Beverly High has fostered a holiday tradition with Albion Street Elementary for the past 80 years. Not even the Great Depression or World War II has impeded the yearly celebration. Through its annual Christmas program Beverly High students have been entertaining and sharing the holiday spirit with hundreds of underprivileged elementary students in East Los Angeles.

"This program teaches students how to give back to the community," said Beverly High math teacher and program coordinator Daniel Zadeh.

Students will head out today to Albion Elementary Street to deliver the toys to approximately 465 students.

According to Zadeh the Beverly High/Albion Street Elementary Christmas program is the longest running philanthropy in the United States by a high school.

"It's a tradition," said Zadeh, "Everything is 100 percent student and teacher funded."

A record breaking 250 students from Beverly High have helped with the logistics of the event, from ordering presents, sorting the gifts by class year, gift wrapping, and distributing the toys.

"For 80 years Beverly High has been bringing gifts to every single child at Albion Elementary," said Albion Street Elementary first grade teacher and program co-coordinator Frank Cooper. "The tradition began in 1927, when Beverly High was part of the LAUSD, but even after Beverly High [left the LAUSD in 1935] the school has not missed a year."

According to Albion Street Elementary interim Principal Esther Macias, State Senator Gloria Romero (D-Los Angeles) will be presenting certificates of recognition to Beverly High and Albion Street Elementary volunteers.

Cooper has been collaborating on the execution of the holiday program for the past five years.

According to Cooper, the program "means so much to the kids here at Albion."

For an entire week Beverly High students are encouraged to donate money to the program. Teachers during homeroom period pass around envelopes for students to place their donations.

"One class raised \$700 by itself, another student had his parents donate \$1,000," said Zadeh. "This year we have raised approximately \$5,000."

Cooper says the student exchange is of great significance.

"I'm not sure who enjoys it more, the high school kids or elementary kids. It really is a mutual exchange of culture, it provide the elementary kids a continuum of what life is like in high school and provides them with the vision that one day they will be in high school and I think that is really important for all the kids," said Cooper.

Albion Street Elementary is considered a Title One school. In order to qualify as a Title One school more than half of the student body parent's income has to be below the poverty level.

Macias believes this type of program is not only charitable but educational.

"I think this program is very important. It shows that we are all working together. The high school students that are coming are not predominantly Hispanic so it shows the students that even though they may be from different backgrounds that they are still interested in helping and relating to them," said Macias. "[Beverly High students] are a positive role model for the children."

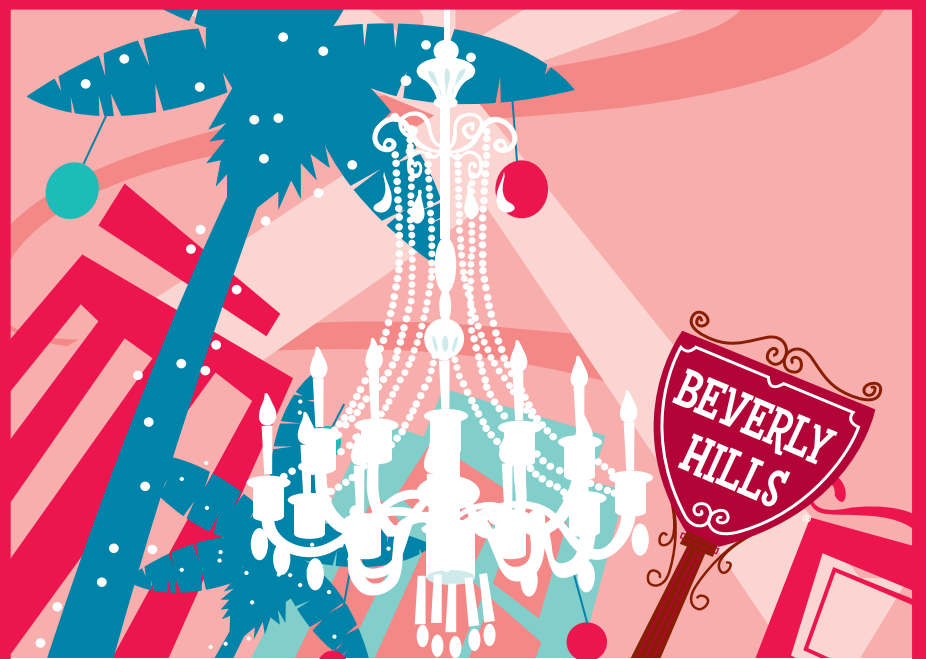
All the money raised goes to purchasing toys and buying the elementary school a gift. In previous years a fax machine and classroom supplies have been purchased for the school.

According to Zadeh this year they are trying to purchase a piano for the elementary school's auditorium.

Zadeh, who is a class of 1990 Beverly High graduate, has been involved with the program for almost eight years, but this will be his last year coordinating the program.

"It's a lot of fun, but also a lot of hard work," said Zadeh. "I think new ideas on how to organize and do things is always good."

The Madrigal Singers and the Beverly High cheerleaders are expected to perform for the students during the four hour holiday program.
