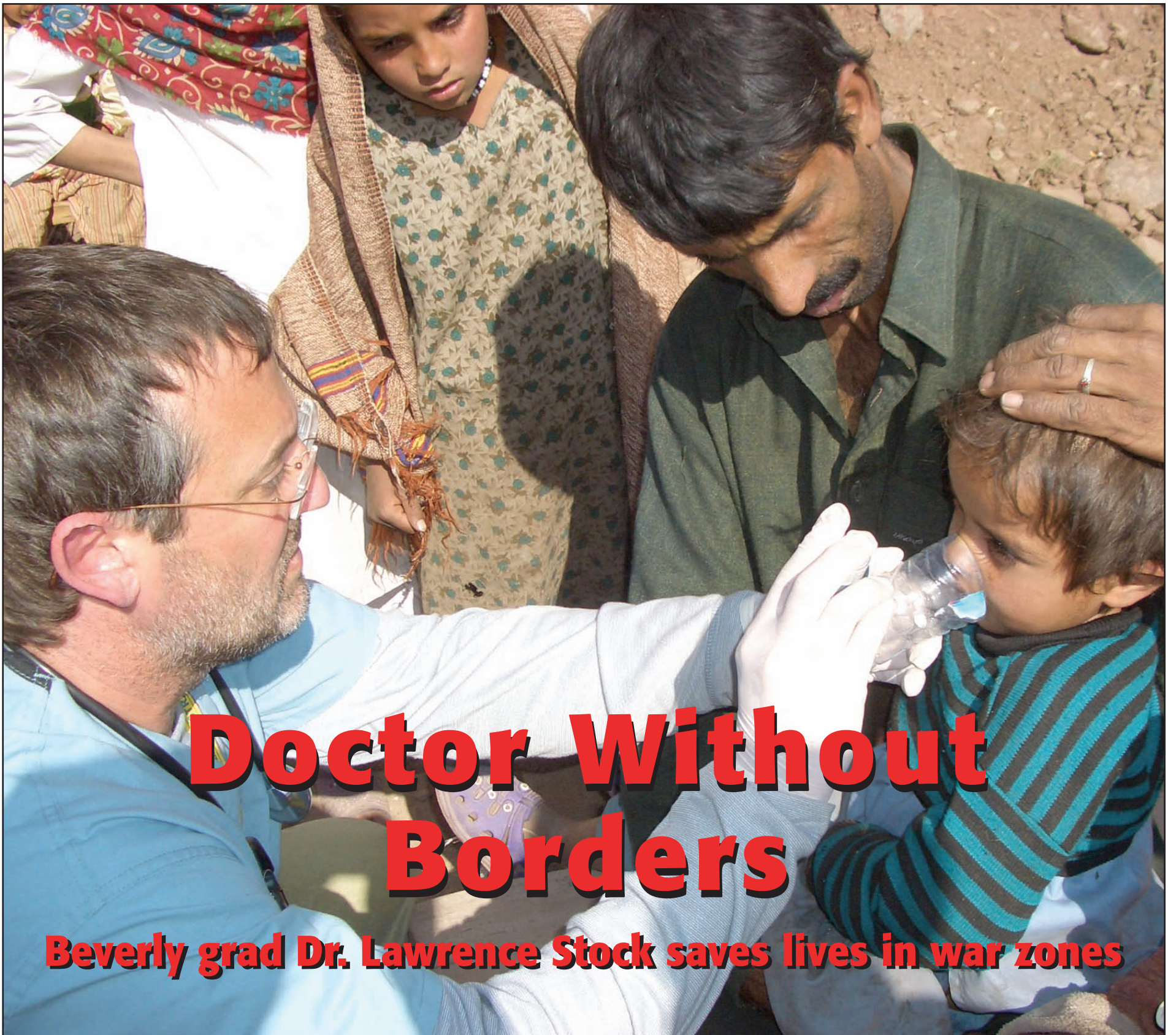

“General Plan”

On Friday, the City announced its proposed new “General Plan” for Beverly Hills which would intentionally and irresponsibly intensify density, height and traffic in our City. Coincidentally, that same week in the Los Angeles Times, an article appeared detailing “the specter of rampant development and a rising tide of street-choking traffic” in Santa Monica. It described a local ballot measure [and those in other cities] that would limit commercial construction for 15 years, quoting “These initiatives are examples of people frustrated with the consequences and trade-offs forced by” overdevelopment.

In Beverly Hills, we are already dealing with traffic, height and noise generated by commercial uses spilling over into residential areas. Soon the Montage, the William Morris Building and the 9900 Wilshire project will add further traffic to our clogged intersections, causing even more cut-through traffic in our residential neighborhoods than we already have.

And adding to this mounting threat to our quality of residential life, the City

Council and Planning Commission now take up a new General Plan that proposes to more than double the density, height and congestion along already overly congested Wilshire and along South Beverly Drive and, believe it or not, with no height limit for “key industries” (however that term will be defined by the developers and their former mayor and councilmember lobbyists). It would change the character of our City forever. And why? All for the sake of \$\$\$\$\$.

If the City needs more revenue after raising utility taxes and approving the Montage, William Morris, 9900 and perhaps the Hilton, further overdevelopment is not the answer.

Did we ever elect a candidate for Council who said he or she would double height, density and traffic?

We call upon the Council to drop these uncalled for General Plan increases in density and height NOW—so that our City will not have to face an internecine battle and another divisive referendum. And do not try to placate us with a “compromise” of some lesser increase—which is nevertheless an increase in what are already the most overcrowded streets in the County. Let us work together so that each of us and our neighbors will not feel the very real threat this plan presents to our quality of life and our property values.

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Beverly Vista Implicated in Free Speech Violation Lawsuit

Student suspended for internet video says school administrators overstepped boundaries

Beverly Vista School officials suspended a student for posting online a video taken off-campus and after-school of classmates "trash-

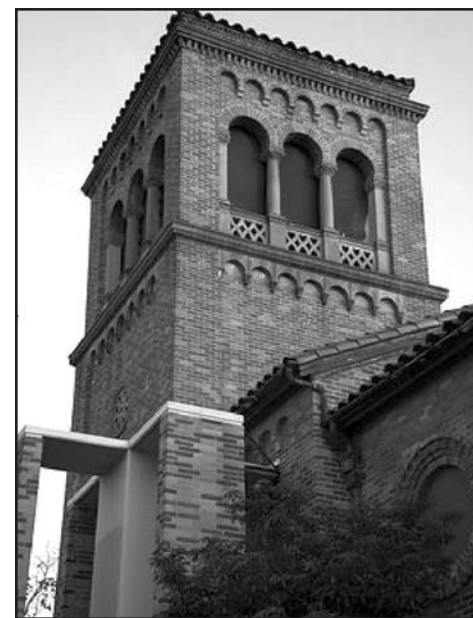
talking" another student in May. Now school officials find themselves slapped with a lawsuit alleging that they violated that student's

right to free speech.

Five Beverly Vista middle school students spent the afternoon of May 27 at an off-campus restaurant on Beverly Drive where one of the students filmed the others verbally bashing an absent classmate. The student who filmed the conversation posted the four-minute 36-second video on YouTube.com for public viewing that night. It was viewed by approximately 20 people before it was taken off the site, according to the complaint filed by the plaintiff.

The girl who received the alleged name-calling reportedly sent the video poster an instant message that night that said, "I want you ro [sic] leave it up for now," according to the complaint.

The subject of the video and her mother

The City of Beverly Hills has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the project described below. The public is invited to attend a meeting of the City's Planning Commission to comment on the environmental impacts addressed in the Draft EIR. *This public notice supersedes the previous public notice on the General Plan, dated August 8, 2008.*

Project Description: A new General Plan has been prepared in an effort to comprehensively update the current General Plan. The new Plan is organized into the following chapters: Community Conservation and Development which includes three elements, Infrastructure and Public Services which include six elements, and Community Safety which includes six elements. The primary focus of the Update is on development of policies and limited land use revisions. The new General Plan would conserve the existing pattern of uses and would establish policies for protection and long-term maintenance of established neighborhoods. Changes under consideration for land use or intensity of land use focus almost exclusively on the City's commercial corridors and commercial districts.

The General Plan has been determined to have potentially significant impacts in the following topical areas: Air Quality; Land Use; Noise; Population and Housing, Transportation, and Utilities and Service Systems.

Purpose of the Meeting: The purpose of the meeting is to consider the findings of the Draft Environmental Impact Report and to discuss policies in the General Plan. Following the initial presentation, interested agencies, organizations, and members of the public will be encouraged to comment on the Draft EIR and General Plan. The Draft EIR is being circulated for a 45-day public review period, from August 8, 2008 to September 22, 2008. Following the public review period, written responses will be prepared for comments submitted, provided that such comments raise environmental issues.

During the public review period, written comments concerning the adequacy of the document may be submitted by any interested person and/or affected agency. Comments should be directed to: City of Beverly Hills, Department of Community Development, 455 North Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, CA 90210, Attn. Larry Sakurai, Principal Planner.

To ensure that the EIR addresses any specific concerns that the public may have comments should be submitted as early as possible, and no later than September 22, 2008.

Alagem's employee files petition against Hilton referendum ballot rebuttal

Hilton expansion project supporter Karim Kano has filed a writ of mandate to change what he calls "false and misleading" rebuttal arguments from the opposing side on the November ballot statements for the Hilton referendum measure.

Kano is the senior managing director at Alagem Capital, a company owned by Beverly Hilton owner Beny Alagem, according to a spokesperson for the Hilton.

Kano, who identifies himself a resident, registered voter and taxpayer in Beverly Hills in the complaint, identifies the words "18-story condominium towers" in the rebuttal as "false and misleading."

"It's a minor but important point that needs to be cleared up and we are following the process to do that," said spokesperson for the Beverly Hilton Marie Garvey, who added that the Hilton plan includes only one 16- to 18-foot condominium building and one 6- to 8-foot condominium building. "The state requires that no false or misleading statements are in the ballot argument and we feel a correction needs to be made. It is important that the voters have the correct information on the project. We are fully confident that the voters will approve this project and affirm the City Council's approval."

The draft ballot statements and rebuttals for both sides of the Hilton referendum measure,

which would allow a Waldorf=Astoria hotel and condominium buildings to be built on the nine-acre Hilton lot, were released on Aug. 4 and were available for public review and input until Aug. 14. The writ of mandate was filed on Aug. 12.

Defendants include Beverly Hills City Clerk Byron Pope and Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters Dean C. Clark. The real parties in interest named in the petition include Larry Larson, Stacy Marks, Peter Falk, Nancy Sinatra Jr., and John Mirisch, all of whom signed the opposition argument.

"The Beverly Hilton appears to be desperate by filing this writ of mandate since they know Beverly Hills voters will vote no on Nov. 4 because the Beverly Hilton expansion is just simply too big," said Larry Larson, treasurer for the Citizens Right to Decide Committee which authored and filed the anti-Hilton expansion referendum.

Larson said he has not yet been served court papers and has not seen the entire text of the writ of mandate. However, he said he is suspicious of the source of the petition.

"No resident would spend tens of thousands of dollars to file this mandate unless they were being compensated by the Hilton," Larson added.

Garvey said that the process to file the petition was paid for by the Committee to Preserve Beverly Hills, which is the campaign committee for the Beverly Hilton.

Barcelona in Beverly Hills condos go to auction

The low level of sales for "Barcelona in Beverly Hills" condominium project on

Hillgreen Drive has led the developer, Marie France-Salaun, to put the units up for auction next week.

The ad for the condos boasts "newly built Mediterranean-style villas ranging in size from 3135sf - 3575 sf" with minimum bids started at \$1,675,000, or \$519 per square foot.

Even in the affluent city of Beverly Hills, the real estate market crunch is taking a toll.

As the Weekly reported in April 2006's Issue 340 ["Hillgreen Owners Seeing Red"], the lot on Hillgreen Drive where the complex stands was annexed from Los Angeles into Beverly Hills in 1999, spiking the value of the land in the process. France-Salaun, whose land was part of the annexation, promptly bought up an adjacent lot and began building the four-story, nine-unit complex around 2004 despite protests from neighbors.

The complex has three more units than other comparable R-4 zoned multi-family complexes, a compromise between Los Angeles' maximum of 15 units and Beverly Hills' maximum of six since the project was not begun as part of Beverly Hills jurisdiction.

"We're very anxious to see it succeed," said neighbor Joan Marcy, a Hillgreen resident and former city planning commissioner. "I feel bad for her that she sees that auction is the only way to sell these. The market is just so bad right now."

Representatives of the condominium complex did not return phone calls in time.

Beverly Roxbury Owners Association meet to discuss Hilton project

The Beverly Roxbury Owners Association will hold its annual meeting at Roxbury Park, room 103 on Aug. 21st at 7:30 p.m. This association represents home owners between Beverly Drive and Roxbury, between Olympic south to Pico Boulevard. Besides annual elections, they plan to discuss the Hilton Revitalization project and the proposed Beverly High Master Plan. They welcome all homeowners within their boundaries to participate.

Schuyler Road house goes up in a blaze



Forty-five firefighters from Beverly Hills and Los Angeles County hosed down a single-family home on Schuyler Road near Doheny after a fire that ignited from a car in the garage spread through the house, according to Beverly Hills Fire Department Chief Tim Scranton.

The "major fire" started around 5:30 p.m. after a car that had undergone electric work earlier in the day ignited, spreading flames through the garage and a small portion of the

home, said Scranton based on preliminary information. All five Beverly Hills Fire Department companies were deployed to the home within four minutes. An additional five companies from the Los Angeles County Fire Department were on the scene to assist in putting out the blaze. Los Angeles City sent two fire engines, one truck and one ambulance to backfill the Beverly Hills Fire Department while their units deployed to this fire.

The fire was "knocked down" by 6:15 p.m., said Scranton. The garage, two cars and a small portion of the house were destroyed with the entire house suffering from smoke damage, said Scranton. No injuries were reported.

All the firefighters "did a great job. And we are appreciative of Los Angeles City and Los Angeles County. Fortunately, the neighbors [of this home] had done a good job of keeping the brush cut back. This happened in a very high fire hazard zone. It could easily have been devastating to the area [if the fire had spread]," said Scranton.

A fire watch was posted outside of the house throughout the night.

Federal Court injunction stops Anderson from discussing subway flaws

Of the three MIT students named in a federal lawsuit brought by Boston's transportation authority, one is a 2005 Beverly High graduate Zack

Anderson, who will be a senior at the university in the fall.

The three students were issued an injunction last Friday sought by the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority to prohibit the students from publicly presenting fare-card security weaknesses they found in the Boston subway system.

As part of a class project, Anderson and two classmates researched security problems with Boston's T, or subway system. The group found a number of system weaknesses that could allow passengers to ride for free.

Two weeks ago, they sat down with the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority (MBTA) to discuss their findings and offer their help in solutions, according to Anderson. The group also informed the MBTA that they would be presenting their findings at an upcoming Defcon conference in Las Vegas, though they would omit detailed information as to how to steal subway rides.

After the leaving the meeting, Anderson said "everything was fine. We were going to help them. They might have hired us as consultants to fix the problems."

But then Friday afternoon around 4:30 p.m. as he was preparing for his presentation, Anderson got a call from a lawyer informing him that "the Boston subway system is filing a federal lawsuit against us," seeking an injunction against their presentation.

"It was shocking, since coming out of last Monday's meeting and given the fact that we wouldn't disclose anything to allow people to get free fare," said Anderson. The students

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immediately turned to non-profit Electronic Frontier Foundation, who was at the conference and had a team of lawyers working their case that night.

An emergency hearing was called Saturday morning, with Anderson phoning in from Las Vegas, where he was already immersed in the conference. The judge ruled in favor the MBTA and Anderson and his classmates were forced to forfeit their Sunday morning presentation.

Their presentation information, however, was already distributed to conference-goers. Their presentation has also been circulating the Internet, with full copies available after a simple Google search.

News media immediately jumped on the story and began questioning whether or not the students' right to free speech under the First Amendment was violated.

"The guiding touchstone for the First Amendment is that you can't prevent someone from speaking before they've spoken," said Doug Mirell, a lawyer for Loeb & Loeb.

But Anderson said he is not strongly concerned about whether or not his rights were violated and that he is ready for the whole case to be over.

"It's a fiasco. I don't see why it's turned into this," said Anderson. "[The case] hasn't been dropped but I don't plan on giving the talk even if it's appealed. I want to resolve this as soon as possible. There's no reason to turn it into anything larger."

Before Anderson was the center of the recent tumult, he was well-known as the creator and publisher of Beverly Underground, a Web-based news publication, while a student at Beverly High.

Anderson will be a senior at MIT in the fall and is working on a start-up company for his creation "GenShock," a "green" shock absorber for cars that will increase fuel economy for trucking, military and hybrid vehicles.

He has also received national media attention for an automation system he calls MIDAS (multifunction in dorm automation system) that does everything from open blinds to start a fog machine and disco ball for a party, which he created his freshman year at MIT.

Beverly Hills Not Affected by Whole Foods Beef Recall

Beverly Hills' Whole Foods Market will not take any beef off its shelves since California is not included in the states listed on Whole Foods Market's voluntary recall of fresh ground beef, according to a company spokesperson.

Whole Foods Market recalled its fresh ground beef sold between June 2 and Aug. 6, 2008, due to concerns that it may carry the E. coli bacteria after the company learned that its meat from Coleman Natural Beef was processed by a plant known for disease problems, Nebraska Beef Ltd., according to Whole Foods Market spokesperson Libba Letton.

"The beef that we are targeting in this recall was only sent to distribution centers in the Northeast, the Southeast and the Midwest and so [California] is separated by a whole other region of ours before you touch a region that was affected," said Letton. "We removed the

beef in question from our shelves last Wednesday. But we have not removed any meat in California. We haven't needed to — that meat is totally safe and high quality and has been raised and treated according to our standards."

Letton said that Coleman switched to using Nebraska Beef as a processor without alerting Whole Foods Market during their business relationship. However, Coleman Natural spokesperson Katie Coakley said that Coleman sold their beef line to Meyer Natural Beef in April 2008, but allowed Meyer to license the Coleman for one year to make for an easier customer transition. Coakley said Coleman Naturals alerted all of their customers of this sale and change in ownership.

Meyer Natural Beef uses as a processor Nebraska Beef, which has recalled over 6 million pounds of meat in the last month including some meat in California. Coakley said she did not know if Coleman had any oversight of Meyer while it licensed the company's name.

The allegations that Whole Foods carried the E. coli-carrying beef came after seven people in Massachusetts became ill. They had all shopped at Whole Foods in the last two months.

"But the Massachusetts Department of Health has tested our beef and all those tests have come back negative for contamination," said Letton.

The E. coli bacteria can be killed by cooking beef to a temperature of at least 160 degrees F on a digital thermometer or until the patty is no longer pink inside, according to the Department of Public Health.

City Releases Draft of General Plan

Some Beverly Hills residents and business owners may be able to build their homes or offices at least two times bigger than they are now if the City Council adopts the new draft of Beverly Hills General Plan, which was last updated 30 years ago.

One of the most significant changes in the draft General Plan is the increase of floor area ratio (FAR) in certain areas of the city from 2:1 to 5:1, which broadly means a building could have five times as much square feet as the property on which it is built, so long as it does not change the character of the building or area. For example, a 10,000 square foot lot could accommodate a 50,000 square foot building.

The areas most impacted by the new FAR are along Wilshire between Maple Drive and Spalding and around Wilshire and La Cienega boulevards, which is potentially slated to become a public transportation hub.

"We're looking 20 years down the road," said City Planner Jonathan Lait about the General Plan's reach.

The city staff has been working with residents for the last seven years to put together this proposal, which is still open to changes and input from residents, according to City Planning Commission chair Noah Furie, who spoke to reporters with Lait last week.

"We want people to be involved because these are significant matters that need to be resolved," said Furie. "At the end of the day, it's up to our elected officials to set major policy for the city. We do our best job to do what we think is appropriate."

According to Furie and Lait, the staff evaluated land use, housing, circulation, conserva-

tion, open space, public safety and noise.

The process began in 2001 with a city-sponsored "Plan Day" for residents and has since moved forward with many other community input opportunities such as 'topic committees' made up of residents, business owner and officials which met to identify issues that needed to be addressed in the city, such as commercial building standards, mixed-use buildings, traffic, and others.

In addition to town hall meetings, the city will have a booth at the Beverly Hills Farmer's Market every Sunday morning to discuss the plan.

The draft General Plan will go to the Beverly Hills City Council for approval or modifications in October.

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Battle Lines Drawn

Chamber Faces Downsizing

Territorial battles in Eastern Europe? We have our own highly charged turf war about to unravel right here in Beverly Hills.

It is entirely possible that our 80 year old Chamber of Commerce will soon be dismantled or, at the very least, shrunk. The catalyst? A very divisive proposed organizational change that would separate the Chamber from the Conference and Visitor's Bureau. The problem? Most people don't care.

Jack Benny once quipped that "Beverly Hills is so exclusive, even the police department has an unlisted telephone number." When it comes to beating its own organizational drum, our Chamber of Commerce seems reluctant or unable to communicate its good works, and that is very unChamber like.

Aside from those active in the Chamber, most of the activities and programs the Chamber undertakes are not

known in the community and yet, these Chamber "responsibilities" have a very direct impact on civic life.

The immediate challenge the Chamber faces is a loss of funding. Very serious big bucks. The city provides the money to operate the Conference and Visitor's Bureau and that funding also pays for office space, staff and other operating costs of the Chamber.

A highly professional performance audit of the Chamber and the CVB by KH Consulting found strengths and weaknesses in both. While it did not recommend separation, it did find failures in accountability while also giving the Chamber good marks for delivering services for which they are funded.

The lengthy report did evaluate cities that have separate Chambers and CVBs, how they relate and the advantages and disadvantages of working together. However, there are few comparisons that

could provide a model – we are very different.

That audit will be discussed Tuesday, August 19 at an afternoon meeting of the city council. As of this writing, Mayor **Barry Brucker** is convinced the two agencies should be split. Does he have two more votes? We will soon know.

To put the issue in some perspective, some basics: The money provided the CVB is largely from the Transient Occupancy (bed) Tax. When the city created the bed tax it was intended not only to pay for city services, but to make money available for promotion of tourism.

The program works. We have one of the highest hotel occupancy rates in the state. Would tourist promotion be just as effective if the CVB was independent of the Chamber? Probably, but no guarantee. **Dan Walsh**, the CEO of the Chamber has a very strong background in promoting tourism. If he no longer has responsibility for the CVB, the loss of his leadership could impact the CVB's effectiveness.

Back to the Chamber. They spend considerable money promoting Beverly Hills throughout the world. They have excellent programs serving our city.

However, inside the city, those good deeds are largely unknown.

Some examples:

A Health and Fitness exposition that improves each year. The most recent had 6,000 visitors and 50 exhibitors.

Increased membership dues revenue by 12 percent and a 42 percent membership initiation increase.

Gold Circle program of providing members services and products to residents.

Twelve percent increase in attendance at "Evening with Mayor" and 20 percent increase in networking programs.

The Economic Development agency of the Chamber also has some impressive and successful programs: formation of a much needed South Beverly Drive merchant's organization that included a recent first ever holiday lighting program and opening season ceremonies. The agency led a very successful sales mission to New York and Mexico City, held a "Luxury Summit" and much, much more. The head of the agency is **Anita Sussman-Eddy**.

The Economic Development Committee under chair **Allan Alexander** has sponsored some outstanding programs including presentations by Michael Eisner, LA Dodger co-owner **Jamie McCourt**, real estate forecasters **Karl Rappaport** and **Jay Newman**, a panel on retailing with Tiffany's **Nellie Seddigh**,

Geary's **Tom Blumenthal** and Saks' **Larry Bruce**, to mention just a few of their monthly events. Incidentally, Chamber members pay additional and expensive dues to belong to the EDC.

On the other hand, there are issues – some serious and some trivial.

The Chamber has a horrendous relationship with community newspapers, especially the Courier. In recent weeks, the Courier has had an investigative reporter delving into Chamber spending, accountability and performance, finding them weak on all counts.

We wrote earlier that Chamber insiders said this war by the Courier against the Chamber came about because Courier publisher **Clif Smith** was not named to the Chamber's Board of Directors.

Not entirely true. Chamber CEO Dan Walsh confirmed that Smith had never actually applied for board membership. According to our sources, Smith did tell then Chamber president **Denny Fitzpatrick** he would be willing to serve, but did not file any letter or application with the board.

While we have many differences on many issues with Smith, it was very unwise of the Chamber not to elect Smith to the board. Smith and Weekly publisher **Josh Gross** should both serve on the board of directors. Certainly, that is common practice in any city with local newspapers.

In fact, it is insulting and even outrageous that representatives of Los Angeles Magazine and Los Angeles Confidential are on the board and no rep of our own newspapers.

The Chamber board does have some real stars and Walsh had done a good job of bringing back some hotel managers who had been estranged from the Chamber for years. The board also includes the venerable **Warren Ackerman**, South Beverly motivator **Bobbe Joy Dawson**, **Jim Jahant** of Brooks Brothers, the legendary **Fred Hayman**, restaurateurs **Elizabeth Ahn**, **Giacomino Drago**, **Todd Johnson**, and the new chamber "chair" **Vicki Mense**. Other board members include **Houman Mahboubi**, **Richard Rosenzweig**, former president and school board member, **Myra Lurie**, **David Marguiles** and many more top business leaders.

What does the board lack: The managing directors of our leading department stores who used to play major roles in the Chamber.

More Chamber issues: The Chamber offices, home for the Conference and Visitor's Bureau, are closed on weekends, it staggers alternate Fridays off days for executives, it has no satellite venue for tourists and neither their telephone service or their web provide a contact number for media or others when the offices are closed.

However, a serious lack of pr judgment hasn't helped the Chamber's cause:

The Chamber recently changed their by-laws and titles of officers. Since its inception, the non-paid leader of the Chamber was the president, elected by the

complained to the school the next morning.

According to the court documents, the video poster was sitting in English class taking an exam the next morning when Beverly Vista authorities took her out of class and told her to sit in a small room for 45 minutes until they told her to take down the video from the Web site or they would ban her from graduation ceremonies. School authorities gave her a two-day suspension for "cyber-bullying."

The other students in the video were interrogated but faced no punishment.

The suspended girl has now brought a lawsuit against the school alleging that in punishing her the school violated her right to free speech. The girl, referred to as J.C. in the complaint, is being represented Cohen and Cohen attorneys Evan Cohen and Martin Keleti, one of which is her father.

The lawsuit, titled J.C. vs. BHUSD, seeks to have the student's record expunged and seeks damages "according to proof," said Keleti, of Cohen and Cohen, an intellectual property law firm.

BHUSD, Beverly Vista principal Erik Warren, assistant principal Cherryne Lue-Sang and counselor Janice Hart are listed as defendants in the complaint.

"The district has decided not to comment on the case at all," said Dr. Amy Lambert, director of pupil services for BHUSD, which is being represented by law firm Gibeaut, Mahan and Briscoe.

According to the complaint, Lue-Sang cited as grounds for suspending the student the California Education Code 48900(p), which states, "a pupil may be suspended or expelled for acts that are enumerated above, if they are related to school activity or school attendance, that occur at any time, including, but not limited to, times when a student is on school

grounds; times when a student is going to or coming from school; during the lunch period, whether on or off campus; or during or while going to or coming from, a school sponsored activity."

"[The school] was overreaching their jurisdiction. It's not student speech and it didn't take place on campus or at a school-sponsored event," said Keleti.

Keleti likened the case to a technological version of name-calling.

"It's not name calling on the playground. It would be like name-calling at the slumber party. And the school has no business controlling speech at someone's slumber party," Keleti said.

However, this is not the first time that the plaintiff has been disciplined by school authorities for posting coarse videos on YouTube. Earlier in the year, the student had been taking video footage of her teachers without their knowledge and posting the videos on YouTube.

This is also not the first time that the district has had to deal with "cyber-bullying" at the schools. Horace Mann School had a problem with students posting mean-spirited and allegedly racist videos about other students on YouTube last year as well.

"Generally speaking, California is more protective of students' free speech rights. In particular is 'Leonard Law' which says kids on public school campuses have the same free speech rights as those who are in the 'real world,'" said Doug Mirell, a lawyer for Loeb and Loeb who specializes in free speech rights, who added that if speech is obscene, libelous, or slanderous the law provides an exception.

"The only other possible exception is that all public school students are prohibited from essentially creating materials which 'so incite

students as to create a clear and present danger of the commission of unlawful acts on school premises or the violation of lawful school regulation or the substantial disruption of the orderly operation.' And it's that last clause that the plaintiff's lawyer in the Beverly Vista case seems to be hanging his hat on. So it's really a fact-based inquiry: Did this video that was only viewed by 20 people cause a substantial disruption of the orderly operation?" said Mirell.

As the case proceeds, the school will have to demonstrate in significant ways how orderly operations were disrupted following this video, said Mirell, who added that he did not have all the evidence in the case to make a definitive statement.

"And it would seem to me that this is really a case of old wine in new bottles and that students would not and have not historically been disciplined in this way for simply engaging in name calling or saying who they like or don't like. And I think the real danger here is that if the rules of the game are allowed to change simply because the medium of communication is different than you are going to have to have school administrators who are spending 24 hours of every day surfing the net for derogatory comments on Facebook, Myspace and everywhere else and frankly I don't think that the way taxpayers want public servants to act," said Mirell.

The plaintiff has since graduated and will attend Beverly High in the fall. The student who was the subject of the video graduated from Beverly Vista but intends to leave the district for private school.

many of the audit's recommendations, some of which have already been planned or initiated.

The first and most important step the audit recommends, which the Chamber supports, is the development of a consolidated strategic plan, from which decisions regarding performance measurements or organizational structures would be defined. While the Chamber Board supports the current organizational structure, the Board is open to exploring whether the strategic plan best serves Beverly Hills businesses by having an alternative structure.

The most important issue to Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce and its three divisions is how businesses are best served. I, along with the rest of the Board of Directors and Chamber staff, look forward to working with the City of Beverly Hills to improve our service to the Beverly Hills business community, as a thriving business community is the foundation to the strength and quality of life in Beverly Hills.

board. The other officers were president elect, vice presidents and immediate past president.

Now, the staff professional, CEO Walsh, is president and the board is led by a chair, vice chair etc. Other staff members are vice president etc. Not very smart and not very good timing.

The Chamber will argue, correctly, that those titles are common in other cities. So what? We are different and that's why the Chamber says how other cities separate the Chamber and the CVBs are not models for us. Can't have it both ways. Titles do matter and the Chamber needs more not less clout and involvement from and with business and community leaders. Those should have the titles of president, vice president etc.

Some conclusions: As with many decisions facing the city, personalities and relationships often become more important than the real issues. This is not and shouldn't be a battle between Smith and Mayor Brucker on one side and Dan Walsh on the other. The officers of the Chamber need to step forward and take a very active role in what can be a defining moment in the Chamber's history.

If the Chamber and the CVB are separated, the Chamber will be a much smaller operation. Membership dues and non-city revenue are simply not enough to

fund their current programs or maintain present staff.

However, the decision has to be based on one important choice: What is best for the business community and our city.

The city should be very deliberative, very slow in making any radical changes including separating the Chamber and the CVB. As we said earlier, the council would be well advised to ask the managing directors of our leading hotels to study the KH performance audit and then advise the council on next steps.

The Chamber sells itself and the city very well in New York; it now needs to do the same in Beverly Hills. Note: Some local programs are well managed including membership services.

Final thought: The Chamber has no monopoly on bad decisions. A former city council wasted thousands of advertising dollars by becoming too involved in selecting advertising programs. Do you remember the scantily attired cutie promoting our city for its spas? Yes, that rubbed me the wrong way.

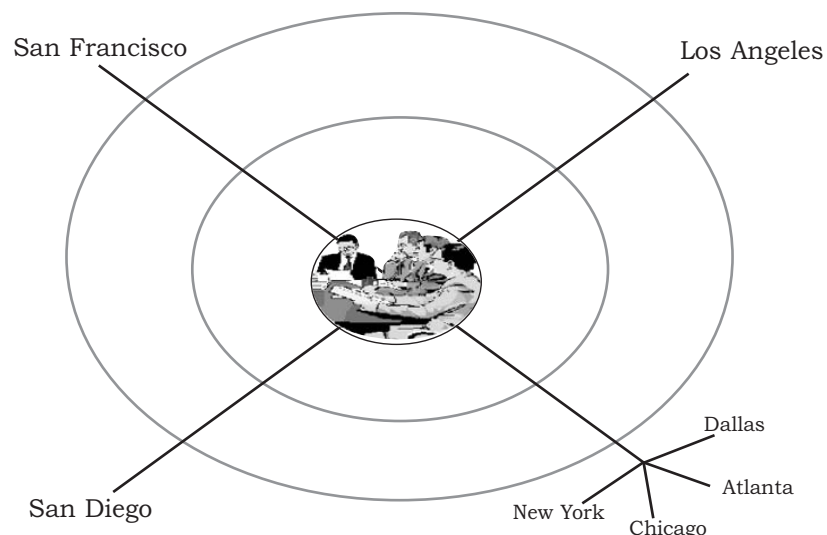

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DOCTOR WITHOUT BORDERS

Beverly graduate Dr. Lawrence Stock saves lives in war zones

So tell me about yourself and what you do.

I'm an emergency medicine physician. After I [graduated] Beverly High [in 1980], I went to college at UC Riverside and was in part of the seven year medical school program with Riverside and UCLA and then I came back and I graduated medical school and trained at Harbor UCLA down in Torrance in emergency medicine for three years and have been in LA ever since. I work at Antelope Valley Hospital (AV) up in Lancaster. I'm the assistant medical director of the emergency medical department and part of the medical executive committee. I got involved in teaching [after] I left Harbor. I've taught there since 1991 as a volunteer faculty appointment through UCLA. And through that I have been teaching down at Harbor and the UCLA residence, which is a separate program. They come up and train at AV where I work.

Beginning in 1996, I started doing some overseas work on a volunteer basis and that has continued on in one variety or another. I've gotten a chance to work in Europe, Africa and Asia. Some of the residents who I taught at Harbor over the years, several of them have come to work with our group and have now become my partners in my ER group. I primarily volunteer with organizations through friends of mine. One is this main group which is called Global Health Access Program (GHAP). The other is called Australian Aid International.

So some of the stuff is direct patient care and some of it is actually training of people who will give direct patient care. I try and do a lot of the training because it gives leverage to more activity because after we leave these are the guys who actually own the problems in their area.

How did you get started doing international work?

The original stuff was several years after I graduated; I spent about a year traveling with my wife after I finished training through Central America in 1991, 1992. So I spent time in Mexico and Central America and came back and was working and trying to figure out exactly where I'd end up. In 1996 a group called International Medical Corp, which is based in Santa Monica now, was looking for ER docs to go to Bosnia. And Bosnia was a pretty intriguing situation I had friends who were already over there and they were interested in starting an emergency medicine [program].

It was also that Bosnia sort of echoed a

bit of World War II — this idea that people were being singled out because of their ethnicity in Europe again. I'm Jewish and felt compelled because we were taught this was never going to happen again and if it was, that we would do something about it. So that was part of my reason. A lot of people who went over there went for similar reasons and that was part of it, not wanting to sit back and just watch something happen. I felt I could do something about it.

Tell us about your some of your experiences.

Emergency medicine just didn't exist in Bosnia so they started this small ER in this town about an hour from Sarajevo, called Janitza, it's nickname is the "town of thieves." There was a mafia in town and the mafia chief was this young guy



who was sort of a cocaine addict. He has two sisters, one was a teacher and one was a nurse, and he had a father who was quite sick. So one day I was working and [the father] came in as a patient. I didn't know he was connected to this guy at all. He looked like he was having a heart attack and he was getting sicker quite quickly. Everything started going wrong. We ran out of oxygen. I had to put a tube down to help him breathe. The sister was there and she didn't understand what was going on because it was [emergency medicine] brand new and she thought I was trying to hurt her father. I stabilized him and he went up to the CCU and she said, "You're gonna have a serious problem. My brother, you don't know who he is, but he is going to come get you if my father doesn't do well."

So later that night, this brother comes into the ER and is stoned on cocaine and

is looking for me and this other American guy who was with me. So [the ER staff] made us leave for a couple days to go to Croatia because they said this guy had killed 50 men and everybody there was terrified of him. So we ended up leaving and this guy's father ended up doing fine. The police chief went and visited him and he apologized so we returned to Bosnia and resumed what we were doing. A week after I left, the father got sick again and this time they chose to come to the ER and was hoping that I was there because they realized I had saved his life and were very appreciative. So it's a little different than your typical day at the ER in the United States but it's how things go.

What else have you done?

I went to Pakistan after the earthquake in Kashmir. I got a chance to take care of the brother of the former prime minister of Kashmir at what had been the prime minister's house. He had broke his arm during the earthquake. He was a big tall good-looking guy, probably about 60 years old and so his family brought a bed out to the garden. He was in so much pain because his bones had done what we call bayoneted, one had broke and the arm was short because one bone was side by side with another instead of being

people who stepped on landmines and have wounded limbs and they're badly injured and would probably die without treatments. So these guys resuscitate people in the jungle and perform major surgery in the jungle in huts. They sometimes perform amputations or take care of broken bones or do blood transfusions; it's real stuff, not just first aid. And we've been training with these guys for the last eight years or so.

Then I went to Liberia in 2003 and then in 2004 when the tsunami happened, I went over to Sri Lanka. Then later that year, there was a big earthquake in south Asia so I went over to Pakistan and Kashmir and spent time there. Most recently we tried getting into Burma after this cyclone hit and I was unsuccessful but we helped about five other people on our team get in and they did a good program over there. So I was involved with that but was outside of Burma and that's kind of the highlights of some of the experiences.

Were you ever fearful?

Not really, I was intrigued. Emergency medicine prepares you to be ready to deal with anything and to think on your feet so my training the nature of my specialty; we're used to managing chaos and new experiences because you never know what is going to happen.

The perception that things are going to be dangerous is way blown out of proportion because the news tends to focus on sensational types of things and people have a hard time putting that into perspective of how often they are really occurring. So people think if they go to a place that's in a war zone that they are going to definitely be in danger. But more often than not the dangers are relatively small and the rewards are relatively high and the experiences are very rich and the people that you meet... You immediately get catapulted in their lives and their struggles and that's very different than just going to travel to a place as a sight-seer. You are actually immersed in their culture.

When I went to Liberia, they've been in a series of wars over the last 20 years. Liberia was in a period where rebels had been in control of 80 percent, actually the entire country. What we saw was an area where there was no law, no healthcare system and no government for over a year. The rebels had taken over the area about nine months before we got there. We would travel from 10 different towns where we were focused and went back to securing the basic of well water and opening clinics. We saw that people died of very simple things, things that would cost pennies to cure, like dehydration and malnutrition and vitamin deficiencies and malaria. It's amazing that there are 1,000s of people who needed care just because of the social chaos that was going on. So when we hear people [in the U.S.] gripe about the law or health care, well, having a place that has no law is far worse.

What keeps you going in times like that?

To realize you are part of a chain of survival. The more you can teach, the more you are leveraging knowledge. You aren't doing this alone and you are part of a web of help and some of it is knowledge and some of it is getting resources to people and some of it is overcoming bad government situations where people can't gain access because of conflicts or corruption or whatever else. But everyone deserves access to health care. It's such a basic universal need that it crosses all cultural boundaries and nationalities.

Also people have used hospitals, doctors and health care providers during war times in order to attack their enemy. They have tried to dismantle or scare away or imprison their physicians or nurses and attack hospitals because they know without hospitals, people are discouraged and feel hopeless. So we've walked into situations like that — places that are trying to reassemble what's been destroyed.

What are some lessons you've learned in your work?

I feel like the skills I have are skills I picked up in a training program that is successful to anybody who became an emergency physician. I don't feel that because I've done these things, some extraordinary things, it doesn't mean it's

because I'm extraordinary. It's really accessible to anybody just to do it.

The rewards you get from doing this kind of stuff far exceed anything you put into it or any time you spend or loss of income you have for not working during that time. You meet people and establish relationships, learn new skills, worlds kind of open up to you and you end up having relationships with people all over the world. And suddenly the world gets a lot smaller and more understandable and you don't feel so alienated from everyone else.

When I went to Bosnia and Albania it was the first time I understood in my life that there was evil in the world and to recognize it and try and fight against it and not sort of misjudge that. And certainly there are shades of grey out there I'm not trying to make everything black and white but good and evil do exist in the world. It's important that people be able to recognize that otherwise we won't be able to do anything about it when it does rise its head.

How often do you travel overseas?

I went over to Thailand every six months, probably 20 trips to the Thai-Burma border in a couple different areas and then these other trips, maybe 30 trips for various reasons, of different lengths from three months to two weeks. That doesn't count going out to lecture and fundraise and plan. GHAP is ongoing;

people are out in the field all the time.

Actually going out and working overseas myself is probably 30 times I'm guessing.

Tell us about growing up in Beverly Hills.

I went to Beverly Vista. I just went to lunch with Pauline Yano. She was my fourth-grade teacher. And Beverly Hills was great, I went through school knowing some of the same kids from kindergarten all the way through high school graduation and I still see some of them now. I remember it was a very good school with good teachers and good kids.

I remember Ms. Yano. She was pretty tough but was a very good teacher — well tough AND good, not tough BUT good. And I also got involved in wrestling when I was a kid at the YMCA in Beverly Hills and we did some wrestling as part of the P.E. I ended up when I got to high school being on the wrestling team. And Pauline is friends with Jack and Jane Gifford, and Jack was the wrestling coach for the varsity wrestling team when I was there. And he was one of my very good teachers. And the other teacher... Well three teachers stand out in my mind: Ms. Yano, Jack Gifford and a guy who is still teaching now, who was my auto shop teacher at Beverly High, Michael Lambert. He is now teaching P.E. at Hawthorne and he was a terrific teacher.

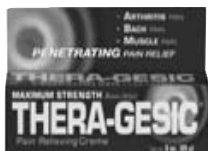
It was a great small school district got a lot of attention and for me it was a great public school to go to.

What's in the future for you?

I don't know I try not to plan too much. I'm happy with continuing to learn and increase my skills and hopefully as time goes on I'll be more and more available to continue to teach and be able to go as I get older get more flexibility to go places when there is perceived need and I can be of some help. I'm pretty happy. I'm not looking to retire. I can't imagine doing anything I enjoy more. Work to me is enjoyable. Sometimes I say I can't believe they are paying me to do this. Being an ER doctor is pretty fun. It's not a boring job and you get to save people's lives virtually every shift. I mean there are a lot of issues; it's sort of at the cross-roads of the problems in health care. It's also one of the most interesting places to work. And then to have the freedom because we do work in shifts because we're part of this great network of people both in my group and outside of it, I'm hooked up all these very high quality people who want to be involved in important things and when you're around a lot of smart motivated people it makes you feel smarter and more motivated and it's not just you, you're part of this web of people who are trying to do the same thing.

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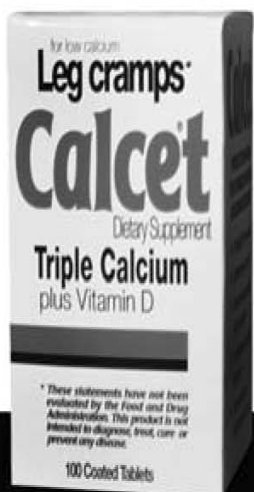


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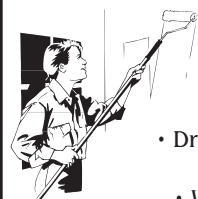
