Willie Brien. Virginia Maas. John Mirisch. These are the candidates that the teachers of

Beverly Hills are endorsing for City Council. How did our association arrive at this recommendation and why are educational employees taking an interest in this city election?

For most of this current decade, BHEA did not play an active role in either school district or city politics. However, our district made many administrative decisions in the middle of this decade that we believe could have been better, particularly in the area of administrative personnel choices. We have also felt an increasing sense of isolation, a shifting workplace environment where our views as professionals are not being incorporated into decision-making. In the fall of 2007, teachers decided that it was time for us to use our collective voice to speak to the community about these issues. We endorsed both Steven Fenton and Brian Goldberg for the school board and in November of 2007, Beverly Hills voters elected both of them.

Now here we are a little more than a year later. The city and the school district share a

close, mutually beneficial relationship. Rather than operating in separate worlds, decision-making in the city affects the district and vice versa. Teachers recognize this. Last month, we conducted face-to-face interviews with the nine candidates who sought our endorsement in this election. We asked the candidates their opinions on communication, joint use of district facilities, labor relations, the local press, and the issue of public versus private schools. We followed an objective process that focused on candidates' positions and records on the issues that matter to us as educators. We offer to you, the Beverly Hills voters, our

conclusions through the endorsement of Brien, Maas, and Mirisch.

Teachers know that education is one of several important topics that the Beverly Hills electorate must consider when choosing the next City Council. BHEA is excited about playing a role in this important process. Willie Brien, Virginia Maas, and John Mirisch bring a healthy mix of political experience, fortitude, and willingness to challenge the status quo. This is good for the city and, by extension, good for our schools

### Brucker won't take position on controversial BHUSD permit

Mayor Barry Brucker, a former Board of Education member, says he has no position on the controversial BHUSD permit policy that recent-

ly has been at the heart of several heated Board meetings.

"I do not have a position on it because I don't want to meddle unless I am asked by [the Board of Education members]," said Brucker in an interview.

Experts expect that within two years the BHUSD will become Basic Aid, in which the district would be funded by a flat-rate from local property taxes instead of by perpupil state money. Resident parents are concerned that their property tax dollars will be subsidizing the education of out-of-district permit students, whose costs are currently covered by state funding. Permit parents say their children have made a home at the BHUSD and deserve to matriculate with their classes.

The five Board members are also split about whether to continue allowing opportunity permits in the district. Board members Steven Fenton and Brian Goldberg favor phasing out opportunity permits at natural educational breaks. Board of Education President Nooshin Meshkaty, Vice President Myra Lurie and member Myra Demeter favor grandfathering opportunity permit students currently in the BHUSD until they matriculate through 12th

Brucker chaired the campaign of Board of Education Vice President Myra Lurie. He will likely chair current President Nooshin Meshkaty's November reelection campaign.

"[Once a district enters Basic Aid, permits] basically become a scholarship. And that is obviously a concern of residents who have moved to Beverly Hills and maybe downsized on their home because they wanted to make certain their kids could attend Beverly Hills schools," said Brucker.

Many resident parents, also, believe that the permit issue is not just a school concern.

"There is no doubt that [schools] are tied to the city. Schools fall under services" like police and fire department protections, said Beverly Hills resident and BHUSD parent Alma Ordaz, who believes the value of the city is predicated in part upon the quality of those services.

While Brucker conceded that the two are intricately linked, he still deferred decision making to the Board.

"I have a tremendous amount of faith in how the school board is coming together on a very complex issue. I think what the school board needs to do is to continue to dialogue and put all the options on the table and recognize no one is going to be 100 percent pleased with their decision but they are elected to make the tough decisions," said Brucker.

Brucker says he has offered to Meshkaty for the Board of Education liaisons meet with City Council liaisons on schools to "sit down and dialogue with the school board to discuss how the city issues are affected by the decision."

Meshkaty says she was not approached

by Brucker on this issue but that the two sets of liaisons typically meet five or six times a year to discuss issues that affect both the school district and the city, like construction projects or traffic.

So does Brucker think the BHUSD should continue issuing opportunity permits after Basic Aid?

"If you're talking about [issuing] new permits, if a school becomes Basic Aid, I would have a good deal of difficulty going that route. I think the community would have a difficult time justifying that," said Brucker. "But there may be some other considerations that might play a role: What do you do about employee kids? What about meeting a certain threshold number of students to allow for adequate programming?"

grams related to the administration of the high school according to state and district mandates." The deadline to apply was on Monday.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Beverly Hills, at its regular meeting to be held on **Tuesday, February 17**, **at 7:00 p.m.**, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, 455 N. Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, California, will hold public hearing to consider:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS REGARDING THE APPLICABILITY OF PARKING AND LOADING STANDARDS TO CERTAIN NONCONFORMING COMMERCIAL STRUCTURES IN THE C-3T-2 ZONE ON OLYMPIC BOULEVARD BETWEEN REXFORD DRIVE AND ROBERTSON BOULEVARD

When the use of an existing, nonconforming structure of 12,000 square feet or more is intensified in the aforementioned portion of Olympic Boulevard, the new use would be required to comply with current parking and loading standards set forth in Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code. Where there are difficulties in meeting the current parking and loading standards, the ordinance would allow an applicant to seek the approval of the Planning Commission through the City's Development Plan Review public hearing process for deviation from the standards.

The proposed ordinance has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. Staff has determined, and the Planning Commission concurred, that the proposed ordinance is exempt from the environmental review requirements of CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, as the ordinance does not authorize construction and, in fact, imposes greater restrictions on certain development in order to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare. Furthermore, staff has determined that the ordinance qualifies for a Categorical Exemption (Section 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines), Class 8, "actions by regulatory agencies for the protection of the environment," because the ordinance would protect neighborhoods from impacts associated with intensification of commercial uses. Therefore, under the authority provided by the CEQA Guidelines, no significant environmental impacts are anticipated.

The City's Planning Commission conducted a duly notice public hearing on January 29, 2009, during which it considered the draft ordinance. The Planning Commission recommended that the City Council adopt the ordinance with certain modifications.

At the public hearing, the City Council will hear and consider all comments. If you challenge the Commission's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City, either at or prior to the public hearing.

#### Alleged Beverly Vista predator arrested

A man police suspect of attempting to seduce at least two Beverly Vista students into his car late last year was arrested by Beverly Hills Police last week.

Forty-year-old Javier Arturo Guzman, of Venice, was taken into custody on suspicion of annoying a child under 18 and possession of child pornography.

Police say Guzman first approached a Beverly Vista middle school student and tried to engage her in conversation in October. Within the next month, he was spotted on several occasion taking photographs of children at the school and attempting to talk with another student.

The Los Angeles District Attorney's Office filed one felony count for child pornography and two misdemeanor counts for annoying a minor against Guzman on Feb. 4. He was transferred into the custody of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department, where he is being held in lieu of \$75,000

#### Two BHUSD buildings receive awards for excellence





# **Selected Short Subjects and Another Local Hero**

Checking the cable television listings for Tuesday, the premium – extra costs stations, had 12 movies in prime time of which eight had two or one star, four had three and none four, and for this we are paying the big bucks?

Or did "Big Dome" grab you?

In fact, the best movies can now be found on "TCM" which had three movies with four and three stars.

Which brings us to the most horrendous waste of talent imaginable – "The United States of Tara" an "original" on Showtime.

If you saw "Little Miss Sunshine," you know that **Toni Collete** is indeed an exceptional actor. Now, in this derivative story of a homemaker/mother with multiple personalities, she labors valiantly to save an ill-conceived debacle which credits **Steven Spielberg** for the concept.

**Joanne Woodward** did it first and far more credibly in "Three Faces of Eve," the 1957 film that **Nunnally Johnson** wrote and produced. But do I really want to see or believe Toni turn into a pugilistic boy type dukeing it out with a family detractor? Not more than once

The alternatives are not that palatable. The long running "The Bachelor" is beyond sexist. Here we have a small platoon of attractive young women competing to win the love, approval and that "Rose" from the show's star.

The "bachelor" just sits there and waits for these women to throw themselves at him – he is not even remotely required to gain their approval.

What a marvelous message about relationships we are teaching young women.

It's a competition, nothing more. The women want to "win." There was one sign of hope. In the current series, one of the contestant's families refused to be shown on camera.

Now, if you want happy news, Channel Five morning news is for you. In a five minute segment Monday I timed three minutes of giggles, two of reporting. This from a station that once had the late **Hal Fishman** as news director. These "anchors" certainly know how to amuse each other, if not their audience

And what is this fascination with car chases? Monday the news programs had two. Channel Nine finally gave up after one chase

came to an end with the driver refusing to leave his car. But for at least a half hour, the helicopter camera focused on the parked car and the parked police vehicles. They and the other stations were not there when it ended in the tragedy of a suicide. Both chases had about two paragraphs in The Times.

Speaking of the Los Angeles Times, they still have problems with geography and the use of telephone directories. A recent effort to locate a school board member led them to the voter registration lists which had the cell phone number of the board member's son. The young man, now attending school back east, was a little surprised to hear the voice of a reporter looking for his mother. A simple dialing of 411 would have been easier.

One television station also had directory assistance issues. Naturally, when the eight baby births made news, the station could not wait to make sure we knew it was a "Beverly Hills Doctor" who may have been the physician involved in the fertility treatment.

The station's reporter must have had a very old directory because they reported that the physician, Dr. **Michael Kamrava**, had "moved" from his "Beverly Hills office."

However, his old office was actually not in Beverly Hills, but that too is an interesting story. The doctor used to have offices, as did the clinic with which he is associated, at 250 North Roberston. Somehow, the owners of that building, which is higher than our codes would have permitted, managed to convince the post office to give them a Beverly Hills zip and address even though it is in Los Angeles. The same owners have an adjacent structure, although only two stories, at 200 North Robertson. A phone call to one of the other doctors still in the 250 building, mostly now leased by Cedars-Sinai, claimed they were in the city of Beverly Hills. Need to check if they are paying taxes to our city or Los Angeles. By the way, this whole annexation by address change once drove community activist Ed Kushner to file a protest. Ed now lives near Solvang, so he stopped bugging the

For the benefit of the tv reporter, the doctor they reported as no longer being in that office, is actually at 9730 Wilshire, one of our oldest medical buildings and is listed in newer directories and 411. Hard reporter detective work did it

The Times coverage of our on-going student permit issue was balanced, as was a Channel Seven report the following day. Not the media's fault that this continuing community debate makes us seem elitist and divided.

This is one issue that could be described reasonably as having two sides that are both totally right. What is not good is the failure to bring the permit problem to a rational conclusion

Let's try to separate the questions involved without all the political and emotional appeals that have divided the school board for many years:

Our school district has long had many kinds of permits for out of district children. Some were for cultural and diversity, others for people who worked here and had a hardship in taking their kids to schools, another was for school or city employees and, the more recent, something called "opportunity" permits. Many of these are still in place, but not all.

The current debate is what to do with the "opportunity" permits. There is almost no disagreement: Even though there may be some financial benefits from permits issued to parents who live outside our city, and this money matter is open to debate, the program should be stopped. Understandably, parents who may well have made great sacrifices to find or keep a home in our community, can not look with favor on those who live outside the city and manage to place their children in our schools.

The whole idea of community schools, controlled by school boards elected by legal residents, is diminished by non-resident enrollment. On the other hand, sense of community does justify encouraging city staff, especially our police and fire personnel, to enroll, with board approval, their kids in city schools.

But what about the kids here because of the "opportunity" permits? These students did not enter illegally, the parents did not use some phony address to skirt our rules and many have become very involved and supportive of the school district. They played by the rules.

Maybe this was a big mistake, but that was not the fault of the parents and certainly not of the kids now in our schools. The only remaining issue is when and how the kids now in the program should be made to leave, if at all.

Compromises seldom please anyone, but a rational and human solution needs to be adopted, now. Some of the proposals would allow kids to complete certain grades in both elementary and high school. Not good enough and not sufficient, compassionate concern for the very innocent students whose educational lives would be disrupted.

Totally exempt from removal should be students with siblings in higher grades able to stay longer. Under no circumstances should we disrupt families. The second method would require intense counseling. Each permit student's family should be given the opportunity to argue for continuation.

If the student has issues with traveling to school, has not done well academically or has behavior problems, they should be "encouraged" to return to their own neighborhood school

Obviously, few permit parents will voluntarily agree to leave the district, but the effort should be made.

Although this is hard to argue, the financial impacts of either losing or gaining from out of district permits, should not be as important as the trauma of having to go to another school will be on the kids – the reason every effort should be made to allow those in the system to graduate.

Neither side on this issue has been all that responsible. Some of the wild accusations thrown at board members who want to abort the program have been far too acrimonious. On the other hand, kicking out kids who are here legally and who have not violated any rules is not something anyone can say with any degree of certainty is reflective of community attitudes. It's simply not in our traditions not to place all children's interests ahead

Nice note from the principal of the Good Shepherd School, **Terry Miller** who disputes some of last week's column about changes in both the school and the church.

Ms. Miller is the first lay (non-Nun) principal of Good Shepherd and, according to parents of the school, is both able and responsive. She said our report that the school will reduce grades and enrollment is not accurate. (We said that another nearby school would absorb these reduced grades.) However, parents with children in her school say this is not what they have heard.

The school principal also says that Good Shepherd Church will not be "merged" with St. Timothy's in West Los Angeles. Depends what you call "merge." True, according to the archdiocese, both will remain operative, but they will share one pastor. Sounds like a kind of merger to me.

Our report also said that Father Colm O'Ryan was retiring – some reported this was entirely voluntary and that he wanted to retire and other church members said he was being told to retire. Somewhere between the two is factual. I spoke to the veteran priest who was accepting the retirement, but he also told me it was the decision of the Cardinal. Father O'Ryan will continue to live on church property but his pastoral duties will be assumed by a priest not yet named.

One very positive note: Principal Miller wants the school to be more involved in the community and is anxious and willing to reach out, including an invitation to this

reporter to make a tour and visit.

Another positive note: The Church bulletin had some very strong words separating them from the views of the recently reconstructed English bishop who denied the holocaust. Good for them.

The Beverly High boys' soccer team completed its first season sweep of Santa Monica in Steve Rappaport's 21 seasons as coach with a 1-0 victory in an Ocean League game Friday at John Adams Middle School in Santa Monica.

Daniel Kohen scored on an estimated 35-yard free kick in the 53rd minute and goal-keeper Nathan Forrest made five saves, including what Rappaport described as "a great, diving save on a penalty kick with 10 minutes to play, for the shutout in his first game since suffering a knee injury Jan. 7 in a 2-1 loss to South Torrance.

The Normans (8-13-2, 4-4 in league play) led 6-5 in shots.

"We controlled the flow of the game," Rappaport said.

Kohen, Erik Munzer, Forrest, Will Byun and Charlie Kelman drew praise for their play from Rappaport.

Beverly Hills' 1-0 victory Jan. 21 at Nickoll

Field was their first over the Vikings since a 2-0 win in a South Torrance Tournament game in December 1991, Rappaport said.

The two teams did not play for nine seasons because they were in different leagues.

Rappaport said he was "basically" hired as coach after the Normans lost to Santa Monica 8-0 and 11-1 the preceding season and a change was needed "because of the embarrassment with Santa Monica."

#### Beverly Hills 4, Culver City 1

Munzer scored twice as the Normans played what Rappaport "definitely our best game of the season" in an Ocean League game at Nickoll Field Jan. 28.

Munzer scored his first goal in the 30th minute off Romeo Patroni's assist, nine minutes after Ryan Pugh opened the scoring for the Centaurs

Beverly Hills took the lead for good in the 48th minute when Kelman scored after steal-

ing the ball from Culver City goalkeeper Miguel Ramirez Romo.

Munzer scored his second goal in the 64th minute. Russell Sternshein scored for the Normans in the 80th minute off Kohen's assist

Beverly Hills led in shots 14-8. Norman goalkeeper Jonas Brock made seven saves, including making what Rappaport called an "incredible" save on 75th-minute penalty kick

"The whole team actually stepped up," Rappaport said. "We got into a rhythm definitely led by Munzer."

Kohen "had a great game," and Mariano Gonzalez was "spectacular in the midfield," said Rappaport, who also praised Kelman's play.

Beverly Hills led in shots 15-9. Brock made five saves.

In the second half, Sentinel goalkeeper Christian Guevara "made two great saves," Rappaport said.

"We just didn't have the luck of putting it in when we hit a good shot," Rappaport said. "Every opportunity they had, they put away."

Munzer, Kohen and Parsa Peykar drew praise from Rappaport for their play.

Josh Newman scored on a rebound in the 46th minute after the Normans allowed goals in the ninth and 36th minutes of an Ocean

league game at Hawthorne Feb. 4.

"In the first half, we were half a step slow," Rappaport said. "They completely controlled the first half.

"Second half was the opposite kind of game. We completely controlled the second half. Unfortunately, they scored two and we only scored one."

Beverly Hills led 11-8 in shots. Brock made six saves

Munzer and Willie Woods were "solid the whole game," and Newman "had a really good game," Rappaport said.

Beverly Hills was outshot, 12-6. Norman goalkeeper Rebecca Gold made 10 saves.


"Harding was definitely the player of the game," Beverly Hills coach Ryan Franks said. "Sweeper Emily Litvak had an excellent game."

# BEVERLY HILTON SUES SOUTHWEST HOMEOWNERS PRESIDENT FOR CAMPAIGNING AGAINST MEASURE H

## Suit seeks \$4 million in damages from Ken Goldman for alleged 'malpractice'

move, Oasis West Realty LLC, owner of The Beverly Hilton, is suing longtime Southwest Homeowners Association president attorney Ken Goldman for malpractice after he campaigned against the hotel's revitalplan ization "Measure H" more than two years after he was employed by the company to help gain approval

In a surprising

for the project.
The hotly contest-

ed Measure H successfully passed by a margin of 129 votes in November allowing The Beverly Hilton to add two condominium buildings and a Waldorf=Astoria hotel to the nine-acre property at the corner of Wilshire and Santa Monica boulevards.

But Oasis officials say they had to spend around \$4 million campaigning in favor of the measure to counteract its former attorney Goldman's efforts against the project and that the company has suffered from the "delay in commencement of the project." The company is seeking a minimum of \$4 million in damages.

The case is raising many complicated legal issues.

According to the complaint filed Jan. 30 by Oasis Realty's attorney Robert Barta, Goldman has engaged "in a series of acts of undeniable treachery and disloyalty" to the company after representing the Beverly Hilton in front of the City Council when seeking approval for the \$500 million expansion plan between 2004 and 2006.

Goldman says he has not been disloyal to Oasis and that the facts in the complaint are not totally accurate, but declined to comment further.

"I terminated my relationship with Oasis West two years before our City Council approved the project that became the subject of the referendum. After the Council's vote and referendum activities were begun by others, I simply exercised my rights as a citizen and resident of Beverly Hills. I did not

violate any duty of loyalty to Oasis West, or violate any duty to preserve the confidences of my former client," wrote Goldman in an e-mail. "I believe that this lawsuit against me and my law firm is without merit, and the case will be vigorously defended."

Oasis hired Goldman and his firm Reed Smith beginning in 2004 as counsel for obtaining amendments to the city's General Plan in connection with the Beverly Hilton redevelopment project. Goldman and his firm worked with the Hilton to gain approvals and entitlements for the project from the city Planning Commission, City Council and other officials until Spring 2006, when Goldman terminated his contract with Oasis for undisclosed reasons, according to the complaint.

The Hilton's project continued forward, without Goldman and Reed Smith, until it was approved with a 3-2 vote by the Beverly Hills City Council on May 12, 2008.

Shortly thereafter, Goldman along with dozens of other residents, and the Citizens Right to Decide Committee, voluntarily began campaigning against the Hilton project and successfully collected 2,574 valid signatures (more than the required 10 percent or 2,075 signatures of Beverly Hills registered voters) for a petition to put the project before the voters on the Nov. 4, 2008, presidential election ballot.

The complaint against Goldman includes as evidence a letter purportedly written and delivered by Goldman and his wife, Lori, to Southwest Homeowners Association members, which Goldman has previously estimated total around 450 homes, during the No on Measure H campaign.

"We stopped by to see if you would sign the Referendum Petition to overturn the City Council's recent approval of the Hilton plans," reads a portion of Goldman's letter included in the complaint.

"But for the disloyal conduct of Mr. Goldman and Reed Smith, Oasis would not have had to spend in excess of \$4 million to oppose the Petition and then to actively campaign for the approval of Measure 'H,' "reads the complaint. Other opponents of Measure H say they would have protested the project regardless of Goldman's involvement or opinion.

Oasis reported spending \$4.6 million for the "Yes on H" campaign in a 7,000-page campaign finance report filed with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder. Oasis paid Goldman and Reed Smith a total of \$60,000 for their services over two years, according to the complaint.

Oasis accuses Goldman and Reed Smith of "breach of fiduciary duty," "professional negligence" and "breach of contract."

"There is no more time-honored and fundamental responsibility owed by a lawyer to his client than the duty of absolute loyalty... This duty is so fundamental to the attorneyclient relationship that it survives even after the termination of the lawyer's engagement," reads the complaint before it accuses Goldman and his firm of violating that duty.

Legal analysts are split on the implications of the lawsuit. Some think the case raises ethical questions; others feel the suit is a clear-cut retribution against Goldman.

Loyola Law School professor Sande Buhai, who specializes in professional responsibility, said this could be a tricky case.

"Let's assume you're a lawyer working for Texaco or Exxon Mobil and you work to get them permits to drill. Then you quit your job and move to the beach, where you see dead baby animals from an oil spill. You have a change of heart. Are you then prevented from becoming an environmentalist?" said Buhai, who has not read a copy of the complaint. "We would allow that. But this is more specific, about a specific project."

On the other hand, Buhai added, lawyers have a duty to avoid even the appearance of impropriety.

According to American Bar Association guidelines, a lawyer can not do anything directly adverse to a client and can never reveal any confidential information from their client protected by attorney-client privilege. (Exceptions are made for lawyers who suspect a client intends to commit physical harm and, ironically, to defend yourself against a malpractice suit.)

"[Goldman] would not be allowed to do [what he did] if he were doing it for a client," said Buhai.

For instance, a lawyer who represents a client in getting environmental permits to build a shopping center can not later represent neighboring residents seeking to oppose the rezoning based on those environmental permits, according to a model rule from the American Bar Association, which judges can use for guidance in deciding cases.

But as an individual, Goldman may be protected by his first amendment right to free

speech.

This case could hinge on an examination of "balancing rights as an individual versus your duties as a professional," according to Buhai

First amendment attorney Doug Mirell, of the law firm Loeb and Loeb, sees the case in another way.

"This seems to be a fairly classic SLAPP [Strategic Lawsuit Against Public Participation] suit," said Mirell, who did not have a chance to read the complaint. A SLAPP statue is a "law that prevents someone from stifling others first amendment rights by requiring the plaintiff to prove essentials of the case" before the suit can proceed.

The statute was passed as a result of *Okun v. Superior Court*, which involved the late Erwin Okun of Beverly Hills, and others, after they protested the proposed use of the city's municipal land in the Industrial Area for private businesses in the late 1970s and early '80s.

"If all [Goldman] did is engage in conduct any ordinary citizen could have engaged in, without using his specialized legal expertise," he would be covered by the SLAPP statue, Mirell says. But if Goldman used his "legal expertise" while protesting the project, he may be held accountable. "Employment doesn't always have to be monetary."

Oasis Realty's lawsuit could have what Mirell called a "chilling effect," in which other citizen groups are intimidated from publicly protesting other projects by threat of a law suit. It's a key effect the SLAPP statute hopes to prevent.

Some speculate hiring Goldman was another way for Oasis to increase quiet acquiescence to the project.

"Oasis understood that Mr. Goldman's statement and opinions on City development matters bore significant influence on City Council member and the local citizenry, in particular, with the members of SHOA [Southwest Homeowners Association], whose members are particularly outspoken with regard to matters of development," according to the complaint.

Oasis lawyer Barta would not comment and Beverly Hilton spokesperson Marie Garvey said she could not comment on pending litigation.

Goldman has not yet filed a legal response to the suit.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 09-O-2563**

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING SECTIONS 10-3-2409, 10-3-2509, AND 10-3-2610 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PERMISSIBLE ENCROACHMENTS INTO SIDE YARDS, STREET SIDE YARDS, AND REAR YARDS IN SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONES, AND AMENDING SECTION 10-3-3600 REGARDING MINOR ACCOMMODATIONS THAT MAY BE **GRANTED** 

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVER-LY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It has come to the attention of

the City that in various households there is a need to provide assisted vertical accessibility in singlefamily homes. Occasionally this need comes in conflict with the setback standards in single-family residential areas. This ordinance accommodates this need by allowing elevator and elevator enclosures to encroach into required side yards, street side yards, and rear yards of existing residences. It is the goal and objective of this ordinance to preserve the quality of life of the community's residents by providing greater flexibility for adding elevators to existing single-family residences, thus providing aging and other residents with the opportunity to enhance accessibility and continue residing in their homes while balancing these accessibility needs with neighbors' interests with respect to light, air, tranquility, and privacy.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Planning Commission

considered the zone text amendment set forth in this Ordinance at a duly-noticed public hearing on December 11, 2008. Evidence, both written and oral was presented during the hearing. After considering the evidence, discussing the ordinance, and providing direction to staff regarding revisions to same, the Planning Commission recommended that the City Council adopt an Ordinance substantially similar to this Ordinance.

The City Council considered Section 3. this Ordinance at a duly noticed public hearing on January 6, 2009. Evidence, both written and oral, was presented during the hearing.

This Ordinance institutes Section 4. minor alterations in land use limitations which do not result in changes in land use or density. It would only allow minor encroachments into side and rear yards. This Ordinance therefore quali-fies as a Class 5 exemption pursuant to Section 15305 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations and is thus exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.

Section 5. City Council hereby adds a new Paragraph K to Section 10-3-2409 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding permissible encroachments in side yards, street side yards, and rear yards in the Central Area of Beverly Hills to read as follows:

Elevators and elevator enclosures, provided the following criteria are met:

- The subject residence is not a newlyconstructed building. "Newly-constructed building" shall mean a building that has been constructed within the past five (5) years or remodeled more than fifty percent (50%) during the past five (5) years as described in Section 10-3-4100 of this Chapter.
- 2. The length of the encroachment measured parallel to the property line does not exceed seven feet (7'), except that for lots located north of Santa Monica Boulevard a minor accommodation permit may be issued to allow a greater length. In order to approve the minor accommodation permit, the reviewing authority must find that the encroachment will not have an adverse impact on:
  - The scale and massing of the streetscape.
  - (2) Neighbors' access to light and air,
  - Neighbors' privacy, and
  - The garden quality of the (4)City.
- The aggregate length of the encroachment of the elevator and elevator enclosure together with a fireplace encroaching into the same setback, pursuant to Paragraph E above, does not exceed thirteen feet (13'), except pur-

suant to a minor accommodation permit issued pursuant to Paragraph K.2.;

- The encroachment is not closer than three feet (3') from the front of the building;
- The elevator and elevator enclosure does not have any windows;
- Noise generated by the elevator complies with City noise regulations set forth in Article 2 of Chapter 1 of Title 5 of this Municipal Code:
- The elevator and enclosure is designed to be compatible with the existing residence in color, material and design.
- The encroachment into the setback 8. does not exceed the following, provided that a minimum setback of three feet (3') shall be maintained in all cases:
  - Thirty inches (30"), or
- b. Sixty inches (60") if a minor accommodation permit pursuant to Article 36 of this chapter is issued. In order to approve the minor accommodation permit, the reviewing authority must find that the encroachment will not have an adverse impact on:
  - The scale and massing of the (1) streetscape.
  - (2) Neighbors' access to light and air.
  - (3)Neighbors' privacy, and
  - The garden quality of the City.'

City Council hereby adds a Section 6. new Paragraph K to Section 10-3-2509 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding permissible encroachments in side yards, street side yards, and rear yards in the Hillside Area of Beverly Hills to read as follows:

- Elevators and elevator enclosures, provided the following criteria are met:
- 1. The subject residence is not a newly-constructed building. "Newly-constructed building" shall mean a building that has been constructed within the past five (5) years or remodeled more than fifty percent (50%) during the past five (5) years as described in Section 10-3-4100 of this Chapter.
- The length of the encroachment measured parallel to the property line does not exceed seven feet (7'), except that a minor accommodation permit may be issued to allow a greater length. In order to approve the minor accommodation permit, the reviewing authority must find that the encroachment will not have an adverse impact on:
  - The scale and massing of the

- streetscape, (2) Neighbors' access to light
- and air. Neighbors' privacy, and
- (4) The garden quality of the Citv.
- The aggregate length of the encroachment of the elevator and elevator enclosure together with a fireplace encroaching into the same setback, pursuant to Paragraph E above, does not exceed thirteen feet (13'), except pursuant to a minor accommodation permit issued pursuant to Paragraph K.2.;
- The encroachment is not closer than three feet (3') from the front of the building;
- The elevator and elevator enclosure does not have any windows;
- Noise generated by the elevator complies with City noise regulations set forth in Article 2 of Chapter 1 of Title 5 of this Municipal Code;
- The elevator and enclosure is designed to be compatible with the existing residence in color, material and design.
- The encroachment into the setback 8. does not exceed the following, provided that a minimum setback of three feet (3') shall be maintained in all cases:
- Thirty inches (30"), or a.
- Sixty inches (60") if a minor accommodation permit pursuant to Article 36 of this chapter is issued. In order to approve the minor accommodation permit, the reviewing authority must find that the encroachment will not have an adverse impact on:
  - (1) The scale and massing of the streetscape,
  - (2) Neighbors' access to light and air,
  - Neighbors' privacy, and
  - (4)The garden quality of the City.

Section 7. City Council hereby adds a new Paragraph K to Section 10-3-2610 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code immediately following paragraph J, and preceding the concluding paragraph of Section 10-3-2610 which shall remain in place with no amendment. The new Paragraph K relates to permissible encroachments in side yards, street side yards, and rear yards in the Trousdale Area of Beverly Hills, and shall read as follows:

Elevators and elevator enclosures, provided the following criteria are met:

The subject residence is not a newly-

constructed building. "Newly-constructed building" shall mean a building that has been constructed within the past five (5) years or remodeled more than fifty percent (50%) during the past five (5) years as described in Section 10-3-4100 of this Chapter.

The length of the encroachment measured parallel to the property line does not exceed seven feet (7'), except that a minor accommodation permit may be issued for a greater length. In order to approve the minor accommodation permit, the reviewing authority must find that the encroachment will not have an adverse impact

> The scale and massing of the streetscape,

Neighbors' access to light and air.

Neighbors' privacy, and (3) The garden quality of the City.

The aggregate length of the encroachment of the elevator and elevator enclosure together with a fireplace encroaching into the same setback, pursuant to Paragraph E above, does not exceed thirteen feet (13'), except pursuant to a minor accommodation permit issued pursuant to Paragraph K.2.;

The encroachment is not closer than three feet (3') from the front of the building;

The elevator and elevator enclosure does not have any windows;

Noise generated by the elevator complies with City noise regulations set forth in Article 2 of Chapter 1 of Title 5 of this Municipal Code;

The elevator and enclosure is designed to be compatible with the existing residence in color, material and design.

The encroachment into the setback does not exceed the following, provided that a minimum setback of three feet (3') shall be maintained in all cases:

Thirty inches (30"), or Sixty inches (60") if a minor accommob. dation permit pursuant to Article 36 of this chapter is issued. In order to approve the minor accommodation permit, the reviewing authority must find that the encroachment will not have an adverse impact on:

(1) The scale and massing of the streetscape,

(2) Neighbors' access to light and air.

Neighbors' privacy, and

The garden quality of the City.

City Council hereby adds Section 8. Paragraph T to Section 10-3-3600 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding minor accommodations that may be granted to read as follows:

Subsections 10-3-2409K, 10-3-2509K, and 10-3-2610K regarding elevator encroachments into a side or rear setback in R-1 zones."

Section 9. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be remain in full force and effect.

Section 10. Publication. City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and his certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 11. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its

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
