



New Council, New Perspectives

Mirisch votes against Chinese Sister City expenditure By Diana Vu

In her first formal meeting as Mayor Nancy Krasne guided the council through permit parking, a number of new city ordinances, efficient spending, and a Sister City program in China.

The city was reminded that Beverly once again, received a National AAA Bond rating based on fiscal management and strength in finances. Beverly Hills stands with Santa Monica, as the only two cities in California with the high-status ranking.

The rating lowers the interest rate for the city, makes financing the cost of infrastructure less, and creates an easier route to attain financing in these tough economic times. Only 20 cities in the country currently

have such a rating.

Through audits, the City Manager has cre-

ated cost-effective practices such as combining departments, and "training the trainers." As reported by Assistant City Manager Katie Lichtig, statistics from Tuesday's meeting show as much as \$8.45 in returns for every dollar invested.

In a discussion regarding the Beverly Hills Re-Branding Initiative, Krasne expressed her concern for the use of the city seal versus the city shield.

Krasne stated she liked the shield, but wanted the council's logo to be different from the Chamber of Commerce, whose shield is the same, but with a three-dimensional effect.

"With the seal comes weight. It's traditional, official, and it means something. When I send out an important letter, I want the seal. Just like when I receive a letter from Obama or Eisenhower, there is a seal on it. If I receive a letter from the White House, there's a White House on it, but no seal," said Krasne.

The shield, which has been branded on over 3,500 street signs, apparel, and vehicles, is a modern take on the Beverly Hills brand.

The seal is the traditional seal that dates back to 1914. It pictures among many things, a golden star, flag, state flag, and eagle.

Councilmember Barry Brucker said that he felt the seal was too cluttered and didn't capture the essence of Beverly Hills.

"I have been around the world with this

shield, and people recognize it. People want to take pictures with me because of it," said Brucker.

Councilmember Jimmy Delshad agreed with the look of the shield, but worried about synchronization and cohesiveness among the members.

Brien and Mirisch remained neutral on the issue.

After deliberation, the council agreed to place the shield on all business cards, with the option to use the official seal on letterhead

Mirisch expressed his concern in regards to the Sister City Program with Pudong, China. He addressed human rights issues and believed the city was just another suburb of Shanghai.

"I've been to Shanghai and I've been to Pudong. It's a suburb, it would be like being a sister city with the Bronx. To me it just does not fit the image of Beverly Hills," said Mirisch.

He responded to Brucker stating he would

like more information about the program and what it will bring to the city.

"I understand we want to attract interest, and I am for that. But it is a special honor to be a Sister City with Beverly Hills and in this case I don't feel it is appropriate. I don't believe it is a good fit.

Brucker continues to support the program and believes it will attract high Chinese clientele towards Beverly Hills hotels and businesses

Funding for Beverly Hills Global Partners was approved months ago, Tuesday's meeting agreed to provide the second supplement of 25,000 dollars.

"We are already committed to this, and we don't want to cause problems. It's water under the bridge right now," said Delshad. "We do this one, and then we can discuss more and take a step back in May."

Krasne said this issue should have an ambassador title, and stated the council will discover if there will be a return on the City's investment.

The applicant is proposing to expand the showroom on 9250 Beverly Boulevard into the canopy service drive area within the existing footprint of the building to create additional exhibit space for Mercedes Benz vehicles. No changes are proposed at the Mercedes Benz service facility located at 400 Foothill Road. A 1,996 square-foot area on the ground floor of the 9250 Beverly Boulevard building that is currently used for vehicle service will be converted to six parking spaces to serve the building.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City, and an addendum to the Negative Declaration for the existing Conditional Use Permit has been prepared since the proposed project will not result in new significant environmental effects.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING SECTIONS 10-3-2450, 10-3-2451, 10-3-2455, AND 10-3-3601 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF DISCRETIONARY REVIEW AUTHORITY OF SPECIFIC TYPES OF APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS IN THE SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONES IN THE CENTRAL AREA OF THE CITY FROM THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO THE DESIGN REVIEW COMMISSION

The City Council will consider draft amendments to specific sections of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code within the single-family residential zone, in the Central area of the City listed as follows:

- A. Central R-1 permit to establish vehicular entrance width and orientation for garages (BHMC Sec. 10-3-2450A);
- B. Central R-1 permit to establish the cumulative coverage of the maximum potential façade permitted for architectural projections that encroach into the front yard (BHMC Sec. 10-3-2450D);
- C. Central R-1 permit to establish standards for placement of windows above a second story facing a street south of Santa Monica Boulevard (BHMC Sec. 10-3-2450E);
- D. Central R-1 permit to establish the maximum encroachment into a front yard for eaves and plant-on accents when the primary dwelling encroaches into the front yard by the maximum amount (BHMC Sec. 10-3-2450G) and,
- E. Minor Accommodation permit for the amount of front yard paving permitted, in the Central area of the City (BHMC Sec. 10-3-3600 C).

The proposed ordinance would amend the City's ordinances to change the reviewing authority over certain permit types from the Planning Commission to the Design Review Commission, and thus constitutes an organizational or administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. The review process and the discretionary nature of the permits at issue will not change, only the body responsible for considering and acting on such permit applications will change. As such, this activity is not a project for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15378 (b)(5). Further, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that amendments to the Beverly Hills Municipal Code will have a significant effect on the environment. The proposed amendments are administrative and procedural in effect, and maintain existing discretionary review processes of certain application and requirements on certain developments in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare. Therefore, as a separate and independent ground, the proposed amendments are exempt from the environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.



Roxbury Park renovations to be presented to City Council

The Recreation and Parks commission is focusing on moving forward with plans to renovate Roxbury Park based on direction from City Council.

The park's Master Plan was developed in reaction to amenities that have been supported by the public and approved by City Council.

According to Steve Zoet, Assistant Director of Community Services, City staff is recommending renovation in two phases. Phase I includes a new community center with a multi-use gymnasium, public meeting rooms, exercise room, library, café, and stage.

In addition, staff offices and a venue for senior citizen functions will also be available.

Phase II will address park improvements to athletic fields, park grounds, and other building such as the Ranger Station and Club House.

"The existing community center [at Roxbury Park] is approximately 60 years old. Although it has undergone some cosmetic upgrades through the years, the space is somewhat limiting. More practical, functional spaces that meets today's needs and demands are desired," said Zoet.

The committee is scheduled to meet with City Council in May to discuss further details and present funding options and opportunities.

At that time, the City will provide direction

on planning and design. The city is not committed to construction presently, but is prepared to assess park priorities based on timing and funding.

The commission will continue to listen to the opinions and needs of the community at monthly Recreation and Parks meetings. The commission also receives input though youth sports organizations.

If plan is approved, planning and construction will take at least 18 months.

"The community would have access to a larger, more modern facility that offers the opportunity to greatly expand services and be more responsive to their needs and interests. At present, space limitations restrict our ability to grow programs that are successful or to introduce new programs that the public has requested," said Zoet.

Peggy Kaus, Vice President of the Beverly Angeles Homeowners Association, and lives at the perimeter of the park, disagrees with the changes.

"I don't want a massive building in the park. The park is beautiful the way that it is because it is a natural oasis and place to relax. What they're doing is not rejuvenation, it's destruction," said Kaus.

According to Kaus, many residents surrounding the park agree with her argument.

"A park is supposed to be green and full of trees, not a building and parking lot," said Kaus.

Will Rogers Park, Beverly Gardens, and La Cienega Parks have had recent improvements, and Greystone Park is undergoing review for the possible inclusion of a catering kitchen, landscaping, and ground work. Additional improvements are being considered for Hammel Park.

Fun and games at City Hall

As new council takes control By Rudy Cole

Permit me to coin an elegant maxim: "If may have missed. Some months back the it ain't broke, why fix it?" city retained the services of an outside con-

For reasons so convoluted, so lacking in reason or good governance, the city is about to decimate a Beverly Hills institution that has never functioned more effectively in the public interest: The Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce.

Actually, the dirty little secret deal is about to happen in this way: The Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce and the Conference and Visitor's Bureau will be separated. Since the city provides funding for the CVB and that agency works in the offices and with Chamber staff, it is the Chamber that will face cuts so severe it will never be the same.

Does this make any sense? Not in the least. So, why are so many well intentioned and able people actually participating in the immolation? Power politics at its worst, and some not so smart decisions by both sides, and there are two, of this debacle.

In case you just tuned in, some scenes you

may have missed. Some months back the city retained the services of an outside consulting firm to "audit" the work of the Chamber and also consider whether separating the charge of promoting tourism should be handled by a separate entity or even placed directly under the control of the city.

Some months before this, the Chamber became embroiled in a nasty battle with the owner and publisher of the Beverly Hills Courier, **Clifton Smith**.

Smith was denied membership on the Chamber's board of directors and it is moderately safe to say he did not take this lightly.

Not only has he carried on an editorial campaign against the Chamber, he has made it a personal tussle with the Chamber's top hired gun: **Dan Walsh.**

Smith has made it clear he wants Walsh "fired." However, the decisions that led to this confrontation are hardly those of Walsh alone. They are the actions of the board of

directors of the Chamber whose membership includes some of our brightest and most able business leaders. Smith needs to take his fight to the board and not Walsh.

But boy did they goof. For the record, Smith did not actually apply for a seat on the board of directors, he was invited to do so by a former Chamber president. When I first reported on this mini-war, Smith called me to give me his side of the story and, after checking, I found out he was correct. However, the result was the same and it certainly led to his anger: He was denied board membership or he may have refused because of board conditions.

There were other issues: The Courier was not pleased with a Chamber relationship with a magazine that competed with the Courier, and The Weekly for that matter, for advertising. Smith felt this was unfair competition, and on a visit by the economic development arm of the Chamber to New York, Smith was kept out of some meetings with tourist and business executives.

Now, the Chamber leadership and board may have very legitimate problems in working with Smith as a person. They feel he uses his paper to bully those with whom he has differences and would be a disruptive board member.

But those were not the reasons given: The Chamber argued that a newspaper publisher should not be on the board for two supposed reasons:

He or she would want to use the position to sell advertising and would have access to internal discussions that might not be ready for prime time.

Both arguments lack merit. All board members have some economic interest in the community, whether to sell cars or obtain clients for a law firm. Perfectly reasonable goals. Why single out newspapers?

As for "insider" information, are there any real secrets in our village? Also, publishers, and reporters too, attend meetings with the clear understanding that the session is "off the record" and we can either stay and accept that or leave and not participate.

The Chamber should also have checked some history. There have been newspaper publishers on past Chamber boards for decades. **Dave Heyler**, publisher of the Beverly Hills Citizen, was a board member as were **Walter Harris**, co-publisher of the Beverly Hills Post and former Courier owner and publisher **March Schwartz**, who served at least two terms on the board.

Smith, and for that matter, The Weekly publisher **Josh Gross**, both should have been asked to serve on the Chamber board of directors. There are few Chambers in America that don't have newspaper publishers on their board.

Wiser, calmer heads could have avoided all of the agony this has caused, including an incendiary, mean spirited attack on a councilmember during the last council election.

On the other hand, this Chamber, and Walsh and his staff deserve considerable credit for their good works, has more valuable programs, from economic summits to organizing a first ever South Beverly Drive merchants association to an annual health fair and many more member support activities than ever in its history. Ironically, it is also Walsh's expertise in tourism that made him such a good fit for a Chamber that led both business and visitor enhancement programs. If and when the separation occurs, Walsh would be lost to this work.

True, there are issues. The Chamber has, at least in my opinion, made some other mistakes: Giving the staff titles of president, vice president etc, and making the leadership use chairperson and vice chair was not a good fit for our city. Arguing, that this was the practice in "other" cities doesn't wash, especially when you also argue that Beverly Hills is too unique to separate the two agencies: You can't have it both ways.

The Chamber also lacks involvement by the major department stores, is too loaded with professionals and not merchant leaders, even though many are highly skilled, and is a toothless tiger when fighting to save itself. Facing near deconstruction, the board leadership seems strangely muted.

So, what will happen? First, and back to the independent audit, although it cited both advantages and problems with separating the Chamber and the CVB, there was no clear recommendation in their study. If the separation occurs, the Chamber will not be the same, jobs will have to be cut, their building either leased or sold and major programs cut. This is hardly in the public interest.

There is a committee working to carry out what is a council mandate: Separation. How this committee came to be formed is worth a whole column. Supposedly, it was "self appointed" a euphemism that can only mean the process did not violate the Brown Act. The members of the committee are among our most knowledgeable, the gms of our hotels, some restaurateurs, a representative of the Rodeo Drive Committee and a pr professional, and this latter appointment also disturbed the Courier.

It is probably far too late for cooler heads to prevail. But a compromise could both save the Chamber and the CVB from government control.

The elected leaders of the Chamber and the appointed members of the hospitality industry should try to talk to Smith and Gross and invite them to serve on both boards – and while not separating the two agencies, they should have different board members all under the general management of whoever is the chief exec of the Chamber, and if some leadership and comprise is shown by all those involved, including members of the city council, that could still be Walsh

The split is going to create a loss of services we can not even begin to afford in the middle of our economic crisis. Come on guys, put aside petty differences and do this for the community.


The city council took its act back to their own chambers Tuesday after an out of city hall try out at the Motion Picture Academy, and newly installed Mayor Nancy Krasne

ran a fairly smooth meeting with some amusing side battles – she wanted a more distinctive logo for the mayor and not business cards or stationary that was the same as lowly staff members.

Councilmember **Barry Brucker** at first balked at Krasne's logo hopes, citing a critical budget short fall as far more critical than business card designs, but the council decided this was one battle it might avoid and agreed to a separate design for the mayor's tools. After all, Krasne cited the president and the White House where President Obama has separate stationary.

On a more serious note, the council came within inches of violating the Brown Act. A group of irate residents of Trousdale appeared at the council to demand action on trees on many area homes that have grown so high they block their views, one reason they moved to Trousdale.

Reasonable problem and one the city should address. But when some members of the council began to try to solve the problem by giving "direction" to the Planning

Replacement of stop-and-go signals with countdown signals was approved earlier this year by City Council.

Turteltaub has the unscripted genre to thank for his second primetime series as a producer.

tour. "This is a huge roll of the dice. It's something that's never been done."

"Harper's Island," which premieres tonight at 10 p.m. on CBS with an episode directed by Turteltaub, is a murder mystery about a group of family and friends who travel to a secluded island for a destination wedding. CBS promises that "Harper's Island" will run for 13 consecutive weeks and by the conclusion July 2, "all questions will be answered, the killer will be revealed and only a few will survive."

This is the second foray into network series television for Turteltaub, best known as the director of such films as "Cool Runnings," "While You Sleeping," "Phenomenon," "National Treasure" and its sequel "National Treasure: Book of Secrets."

"I think it's much harder to do a television show than a feature," Turteltaub said. "It's like the lottery doing TV. If you make the movie, you make the movie and it's going to show. You do a TV pilot, they may not pick it up.

Then you do a series and it gets canceled."

Turteltaub's first network series was "Jericho," which was canceled by CBS in 2007 after its first season, then given a second season after a campaign by its fans. However, ratings remained low and it was canceled for a second and final time.

Turtletaub said the experience with "Jericho" did not dissuade him from producing a second series.

"Almost every television show ends badly," said Turteltaub, whose father Saul produced such series as "That Girl," "Sanford and Son" and "Kate & Allie." "There's a handful of shows that don't get canceled. The potential for disappointment is huge, but I think it's a really fun, creative way to make a living."

"Harper's Island" has a second tie to Beverly Hills. Tyler Bensinger, who graduated from Hawthorne School in 1976, a year before Turteltaub, is also one of its executive producers

The Weekly's Exclusive Interview with President Bijan Nahai By Diana Vu

Tell us about the Magbit Foundation.

The Magbit Foundation is a charitable organization that started approximately 20 years ago. Its purpose is to provide interest-free loans to college students who have obtained admittance to universities in Israel. The foundation has given over 9,500 loans and we assist approximately 500 students each school year. As the students graduate and enter the workforce, they would then repay the loans that the foundation had provided them.

Essentially, what we now see is an organization that has approximately \$7 million in circulation. And 97 percent of the loans that we have extended have been repaid. Certainly these students are worthy of the donation and take their education seriously.

There isn't a deadline, but they know that within a reasonable period of their graduation, once they've entered the workforce, they will begin to pay the loans back either in full sum or installments.

They all are very respecting of the fact that we make financial possibilities for them to take on a graduate education.

Do you provide loans for students in the United States as well?

Our mission is to assist [Iranian-Jewish] students for obtaining admittance for universities in Israel. We do not extend loans to those who do not qualify for financial aid. We pre-screen from numerous universities in Israel, to make sure these individuals are in need of financial assistance.

Many of them, although they have been admitted into the university, cannot afford to pursue their studies. Hence, we review applications to determine whether or not there is an actual need.

How do you determine who receives the loans?

All the universities that we sponsor, which are all the major universities in Israel, are required to send out applications prior to the commencement of the school year. We then have a committee at the Magbit Foundation that reviews all of those applications for student loans.

There are poignant questions in those applications and they have to meet certain financial situations. The universities do some of the pre-screening for us. They make sure that the applications that are sent to us are

legitimate.

It becomes an approval process for us. We then determine whether or not we believe the students qualify.

Are there any other Magbit Foundations in the US?

We are the only Magbit Foundation in the US, here in Beverly Hills.

We also have a Youth

division. They set up functions on their own; get the young people to mingle. This group also brings awareness of the work of the Magbit foundation and support the foundation itself. It strives to get the youth to rally and have their own events to support the foundation.

We recently appointed a new president for the Young Leadership Division, her name is Jennifer Ghadishah. They division will be having a mixer later this month, and the annual Comedy Fest will held this summer. Their website is www.youngmagbit.org.

The events are really useful, and translate to acquaintances, friends, and even marriages. It really prepares the next generation to take the reigns of the Magbit Foundation.

You are also involved in the insurance business, how did you become involved in that?

My family owned the largest privately held insurance company in Iran. I became a graduate of the London Insurance Institute, I then went back to Iran and joined by father and uncle with the insurance company and ran the international division.

In 1979, they nationalized the insurance industry in Iran, therefore they nationalized our company without

any compensation and because of our ethnic backgrounds and high profile, and it was not a safe haven for us to remain in Iran.

That was when we ventured into the United States. After time, and after we realized this was our permanent home, I then established a brokerage by the name of Nahai Insurance services here in Beverly Hills back in 1980.

Tell us about your family.

I have been married for 36 years to Mahnaz [Nahai]. I have a daughter [Azita Nahai] who is getting her doctorate in human development and I have a son [Shahrad Nahai] who is a graduate of Boston University majoring in finance.

He joined a firm about 8 years ago and now has taken the reigns of being our chief operating officer. He will be overseeing much of the technology that our business requires as well as consult.

What sparked your interest in becoming a part of the Foundation?

There use to be a Magbit Foundation in Iran, which was headed by my father. It had a different mission statement, and rather than loans, it was more about fundraising for different causes in Israel. My father, being a huge philanthropist, instilled in us as kids, the worthiness of being involved in charity.

As such, I saw education as very integral and important, and Magbit was the right fit. I have been involved directly and indirectly for approximately 19 years. I've been president for the past three years.

We've made some great strides, and taken on new universities. Our growth and expansion with universities has been very encouraging, as well as the level of fundraising that we've been able to accomplish.

Tell us more about the Board of Directors that you work with.

[Vice Mayor] Jimmy Delshad is the chair, and I work with a diverse group of people. Real estate developers, people involved in the manufacturing field, and people who have brought in their energy to assist with new ideas and thoughts.

Fortunately, we've had a very active board, one comprised of successful business people in the community.

Soloman Gabbay, Mr. and Mrs. Parviz Nazarian, Ebby Simhaee, all these people are specific individuals who have made tremendous impact on the organization

What is one of the biggest accomplishments you've seen from your time as president?

We took it upon ourselves to honor an individual who has been successful and not only in philanthropy, but in business. We introduced this concept to honor individuals with the Humanitarian Award at the Gala during my presidency. This year's recipient is

This has attracted a great following, because people love to come see one of their own honored. That has created more awareness for Magbit and has increased the number of participants at our event.

Tell us more about the Gala coming up in May.
