



PROJECT: 9000 Wilshire Boulevard Commercial Project

The City of Beverly Hills has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIR) for a proposed commercial office project located at <u>9000 Wilshire Boulevard</u> as more fully described below. The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to review the Draft EIR on <u>January 26, 2017 at 1:30 p.m.</u>, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. The purpose of this meeting is to review the content and adequacy of the Draft EIR. The merits of the project will not be discussed at this meeting, and no decisions will be made with regard to the Planning Commission's approval or denial of the project. At a future date, a separate, noticed public hearing will be held by the Planning Commission to review the merits of the proposed project and take action on the approval or denial of a Development Plan Review Permit for the project.

Project Location: The property is located in the City of Beverly Hills, at the southwest corner of the intersection of Wilshire Boulevard and S. Almont Drive. The 15,876-square foot site consists of two parcels that are currently developed with two commercial retail buildings and a paved parking lot. The address for the project site is 9000-9010 Wilshire Boulevard, and the Assessor's Parcel Numbers are 4331-028-003 and 4331-028-004.

Project Description: The proposed project would involve demolition of the existing commercial buildings and the removal of the paved parking lot. The two-story building on the east side of the site is currently occupied by an antique/art shop, and the one-story building on the west side of the site consists of three retail spaces that are occupied by a café, vape shop/lounge, and an insurance office. After demolition, a new commercial office development with a 14,558 square-foot building footprint would be constructed, which would consist of three stories of commercial office development (for a total of 31,702 square-feet of floor area) and four levels of subterranean parking. The project would also include a rooftop lunchroom, drought-tolerant landscape, bike storage, and a total of 91 on-site

parking spaces. The project would be 45 feet in height plus an additional 15 feet due to the proposed rooftop structures and would have a floor area ratio (FAR) of approximately 2.0. The project site is currently zoned C-3 for general commercial uses, and the proposed use of the site for a commercial office development would not require amendments to the City's General Plan or the Beverly Hills Municipal Code.

Environmental Review: In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City of Beverly Hills has prepared a Draft EIR to analyze potential environmental impacts associated with development of the project. Specifically, the Draft EIR analyzes the following potentially significant environmental effects of the project:

• Cultural and Tribal Resources

• Transportation and Traffic

Based on the studies in the Draft EIR, with mitigation, no significant environmental effects are anticipated regarding transportation and traffic as a result of the project. However, environmental effects to cultural resources would remain significant and unavoidable after implementation of required mitigation.

The project site does not appear on the Hazardous Waste and Substances site "Cortese" list.

Public Review and Comment on Draft EIR: The Draft EIR is being circulated for the required 45-day public review period, from January 6, 2017 to February 20, 2017. Written comments must be submitted during the comment period, and should be addressed to:

Pinhas Rahav, have been participating in a weekly community soccer game for over 10 years; however, the team has recently begun to encounter police officers asking them to leave the fields during the early hours of the

"There is no park in Beverly Hills for adult soccer," Newmark told the Weekly. "They should have a place to play [in the City]. It's the place where they own their house and it's where they pay taxes.'

According to Community Services Director Nancy Hunt Coffey, the BHUSD can issue permits for field use at its discretion. Permit applications are available on bhusd.org under "Civic Center Rentals." The online application states fair market value charges \$100 per hour and nonprofit rentals run at \$60 per hour.

"Beverly Vista is school district property, so the school has first use priority during the day and for after school activities," Hunt Coffey said. "The City has second use [priority] of the field, which typically goes to AYSO, other youth soccer groups, or any other city camps, [activities] like that."

Pickup games are permitted when the group is made up of six individuals or less. Groups of six or more are required to obtain a permit, according to Recreation Services Manager Teri Angel.

"We have the permit process in place as a result of the [Joint Powers Agreement] so that [residents] can use the fields," Hunt-Coffey said. "In a lot of other cities on the weekends, you'll see the schools are locked up so no one can use them."

Hakim explained to the Council that the

self-organized men's team would like to be able to continue holding their weekly soccer game from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Sundays.

"I've called and asked for a permit, [but I] keep getting miscellaneous excuses," Hakim said during the meeting.

Angel told the Weekly the demand for field use is high and access is low.

"Field space is extremely tight and difficult," Angel said. "We try to accommodate as much as we can."

At the Council meeting, it was also suggested that the new turf field at Beverly Vista is not durable for adults.

"The school district has rules for the use of the K-8 field," Hunt-Coffey said. "They are to be used by individuals who are 13 [years old] and younger. Some adults have come forward [and they] want to play on those fields, [but the City and the school district] want to keep them in shape because they are brand new.'

Adult soccer players are encouraged to join the City's league, for players 18 years of age and up, which begins in February and runs through May, following the AYSO



Bott received a seat as a delegate, but lost the position of Executive Board candidate by five votes to Progressive nominee Sue Himmelrich.

Known for her far left views on domestic policy, Winograd is an outspoken opponent of Israel.

Waxman responded to Winograd's comments in a fundraising letter for Harman, "In Marcy's Winograd's foreign policy, Israel would cease to exist. In Marcy Winograd's vision, Jews would be at the mercy of those who do not respect democracy or human rights."

Himmelrich and McKeown currently serve as Santa Monica councilmembers. Horvath is a councilmember in West Hollywood.

In May, the delegates will attend the 2017 California Democrats State Convention in Sacramento.

City Council not ready to move forward with Golden Triangle Apparel licensing agreement

The City Council addressed some concerns during Tuesday's study session regarding a proposed license agreement with Golden Triangle Apparel.

The proposed agreement is for a four-year contract to design and manufacture Beverly Hills shield branded apparel, headwear and accessories such as t-shirts, sweatshirts, hats and swimwear, according to the staff report.

The licensing agreement was recommended to the Council by CMG Brands, which provides exclusive licensing representation to the City.

Councilmember Julian Gold pointed out a

Golden Triangle Apparel will pay the City a non-refundable guarantee of \$100,000 against future royalties over the next two years, according to the staff report. \$25,000 is payable upon execution of the agreement and \$75,000 is payable by December 31, 2018.

Royalty fees to the City are 10 percent of the licensee's wholesale selling price, if sold at wholesale, or five percent of the retail price, if sold directly by licensee to consumers.

CMG Brands will receive 31.5 percent of the payments received on behalf of the City under the license agreement.

"In terms of the royalty figures that are being purposed, I think they're too low," said Councilmember Lili Bosse. "It says [the City] would only get five percent of retail and the numbers don't skew in our favor in any way with that."

The Council was not ready to move forward with granting a license to Golden Triangle Apparel and asked that it return as an agenda item.

Traffic & Parking begins developing Bicycle-Pedestrian Mobility Master Plan

The Traffic and Parking Commission began developing a Bicycle-Pedestrian Mobility Master Plan during its first meeting of the New Year on Wednesday, Jan. 5.

The City's original Bicycle Master Plan was adopted in 1977, and was included in the 2010 General Plan Appendices as a free standing Master Plan, according to the staff report.

"The General Plan [sets] the guidelines," said Transportation Planning Analyst Christian Vasquez. "The Master Plan, I would say, is more of an implementation of the guidelines in the General Plan. That is the synergy. The adopted General Plan included the 1977 Master Plan as an appendix and one of the implantations of the General Plan was to update [the Bicycle Master Plan]."

The staff report noted the 1977 bicycle element has not been amended to reflect current bicycle infrastructure and potential first/last mile connectivity to alternate forms of transportation, including public transit and walking

Commissioner Jay Solnit asked city staff and his colleagues, "Why hasn't more been done in [the last] 40 years?"

The answers he received were consistent with the fact that the City Council identified the development of a Bicycle Master Plan as a priority for the 2016/2017 fiscal year, in order to begin the first steps toward a citywide Transportation Plan.

Transportation Planner Martha Eros also added that the construction of the Purple Line Extension Project, ultimately bringing a subway through the City, raises the need to start looking at connectivity.

"This is, to me, all about safety," said Commissioner Jake Manaster. "Convenience, getting to work, all of that other stuff falls away if we can't make it safe. I think the safety comes first, not because it's a mantra, but because if you otherwise don't take care

of it you're actually being a little reckless."

2010, In the Commission formed a bicycle ad hoc committee to address bicycle parking in the City. At that time, the Committee began preliminary discussions on updating the 1977 Bicycle Master Plan to include a bike rack program and identify possible bikeways in the City.

In 2011 and 2012, City Council directed staff to proceed with the implementation of a Bicycle Rack-on-Request program that provides business owners the opportunity to request a bike rack to be installed adjacent to their place of business in the public right-of-way.

Forty-two racks have been installed since the inception of the program, according to the staff report.

The Commission also recommended five bicycle routes on Burton Way, North Crescent Drive, Charleville Boulevard, North/South Beverly Drive and Carmelita Avenue.

City Council directed staff to proceed with the implementation of two pilot bikeways on Burton Way and Crescent Drive.

Neighboring cities, including West Hollywood, Culver City, Santa Monica and Los Angeles, have recently adopted pedestrian/bicycle plans.

The City has continued to grow its bicycle program with the launch of the Beverly Hills Bike Share system in May 2016, with approximately 50 smart bicycles in circulation.

Staff is expected to provide a one-year review of the Bike Share program operations and strategies for the Westside Cities interoperability of the system in May/June 2017

City Council challenges Los Angeles County Registrar to combat voter fraud

The City Council and staff say they will continue to work in partnership with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder's Office to address concerns regarding voter fraud, according to the Jan. 10 study session staff report.

Last October, the No on HH campaign alleged that "supporters of Measure HH, the Hilton Condominium Tower Initiative, [had] engaged in documented cases of voter registration fraud during the November 2016 election," according to a complaint obtained by the *Weekly* [Issue #891].

The complaint, sent to the county registrar's office and the L.A. County District



ADL facilitates dialogue to combat discrimination

Jim and Ada Horwich hosted a discussion on the Jewish response to the presidential election and fundraiser for the Anti-Defamation League, at their home in Beverly Hills. The event featured remarks by retired Los Angeles County Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky (pictured above) and Los Angeles Councilmember Bob Blumenfield.

More than 150 young leaders attended the event, which raised \$15,000 to support the ADL's work in combating anti-Semitism and all forms of bigotry and discrimination in America.

Attorney's office, claimed that "331 'voters' are illegally registered at four different post office boxes around Beverly Hills."

At Tuesday's study session, representatives from the L.A. county Registrar's Office and the Secretary of State's Office outlined how their respective agencies handle reports of voter fraud.

The Division Manager from the County Registrar Aaron Nevarez shared with the Councilmembers how his office educates its constituents on proper voter registration.

"It is a priority of our office to make sure that we protect the integrity of the election process," Nevarez said. "We want to make sure that people understand the voter registration rules. Our website is updated frequently as law changes and it has a lot of relevant information as does the local registrar's office."

As the City begins to prepare for the upcoming Council election on March 7, the Councilmembers have prioritized the issue of voter fraud. Councilmember Lili Bosse expressed dissatisfaction with the presentation because she was "hoping to get answers and to get results."

"As elected officials we are responsible to have immediate results," Bosse said. "We're responsible to have transparency, accountability and consequences."

The County handles voter registration, meaning the City has little oversight.

The Los Angeles District Attorney's office was also invited to attend, but declined, according to the staff report.

192 students currently attend BHUSD schools on interdistrict permit

The BHUSD Board of Education approved the annual establishment of the interdistrict permit cap for 2017 – 2018, during its meeting on Tuesday, Jan. 10.

accept permits," said Chief Academic Officer Dr. Jennifer Tedford. "We have not accepted them for many years because we receive no revenue for students in contrast to other districts that are 'ADA.' They receive revenue for every student that they have in their district."

The district currently enrolls approximately 4,077 students, with 192 students attending the BHUSD schools on an interdistrict attendance permit.

Beverly Hills Post office outlines plans to improve service

At the request of Mayor John Mirisch, the City Council discussed concerns brought forward by the residents and businesses of Beverly Hills regarding issues with the level of service and delivery from the Beverly Hills Post office.

The staff report from Tuesday's study session stated "the Beverly Hills Post office has lost mail, been late in delivering mail, delivered mail to incorrect addresses, has had long lines and wait times, and other service delivery, and customer service related issues"

This item was originally scheduled for the Dec. 20, 2016 study session, but was tabled until the Jan. 10, 2017 meeting.

The Post office had several representatives present at the Dec. 20, 2016 meeting to show their commitment to improving

service, according to the Jan. 10, 2017 staff report.

Additionally, the staff report noted that the Post office mailed a letter to the City on Dec. 29, 2016 to provide an update on what they are doing to address the concerns of the City's constituents. The plan outlined in the

letter included:

Officer-in-Charge Delisa Jackson will host meet-and-greet opportunities at the Beverly Hills main office from

10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. every Friday.

The Beverly Hills Post office has activated a phone line with voice mail capabilities as they understand that connecting with the Post office via telephone may be difficult. The number is (310) 247-3404. Messages are expected to be retrieved daily and returned within one business day. Constituents may also reach the District Consumer and Industry Contract team at (323) 586-1250 to express their concerns with the Beverly Hills Post office.

United States Postal Service employees will continue to undergo additional training on the USPS processes and procedures including those related to customer service.

WHAT'S THE FUTURE OF HAWTHORNE?

Hawthorne parents and faculty criticize Board of **Education at raucous meeting**

By Madelyn Pariser

A heated crowd confronted the spoke out against closing Hawthorne, BHUSD Board of Education Tuesday regarding speculation that the Board might close Hawthorne School.

Rumors began to spread following a special meeting last Thursday, Jan. 5 where board members discussed options for solving a \$5 million hole in the upcoming.

During the meeting, Board memrequested that staff return to the Board with numbers on the potential financial implications of closing Hawthorne.

After the meeting, a flyer was circulated among parents and teachers asking them to attend Tuesday's meeting to address the issue.



"If the school board is looking for ways to save some money, one suggestion I would make [is] that they may want to cut off the legal fees it's spending in the subway fight," said Beverly Hills resident and attorney Alan Isaacman "and maybe you can even work out something with the opposition so they can reimburse you [on] legal fees spent."

The Board responded equally as passionate to the concerns of the speakers.

"We have to look at everything if we're going to talk about making major cuts," Margo said. "If we don't, then we are going to do it erroneously and you're going to wind up losing programs and maybe you didn't need to lose that program. I don't want to cut programs. We couldn't close your school this year, even if we wanted to. We have nowhere to put the kids. We were never going to just shut the school down."

The BHUSD is \$4.6 million in the red, according to the first interim report given at the Dec. 12 Board meeting. The



reducing expenditures by approximately \$5 million for the 2017-18 fiscal year and sustaining the reduction for the following three years.

However, Margo also said that the Board has a "budget situation, not a crisis," and that he "doesn't think its \$5 million worth."

Vice President Lisa Korbatov stated that she was confused by the reaction from the crowd because she "worked for the past seven weeks of her life to pass Measure Y to get bond money to build you the best school money can buy."

Bond monies cannot be used for program or salaries. A Measure Y bond failed on the ballot last November. Even if Measure Y had passed, it would not address the underlying enrollment problems in the district.

The Board has gone into deficit spending for a number of reasons, including maintaining the four K-8 schools, unusually low class sizes, high teacher salaries, a super rich curriculum and the basic aid funding model.

Trevor Charlston co-owns Bead Relief with John Gornik and Greg Elias. Charlston and Gornik are childhood friends who attended El Rodeo and Beverly High together. Bead Relief has worked with over 80 different charity partners to design bracelets which uniquely represent their cause. The bracelets are then sold on the Bead Relief website and at retailers across the country. The company has raised over \$75,000 in charitable contribu-

What inspired the idea behind Bead

Bead Relief was founded by two very good friends of mine, John Gornik and Greg Elias.

went Kindergarten with John [at El Rodeo school] and he has always made these small, colorful beaded bracelets ever since he was a little kid. [All the kids at El Rodeo] had them; everyone wore them. I would wear them, his family would wear them. He made them as a hobby come in and express their growing up.

Back in 2013, John and Greg were working for a software sales company together. [They weren't] very satisfied with their jobs. They wanted to do something meaning-

Greg knew how much people loved these bracelets, [so he asked John] what if we found a way to connect these bracelets to some sort of charity platform?

John and Greg were canvassing L.A., basically making sales calls for the software company they were working for, and they saw firsthand some of the rougher areas in L.A.

In the beginning of 2013, John and Greg quit their jobs in software sales and decided to pursue Bead Relief fulltime.

The first charity they partnered with was A Place Called Home, [which] they had come into contact with during their days of software sales. They approached the charity [about a partnership] in [creating] a bracelet to help market the nonprofit, while raising awareness and donations. From there, it has continued to grow over the last four years.

In the beginning, I was a huge supporter. I pushed them and encouraged them to leave their jobs in software sales to do Bead Relief fulltime. When it was founded in 2013, I was just a concerned friend that wanted to see it be great. In 2015, [John and Greg] were doing a round of funding and they were selling part of the company.

I loved Bead Relief and John has been one of my best friends for my entire life. I went to school with him from Kindergarten

> through school. I wanted to be a part of it. I thought I definitely had a skill set which could be used to help grow the business, so I ended up investing [and] became the head of business development.

You own a business with your close friend. John Gornik, who you graduated with from **Beverly High** in 2006. Tell us about that.

I absolutely love it because the one thing I know for a fact is that I trust John.

It is really nice to work with peo-

ple that you know you can trust. We're constantly in communication with each other about the business. Everything is open and transparent. There's no incentive between all of us other than seeing that the business succeeds and grows. and that we make a positive impact. Working with a lot of guys who you share a passion [with] is invaluable.

Because John is such a good friend of mine, it really allows us to sit down and listen to each other and share ideas. In other work settings I've been in, it's not always the most conducive to people's ideas and hashing things out. But because John is such a good friend of mine, we always give each other the

benefit of the doubt. We're always willing to listen; no one gets shut down for anything.

We trust each other to do what's best for the business.

We're also helping them raise awareness. I think the charities do attach themselves to these bracelets because it's their [specific] bracelet. I think that's pretty special to them.

A lot of charities were really receptive to the idea, so we realized we could reach a wide scope of charitable giving rather than just focusing on one cause.
