Mirisch votes against salary increase for BHPOA employees

Mayor John Mirisch voted against an estimated 15 percent salary increase for employees of the Beverly Hills Police Officer's Association, proposed in a memorandum at the City Council's formal meeting on Tuesday, Feb. 7.

Vice Mayor Nancy Krasne and Councilmembers Julian Gold and Kathy Reims voted in favor of the memorandum of understanding between the City and the BHPOA. Councilmember Lili Bosse did not attend the meeting.

Mirisch explained that he is concerned most about the impact on the City's pension liabilities.

"As much as I appreciate and support the work of our police department, but consistent with how I voted on all the other MOA's for the same reason, it's nothing that I can support," Mirisch said. "I think that the number one issue facing us as a city, fiscally, is the issue of pension liability."

The unfunded liabilities currently stand at over \$300 million, according to Mirisch.

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

Prior to the approved salary increases, labor negotiator Peter Brown estimated that the City spends around \$227,000 to \$228,000 annually on the total compensation of each BHPOA employee.

"I actually would not be against increasing take-home pay to an even higher level if the bargaining units were amenable to slowly moving away from defined benefit pensions," Mirisch said.

The last memorandum of understanding expired on Oct. 6, 2016. The new terms of agreement approved by the majority of the Council will be effective through Sept. 30, 2019.

Over the next three years, the memorandum of understanding will result in a net increase of \$3,759,905, according to the staff report.

The BHPOA represents all sworn police employees of the City at the rank of police sergeant, police officer and pre-service police officer, who are recruits attending the police academy training to be a sworn police officer.

Reims did not disagree that the unfunded liabilities will be a deficit to the City in the future; however, she asserted that the solution needs to come from the state.

"We value our police, almost beyond anything, and we want to remain competitive with other police departments in other Cities so I am prepared to support this," Reims said. "I absolutely think that [pension liabilities] need to be dealt with at the state level in a fair and equitable way, [but] this is the system that we have. If we have the opportunity to participate, in some effort, to look at a long-term solution to this problem, I think Beverly Hills should do so but not on the backs of our employees. I don't think it would be fair."

Later in the meeting, Mirisch also voted against the approval of the salary schedules reflecting the negotiated salary increases with the BHPOA.

The California Public Employee's Retirement System (CalPERS) required the Council to approve a publically available salary schedule for all negotiated pay rate increases.

The City previously paid CaIPERS on

behalf of classic members belonging to the BHPOA eight percent of the normal member contribution. Classic employees were paying one percent of their normal member contribution.

Mirisch remained consistent with his vote and voted "no" on a resolution terminating the paying and reporting the value of employer and paid member contributions for the BHPOA.

All other Councilmembers in attendance of the meeting voted in favor of both the salary schedules and the resolution

"Classic" member employees will begin paying their full nine percent member contribution.

Traffic & Parking Commission addresses issues emerging from North Santa Monica reconstruction

Construction on North Santa Monica Boulevard began one week late due to weather delays on Jan. 17, according to Project Manager Samer Elayyan.

The Traffic and Parking Commission received an update on the North Santa Monica Boulevard Reconstruction Project at its meeting on Feb. 2.

Forty metered parking spaces along South Santa Monica Boulevard were removed by the City the evening before construction began, according to the staff report.

Earlier in the meeting, City Council candidate Vera Markowitz spoke during public comment to point out that a lane leading up to the North Bedford Drive parking garage

9,934 Vote by Mail ballots have been issued to voters for the Beverly Hills City Council election, taking place on March 7. 300 of the Vote by Mail ballots have been returned to the Los Angeles County Registrar Recorder's office as of Tuesday, Feb. 14, according to the L.A. County Registrar Voter Records Research and Integrity department

City Clerk Byron Pope told the Weekly the County is conducting the election this year because of the countywide measure on homelessness set to appear on the March 7 ballot.

Chair David Seidel noted that gross number of parking has increased by add-

ing the assisted parking on top of the Santa Monica 5, but that this addition of parking may need communicated to the public. He also noted that the Commission is tasked with finding ways to alleviate traffic issues that may arise throughout the recon-

struction project.

"As we move into this project, things like this are going to pop up that we either did or didn't anticipate," Seidel said. "As we see them, we are going to try to address them as near real-time as we can."

The first phase of construction is on the north curb of North Santa Monica Boulevard. It is estimated to last 50 calendar days, according to Elayyan. During

the majority of this phase, all four lanes are expected to be open; however, it is estimated that by May there will be a twoweek period where only two lanes will be opened for west- bound traffic. East bound traffic will be detoured to Wilshire Boulevard.

Originally, the construction was going to be divided into two segments: the west segment between Wilshire Boulevard and Alpine Drive and the east segment between Alpine Drive and Doheny Drive. However, residents and local business owners expressed concerns about accessing the business triangle during the renovation, so it was decided the west segment would be broken up into two parts.

The project is now scheduled into three segments which include segment one, Wilshire Boulevard to east of Rodeo Drive; segment two, east of Rodeo Drive to Alpine Drive; segment three, Alpine Drive to Doheny Drive.

Nice, France when a truck was driven into a crowd on Bastille Day. The attack claimed more than 80 lives and injured hundreds.

Krentzman's wife, Sophie, is a native to France. At the time of the incident, she called out her husband's name to alert him that a truck was barreling through the crowd, ultimately saving his life.

"We're going to continue to go to France because we love that country," Krentzman said. "We're not going to let one bad apple destroy our lives."

Krentzmen's mother, Sandy, is a longtime resident of Beverly Hills.

Ninth Circuit rejects BHUSD's emergency request to suspend Purple Line construction

Law360, a LexisNexis publication, reported that the Ninth Circuit denied BHUSD's emergency requests to prevent Metro from awarding a \$1.4 billion design-build contract for a subway extension project.

The district had asked the appeals court to grant injunctions to prevent Metro and the Federal Transit Administration from receiving or disbursing any federal funds toward the challenged subway route while

it appeals U.S. District Judge George H. Wu's denial of injunctions in two parallel lawsuits against the agencies.

Wu previously denied the district's bid to prevent Metro from approving a design-build contract for Section 2 of the Westside Subway Extension. The 3 AM Phone Call

a pair of brief orders at the end of January. The school district's request for a temporary injunction argued that if Metro is allowed to commit federal grant money for the project on Thursday as planned, it would lock itself into the challenged route alignment that goes under a school, even though it's supposed to be reviewing alternatives under the National Environmental Protection Act.

Metro argued they could lose federal funding assistance and the entire project could suffer delays, ultimately costing the taxpayers more money.

"We're pleased with the ruling, which allowed us to issue the construction contract for Section 2 and continue moving forward on building the Purple Line Extension as quickly as we can to Westwood and the Veteran's Administration Medical Center," Metro's Senior Public Communications Officer Kim Upton told the *Weekly*. "We're excited about the Purple Line because we know it will help relieve traffic and benefit all of Los Angeles, particularly

Kasowitz Benson Torres & Friedman partner Jennifer Recine, listed as one of the attorneys representing BHUSD, did not return the *Weekly*'s call in time for comment.

The dispute over the \$2.4 billion second phase of Los Angeles' long-planned West Side subway extension dates back to November 2012, when the school district sued the FTA. The district then sued the Los Angeles Transportation Agency in November 2016.

In the case against the FTA, Judge Wu ruled in August that the agency failed to properly consider the environmental effects of tunneling under Beverly Hills High School before approving the expansion plan, and ordered a supplemental environmental impact statement.

However, the judge denied the school district's request to invalidate the entire environmental review for Phase 2, which the FTA said could have caused delays and cost taxpayers up to \$100 million.

Phase 2 of the subway extension will extend the current Purple Line nine miles from the existing terminus near the Wilshire-Western traffic intersection to the West Los Angeles Veterans Affairs Hospital.

False Security Alarm program update shows increase in false alarms

Statistics listed in the Feb. 7 City Council staff report do not reveal a clear answer as to whether or not the City's False Security Alarm Reduction program has been successful in decreasing the number of false alarm calls made to the Beverly Hills Police Department.

Staff provided a six-month progress report on the implementation of the revised false alarm ordinance and corresponding fee schedule as an informational-only item in the agenda.

The number of false alarms received from May 1, 2015 to Nov. 30, 2015 was compared to the number of false alarm calls received from May 1, 2016 to Nov. 30, 2016.

According to the staff report, there was a 7.83 percent increase in the total number of false alarms. Twelve locations had 10 or more false alarms, which contributed to the increase.

The number of locations with four or less false alarms went from 1,044 to 996,

decreasing it by 4.5 percent.

The Council adopted a False Security Alarm Reduction program in April of 2009. The goal of the program was to modify security alarm user behavior and divert public safety resources to legitimate activities, which would help maintain BHPD response times. False alarm fees collected as a result of the program would help offset the costs associated with responding to false alarms.

On May 17, 2016 the Council approved an ordinance that removed the previous stipulation requiring an alarm company to make two attempts to contact the alarm subscriber by telephone to verify the legitimacy of the alarm. The amended ordinance removed that requirement and placed the responsibility of determining alarm verification on the alarm company and property owner.

City staff anticipated that it would likely increase the number of false alarm calls that the police Department received. Consequently, staff requested that the Council approve a resolution that amended the false alarm fees for police response time to be free in order to lessen the burden on the residents and businesses.

Council decided that the first three responses would be at no cost, \$210 that can be waived within a 60 days after completion of an Alarm User Awareness class for the fourth response, \$261 for the fifth response, and \$366 for the sixth response.

When staff compared data from May 1 to Nov. 30 in 2015 and 2016 to see the

financial impact from the reduction in fees, they found there was a \$193,000 loss in revenue.

Police Department staff will be working with the locations that have a high number of false alarms by making contact with location owners and educating them in order to prevent further false alarms, according to the staff report.

BHPD Captain Tony Lee selected as UCLA Chief of Police

The Beverly Hills Police Department announced on Tuesday, Feb. 14 that Captain Tony Lee was hired as the Chief of Police for the University of California Los Angeles Police Department.

Lee is leaving the BHPD after 26 years of service. He oversaw all three divisions, including Field Services, Investigations, and most recently, Administrative Services. He has also served as an Acting Chief of Police several times over the past few years.

Lee has received notable training from the prestigious FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia, Harvard Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University, Senior Management Institute for Police at Boston University, and the LAPD's West Point Leadership.

He holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration and a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from California State Universities. Prior to joining the BHPD, Lee was a competition fighter in karate, winning the Long Beach International Karate Championships three consecutive years as well as securing three gold medals in the Police Olympics.

"It's been an amazing 26 year journey serving the greatest community in the world and working side by side with some of the best and brightest police profes-

sionals in California," Lee wrote. "I've made life-long friends in this community, and with heavy а heart. T just can't express



express how thank-

ful and privileged I was to work here."

COVERSTORY MAKING THE CUT

All options on the table as Board considers how to cut \$5 million from budget

By Madelyn Pariser

BHUSD administrators outlined several options to cut back deficit spending during the Board of Education study session last Friday, Feb. 9.

In December, Chief Administrative Officer La Tanya Kirk-Carter announced that the district is \$4.6 million in the red. At that time, the Board unanimously voted in favor of reducing expenditures

by approximately \$5 million for the 2017-18 fiscal year and sustaining the reduction for the following three years.

Kirk-Carter, along with Chief Academic Officer Jennifer Tedford and Chief Human Resources Administrator Yolanda Mendoza, were tasked with presenting on the various causes of the projected deficit spending and making recommendations for long-term financial sustainability.

Tedford explained that the financial analysis was based off of data from areas such as enrollment trends and district class size.

There has been an overall decline in enrollment over the last six years, according to Tedford.

The district operates on a basic aid model, meaning local property taxes meet or exceed its revenue limit. A basic aid district keeps the money from local property taxes and still receives constitutionally guaranteed state basic aid funding.

Kirk-Carter indicated that most of the district's money is going toward certificated staffing. She reported that certificated teacher salaries are at \$5,455 per ADA with an additional \$1,145 for other certificated salaries such as counselors and specialized teachers, bringing the total to approximately \$6,600.

"Revenue really isn't our problem," Kirk-Carter said "It is how we spend it." She also noted that the current budget for the 2016-17 legal fees is \$1.3 million. In 2014-15, she said the district was spending \$4 million on legal fees. "One of the allusions [is] that we're spending quite a bit of money on legal. We're not spending a lot of money on legal. [Our] contractive services are high because in that same category are our PTA and our BHEF donations, and we've

spent them accordingly." BHUSD's legal fees exceeded \$600,000

between Jan. 10 to Feb. 7, according to the Feb. 7 warrant report [Issue #906]. No other school district of the same size has legal fees at that level.

Some of the suggestions for cuts recommended by the administration included eliminating K-8 technology/STEM teachers by supplementing programs in core classes with iCoach support and reducing librarian technical staffing by 50 percent and moving to a shared service model.

Michael Bregy commended the Board on its ability to make cuts in years prior; however, he attributed much of the district's deficit spending to the costly K-8 model.

"Part of the problem, as I've discovered, is really looking at what the community values," Bregy said. "[The] difficult part about it is the way the system is setup and the constraints that we have with running a K-8 model. It's an expensive model. That's a community value and that's something that we would need to talk about. There are a lot of savings when you are starting to put a configuration together where you have a large number of students in a certain grade."

The administrators looked to the Board for feedback and direction.

"All cuts are not equal," Korbatov said. "I appreciate that you gave the full Chinese menu and I'm going to think very thoughtfully about it. I understand that there's a magic number of \$5 million. The Municipal League put the City Council candidates under rapid fire during its forum in the Council Chambers on Wednesday, Feb.

8. At the start of the evening, each of the candidates provided were two minutes to introduce themselves. followed by a five-minute question and answer with moderators Greenberg Glusker partner Fred Fenster, attorney Allyson Wittner and Municipal League Chairman Thomas

White. During the five- there was this referendum minute discussion, the moderators quickly asked candidates to answer questions such as how they voted for Measure HH, their position with respect to lots 12 and 13, and their opinions on the effectiveness of the current Council.

modera-The tors alternated the order and the specific questions asked to each of the candidates.

City Treasurer Eliot Finkel. Recreation and

Parks Commissioner Frances Bilak and resident Vera Markowitz were asked about their stance on Measure HH.

Measure HH, the Hilton Condominium Tower initiative on the November 2016 ballot, asked residents to vote on the construction of a 26-story residential development which would be considered the City's first ever skyscraper.

Bilak and Markowitz voted in favor of the initiative. Bilak says she voted 'no' on

Measure H in 2008.

"I would never have allowed an 18-story building to have been entitled to [devel-

> oper] Mr. [Beny] Alagem," Bilak said. "Between 2008 and 2015 when there was this referendum filed, I felt that City Council should have gone and placed a hard cap in that Special Plan so that he couldn't have filed a referendum to go up 26-stories."

> Regardless, she voted to approve Measure HH in 2016 because of the purported increase in green space included in the revised measure.

"[I voted for Measure HH because] I wanted more green space for this city. There's an L.A. resident survey that indicates Beverly Hills has one half of the green space that every other L.A. resident has.'

Markowitz was in favor of Measure HH because she felt that the aesthetic of the two small buildings purposed in 2008 were not designed well.

"I love great architecture," Markowitz said. "I thought the two small buildings

were not attractive at all. I would not have passed it in '08. I thought that was very poor design. I like the new design and it was strictly based on design."

Finkel said he voted against the measure because the developer chose to bypass the City's planning process.

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



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
