Committee Hears Early Plans for Wilshire/La Cienega Station

At its last meeting on December 20, the Beverly Hills Strategic Planning Committee was presented with preliminary ideas

and schematics for the Wilshire/La Cienega subway station, which will be operational in mid-2023 as part of the Metropolitan Transportation Authority's Purple Line Extension project.

City Project Manager Robert Welch said the tunnel for the station will be 3.92 miles long and is expected to accommodate 10,000 daily boardings when it first opens in 2023. That ridership is expected to drop to 6,500 daily boardings after section three of the extension project, which will connect downtown Los Ange-

les to the Westside, opens in 2026. The goal of the subway station itself, however, is to draw those riders into Beverly Hills by presenting them with a design that pulls them off of the subway and up to the street level. Plans for how to accomplish this are in the early stages, Welch said, though he did share some of the early plans for street-level amenities, such as bike storage lockers, a bike share dock, artwork, landscaping, elevators, stairs, and escala-

Committee member Kathy Reims asked Welch whether or not pick-up and drop-off would be included as part of the station, noting that it would "not be safe or efficient if it's added in as an afterthought."

"We see rideshare cutouts and queuing lots at every venue these days, so I'm surprised that would not be immediately available as part of this," Committee member Myra Lurie agreed. "I think we can very safely predict people will be using t hat for first and last mile transit."

Welch said that Metro typically does not include drop-off and pick-up areas when constructing stations, but City Manager Mahdi Aluzri clarified that the City is planning to provide an area for dropping off and picking up subway users.

"One of the primary reasons the City acquired the Gale property is to provide for that opportunity," Aluzri said, referencing the City's purchase of 8421 Wilshire Boulevard, which was bought as part of the Memorandum of Agreement with Metro and is currently being used as a staging yard. "The unfortunate thing about it is the possession of the site is going to be later during the process because they're using it, so that might delay our chances to put something in place that will be available at the time that the station becomes operational. So, we're looking at other opportunities in the area to see what opportunities we have."

More details of what will be constructed at the street-level for the Wilshire/La Cienega station will be discussed at the January 10 meeting of the Traffic and Parking Commission as part of the City's Complete Streets Plan, which will outline potential infrastructure projects, policies and programs to be implemented city-

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PTA Elections Focused on Fairly Representing **Reconfigured Schools**

Following BHPD reconfiguration, elections for next academic year's BHUSD parent-teacher associations (PTAs) will be focused on having fair representation across school families, according to current Beverly Vista PTA President Nathan Kruger.

At Beverly Vista, where students from each of the district's elementary schools will be pooled together to create Beverly Hills' first-ever middle school, representation is especially important.

"All these parents are going to be coming to Beverly Vista from the other schools, so obviously the parents from BV could easily be overrepresented on the executive board," Kruger said. "Because of that, we're doing a lot of work now to reach out to parents from other schools to build relationships and figure out who is most interested in taking on a leadership role. We really want to make sure we get them in."

One of the ways Beverly Vista is working to accommodate and represent all of the current K-8 schools on its new executive board, according to El Rodeo PTA President Molly Corey, is to change the number of individuals on their nominating committee—the group responsible for selecting the slate from which voters select board members—from three to five.

"BV has changed their nominating committee from three to five so that there will be one representative from each current K-8 as well as a high school PTA parent without a kid in the younger grades," Corey said. Kruger called the high school parent a "tiebreaker" representative, who would help keep votes equitable.

In order to vote, serve on the nominat-

ing committee, or vote for who serves on the nominating committee, members must join their new school's PTA before January 26. After parjoining, ents can fill out forms at each of the district's

schools to nominate himself or herself or another PTA member for an executive board position.

The nominating committee, which Corey said would form in February, will then use those nomination sheets to form a slate of potential candidates for the new executive board. In April, the full PTA will vote on which of the candidates will officially take the lead going into the 2019-20 school year.

"The dates have been pushed back a month so that more people will have the opportunity to get involved," Corey told the Weekly. "There has been a great deal of discussion about making the process equitable between the schools as well as having representation from each school on the executive board. If people really want to participate and volunteer their time,

there will always be a space for them."

Stephen Daldry will direct his National Theatre of Great Britain's landmark production of J.B. Hubbard Street Dance Chicago and Third Coast Percussion at The Wallis

The Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts is set to present the highly anticipated West Coast premiere of excerpts from the first collaboration between the acclaimed Chicago-based company Hubbard Street Dance Chicago and Grammy Award-winning Third Coast Percussion with three performances on Thursday, January 10 through Saturday, January 12 at 7:30 p.m.

The new works, both by Los Angeles choreographers, include "For All Its Fury" by YouTube sensation Emma Portner, who gained international attention for her video and tour choreography for Justin Bieber, and "Everything Must Go," by Teddy Forance, whose work has been featured on the hit television show "So You Think You Can Dance." Inspired by the principal of sustainability and loosely intertwined, the works feature a powerful score by British singer/songwriter/ composer Devonté Hynes, also known as Blood Orange, which will be performed live on stage by Third Coast Percussion. The highly regarded quartet of classically trained percussionists also performs a solo interlude by Hynes. Hubbard Street's Wallis debut launches a four-month North American tour by the company that also includes stops in New York City, West Palm Beach, FL, and Vancouver, British Columbia.

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Remembering Barbara Yaroslavsky

A 1965 Beverly High graduate, Barbara Edelston Yaroslavsky, wife of former Los Angeles County Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky, died last Wednesday at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center after complications from West Nile virus. She was 71.

In life, Yaroslavsky was a longtime activist and volunteer in the Jewish community and on behalf of several nonprofit and social services agencies, particularly those focused on education and healthcare.

She was president of Los Angeles' Commission on Community and Family Services at the time of

her death and was a former chair of the Medical Board of California. Yaroslavsky also served on the advisory board of LA's BEST Afterschool Enrichment Program for underserved youth.

She is survived by her husband of 47 years, two children, four grandchildren, a brother and sister-in-laws

Funeral services were held on Sunday, where speakers included members of her family and Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti.

We asked a handful of her Beverly Hills-area friends to share their favorite memories of her.



Toni and Bruce Corwin:

"Barb was, simply said, the REAL DEAL. She knew what mattered. She knew how to get things done. Her heart knew only kindness and how to share it with others. She will be missed by the countless friends who shared her life and were part of her village."

Former Congressmember Jane Harman (D-Venice):

"Zev was already a political hot shot when I first ran for Congress in 1992. He didn't have to have much time for me, but he—and especially the warm and wonderful Barbaraprovided guidance and friendship. This continued through the years, and their partnership was a fabulous example to the rest of us struggling with work/life balance. Their post-elected politics chapter was proceeding so well until a cruel and rare illness struck Barbara. Her unexpected death is a shock wave. Zev has to know how many of us will do everything we can to fill the void and cherish her memory."

"It's so very hard to imagine being at an important Democratic or Jew-

ish community event without seeing dear Barbara. I always made a point of saying hello, giving her a hug or throwing her a kiss. I loved her humor and intelligence and her devotion to her values and principles. Barbara will truly be missed and never forgotten."

"Barbara Yaroslavsky was beloved in our community for many reasons. She seemed to be everywhere—working smartly and effectively to help on so many causes and issues: education, health care, the arts (especially music), embodying and advocating the values of tikkun olam. And, whatever the cause and wherever the venue, she always combined preparation, wisdom, clarity, wit and a sly sense of humor. She was deeply knowledgeable. When she spoke, people listened—and responded. She was forceful while still being graceful. She was wise and knew when and how to most effectively suggest the most effective course of action. And she was al-

ways warm and inclusive. As my sister, Dena Schechter, put it she seemed to materialize wherever she was needed. I will greatly miss her sense of humor, poking fun at pretension in a lighthearted way.

Barbara and Zev's marriage seems to me to have been a 47-year love affair. Throughout those years, Barbara's uncommon insights, warmth, wise counsel, energy and broad and deep engagement provided incredible

blessings not only to her family and close friends but throughout our community."



"Barbara, a genuine force of nature, with her compassion, intellect, dedication to social values, closeness to family and friends and a wonderful sense of humor was a truly unique woman. She was a star that burned brightly whose warmth and deeds will forever live on – a special person in our lives."

Water Repairs Completed, Conservation Order Lifted

Crews from the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) of Southern California completed repairs on the main water delivery pipeline serving Beverly Hills last week and Sunset at Alpine Drive reopened in both directions on Sunday morning, with final repairs to be made to the roadway this month.

"We are thankful for the community's cooperation and the diligence of all who worked to resolve this leak as quickly as possible," said Beverly Hills Mayor Julian Gold.

During the repairs, city residents and businesses were asked to take extra steps to conserve water until the water line was returned to service. Normal water-efficient habits have since resumed.

"Thanks to the patience and cooperation of the residents, visitors and businesses in Beverly Hills, we've been able to make these emergency repairs and ensure the city has a reliable water supply," said Jim Green, MWD's water systems operations manager.

Evidence of the leak was first discovered at the intersection of Sunset Boulevard and Alpine Drive in late December. After pinpointing the exact location of the leak in the Santa Monica Feeder, which spans 24 miles and provides treated water to five cities along the way including Beverly Hills, crews began repairs last Wednesday.
