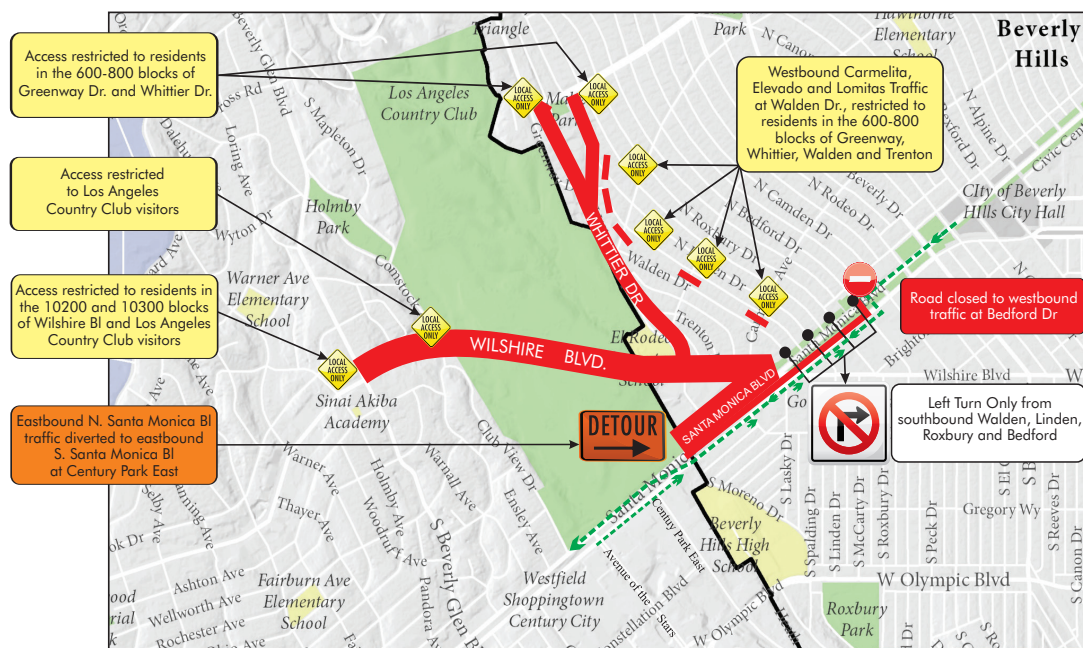

"Future Focused Schools Adds Meetings" [Issue #949]

Last week *Beverly Hills Weekly* printed a few things related to the ongoing reconfiguration efforts. A Letter to the Editor from Jonathan Prince, a brief noting of the BH4OurKids website (suggesting it "attacked" the FFST) and a "profile" of Tristen Walker Shuman (a member of the FFST). To be clear, nothing that has been written on the BH4OurKids website has been phrased as an attack on anything or any person. Reading the language of the BH4OurKids website, that should be completely clear. That is not who any of us are, nor should that be the way we treat one another as we seek the same common goal: the best education for our children.

Although some FFST volunteers have shared the information they have regarding financial information, as a whole, all the available information, in its entirety, has not been shared with the community at large. Nor have they shared substantial academic research supporting the formation of a separate middle school. From the data that was posted on the FFST website, a reconfiguration of TK-5th and one middle school would save \$3,021,534 a year. Another model, with two TK-5 schools and a middle school would save \$4,389,946 a year. Finally, another configuration, with three TK-8 schools would save \$4,148,062 a year (notes from their December 18th meeting). Thus, keeping the K-8 model would appear to be feasible and sustainable (if significant reductions are needed) compared to just reconfiguring the schools to include a middle school. But it does not appear, even based upon the most recent budget data discussed by a FFST member on Facebook, that any change needs to happen so quickly.

There is a Change.org petition which has circulated in the schools, and to date, approximately 457 people have signed the "Save our Schools" petition, showing support for preserving the BH K-8 model. To my knowledge, this petition has only circulated via word of mouth, rather than parents standing outside the schools soliciting signatures. It seems likely that if more people had access to this petition, this number of concerned parents would be even greater. Trying to couch all these parents as only those of "children who are not in middle school" or adverse to change is baseless and belittling. While some of us do have elementary school children, many of us have high school age children and we also have spoken to large numbers of the BH community who have NO school aged children and do not want to see the district abandon the K-8 models. Research shows the many advantages of K-8 and likewise, the disadvantages of having a separate middle school. Thus, having a "fear of the unknown" does not quite appear to couch us as critics who do

not want change. To my knowledge, no surveys have been taken to account for what the taxpayers who would be affected by this decision want for their schools. Change is fantastic, if it is in the best interests of our children.

There is much research to support the K-8 model (and there are many articles posted on the BH4OurKids website). These studies are relevant and must be considered. Financial statistics alone should not fuel any decision. Nor does it appear, from the most recent audited information, that there is a \$5 million deficit (a number that was floated often when the reconfiguration discussion became more publicized). BHUSD is a school district, not a for-profit business. On the BH4OurKids website, there is a very recent study, which supports a K-5 model on its face. Yet, after making inquiries to the authors, they said that their results provided "some support for separate elementary and middle schools in an urban, mostly low income environment; it may have very different results in suburban environment." Nor did the study go beyond academic outcomes and did not include any analysis of psychological outcomes (as stated by the authors themselves). These studies are discussing exactly what is at stake here – the benefits and drawbacks to creating a separate middle school. If that is not relevant, then what exactly is?

Being "open" to this process does not mean that those of us who believe in the K-8 model and want to see our children

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at its regular meeting on **Thursday, January 11, 2018**, will hold a public hearing beginning at **7:00 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to consider an ordinance to amend development standards generally pertaining to basements in the single-family residential zones of the City, and development standards generally pertaining to grading and retaining walls in the Hillside Area of the City. In addition, the Planning Commission will discuss the applicability of the proposed ordinance to pipeline projects that are currently under review by the City. The proposed ordinance includes the following measures, which may be further modified by the Planning Commission:

- The definition of “floor area” in single-family residential zones is proposed to be amended to define a “basement” as an area that is located directly below the portion of a story above which has a finished floor level that is a maximum of three feet (3’) above finished grade at any cross-section cut through the building with certain exceptions for driveways, light courts, pools and water features, and stairs and access ways that might otherwise cause a basement to be exposed by more than 3’ above grade. The proposed amendments would also require a basement that extends beyond a story above to be located entirely below both finished and natural grades (Beverly Hills Municipal Code [BHMC] § 10-3-100).
- A definition of “light court” is proposed to be added to the BHMC. As proposed, a light court would be an excavated area adjacent to a building that extends more than 4’-0” from the building perimeter that is enclosed on four sides, open on the top, and allows light into a below grade level of a building. The BHMC does not currently contain a definition of light court. (BHMC § 10-3-100)
- The definitions of “finished grade” and “natural grade” are proposed to be added to the BHMC to ensure clarity of the code and consistency in its application. (BHMC § 10-3-100)
- The language governing the maximum height of walls, fences, and hedges within the Hillside Area of the City is proposed to be amended to limit the total height of any wall fence or hedge to 12’-0” regardless of the side of the wall, fence, or hedge from which a measurement is being taken. An R-1 Permit is also proposed to be added to allow relief from these regulations. (BHMC § 10-3-2516)
- The language governing the construction of series of walls in the Hillside Area of the City is proposed to be amended to allow for a maximum cumulative height of 12’-0” for all walls constructed on the same property within any 50’ perpendicular section. A 10’-0” landscaped horizontal distance must also be provided between each wall. An R-1 Permit is also proposed to be added to allow relief from these regulations. (BHMC § 10-3-2516)
- The calculation method provided in the BHMC that defines the total cubic yards of landform alteration (cut/fill) allowed on a site in the Hillside Area of the City within a five year period is proposed to be amended. (BHMC 10-3-2521)
- The regulations regarding import/export of earth material within the Hillside Area of the City are proposed to be amended to clarify that cubic yardage will be based on in-ground earth volumes. The code does not currently stipulate whether the amount of earth material is in ground compacted earth material or excavation un-compacted earth material. (Proposed amendment of BHMC 10-3-2521 and BHMC 10-3-2521.1) The Planning Commission may also consider revisions to BHMC Section 10-3-2521 and 10-3-2521.1 to reduce the number of cubic yards of earth material that may be imported or exported from sites in the Hillside Area to account for the difference in volume from in-ground compacted conditions, and post-excavation un-compacted conditions.
- The definition of “height of building” is proposed to be changed to bring the method of measuring the height of buildings in the Hillside Area of the City in line with the method of determining whether or not a portion of a building can be considered a basement. (Proposed amendment of BHMC 10-3-100)
- The findings pertaining to Hillside R-1 Permits are proposed to be amended to add a provision that the total number of construction-related vehicle trips associated with a project as a whole may be considered by a reviewing authority when considering a Hillside R-1 Permit for import and export of earth material. (BHMC §10-3-2550)
- Other non-substantive changes to reorganize and reorder Article 25 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the BHMC, which contains development standards applicable to the Hillside Area of the City.
- Language pertaining to the applicability of the proposed ordinance to projects that are currently under review by the City of Beverly Hills (pipeline projects). The proposed ordinance, which may be modified by the Planning Commission includes exempting the following pipeline projects from the new provisions: all pipeline projects in the Central and Trousdale Areas of the City, pipeline projects in the Hillside Area of the City that have previously received an R-1 Permit, pipeline projects in the Hillside Area of the City that are not a new single-family homes and/or are not increasing cumulative floor area on a site by more than 50%. Pipeline projects that are not exempt will be allowed to request an R-1 Permit for review of the project under the existing code provisions by the Planning Commission.

This Ordinance has been preliminarily assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. The Planning Commission will consider the adoption and implementation of the Ordinance to be exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) as there is no possibility that adoption and implementation of the Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment because the Ordinance does not authorize construction and it would impose greater restrictions on certain development in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare. Additionally the Planning Commission will consider if adoption and implementation of the Ordinance is eligible for a Class 8 categorical exemption pursuant to Section 15308 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations for actions taken to assure the maintenance and protection of the environment.

Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the Commission. Any comments submitted will be considered as part of the public record. According to Government Code Section 65009, if you challenge the Commission’s action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City, either at or prior to the public hearing.

educated in this model should accept that a separate middle school is somehow the answer to our district achieving higher test scores and higher state rankings. We can improve our academics without losing a model that creates the amazing communities in which many of us (and research shows) supports the self-esteem and leadership of our middle school students. Also, the K-8 model provides the opportunity for the younger grades to have meaningful, enriching interaction with the older grades, as evidenced by programs such as the “Taste of Broadway”. These unique programs would be lost if we lose this model. We should provide more academic and enrichment opportunities. There is no reason there can not be new programs (e.g. Robotics, Debate and Athletics) brought to benefit middle school students (and potentially even 4th and 5th graders).

The research that is out there seems more relevant that a comparison to other districts that are “high performing” and also have middle schools. Maybe we need to look at how those districts spend their money – we are spending approximately \$14,663 per pupil and Palos Verdes spends \$9831 and Las Virgenes \$9150 per pupil. (Source: FFST notes on the BHUSD website). If having a middle school does create a distinct academic advantage and will lead to better outcomes for our students where is the research and data that show that result? Simply pointing out that those districts have higher test scores without an analysis of why they do should not push us toward a middle

school.

If a middle school is the answer, where is the supporting research? Tell us how our children are going to fare better academically (with data) and be supported emotionally? Bullying is a problem in this district (as sadly, it is in many), how is a separate middle school going to be able to erect and employ an effective anti-bullying program, when it is already an issue in our K-8 schools? How is this district prepared to deal with that? How will our district deal with the influx of older behaviors that are likely to plague this new mix of pre-teens and teens?

The academic studies included on the BH4OurKids website should be incorporated within any attempt to effect change within our schools. The feeling that many of us share, that K-8 is a better model than having a separate middle school, is validated by many of these studies. Forcing a dramatic, rushed change to a middle school without all the supporting research and data and without conducting a survey of the community could create more problems for this district and our children. I believe change can be effected to improve our existing model which makes our district and our community a special, unique one.

Future Focused Schools Team to Hold Upcoming Town Hall Meetings

The Future Focused Schools Team (FFST) will hold two upcoming meetings for community members to discuss reconfiguration of the BHUSD.

Superintendent Michael Bregy first introduced the idea of the now-22-member committee several months ago in a presentation that discussed the BHUSD’s currently unsustainable financial path.

Bregy said that because the district is at a financial “tipping point,” the FFST program would aim to “improve educational opportunities for students while ensuring long-term financial sustainability.” This could mean turning one of the four campuses into a middle school, and thus, forgoing the K-8 model currently in place.

The team has worked over the last few months to develop viable reconfiguration options for the Board of Education to consider. While no final decision has been reached yet, Team member Jonathan Prince told the Weekly that by learning about teachers’ contracts, certi-

fication of teachers at the middle school level, and the potential financial impacts of maintaining the current model, the group is on the road to a consensus.

“People are beginning to understand the price that we’ll pay if we don’t make significant changes,” said Prince.

The other team members, selected anonymously from a pool of 54 applicants, include Kevin Allen, Teri Angel, Jocelyn Bresnick, Merle Bauer, Kimberly Combs, Lee Egerman, Mark Frenn, Christian Fuhrer, Fred Gluckman, Kari Kramer, Jory Lindsay, Mark Mead, Sean Nassirzadeh, Molly Peterson, Franny Rennie, Mark Slavkin, Ethan Smith, Ronit Stone, Kim Timmerman, Tristen Walker and Marvin Winans.

Several factors have caused BHUSD’s critical deficit. For instance, the District went basic aid several years ago, meaning that it no longer gets paid per student. This led to the removal of permits, or students attending BHUSD schools that don’t live in the district.

Whether or not these are direct causes, the fact is that the District currently maintains a total enrollment of below 4,000—the lowest number BHUSD has seen in over 50 years.

Still, many parents with school-aged kids continue to question the efficacy of the proposed changes. Several unidentified parents have gone so far as to assemble an anonymous group, “BH 4 Our Kids,” criticizing the FFST and

suggesting that the district’s outstanding deficit is either nonexistent or blown out of proportion.

“Research tells us that it is unclear whether turning one of our K-8 schools into a dedicated middle school would even represent a cost savings,” reads the mission statement, which does not go on to clarify what research the group is referring to.

The website also goes on to criticize the fast rate in which they believe the process has advanced, writing, “Undertaking such a drastic change so hastily, without any chance for meaningful community input, is in a word, reckless.”

The community meetings, intended specifically for community input, will take place on January 10 and 11 at the Salter Theater.

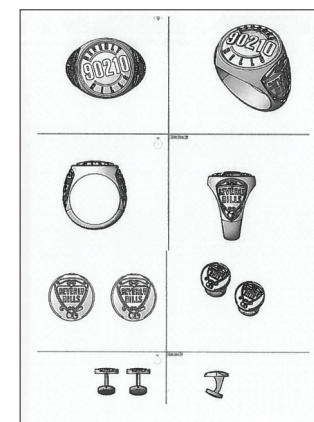

City Approves Agreement with Leon’s Jewelry

The City Council approved at their December 14 study session an agreement with Leon’s Jewelry to manufacture and distribute City-branded jewelry.

The discussion came about because City is the owner of the Beverly Hills shield design trademark (“Shield”). The City has had an agreement with CMG Brands for about four years to provide exclusive licensing representation to the City by entering into licensing agreements with film and television studios, theme parks and merchandising firms.

At CMG Brands request, the City-based Leon's Jewelry will be authorized to produce and market shield-branded jewelry including rings, cuff links, charms, bracelets and necklaces.

Leon's Jewelry, owned by Leon Haytayan and located on North Beverly Drive, has been in business for 38 years, 17 of those years in Beverly Hills. The company is now allowed to distribute worldwide the merchandise through its authorized wholesalers to retail establishments for resale to the consumer.

Although financial terms are subject to negotiation, Leon's Jewelry will pay the City a non-refundable guarantee, against future royalty fees, of \$6,000. The royalty fees are 11 percent of the licensee's wholesale selling price, if sold at wholesale; or 5.5 percent of the retail price, if sold directly by licensee to consumers.

Although the proposal was to provide samples of products under \$100 and photos of samples over \$100, Mayor Lili Bosse said she would like to see samples of all the products before they are sold.

"I think it makes a very big difference," said Bosse. "Anything that has our branding, I think it really makes a difference to see it, touch it, feel it."

The City has the right to purchase up to 12 additional samples of each item for 50 percent the actual selling price.

Council Discusses Updates on the Fiber to the Premise Initiative

At their last study session of 2017, the City Council heard and discussed updates regarding the Fiber to the Premise Initiative—a project aiming to provide high-speed broadband Internet service to residents and businesses through enhanced infrastructure.

Chief Information Officer David Schrimmer gave a presentation outlining the current stage of construction. For

instance, staff has recently create a website to serve as the primary repository for project information. The website explains the purpose of the initiative, why

it's important for the residents and businesses, and a history of the project.

"We wanted to provide a lot of information very quickly and without much clutter," said Schrimmer.

Also included on the new website—found at beverlyhillsfiber.org—is a map showing, in real time, where exactly construction is taking place. Most recently, construction activities included

the North West Residential area— north of Sunset Boulevard and west of Alpine Drive. Now, construction is occurring in the South East residential area— between Wilshire and Clifton and Robertson to Le Doux.

During the comments portion, Councilmember John Mirisch suggested making the project net neutral, sharing advantages like protecting the content provider from abuse and paving the way for other cities.

"I do believe, especially in this day and age, that we need to embrace the principles of net neutrality and I suggest that now is as good a time as any," said Mirisch.

Both Schrimmer and the other Councilmembers agreed to include net neutrality into all of the materials.

The City Council originally approved the first round of agreements needed to begin the construction phase in May 2017, which included months of information gathering and assessment around the feasibility of the initiative.

The project involves the installation of new and upgraded fiber connections as well as billing and customer support services for the end-users of the system. It will require placing about 100 miles of fiber optic cable linking homes, schools and businesses using both aerial and underground construction.

Upon completion the City will be able to offer Internet services that operate at speeds of 1 Gigabit at \$55 per month during the initial phase.

Construction is expected to take between 30 and 36 months to complete, but services will be made available in phases as areas are completed and quality assurance has been performed.

The first "friendly" customers are expected to be in place during Q2 of this year.

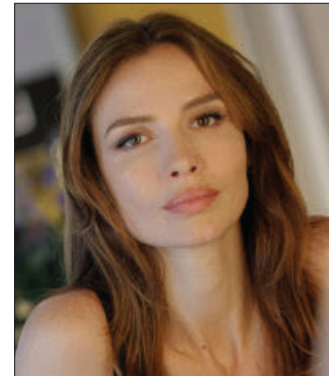

Public Works Chair Jerry Felsenthal on the future of water and City self-reliability

What made you want to apply for the Public Works Commission?

First of all, I love the City of Beverly Hills. It has been my home for close to 50 years. Second of all, anyone who lives in the City and has concern for it reaches a decision of whether they wish to be involved in the City or not. Some do and some don't. But the reason that I became involved is that I wanted to make a difference. We can make meaningful differences in our lives in different ways, one of which is participating in local government, so I chose to do that. I started that about 10 years ago by serving for six years on the Planning Commission, which I found to be very rewarding. In the particular case of the Planning Commission, it may be more political than in the case of Public Works. In the case of Public Works, we are involved in the creation and maintenance and efficiency of an infrastructure city, which is critical to the function of the City. Public Works does so many things that [people] don't even realize on a day-to-day basis, [and] if we didn't do a good job of it, [they] would notice right away.

You're a developer. What's different about serving in government than the private sector?

My background started out in economics. I was trained as an economist; I came back to Los Angeles and by happenstance I ended up going into the industrial building development business. The major difference between the way government works and the way private enterprise works has to do with process. Government is predicated on a series of institutional processes; private enterprise is far less reliant on those processes. They are, of course, exacerbated by all the additional bills that get passed by legislature every year. So I would say that the biggest difference between my life as a private developer and government is process. It requires a great deal of more transparency, it requires a great

deal of more reporting, and it requires open deliberation.

What are the biggest challenges facing the Public Works Commission in the New Year?

From my point of view, implementation of the 10 Year Master Water Plan and increasing our emergency water supply are among the [timeliest] issues. At present we are 100 percent dependent on the Metropolitan Water District [MWD] for all of our water. In addition to that, we only have a one percent vote and water is a very political issue in California. We have the technology to convert local water into potable water and the [Reverse Osmosis] Plant necessary for the production is at hand. Our emergency water supply is at the low end of

the recommended supply. We've had a great community response to water conservation during the last year's drought and now we see ourselves slowly giving up some of those savings. So, those are some the reasons I see the implementation of the master water plan as really important. In addition, just looking at some of the meteorological facts about California and Los Angeles [shows] that March 2017 through December 2017 is shaping up to be the driest March-December on record.

Tell us about Athens Group taking over as the City's new garbage collection service.

At present, the City has a contract for trash pickup. It runs for another 18 months. The people that had our contracts for disposal were basically purchased by Athens. Athens, when doing so, inherited an existing contract. So, the immediate effect of solid waste pickup will not necessarily be felt as our contract still has another year, year and a half to go. There are substantial increases being imposed upon the City of Los Angeles and other municipalities similar to ours. Public Works is currently analyzing what the City of Los Angeles is doing and discussing our future contacts with Athens, and we hope to be able to negotiate a favorable contract when our current contract expires. Those negotiations have not yet taken place but we are mindful of it and we hope to negotiate the very best contract.

In regard to the recent water rate increases, former Chair Jeff Wolfe said to the Weekly in Issue #901, “Having our own treatment plant is going to benefit the City in terms of issues related to reliability. At the end of the day, you do have to look back on the costs and how it's going to affect the rates.” Why is this important?

From my personal point of view, the question of self-reliability and self-production of water is imperative. We've lived long enough to know there will be emergencies, there will be catastrophes, there will be fires, there will be earthquakes. What we don't know is when they will occur and how severe they will be. So when you speak about the concept of water self-reliability, you need to look at it in the form of an insurance policy. Are we willing to pay more to protect ourselves in the event and in the case that those events take place? What value do we place on the ability to pump water in the City in case a major earthquake destroys some of the infrastructure, or a major fire in which you don't have suf-

ficient water, i.e. the Thomas Fires? The answer is that it's directly linked to the economics and the function of government. The economics of the additional costs are small in comparison to what's at stake. The question becomes is it worth an extra \$10, \$20 or \$30 a month to build an infrastructure that will allow [the City] to be water self-sufficient, and that is for the Council to decide. They

really have done extremely well in that regard. To date we've received support from City Council to move forward with the 10-year Master Water Plan, we've satisfied ourselves that our water sources are reliable and modifications to our water production plant will allow us to once again procure quality water for our community.

Tell us about your family.

I am very fortunate to have been married to my wife Judy for 44 years. We have three children, my son Leland who lives in Beverly Hills, my daughter Lisa, and my son Alan who is a poet living in Brooklyn. All of them at various times attended the Beverly Hills public schools, and then some went on to private. Our family is very involved in the civic activities of the City. And my daughter-in-law Erica is a member of Team Beverly Hills.

What are your main goals as Chair?

My priority would be the 10-year Master Water Plan and ensuring that we have an adequate amount of emergency water supply. In addition to that, I hope that we'll be able to prepare ourselves for the renegotiation of our solid waste contract with the Athens Group. We feel very positive about all these things in the sense that we have an outstanding, dedicated staff.
