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

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

## **Hertz Circulates Petition Against Basement Ordinance**

Attorney Bradley Hertz is leading a paid petition drive to garner enough signatures that would reverse the Council's passage of the Basement Ordinance last month.

Hertz, of the Sutton Law Firm, specializes in election and campaign law.

In order to qualify, petitioners have until April 10—30 days from the ordinance's March 12 approval—to gather signatures of 10 percent of the City's registered voters.

Although paid petitioners are not required to explain every detail in their pitches, they are required to include the entire 19-page ordinance with the petition

and to explain clearly what the referendum is seeking.

The basement ordinance defines basements as "any floor level directly below a story of the portion thereof which has

a finished floor level that is a maximum of three feet above finished grade at any cross-section cut through the building."

It passed after months of negotiations and residential backing.

"Bradley Hertz is an attorney who lives and works in Woodland Hills. He has no connection to Beverly Hills. He is a registered lobbyist with the City of Beverly Hills. He was hired to repeal and/or water down the transparency laws for lobbyists, namely the very ordinance that required

him to disclose his lobbying efforts. It is no surprise he represents the Los Angeles Lobbyist Association in an effort to impede our disclosure laws," said attorney Ronald Richards, who supported the basement ordinance. "Mr. Hertz is an enemy of the People of Beverly Hills and their bucolic serene Hillside area. He will represent whoever pays him without regard for what the consequences are to the Hillside Area or to the City's zoning laws. The basement ordinance along with the retaining wall protections, grading protections, land form alteration protections, and plugging the basement definition loophole was unanimously approved by our elected officials and was the result of years of work by the Planning Commission and a heavily negotiated compromise amongst the non-recused City Council members. Since Mr. Hertz does not live or work in Beverly Hills, he does not care one iota about the concrete carnage that will be left behind or the environmental damage overdevelopment causes to the residents."

Hertz did not return the Weekly's call for comment.

## Board Considers Assembling "New" Reconfiguration Committee

Despite a Future Focused Schools (FFST) report in February, the Board brought back the possibility of assembling a "new" reconfiguration committee to discuss the future of BHUSD reconfiguration.

Formed by Superintendent Michael Bregy back in October, the FFST worked for several months to research viable options for BHUSD reconfiguration, given the district's financial instability.

Their presentation—which advocated 19-2 for the creation of a dedicated 6-8 middle school at El Rodeo—evoked mixed feelings from community members.

Bregy said that one of the key takeaways from those meetings was that the community desires not only a long-term plan, but to be apart of the formation of that long-term plan.

"I think it's important that reconfiguration continuously be part of our conversation. There's a lot of work, a lot of momentum, a lot of education that's happened," said Bregy. "We've engaged our community, and I don't want the perception to be that we've made a decision and that everything is fine, because everything is not fine."

Bregy emphasized the importance of not placing reconfiguration on the backburner for the next several months. This, he says, would make the Board reactive rather than proactive.

He also stated that the possibility of assembling a new committee group similar to Future Focused Schools Team is "a discussion we need to start having."

Board member Noah Margo said that he would support giving direction to form a new committee at that meeting.

"Because of the concerns for the financial condition of the district, we have all gotten to the point where there has to be a plan to address this," said Margo. "I don't think we need to wait to give direction on getting some sort of new committee together."

But Board President Lisa Korbatov argued that before reconfiguration conversations can begin, they must address construction. She pointed out that both Horace Mann and Beverly High are under construction, and that El Rodeo isn't online at all.

"I think this is a great conversation in theory; I just don't think you can put real application of real solutions until you have the physical space," said Korbatov.

The reconfiguration discussion will return at the April 10 Board meeting.

### **Architectural Commission Approves Gucci Barricade**

The Architectural Commission approved last Wednesday a temporary construction barricade graphic for Gucci.

The graphic includes a two square-foot identification sign located on each construction barricade return and a brand specific graphic on the main street-facing elevation.

Placed in front of the Gucci store during remodeling, Gucci is paying for the sign which is not in conjunction with Metro construction.

The commission previously reviewed and approved a façade remodel, sign accommodation for multiple business identification signs, a construction barricade graphic and landscape elements on November 15, 2017.

Any modifications, however, require further review and approval. One such change included revisions to the design of the barricade graphic.

But some commissioners suggested that perhaps a different color would better suit the proposed graphic.

"It seems disjointed with this white between the two pictures," said Commissioner Andrea Apatow. "I'm not going to design it; I'm just pointing out that it feels awkward."

Gucci representative Roy Hansen said that as a part of the condition, Gucci's name had to be centered and could not be in color so as to not obstruct the sign.

"They were worried that putting any color behind it would hide the sign and make it hard to see since the majority of the background is such a dark color," said Hansen.

Commission Chair Michelle Kaye said that because it's a temporary barricade, she doesn't feel "strongly enough" to force an alternative design.

"But I would love for them to consider it," said Kaye, adding that colors such as magenta or pink would be more aesthetically pleasing and create more unity.

## Community Services Issues RFQ for La Cienega Park

The Community Services Department has issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for La Cienega Park and the Community Center Public Outreach and Engagement Project.

The department has also begun outreach to consulting firms specializing in engagement work. The RFQ was publicly posted to advertise the call for qualifications and invited and secure submittals.

Staff met with Public Works to discuss the steps necessary to help insure a successful outreach and community engagement effort.

Proposals will first be reviewed by staff and preliminarily discussed before initiating the review and selection process.

Interested firms had until March 22 at 5:00 p.m. to submit an application for consideration.

The Design Review Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at a special meeting (Study Session) on **Monday**, **April 9, 2018**, will hold a public meeting beginning at **7:00 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to discuss the potential expansion of the City's single-family Design Review program beyond the Central Area of the City, which may include single-family zones in the Hillside and Trousdale Estates areas of the City. The potential to expand the areas subject to Design Review in the City will also be reviewed in the future by the Planning Commission and City Council.

The Design Review Commission's discussion regarding expansion of Design Review may include, but is not limited to, the following topics of discussion:

### **Preliminary Topics for Discussion**

- If Design Review is expanded to the Hillside Area, should it also be extended to Trousdale Estates?
- Should review be limited to the street-facing façade only, as in the Central Area, or should review include other elevations that may be visible from surrounding properties or streets?
- Should properties that are not visible from the street (e.g. flag lots, large estates, significant landscaping, etc.) be exempt from Design Review?
- Should the required findings be the same as in the Central Area, or should new findings be developed for hillside areas?
- Should story poles (poles and flags outlining the envelope of a structure) be required to better understand where a project is visible from and how the massing fits into the topography?
- For projects that require review by both the Planning Commission and Design Review Commission, is there a preferable sequence as to which Commission reviews the project first, or should one Commission be designated to conduct the review in its entirety?
- Should Design Review include review of accessory elements such as retaining walls, fences, accessory structures, swimming pools, water features, game courts, decks, mechanical equipment, landscaping, lighting, paving, etc.?
- Review of trash enclosures
- Should there be options for Track One (Staff level) and Track Two (Commission level) review of projects, and should the Style Guide apply?
- What are the staffing and project timeline impacts that might result from expansion of Design Review, and how can these best be minimized?
- Should the Design Review Commission meet more frequently than once per month?
- What type of public notice should be provided and should bus tours by the Commission be required?

Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the Commission. Any comments submitted will be considered as part of the public record.

## Coldwater Park Renovation Underway

At their Tuesday meeting, the Recreation and Parks Commission discussed an update regarding the Coldwater Park and Playground renovation.

The City Council gave an Award of contract to bidder R.E. Schultz Construction for the project and site improvements at the February 6 Council meeting.

The corresponding purchase order is \$795,751.

Fencing to secure the site during construction has yet to go up as play equipment "was ordered and takes a few weeks to get delivered," according to the staff report.

The construction contractor must also prepare the site and will begin doing that work about two weeks prior to equipment arrival and installation.

### Board Approves DLR Agreement for Architect's Fees

The Board of Education has approved an agreement with DLR Group for Architectural and Engineering Services for predesign, campus modernization, and redevelopment services at Beverly High.

Architect fees are based on a percentage of the cost of construction on a sliding scale by the office of public school construction, according to a staff report.

DLR has submitted a proposal to perform these services for Buildings B1 and B2 for \$723,304.

The total Construction Design Estimate is \$43,000,000

### City's New Electric Vehicle Charging Policy to Take Effect

As more electric vehicles enter the market and our roadways, the City of Beverly Hills has established a new Electric Vehicle (EV) charging policy to prepare the City's EV charging infrastructure to meet the increasing demand.

The new policy, effective April 2, encourages more frequent turnover and efficient use of the City's 35 publicly available EV charging stations. Currently, 59 level 2 connections are available in 14 City parking facilities and at Roxbury Park.

Key components of the EV Charging Policy include implementing energy and station fees, in addition to facility parking fees, prohibiting plug-in hybrid electric vehicles from charging, implementing new enforcement regulation inherent in signage

The new rate structure establishes an Energy Fee of \$0.25/kilowatt-hour (kWh)—applicable only when the vehicle is actively charging—to recover the cost of providing electricity, as well as a Station Fee of \$6/hour—applicable after the first two hours of establishing a connection, regardless of whether the vehicle is charging—to encourage turnover to make the station available for other users.

In order to improve access for vehicles that are completely reliant on electric power, the new policy reserves the City's EV charging stations for battery-only electric vehicles. All other vehicles (including

plug-in hybrid electric vehicles) and any vehicle without an active charging session or not connected to a station may be subject to citation and/or towing at the owner's expense. Drivers should consult EV charging station signage for details about fees, rates and restrictions.

The City Council received a presentation of the proposed EV Charging Policy, based on recommendations from the Traffic and Parking Commission, at the July 5, 2016 study session.

### Vice Mayor John Mirisch on why he opposes Senate Bill 827

Proposed by Senator Scott Wiener (D-San Francisco), SB 827 would allow developers the right to build four to five stories within a half-mile of a major transit stop or a transit corridor, effectively invalidating many local zoning ordinances.

### Tell us why you're opposed to the Scott Wiener bill.

The ideological basis is that single-family housing is "racist." I don't believe that. Scott Wiener thinks that single-family housing is, by definition, "racist." I don't agree. The bill attempts to eliminate single-family housing.

### Do you believe it to be a transit bill?

No, I think [former County Supervisor] Zev Yaroslavsky is correct. It's not even a housing bill; it's a real estate bill.

It would create a lot of luxury condos. I don't think you'll find anybody or very few people in Beverly Hills who are supportive of it. There are a few intellectuals and academics who are completely out of touch who support it, and their positions are in many ways intellectually dishonest [because] they're funded themselves by developers. It's about money.

### How would SB 827 affect Beverly

It would destroy Beverly Hills. Beverly Hills is a very well-planned community and it is a diverse community. This would destroy what Beverly Hills is by effectively taking away zoning regulations and replacing our general planwhich was carefully crafted to reflect our community—with a Soviet-style Sacramento-imposed master plan.

It destroys communities. Not just Beverly Hills, but other communities. [The

bill doesn't treat people like human beings and to me, good policy treats people like human beings. And yes, we have a housing problem. This is not the solution to it. This is like trying to cure psoriasis with an appendectomy.

### What do you plan to do to fight the bill?

I think a lot of people are talking to our legislators and working with other groups. This is something that's being opposed across the board by pretty much everyone

from social justice activists to environmental activists. The only people really supporting it are astroturf groups that are funded by the developers. This bill would represent the single largest wealth transfer in the history of the State of California from the public to the private sector.

We need to galvanize support and show that there is massive opposition to it. We're working with the League of Cities. Most cities throughout the state are

obviously opposed to it. We don't need more Sacramento interference; in fact, we need less of it. It's a problem in general, and as I mentioned at the installation, this is just one of many problems created by the influence of lobbyists and special interests in Sacramento. Really, the solution is less federal, less state, more local and more community. I think it may take a California

constitutional amendment to protect communities and protect local rights.

Editor's note: The City Council unanimously passed a resolution opposing SB 827, saying that the result would "clearly be a spike in average rents in Beverly Hills and a net loss of affordable units."

In 2016, she was given the Olympic Truce Award at the Rio Olympic Games. In 2011, Newsweek named her one of "150 Women Who Shake the World," and Los Angeles magazine named her one of "10 Women Making a Difference in Los Angeles." In 2010, the French magazine L'Equipe named her one of the "10 Women Who Changed Sport" in the world. In 2006, the NCAA named her one of "NCAA's Most 100 Influential Student

In May 2003, Sports Illustrated named her one of the 101 most influential minorities in all of sports, and from 1991-1999, The Sporting News named her one of the 100 most powerful people in sports.

What is the C.E.R.T. Program?

The City of Beverly Hills Community Emergency Response Training (C.E.R.T.) is designed to teach a person to help themselves, family and neighbors in a disaster situation.

This training covers basic skills that are important to know when emergency services are not immediately available. You can make a difference by using the training to save lives and

Emergency responders, emergency management personnel, and emergency trained volunteers provide training. Program material covers earthquakes, fires, terrorism, hazardous incidents and other general life-threatening situations.

This Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) certified course does not require previous emergency knowledge for participation.

### What Does a C.E.R.T. Participant Learn?

Community Emergency Response Team Training instructs individuals to prepare and respond to potential hazards following a disaster. Participants will learn to:

- Recognize the potential hazards associated with a particular type of emergency and take the appropriate action.
- Identify, organize and utilize available resources and people.
- Treat for life-threatening condition through Simple Triage and Rapid Treatment (S.T.A.R.T.).

### What Does the C.E.R.T. Involve?

Participants attend a total of seven modules. Classes include lectures, videos, slides, interactive participation and skills assessment. Becoming a member of C.E.R.T. involves a serious time commitment and only those who who complete all training

## WHAT'S NEXT FOR **RECONFIGURATION?**

Superintendent Michael Bregy on safety and what the schools might look like in the future

### Do you feel that the school security issue has wiped FFST off the map, so to speak?

Our Board of Education actually met with the mayor and police chief before [the] Parkland [shooting] happened about a week before the shooting. So it had been on our radar as far as security. I do think Parkland was the tipping point, but it's important [to say] that we met with the mayor and the city manager and the assistant chief and two board members a week before, because school security has been on our minds. In Beverly Hills, we do get a lot of visitors, so it's been important to us.

### You recently appointed Chris Hertz to Director of Security. Tell us about the specific responsibilities of the position.

I was in a district in Illinois where we had an administrator in a position in charge of school safety. So I was familiar with the [existence] of that position, but I brought it to the Board and said, "I don't know of anyone in California that's doing this, but [here's] a position in a former district where we realized it's really easy to have different procedures for different buildings." It's a conversation I started with the Board-we did begin to [discuss] the position. But after Parkland, it just became really heightened and [important for] somebody to be in charge of

It should be a natural fit to have leadership in our number one priority, which is student safety. [Some of Hertz's responsibilities] are to get us up to speed, because we are lacking some of the procedures and systems in place. I think our staff does a great job and they know what to do in an emergency, but I feel like we're lacking some of the tools that are necessary, some of the technology that's available. We're not checking people into our buildings against a database. I needed somebody who could work with me to start putting systems in place because I feel like our buildings do a great job but oftentimes, they begin to create systems and procedures that work just for their building. That's difficult as a school district, so it's [about] developing those district-wide expectations and procedures and practices so that the expectations will be the same at every building. It's going to be the same type of system, and there will be a locked door here and that you'll be met by a security guard asking how they can help you and if you have an appointment. I think it's only fair to the community that there are common

This year the district is offering a SERP, a.k.a a "Golden Handshake," to

encourage retirements. Has that mitigated the number of certificated layoffs somewhat? Explain.

There's obviously great benefits to offering it to somebody who is at retirement. We didn't have that many people because we've offered it before. We have some people who are ready to retire, and we have some people who want to continue doing what they do. So, this is an opportunity-it's obviously less expensive for the district to bring in somebody who's new, but some of our most seasoned teachers are our best teachers. So, you want to offer it because if some-

body's ready to go, it's a nice incentive to go. But also, if people don't want to take it it's great because they can People like to make it simple and like, "Oh, we saved 12 jobs," but it doesn't work like that. Let's say a fourth grade teacher takes the SERP. We're tightly staffed in our elementary buildings so we have to replace that person because we have 23 kids that need a teacher. Just because

someone takes doesn't mean [we saved] 12 jobs. It doesn't work like that. We're a very complicated organization. It's not a one for one type of deal.

### So, what's the timeline on the future of reconfiguration?

We want to start having some of these

practices happening at each of the five conversations publicly. With the Future Focused Schools team, a lot of the conversations and dialogue that we had was with a group of people selected to serve on this team, and I think some of that got lost. There were updates, but it was more like reporting. It was more like one-way communication because the team and administration would give the Board updates on our progress. What I believe the community has demonstrated by attending our Board meetings is that [they want us] to involve them. Not everybody can be on a team. You can't have a team of 100 people. That's why we are going to be placing reconfiguration on future agendas—so that we can have more of an open discussion around reconfiguration and more of a conversation at the Board

> level and administration level instead of it being more like a report.

We have to do a better job of keeping this a continuous conversation instead of a select group of people. That's why our Board said this needs to be on our agenda, and I couldn't agree more. We need to build the trust up again that we want to be more inclusive. We learned really critical information from the people who did get up and speak. This can't

be an isolated event; it has to be a continuous conversation. It's going to be a long-term plan [where] we keep it as part of the dialogue. We'll probably put [reconfiguration] on every other agenda. We can keep this ongoing, because otherwise we become reactive. If we wait until September, then we're on a timeline again.

## Bregy Gives Update on BHHS Football Program

Norman boys' lacrosse team routs Downey

School administrators will "have to make tough decisions" on Beverly High's football team "based on the participation that we're going to get," Beverly Hills Unified School District Superintendent Michael Bregy said.

"We're moving forward with that this is a program we're going to keep in the fidelity we've been able to keep it at or improve but right now, it's a little premature to determine what we're going to look like for next year," Bregy said in a telephone interview Tuesday.

Bregy said later in the interview in response to a question it was "very likely" Beverly High would continue to field an 11-man football program for the 2018 season, as it has since the school opened in 1927, and "very likely" it would win at least one game.

The Normans have lost 21 consecutive games dating back to the 2015 season and are 2-48 over the past five seasons.

A lack of players, at least partially the result of parents not giving their children permission to play because of a fear of concussions, was cited by former coach

Steve Geanakos multiple times as a key reason for the team's recent lack of success

Earlier in the interview, Bregy said "there has been some conversation" about switching to eight-man football "but there's been no decisions made about that."

"As of right now, we're moving forward with what we've had," Bregy said. "We're not expecting any change there."

Meetings to get a better gauge of how many students will play varsity football are expected to be held near the end of the school year in May, Bregy said.

Beverly High Principal Mark Mead "is doing some informal discussions and recruiting" to fill the school's vacant football coaching position and "we are as well at the district office to start to gauge interest," Bregy said.

"We're getting the word out and starting to have some conversations with people and contacts."

Bregy said the district "will cast a wide net" in the search for a successor to Geanakos, who resigned as coach af-

ter two seasons because of what he described as "a difference of opinion" with Bregy and Mead.

"We're not just going to settle for somebody who wants to do it," Bregy said. "The most important thing to us is find somebody that absolutely wants to be the next Beverly Hills High School football head coach."

There has been interest in the position from both within and outside the district, Bregy said.

The job has been posted for both certificated and classified personnel on an external website listing openings in education

A qualified, certificated BHUSD employee, with a single-subject credential, would receive the position over an applicant from outside the district, according to Laura Skirde, the district's director of communications.

The school's four football coaches since 1990 all had a connection to the school before becoming coach, including Charlie Stansbury, the coach from 2013-15, whose father Bill had coached the team from 1980-89.

Bregy said he expects to be able to provide an update on the coaching search during the last week of April when the district's staffing needs for the 2018-19 school year become clearer.
