Attorney Responds to City's Statement After Spagnoli Lawsuit

Attorney Brad Gage spoke exclusively with the Weekly following the City's public statement regarding the Moreno v. City of Beverly Hills jury verdict that came back July 9.

"First, the city violated the Evidence Code and rules of court in discussing settlement negotiations," Gage said. According to Gage, the city's claim that plaintiffs demanded more than \$20 million is false.

"We actually advised we would have settled for \$2 million with other considerations," Gage said.

Gage also disputed the City's statement claiming that the jury's finding that Spagnoli's comments rose to the level of harassment and retaliation.

"While the city claims there was no wrongdoing by Chief Spagnoli during trial the city revealed that it actually disciplined Spagnoli for numerous harassing comments. It also did not investigate other statements or actions by Spagnoli," Gage said.

Gage said he was most bothered by the City's statement that 'condemns' his clients and others that testified at trial.

"Perhaps most troubling is the statement by the city that it 'condemns' my clients and others that testified at trial. The city has made it clear it will retaliate against my clients further." Gage said, "I want to make it clear that when the city retaliates Goldberg and Gage will be there to stand up to tyranny retaliation and bullying."

Gage represented four city employees that said they've witnessed or been subjected to discrimination and harassment under the leadership of BHPD Police Chief Sandra Spagnoli. The jury ruled in favor of the plaintiffs, costing the City a total of \$1.1 million.

Keith Sterling, Public Information Manager of the City, responded to Gage's statements

"We did not disclose what was offered in settlement negotiations. In open court, attorneys asked for a total of \$20 million for the plaintiffs in this case," Sterling said. "We have acknowledged that an independent investigation of the Chief's alleged actions was conducted. The City did not condemn those who testified, but rather the actions of those who have attempted to undermine the chief, as confirmed in testimony during the trial."

R-1 Permit Approval for Ridgedale Drive Property

At the Planning Commissions meeting last Thursday, Crest Real Estate, on behalf of Alan Salzman, requested a Hillside R-1 Permit allowing an accessory structure located within a rear yard setback to exceed 14' in height at the property located at 1024 Ridgedale Drive.

The permit would specifically account for the construction of a deck that exceeds 14' in height and is located within a required rear yard setback. The proposed deck is defined as a structure and would extend over the slope, have a surface area of approximately 3,150 square feet, be 22' feet at its tallest point, and be attached to an existing swimming pool with spa.

The subject property is located in the Hillside Area of the City, north of Sunset Boulevard. According to staff, the proposed rear yard deck will not have a substantial adverse impact on the scale

or character of the area, on the privacy of neighboring properties, on the neighbors' access to light and air, or on the streetscape.

The property's rear yard faces north and is screened by on- and off-site trees and landscaping that provides privacy for the neighboring residences and the project site.

The proposed deck would be screened through existing and proposed on- and off-site vegetation comprised of trees, landscaping, and vines.

In order to provide the proper amount of screening, Jason Somers of Crest Real Estate said that the applicant is willing to implement the following landscaping options:

- Perimeter of proposed deck: Three new Wilson Olive trees, three new Crepe Myrtle trees, and new English Lavender plants.
- Off-deck within the rear yard area: Two new Catalina Ironwood trees and existing perimeter trees and landscaping.
- Underside of proposed deck: New climbing vines on steel cables will be added to screen the underside of the deck structure. The deck surface will be composed of synthetic turf and bluestone payers.

The proposed deck would provide an extension to the useable recreational area located in the rear yard of this property. Amenities in the rear yard include the swimming pool with spa as well as an ad-

jacent pool cabana.

Somers said that the deck would not be visible from any public right of way. "We're doing everything that we can to landscape and screen to the best of out ability," he said.

Commissioners all agreed that the amount of screening around the proposed deck area needed to be ample enough so that it would not have any negative affects for the neighbors.

"This seems to be a sensible thing to do but I'm thinking we should include a condition that the screening must completely cover the property from the view of the neighbors," Vice Chair Peter Ostroff said.

Another aspect that some commissioners commented on was the material being used for one small section of the pool deck

"I'm almost in complete support of this, but I don't like the fact that the artificial turf being permanent does pose a problem," Commissioner Andy Licht said.

The issue was resolved, as Somers said that using turf instead of grass in the small area mentioned makes it much more cost-effective for the architect to build on.

Commissioner Lori Greene Gordon expressed her thoughts that sometimes the process for obtaining an R-1 permit gets over-complicated, as was her belief with the proposal that came in front of the commission with this project.

"I think there are times where our code overreaches so I think we have to be cognizant of that while also protecting," Gordon said.

Some other commissioners disagreed.

"What's critical here is that everyone understand that there are a number of steps that have to be taken if an applicant wants to do something and make changes," Ostroff said.

The Plannning Commission unanimously approved requested a Hillside R-1 Permit allowing an accessory structure located within a rear yard setback to exceed 14' in height at the property located at 1024 Ridgedale Drive, under the conditions that the existing hedge and landscape buffer along the northern properly line is maintained so that the property is not visible to neighbors or from the street, and that there is no habitable space allowed under the deck.

School District Traffic Mitigation Solution Presented

BHUSD retained consulting services to prepare a traffic study with potential traffic mitigation measures following the reconfiguration of the district.

The reconfiguration of the BHUSD may pose potential traffic circulation starting August 2019 at the start of the school year. The impacted schools are Beverly Vista, Horace Mann, and Hawthorne schools due to the two-year closure of El Rodeo School for full-time construction.

The Traffic and Parking Commission (TPC) reviewed traffic mitigation plans developed by Transportation Planning and Traffic Engineering team in collaboration with the Beverly Hills Police Department and BHUSD, at the May 2 and June 6, 2019 TPC meetings. The TPC is scheduled to receive public comment regarding the plans at the July 11 2019 TPC Special Meeting.

Starting in February 2019, staff prepared for the anticipated changes in neighborhood traffic by conducting field observations, collecting spot counts and talking with Traffic Control Officers (TCO) at each of the stated schools.

Staff and BHUSD agreed to multiple modifications for more efficient student pick-up and drop-off hours at Beverly Vista School. Existing signs will be replaced with 'No Parking, 7 am. to 9 am. and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., Passenger Loading Only, except Saturday and Sunday" signs on the East side of Elm Drive adjacent to Beverly Vista School, South side of Charleville Boulevard between Elm Drive and Rexford Drive, North side of Gregory Way between Elm Drive and Rexford Drive.

Both parties agreed to modify existing signs at Horace Mann. Existing signs on the west side of Hamel Drive, between Wilshire and Charleville Boulevards, will be replaced with "No Parking, 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., Passenger Loading Only, Except Saturday and Sunday." The south side of Charleville Boulevard, immediately west of Arnaz Drive, will become a 3-hour parking zone from 8 am. to 6 p.m. "No U-turn" signs will be installed along Hamel Drive between Wilshire and Charleville Boulevards

Only one traffic modification is proposed within the vicinity of Hawthorne, to replace the existing passenger loading signs on Rexford Drive adjacent to the school with "No Parking, 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., Passenger Loading Only, Except Saturday and Sunday."

The Transportation work plan includes installing the new signage on the public right-of-way in mid to late July, scheduling a joint meeting with BHPD and BHUSD prior to the start of the school year to review the traffic circulation plan

and clarify operation concerns from both agencies. Staff will observe traffic conditions during first few weeks of school and make adjustments as needed.

The cost of modifying parking and loading signs would be nominal and will be installed by City staff.

Open Air and Extended Hours Permits Approved for Lasky Drive Hotel

The Planning Commission met on last Thursday to review a proposed open-air and extended hours permit for a new hotel development on 140 South Lasky Drive.

Principal Manager at Kollin Altomare Architects Christopher Alex presented the request for permits before the committee. The request for an open-air permit pertained to the rooftop pool and lounge area that the firm intends to design.

The firm also requested an extended hours permit to allow guests of the hotel and residents to patron the restaurant, which will be located on the first floor. The requested and approved hours of operation for the restaurant are from 6 a.m. to 12 a.m. Monday through Thursday, 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. on Friday and Saturday, and 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Sunday.

The Planning Commission placed sanctions on the approval for the open-air permit, however. "This really isn't the place for [large parties] on the roof. Generally speaking, this is a beautiful project, but the roof should not be a place for large gatherings or parties of any type," Vice Chair Peter Ostroff said.

Alex explained that the roof is meant to be "an intimate zone" rather than a venue for large events of any kind, and offered a revised roof plan equipped with a gym for hotel guests. "A growing component of the luxury hotel experience is the amenities," Alex said.

The project site is located on a 18,380 square-foot lot comprised of three parcels of land on the eastern side of South Lasky Drive. The site is currently surrounded by commercial real estate consisting of office and retail uses to the north and south, hotel and office uses to the west, and multi-family residential uses consisting of apartments and condominiums to the east.

A total of four hotels are located within 600 feet of the project site: The Beverly Hilton, Waldorf Astoria, Peninsula Hotel and the Mosaic Hotel.

Meg Legget, who resides on Spalding Avenue, said she is a "fan of the Mosaic [and other surrounding hotels]," but has "mixed feelings about Lasky."

"The development [of Lasky] would suddenly obstruct our sunlight. [The residents] are afraid of the noise and the traffic," she said. "The thought of having 6 a.m. up-and-running restaurants sounds intimidating."

Alex pointed to the proposed use of the project site as a hotel is similar to and compatible with the use that currently exists and is in operation. The project intends to improve the already existing Maison 140 hotel on the property, expanding it from a 3-story, 44-guestroom hotel to a 4-story, 66-guestroom hotel with the proposed



amenities, resulting in a net increase of 22 guestrooms over the existing hotel.

"I believe that this project, while it may seem large, [has] proven through multiple studies that we are quite close to scale with the residential property to our east," said Alex. "It is the same height, we did the shade and shadow study, showing the worst case during summer and winter solstice. We felt well within the requirements."

The planning committee closed with a response to the resident. "This [project] is something that is rare for us to see, and they are allowed to go to that height," Commissioner Lori Greene Gordon said, "We appreciate someone coming to this city and giving us this."

"The ultimate goal [of the project] is to fit the true fabric of the city it resides in," Alex said. "Guests don't stay at luxury hotels to sleep - they are looking for experiences. [This will] be a 21st century, small-scale version of a grand European hotel "

"This is a project that will be really great for the neighborhood," Commission Chair Alan Block said.

The committee unanimously approved both permits conditionally. Both parties agreed to include a gym for guests on the roof of the property to deter any large events or gatherings.

The project hotel at 140 South Lasky Drive will begin to undergo renovations, with an expected completion date within the next two years. The name of the proposed hotel is undisclosed.

San Ysidro Drive Property **Preliminarily Approved for Landmark Consideration**

At the Cultural Heritage Commission's April meeting, a preliminary hearing for the property at 1119 San Ysidro Drive's nomination to the Register of Historic

Properties was held

The two-story single-family residence was built in 1927 and designed by Stephen Goosson, who was trained as an architect at Syracuse University and Ecole des Beaux Arts in Paris.

Goosson later experienced success as a set designer and art director in Hollywood, garnered five Academy Award nominations and one win for art direction in 1937

The design of the residence is considered Andalusian in style, exhibiting many of the character-defining features of the

Spanish Colonial Revival.

It features low-pitched red barrel tile roofs, smooth trowel plaster exterior

sheathing, hand wrought iron railings and grillwork, decorative, hand painted ceramic Malibu tiles, and water features integrated into the terraced hillside landscape design.

"This is a different one for me," Commissioner Craig Corman said, "I'm not sure that there's enough in the record for me to recommend going forward. I'm not so sure that this house is special enough to warrant being a landmark."

Commissioner Noah Furie had the opportunity to view the property from the inside, and said that he did think the property should be formally considered for nomination as a City landmark.

The majority of the Commissioners did not think that there was significant information about the property presented to approve its nomination to the Beverly Hills Register of Historic Properties.

However, Commission Chair Richard Waldow said that he thought the property met enough of the criteria to move forward to the preliminary hearing. Commissioners approved the preliminary hearing for the property to be considered a landmark 4 to 1, with Corman voting no.

Website Promoting BOLD Events to Launch

The Arts and Culture Commission met on Tuesday morning to discuss the planning, outreach, and upcoming kickoff celebration of the arts and culture initiative.

Pam Shinault, Assistant Director of Community Services, along with Chair of the Arts and Culture Commission Stephanie Vahn led the discussion to expand awareness of arts and culture in Beverly Hills through strategic priorities, which includes building a website to increase visibility.

"We've already started work with an outside consultant to produce a community arts and culture calendar," Shinault said, "The website will be a go-to resource for residents."

The commission also discussed stakeholder outreach for the kickoff celebration, which is set for August.

"We'll do [a] special invitation to stakeholders, [as well as] public noticing. That can be people in and out of Beverly Hills," Shinault said. The commission discussed the possibility of utilizing the planned website to affectively reach out to stakeholders, the community, and all interested parties.

"[There will be] opportunities for stake-

holders, [and information on] how they can participate in the near term or future," Shinault said, "We need to make sure [the stakeholders] have content on our calendar. Links to ticket sales can be on the website as well."

The commission plans to implement the site before the kickoff celebration, and will be bringing in a third-party tech company to assist in the implementation.

"We will do everything," Shinault said. "Facebook, social media, print media, ev-

erything to get people to participate."

The kickoff will be a pedestrian only celebration with live music, fireworks and social art installations.

Facade Remodel Approved for Residence at 621 N Rodeo

At last Tuesday's Design Review Commission meeting, a proposal for facade remodeling at a property on N Rodeo Drive was approved.

The proposal outlined the remodeling of the existing single-family residence to create an updated contemporary design. The new design includes an articulated façade, which highlights the central entry

feature for the residence.

Large rectangular glazing units flank the entry area of the property. According to City staff, the main challenge for the project is the encapsulation of the existing traditional structure within the confines of the newly proposed contemporary design.

Consideration may be given to creating greater depth to the portion of the façade treatment that highlights the entry.

Also, the location of all air-handling units on the exterior of the structure will be indicated and any rooftop screening elements required should be provided for further review and approval.

As the project moves forward the design team will also provide details for the proposed fencing and gates located in the In the façade remodel, the overall size of the house will remain the same. The intent of the project is to deal with visual clutter, bulk and multiple exterior wall lines and rooflines that will be reduced and simpli-

fied

The proposed development will enhance the appearance of the neighborhood in that the new construction has been designed in context to the appearance of new developments in the surrounding neighborhood while remaining sensitive to the mass and scale of adjacent properties.

According to staff, the updated geometry of the landscaping will promote the garden quality image and appearance of the city, consistent with city goals and existing mature landscaping in the neighborhood.

David Leonard, whose parents live at neighboring property at 623 N Rodeo, addressed the Commission after the project proposal was presented.

"Our only concern is that the construction stay within the appropriate property lines." Leonard said.

Homeowner Yakov Mizrahi said that all construction would be done within the property lines.

Vice Chair Tony Spann asked the homeowner if he would be keeping the original foundation, and how he came up with the design.

Mizrahi said that the family's design proposal would put forth a new style that would keep them happy with the property. The changes to the property's structure, according to the Mizrahi, would make the house modern and simplistic.

"When I saw this house for the first

time this is what I envisioned: something much more modern, streamlined with the lines. The current house has so many different roof settings, heights."

Many of the commissioners did not like how the proposed design of the property looked.

"As it stands, even among the five of the Commissioners none of us fell in love with [the design]. I think you want to put some time into it and redesign this project and come back before us with a more holistic design that is architecturally appealing," Commissioner

Mahnaz Sharifi said.

The commissioners unanimously reject the proposal, but agreed to hear a new design proposal at the Design Review Commission meeting on August 1.

Colombian Orphans in Need of Families Visit the Community

An advocacy event was held on Saturday, July 6th, at Roxbury Memorial Park in Beverly Hills. Twelve kids, ages 8-15, who have no prospect of adoption in their home country arrived in Southern California last week with the organization Kidsave.

Host families, together with Kidsave coordinators and volunteers, advocate to find adoptive families for the kids while they are here. The organization has only four weeks left to find children adoptive families before they return to Colombia on August 1st.


The boutique will begin at 10 a.m. and doors open at noon. The luncheon charge is \$175 per person and includes parking. All proceeds from the event will help sus-

City Explores Set Standards for Future Mixed-Use Developments

The city is continuing to work with an ad-hoc committee in an effort to explore set standards for mixed-use developments within Beverly Hills. The ad-hoc committee presented their suggestions on July 11 before the Planning Commission. This is following a 2018 City Council meeting in which staff presented a study session in response to a request by then-Mayor Julian A. Gold and Councilmember Robert



Wunderlich to provide the City Council with an opportunity to discuss the concept of mixed-use development in the city.

This study session included discussion as to whether there was a desire to direct the Planning Commission to study the possible creation of development standards for mixed-use development in the city. The City Council was supportive of moving forward with further study on this topic as well as the hiring of a consultant to assist the Commission and staff with studying the creation of regulations for mixed-use projects.

On December 13, 2018, the Planning Commission held a study session on the topic of mixed-use development and established an ad-hoc committee consisting of Chair Alan Block and Vice Chair Peter Ostroff. Since the Commission's study session, the ad-hoc committee has met several times to discuss the topic and how to develop regulations for mixed-use development in the city.

Currently, the city of Beverly Hills does not have regulations that allow for mixed-use development, with sparse exceptions. The existing mixed-use projects that have been approved by the city were done so on a case-by-case basis, and the ad-hoc committee seeks to provide a more comprehensive approach to planning for mixed-use in a consistent manner with

known standards and objectives.

Principal Planner Masa Alkire, representing the ad-hoc committee, presented their findings to the Planning Commission, stating that mixed-use developments provide an opportunity to sustain housing without displacing existing residents. The committee also stated that it can provide property owners with additional uses for their property beyond commercial or residential singularly.

The ad-hoc committee also found that mixed-use housing could increase the vibrancy and walkability of the City, although it may potentially reduce the amount of commercial space available.

The committee cited their findings based on visits to neighboring cities that have already implemented mixed-use housing, including West Hollywood and Culver City.

At the Planning Commissions meeting, commissioners discussed appropriate areas where mixed-use housing could be placed. Suggestions included properties

fronting Wilshire Boulevard between San Vicente Boulevard and Rexford Drive, properties fronting La Cienega Boulevard between the northern and southern borders of the City, and properties fronting Robertson Boulevard between the northern and southern borders of the City.

The Planning Commission also discussed what the project approval process includes and the standards that must be met in order to implement this new type of housing. The Planning Commission must approve the development of mixeduse housing for the project to move forward. A new mixed-use permit must also

be developed that includes findings

Ad hoc recommends that height of mixed-use buildings be consistent with the maximum height Floor to Area Ratio (FAR) that currently exists in the C-3 zone, which is 3 stories per 45 feet, and a 2 to 1 FAR.

Staff is seeking Planning Commission and public input on the findings of the ad-hoc committee's findings moving forward. They will then work with the ad-hoc committee to address comments received.

Eliot Finkel Discusses His New Postion as Conference and Vistors Bureau Chair

How did you get involved with the Conference and Visitors Bureau?

I was invited to join by Offer Nissenbaum, we were friends and he served on the Budget Review Committee that I had formed as treasurer and he said 'I think you would be goof for the CVB Board.'

What projects is the CVB currently working on?

The CVB does a lot of different things. There are ongoing efforts, the annual trip to New York. As a member of the Board, at CVB meetings, several of the hotel general manager said it would be nice if Rodeo Drive were open later at nights, so that they could tell guests that want to dine and shop in the evening in Beverly

Hills, that they could go there instead of sending them to Century City of the Grove. That was the germ of an idea which I believe at the time [former] Mayor [Lili] Bosse picked up and ran with— the BOLD program. The CVB has been engaged in heavily supporting

that program at the request of the City ever since it started.

You were City Treasurer from 2005-2017, how does that prepare you for this position?

I'm not sure it did! I think what I've brought to the Board which they needed more of was an understanding of how the City works and who knew people at City Hall. I say that because the CVB is financed entirely by the City as part of an agreement that goes back to the 90's.

When the Weekly spoke with outgoing CVB Chair Offer Nissenbaum in Issue #979 he said, "One of the things we're battling that is negatively affecting the hotel community is Airbnb. We can regulate it better; we can control it better, and we can do a better job of not letting it hurt the hotel community as a whole.' Do you think the City has addressed this issue or does it sill need more work?

I think it's a difficult issue. I do believe that the City has tried to address it but it's a difficult thing to enforce because they're waiting for people to tell them that something is happening. I believe they have actually started going online to look for people who are advertising Airbnbs in the City. But, I would day that the City's isn't in the monitoring business of the Internet. One of the biggest sources they have is public complaints—they will definitely go out and cite [individuals] because it is against the law. It's illegal to have an Airbnb in this City, and it is potentially damaging to the hotel industry and we'd like to stop it. More enforcement would help,

> but like any legal enforcement anywhere else the citizen have to participate. Without the help of the citizens it's hard to get all the people who are violating the rules.

What advice has Offer given you?

Offer and I come from very different places. I'm a financial analyst, that's what

I do for a living and that's why it was easy for me to be treasurer-- that was my primary job, investing the City's reserve funds. Offer is a marketing genius and I discovered when I joined the Board that [many members] has huge marketing talents that I don't profess to have myself. But it's a wonderful resource. Part of our job is to let City Hall know that we have this wonderful [group of people] volunteering their time, and we should listen to them and let them show us the way to market the City. I've been around long enough to say that I know some experts when I see them and there are some real experts that live it-- Offer is one of them.

In Issue #1030 of the Weekly, incoming Chamber of Commerce President Deborah Kallick said," We work closely with our elected officials that represent the City in Sacramento to make sure that they're aware of our concerns." How do you see the CVB

and the Chamber of Commerce work together to achieve common goals like this?

We do that on a regular basis and I believe that certainly the CVB Board has members of both the Rodeo Drive Committee involved. Several of the members are on both Boards or all three Boards.

There's a lot of cross connection. **CVB** the and the Chamber are in the same building, and the CVB Board meets in the Chamber conference room. know T o d d

I know that Todd and Julie work well together. Working together is in everybody's best interest—that said, each group has it's own goals and they are supported in different ways. The CVB is supported solely by the City, the Chamber is pretty much independent and Rodeo Drive Committee is somewhere in the middle.

You're an investment counselor at your own company EFINVEST. Tell us about that.

I started my own business 45 years ago. I started it from scratch and I have been building it ever since. My son and I make the investment decisions and we have a wonderful little business that has been growing steadily over the decades. It's something that we both love to do; we are both analysts at heart. There's nothing I'd rather do than try to figure out what's going on in the world and where to make good investments.

Tell us about your family.

I have two children. My son Peter, my business partner, lives in San Francisco with his wife and two children. I have a daughter named Cindy, who's currently residing in Santa Cruz. She's the head of finance for a new cannabis company. She worked in New York for a long time as an investment banker, and then working for various fashion companies before deciding that the future of growth was in cannabis.

You're originally from Chicago. How did you get to Beverly Hills?

When I was a senior in college, I believe that was back in 1962, my parents were traveling and they said for spring break I could visit some friends in Los Angeles. So I came out here, and I hadn't seen the sun in a month—it was just a misera-

> ble, cold, g r e v Chicago winter. came here and it was in the 70s and sunny and I said this is where I'm going to live. When I graduat-

ed college I took my savings and bought my dads 1960s Volvo and I drove out here to look for a new job.

What kind of challenges are you facing this year?

We are always looking for fresh things to do to attract people and other things, which we gather from around the world. We had a pop up attraction in New York where there was a contest and the winner got flown out to Los Angeles. Promoting the City is an ongoing effort. One of the things that I know the CVB did was a promotional Chinese New Years event. They [coordinated] with Beijing, and now they are having a dance troop coming here to preform. We always look to see where people are coming from and what they're spending, and then we decide how to appeal to those markets. I know they're looking more towards Russia, Mexico and I believe some more towards Brazil and Australia.

A year from now, what do you hope for the CVB to have achieved?

I would like to see the CVB Board come together a little more, that's not anything against the Board its just that some turnover will [change things]. There are some new hotel general managers and so getting everyone working together will enable us to do even more. 
