

Commissioners Undecided on Pool Proposal for La Cienega Park

A La Cienega Park and Recreation Master Plan was presented by staff to the Recreation and Parks Commission last week for review.

Over the last few months, staff and architectural team Johnson Favaro have been working together on the proposed conceptual design and preliminary construction cost estimates for the La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex Master Plan project, which is based on the extensive public feedback that was gathered over the last year.

The Recreation and Parks Commission Liaisons met on August 14 and indicated support for the project, and also mentioned that a Council discussion regarding city projects and funding availability and funding needs will be discussed at one of their meetings in September.

Staff recommended that the La Cienega project be broken into two construction phases. Phase 1 would encompass the construction of a new community center, a gymnasium, an aquatics center and an indoor and outdoor tennis facility on the

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east side of La Cienega Boulevard. Phase 2 would be focused on field improvements on both sides of the street.

Additionally, the construction phasing approach allows for the existing community center to remain until the new one is open.

At the fifth level of the renovated recre-

ational center would reside two pools, one intended for family recreation at 50 meters by 25 yards, and one intended solely for fitness at 25 meters and 25 yards.

In conjunction with lockers and lifeguard areas, a "modest" kitchen and catering corner was proposed.

The pool would be part of a "stacked facility," sitting on top of a recreation center.

Staff sought feedback and a recommendation from the Commission on the proposed concept design and preliminary

construction cost estimate.

"I'm confused about the swimming pool," Commissioner Susan Mishler said. "Will we potentially have two pools in the city open to the public?'

The BHUSD has a plan to potentially add "a separate and distinct pool," according to Community Services Assistant Director Pam Shinault, as part of high school construction, which could be 10 years away.

Currently, the pool at Beverly High is only open to the public through the City's recreation department, according to District Director of Athletics Timothy Ellis.

"No decisions have been made regarding use of school recreation amenities like the pool, if La Cienega's proposed design is built in the future. [Beverly High] is expected to be under construction for a number of years, with the recreation amenities, like a new pool, constructed later in the construction phases," Shinault said. "Therefore, there may be a number of years before any discussion occurs as to how the City may use a new high school pool in the future"

Architect Steve Johnson said that the pool in La Cienega park would be utilized for community services such as water polo or swim lessons, that would be separate from the pool at Beverly High, which is used primarily by students of the BHUSD.

Next steps following the commission meeting will include conducting a Town Hall meeting where the proposed concept

plan and preliminary construction cost estimate will be shared and public input sought. This meeting will be set sometime later in Septem-

Subsequently, the presentation and public feedback gathered at the town hall, along with the Recreation and Parks Commission recommendations, will be presented to City Council sometime in Oc-

tober or November, where the adoption of the proposed master plan may be sought.

A town hall meeting will be held on the park project on September 25 at 6 p.m.

Commissioner Questions Cost of Parking Lot

A new parking lot proposal for the La Cienega Master Plan Project was brought before the Recreation and Parks Commission last week

The proposal was presented by Archi-

tect Steve Johnson of Architectural Firm Johnson Favaro. Currently in process, the master plan provides a detailing of the redevelopment of the 17-acre La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex. The plan also provides a blueprint for above grade holding 250 vehicles and below grade holding 250 vehicles on both sides of La Cienega Boulevard.

The cost of the parking lot structure is an anticipated \$13.4 million, according to

the firm's cost estimators

"That would [total] to \$53,500 per space," Commissioner Julian Javor said. "I would expect that cost to include excavation. It seems a bit high."

Johnson said that, according to the cost estimator, the price is relative to square footage rather than space. He also added that this takes into account the cost of support beams, stairs, and other necessities.

"It's not a suburban parking lot structure, it's much more complex than that," Johnson said.

The parking lot will be a flat-floor concept with speed ramps, "which can allow for future uses," Johnson said.

Javor noted that, with the improvement of public transportation and autonomous driving, a need for such a large facility seems "too costly."

The Wilshire/La Cienega Metro station is scheduled to open in 2023 approximately one block north of the park.

Workers Sue Caffe Roma Management Alleging Wage Theft

TheBet Tzedek organization and Handley Farah & Anderson filed a lawsuit on behalf of current and former employees of Caffe Roma, alleging that for years the management and its owners have wrongly withheld tips owed to the workers and failed to provide meal and rest Caffe Roma breaks required under state law.

Under California's meal break law, if you are a non-exempt worker, you are entitled to a 30-minute uninterrupted, duty-free meal break if you work more than five hours in a workday. You are also entitled to a 10-minute uninterrupted, duty-free rest break for every fours hours you work.



If an employer does not comply with break law requirements, they are required to pay you one extra hour of regular pay for each day on which a meal break violation occurred and another extra hour of regular pay for each day on which a rest break violation occurred.

The City of Beverly Hills (City) is the lead agency in preparing a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the proposed Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) Westside Purple Line Wilshire/ Rodeo Station North Portal (proposed project). The Draft EIR will evaluate the potential for environmental impacts resulting from the proposed project and provide mitigation measures where required. The public is invited to attend a public scoping meeting on Thursday, September 19, 2019, from 6:00pm to 8:00pm, at the Municipal Gallery, Beverly Hills City Hall, 2nd Floor, 455 North Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, CA, 90210 to provide comments on the scope and content of the Draft EIR, including environmental issues that should be addressed in the Draft EIR.

Project Location: The proposed project to be evaluated in the Draft EIR involves the construction of a station entrance/exit to the Purple Line's Wilshire/Rodeo Station on the north side of Wilshire Boulevard. The Draft EIR will evaluate three alternative locations within the City of Beverly Hills adjacent to the future Metro Wilshire/Rodeo Station now under construction as part of the Metro Purple Line Extension (Section 2) Project.

Project Description: The proposed project would provide a station entrance/exit for the Wilshire/Rodeo Station, on the north side of Wilshire Boulevard to facilitate direct access from the Wilshire/Rodeo Station to the dense commercial and tourism activity center located north of Wilshire Boulevard. Three potential station entrance/exit alternatives are being considered: Beverly Drive Alternative: Cañon Drive Alternative: and Cañon Drive Staging Yard Alternative. Each Alternative would include an aboveground street level entrance/exit, a limited intermediate stairway landing level, and a walkway or concourse level.

Purpose of the Scoping Meeting: The purpose of the scoping meeting is to present the preliminary environmental issues identified for inclusion in the Draft EIR to the public, and to provide an opportunity for the public to comment on environmental issues that should be addressed in the Draft EIR. The meeting will include a presentation that describes the proposed project and the environmental issues to analyze in the Draft EIR. Following the presentation, interested agencies, organizations, and members of the public will be invited to present their views concerning what environmental issues should be included in the Draft EIR. All oral and written comments made during the scoping meeting will be recorded. The intent is that the scoping meeting and period will allow the team to gather an inventory of potential environmental effects from agencies and the public that will be considered for inclusion in the Draft FIR.

32-Day Comment Period: The City invites all interested members of the public to provide written comments on issues related to potential environmental impacts during a 32-day scoping comment period, which will commence on Thursday, September 5, 2019, and will conclude on Monday, October 7, 2019. All comments received during scoping will be compiled and put in a scoping report and appended to the Draft EIR. After preparation of the Draft EIR, it will be released for public review and comment. 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The plantiffs in the lawsuit are members of the Los Angeles Chapter of the Restaurant Opportunities Center (ROC) United, whose mission is to improve wages and working conditions for the nation's restaurant workforce.

"The owners of Caffe Roma have used employees' tips to unlawfully subsidize payment of their managerial staff. Futuremore, they have denied meal and rest breaks to its employees as required by California law, frequently requiring workers to complete 13-hour shifts without any breaks at all," said Bet Tzedek attorney Sebastian Sanchez.

"At Caffe Roma, money was more important to the owners than the workers' health, our well-being and ultimately, our humanity," former employee Linda Rijel said. "I hope this lawsuit is a banner of hope to employees that are being mistreated by dishonest restaurant owners, because action is always spurred through hope."

This is an ongoing complaint that had arisen last year when 20 people, including five former employees of Caffe Roma protested inside the restaurant on July 13 present allegations of sexual harassment, tip theft, failure to pay overtime, denial of meal and rest breaks, untimely payments, and lack of transparency regarding sick days to chef and owner Agostino Sciandri.

Caffe Roma's manager declined to comment

BHUSD to Conduct Asbestos Monitoring at El Rodeo

The BHUSD approved the costs for asbestos monitoring at El Rodeo.

On July 1, 2015, the BHUSD entered into an agreement with Environmental Audit, Inc., for asbestos and lead monitoring services during abatement at El Rodeo School.

To proceed with the seismic retrofit and modernization project at El Rodeo School, additional asbestos and lead abatement monitoring and inspection services are required by state law. BHUSD Superintendent Michael Bregy authorized a third amendment to the Agreement with Environmental Audit, Inc., to conduct these services for a fee of \$61,380.

Amendment number 3 was made and entered on August 28 by and between the BHUSD and Environmental Audit, Inc.

The agreement was amended to include tasks and estimated costs for the service. Project managers are to attend approximately 10 construction meetings, including pre-construction meetings and scheduled ongoing construction meetings.

The service provided is required to assure compliance with all regulatory agencies' requirements in connection with the work, and assure the asbestos containing material is properly packaged, manifested, transported, and disposed.

BHUSD Approves Appointment of School Safety Director

The BHUSD approved the appointment of Scott Lovelace as School Safety Director last week.

Lovelace was an officer in the San Diego Police Department for 11 years and the District Safety Manager in the San Ysidro School District for two years prior to joining the BHUSD. Lovelace holds a Bachelor's degree in Sociology from National University and a Master's degree in Demographic and Social Analysis from UC Irvine.

"The Beverly Hills Unified School District is at the forefront of developing innovative safety and security strategies to ensure a healthy learning environment," Lovelace said. "I am excited and honored for the opportunity to bring my training and experience to the BHUSD team."

The salary for the position is \$155,000, according to the BHUSD Director of Public Relations.

City Holds Community Meeting on Oil Well Plugging

The BHUSD, in conjunction with the City, held a community meeting last Wednesday at La Cienega park in the interest of providing an update on the oil well project at Beverly High.

"The City and the District have been working closely with ARB, Inc., a California infrastructure company, to plug the oil wells," Superintendent Michael Bregy said.

With the plugging of 12 oil wells now complete and seven remaining, it is estimated that the project will conclude in the summer of 2020.

"Plugging projects such as this one are commonly and safely conducted in a variety of locations, including urban areas," Bregy said.

The impacts from the plugging operation may include construction noise and occasional lane closures for the movement of equipment. Environmental monitoring will continue to take place throughout the project.

BHEA President offers thoughts on BHUSD reconfiguration

Who do you represent as president of BHEA?

I represent the certificated staff, but there's also a couple other unions that are a part of us like instructional aides ... they have their own presidents, so I mostly work with the certificated teach-

What is the BHEA's general consensus regarding reconfiguration?

Among the members, people are generally for it. We saw the benefits of having a middle school that was better able to serve the needs of those students.

Before, we essentially had four middle schools. All of our resources were spread so thin over those schools, it was hard to give those students everything that they needed or desired.

Everything the students desired as in programs, or classes?

Right, programming, electives... there's so many benefits of combining schools.

At my old site, it was me and one other [teacher] who taught band, and I taught vocal music. And now, we have seven people in the fine art department so that pool of knowledge goes a long way.

New and improved programming and

electives, in conjunction with strengthened educator communication have brought about obvious positive changes. For example, there are benefits of 'veteran' teachers interacting with younger teachers, and vice versa.

Can you talk more about the positive interaction between teachers that was brought about from reconfiguration?

For [all] departments, colleagues are able to see each other and meet together and go over best practices much more readily when they are all in one place, rather than having a meeting [once a] month

When there were four [schools], I would scrape together kids for a choir if it was possible. Now it's so much better, there are so many students to draw from.

And what about the physical changes?

I was at Horace Mann, it was really great because they just remodeled it. I had been in portable buildings for years and now, they built a beautiful underground parking garage with a gate and all the technology was brand new...

What about the technology, I heard there were some concerns among parents about that?

At Beverly Vista they're trying to get the technology up and running, and there is some push back, but like with everything new, there will be growing pains.

Tell me more about working at the brand-new Beverly Vista, how are teachers taking to their new surroundings?

I think it was the only site big enough to hold everyone but it depends on where you are... El Rodeo is being totally remodeled, it's totally down... and Hawthorne is the one site that has more remodeling to be done to it than any of the other sites but it probably just depends on where you're coming

But specifically from a teacher's standpoint?

The move was monumental, almost everyone in the district moved. Even at the high school where

they didn't move offsite, they had to move into portables and things like that because they are doing all this remodeling here... so it was just a huge amount of moving in..

Every time you move, it's a shock to the system. Its stressful. There were some issues around that, but I think that now that everyone is in their new spots, that's mostly being settled out.. I think that by another week probably everyone.

What about the theatre space at Beverly High, any updates on that?

The theatre has been closed for [6 or 7] years... they passed the last bond, Mea-

> sure BH, so that's supposed to re-do all that. But I don't know the timeline on that, I'd imagine it's a few years out still.

> That's not unusual, in college very often you'd go to a church, or a sacred space... because really the acoustics can be far better for what you're doing.

> Here at the high school there's a robust theatre program for sure. At the middle school there is sort of a new theatre

for a choir if It was possible. Now it's so much better, there are so many students to draw from. For example, last year I had 14 kids in my choir, and this year I have 52. So it's a huge difference.

There is a performing arts requirement in high school, but students get to choose their electives.

the nonprofit.


your work as founder.

BHHS football team scores 68 in season-opening victory Normans to play at Carpinteria Friday

Beverly High opened its football season by scoring its most points since at least 1989 in a 68-18 victory over Sotomayor in an intersectional game Thursday night at Sotomayor.

Sophomore Dan Menache ran for 175 yards and two touchdowns on nine carries and threw a 37-yard touchdown pass to his older brother Max Menache, a junior. Dan Menache completed four of eight passes for 58 yards.

Vernon Tucker ran for 141 yards and two touchdowns on nine carries and made a team-high nine tackles and a quarter-back sack.

Ilai Dardashti ran for 117 yards, including a 92-yard touchdown, on three carries.

Senior cornerback Will Liner made two interceptions and recovered two fumbles, returning one for a touchdown, in his first football game since his freshman year.

The Normans led 36-12 at the end of the first quarter and 44-18 at halftime and entering the fourth quarter.

"It was a team that we beat last year so we were confident that we could play well," Beverly Hills coach Jarrod Bunch said, referring to the 32-0 victory in the 2018 opener. "I'm glad we didn't come in over-confident."

The Normans played "very hard the whole time," Bunch said.

Bunch said his team had three players rush for more than 100 yards because of 'some great play calls' on the run/pass option, Dan Menache making "some great plays and outran everybody" and Tucker running "very hard every time he got his hands on the ball."

The Beverly Hills offensive line "played better than it has in the past," said Bunch, who is in his second season as the Normans coach.

Other defensive standouts included senior defensive tackles Ethan Etebar, who made five tackles, and Jeremy Zarnegin, and junior defensive end Milan Nadzakov, who made a quarterback sack, Bunch said.

Sotomayor is a Los Angeles Unified School District school in Glassell Park that opened in 2011. Its football team also includes students enrolled at the two charter high schools on the Sotomayor Learn-

ing Academies campus -- Alliance Tennenbaum Family Technology High and PUC Early College Academy for Leaders and Scholars.

What's Next?

The Normans are scheduled to play at Carpinteria Friday in a nonleague game beginning at 7 p.m.

The Warriors opened their season with a 42-0 loss to Santa Ynez Friday, allowing 28 points in the first quarter and 14 in the second.

"We know this is a test," Bunch said. "We're looking forward to that test. We are going there to win, not to just play well. This year, we're trying to be undefeated."

Architectural Commission Chair Sharon Persovski on Preserving the Unique Look of Beverly Hills

What made you want to serve on the Architectural Commission?

I have many years of design experience designing projects in United States and around the world (Mexico, South America, Japan, China, Hong Kong and Singapore and elsewhere), in retail, hospitality and corporate environments for

some of the best design and architecture firms in the world. I felt that I could contribute my knowledge and experience with the principles and processes of design to the Commission. The Architectural Commission required one Commissioner with signage and wayfinding experience -- a field where it is very hard to find candidates, and this is my specialty. It was a

great opportunity for me. I am so pleased I can contribute my talent and experience to this great City.

What do you think makes the architecture in Beverly Hills unique and distinct?

We have in our City a wonderful shared inheritance of cultural heritage -- a lot of great buildings and architecture. Some great architects have created and built spaces that are extraordinary -- like Frank Lloyd Wright in the Anderton Court Shops on Rodeo Drive, Gin Wang in the Union 76 Gas Station, Richard Neutra's houses, among others, that

make their work unique treasures. We are a special place because of our history, our talent and our community. People who visit us from all over the world are able to recognize that these buildings are unique.

What kind of architecture or design are you most attracted to?

I like all different kinds of architecture, but I especially like architecture that is out of the ordinary. Minimalism, modern and contemporary are some of my favorite styles.

Architecture that is simple but at the same time elegant, and often works well, using basic shapes, colors and lighting – this is what attracts me.

What is the Commission working on now?

We have recently reviewed several exciting projects like the Gucci retail-hostería, the redesign of the Chanel retail store, a place where some of the best designers in the world have made significant contributions – the designer Karl Lagerfeld and the architect Peter Marino, to name a few. We are reviewing design drawings, plans and elevations of a simple and clean design where concepts of design, architecture and landscape have fused together to create an exciting project. Other projects like Sunglass Hut, Brooks Brothers, Bogli-

oli that they presented interesting design concepts for façade remodel and signage accommodations. We usually work in reviewing applicant designs: how they implement their branding and image into their retail façade. Additionally,

we make sure that are the right size, in contrasting colors, and legible. Also, we review the different materials and finishes that they use. There is also land-scape and lighting.

Two weeks ago we had one of our decisions appealed to the City Council. It was related to a commercial space on Beverly Drive. The company brought it to the City Council and the Council

decided to support the Commission 5-0, because the applicant built a sign and installed it without prior review and authorization of the Commission. They will have to rebuild their signage. It is our job to review the designs, and to make sure everyone adheres to the high standards we set in Beverly Hills. We like to think we treat everyone courteously and fairly, even if they are not always happy with our decisions.

In the Weekly's interview with previous chair Michelle Kaye in Issue #929, we asked how she defined good architecture. She responded "I think architecture should enhance and complement its surroundings and the feeling within the city. It also should hopefully look relevant down the road and stand the test of time." What is your definition of great architecture?

First of all, as Architecture Commissioners we have a responsibility to take care of the image of the City of Beverly Hills. Great architecture for me implies great responsibility in creating design and spaces that are sustainable. I would like to see buildings that can be perceived as cultural symbols, as works of

art. For me, great architecture is out of the ordinary – it's designs that are different, that take risks in looking for new ways of representing spaces, and that are innovative but at the same time achievable. I would like to see architecture

that has a connection with people and the environment that contributes to the future of a vibrant City with high expectations and reputation for excellence.

Tell us about your family.

Both of my kids [attend Beverly High]. My son, Andrew Rugendorf, is in his last year and my daughter Ariela Rugendorf just started high school. They both enjoy art,

and I am happy about that. They like sports a lot too -- my son plays lacrosse and my daughter is a cheerleader.

You're the founder of 'Smiles through Art.' Tell us a little about the mission behind the organization.

I founded a non-profit organization called "Smiles Through Art" with the purpose to create programs to help children who have certain conditions and are economically disadvantaged. To bring a little joy into their lives through art, because art does that.

I was invited to Mexico City to work with a community of 150 children. These children were living in extremely poor conditions. They asked if I could create an art program for them.

The project's name was "Blooming Communities" and it was centered around flowers, and they learned how to create something that looks beautiful using color acrylic boxes, paint and sponges. It was very successful. It gave me a great pleasure to be able to help children that were in need. Eventually I would like to have a lot of projects here in the City, throughout the region and internationally.




