



Notice of Public Hearing for Adoption of a

GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY PLAN

for the Santa Monica Groundwater Subbasin (Water Code Section 10728.4)

This is a Notice that the Santa Monica Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA), which is composed of the cities of Santa Monica, Culver City, Beverly Hills, Los Angeles through the Department of Water and Power, and the County of Los Angeles, is proposing adoption of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the Santa Monica Groundwater Subbasin pursuant to Water Code Section 10728.4 under the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) of 2014. The GSP is the governing document related to groundwater for Santa Monica Subbasin, Groundwater Basin Number 4-11.01.

SGMA stipulates that at least 90 days prior to holding a public hearing to adopt a GSP, a GSA must provide notice to a city or county within the area of the proposed GSP (Water Code Section 10728.4). The GSA must review and consider comments from any city or county within the area of the proposed GSP that receives this notice and shall consult with any city or county that requests consultation within 30 days of receipt of this notice.

The GSP was available for public comment from July 15, 2021, to September 28, 2021, and was posted on https://www.santamonica.gov/gsp.

A Public Hearing for Adoption of the GSP for the Santa Monica Subbasin is being held at 5:30 pm on Thursday, January 13, 2022, via Zoom pursuant to SB 361. This legislation allows local agencies to address emergent pandemic conditions by allowing local officials, and the public, to participate in public meetings via virtual platforms. If the order is in effect, the Zoom link to the meeting will be posted on December 1, 2021.

Once adopted by the GSA, the GSP for the Santa Monica Groundwater Subbasin will be submitted to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) via the DWR web portal for their review and evaluation. Once the GSP is posted on the DWR web portal, it will be open to additional public comment for 75 days. The GSA will begin implementing the GSP immediately, even before DWR's review of the GSP is complete.

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
(You shall not deny falsely. You shall not lie, one man to his fellow).

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"They think it's going to be a fun and safe photo opportunity. Let's show up here and show them it's not...let's make them afraid."

Clearly, the union is dealing with the backlash of the bad PR from their alignment with those who would harass our schoolchildren. We can understand why they eventually took down the social media post advertising the Anti-Vaxxer school protest and why they are trying to disassociate themselves from an incident that was so traumatic for many of our school children who are currently attending Hawthorne, my alma mater.

The BHFA claims that they thought the protest directed towards schoolchildren and their parents were "an event in support of BHUSD parents." And yet the speakers sharing the stage with the BHFA president and other BHFA members on Tuesday made crystal clear their goal was to make children and their parents "afraid." The response of the members of the BHFA and their supporters in front of City Hall on Tuesday was not to express disapproval or disgust but to actively cheer on these threats.

When you cheer people on to set a fire on Tuesday and they do it on Wednesday, you don't get to simply walk away from it on Thursday. You're still responsible.

The claim that the union thought the Walk-to-School protest was "in support Of BHUSD parents" is both laughable and an insult to the intelligence of this community

When common sense, facts, and all else fails, the union tries to invoke the almost "100 year history of service" of the BH Fire Department.

But that history of service isn't the issue here.

The issue here is the selfish and destructive behavior of a few union members, none of whom were born when the BHFD was founded. The issue here is the unwillingness of a few BHFA members to take measures mandated by the County Department of Health to protect the community. The issue here is that those paid an average total compensation of \$348,000 per person per year seems to be rooting for something bad to happen "to prove a point."

The issue here is their self-entitlement and that, in constantly referring to the BHFD as "their" department, they forget whom they're working for. They forget that it isn't "their" department. It's OUR department, the residents, and the community's. And that's something they must never forget.

The issue here is that the behavior of a minority of their members heaps dishonor upon that 100 year history.

It's time for the BHFA to own up to the unacceptable behavior of some of their members and to take corrective action, not to double down on bad behavior.

It's time for the BHFA to end their members' acts of insubordination, to ful-fill their job requirements without unnecessarily putting our residents at risk, to apologize to Chief [Greg] Barton for the egregious disrespect they have shown him, and to apologize to the Beverly Hills

residents and the entire community at large for this unacceptable behavior.

In short, it's time for the BHFA to get all its members to stop acting in a way that profoundly dishonors the 100 year history they so proudly and incongruously now invoke.

City Council Adopts Urgency Ordinance Restricting School Demonstrations

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council unanimously adopted an urgency ordinance and a regular ordinance that prohibits demonstrations within 300 feet of an entrance to a school.

At last Wednesday's "Walk to School" event, people protesting vaccine and face mask mandates protested at the same time and location as the event and stood immediately outside the entrance to the school as school children were attempting to enter the school building. Parents and school children were forced to avoid these protesters at the entrance to the school forcing some people to walk in the street and the close presence of protesters screaming and yelling caused some children to become upset and frightened.

Mayor Robert Wunderlich and Councilmember John Mirisch both requested that the city address this issue. The ordinances prohibits protests near the entrance to schools, prohibiting protesters from following anyone who is a student, and prohibiting protesters from engaging in protests at the same time and location as lawfully permitted events or other protests.

According to the staff report, children who are enrolled in public school are compelled to arrive and depart at designated hours and use a designated entrance. These children are a captive audience and cannot avoid the speech delivered by protesters gathered near entrances to their schools. The entrances around schools can also become very crowded and sidewalks around the entrances are very narrow.

Staff further explained that there is not enough room on the sidewalk to safely accommodate school children and demonstrators. Consequently, the ordinances provide that there can be no demonstration within 300 feet of the entrance to a school on days when school is in session and during the hours immediately before and after the school day. The city estimates that 300 feet is an adequate distance to allow students to enter and depart the school without obstruction and to allow protesters to address the parents and other adults traveling to or from school during those hours.

Since students are a captive audience when they must travel to school, they need appropriate space to be able to distance themselves from demonstrators, and because of this, the ordinances provide

that within 10 blocks of a school, demonstrators are prohibited from following any student who is going to or from school.

The ordinance also prohibits any demonstration which is conducted at the same time and location of another demonstration that is already taking place or is conducted at the same time or location as a lawful event that was issued a permit.

"This is a situation that I completely will go to the mat on, and I can tell you that this entire council, this entire community will go to the mat on this. There are even people that I know in this community that haven't had the vaccine, and they too have been mortified by what occurred last week. When you are talking about children that's it, that's the final straw," said Councilmember Lilli Bosse.

One's speech will not influence how these ordinances are administered and are intended to preserve the physical safety and traffic safety of students traveling to and from school.

Traffic and Parking Commission Discusses Update on Purple Line Extension

At their Oct. 7 meeting the Traffic and Parking Commission provided an update on the construction of the Metro Purple Line Extension.

Wilshire/La Cienega construction is ongoing through next year. Currently, Metro is hauling, excavating, and installing lagging for the north appendage structure. Both Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) have reached the end of the Section 1 tracks. In July, Metro's contractor started the removal of the TBM gantries, which is an overhead bridge-like structure supporting equipment such as a crane. This operation will continue through the end of this month. These gantries are expected to be oversized overloads, which may require a Caltrans circulation permit, CHP officer escort, and temporary closure of North Gale Drive. Any transport of oversized load is scheduled for after 9:00 p.m.

In March Metro installed a k-rail closure on the north side of Wilshire Boulevard between San Vicente Boulevard and Hamilton Drive to support phase one of construction of appendage structures, which house vital functions for the stations, such as emergency exits, ventilation rooms, and entrance and exit structures. This phase reduces Wilshire Boulevard to two lanes in each direction with parking restrictions and closes the north sidewalk on Wilshire Boulevard between San Vicente Boulevard and Hamilton Drive. Pedestrian crossings at Wilshire Boulevard and Gale Drive are maintained. Appendage construction will continue for about 2.5 years.

Additionally, Metro will implement "bump outs" on westbound Wilshire Boulevard. This traffic closure will be implemented on weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and weekends from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., which will reduce Wilshire Boulevard to one lane on the westbound side.

Excavation of the Wilshire/Rodeo station is complete and construction is in progress. All material deliveries and concrete placements are anticipated to be five days a week, Monday night through Saturday morning. Since completion of the station's invert slab, the contractor has been delivering steel, forms, and conduits and placing concrete for the construction of the station walls. The placement of the walls is expected to continue for several weeks.

The installation of various instruments within the station box and along the tunnel alignment to monitor possible movement of the ground and utilities is complete, as well as geological conditions during construction. Maintenance of these devices will be ongoing and will require closures of traffic lanes, crosswalks, and parking meters. Currently, the instrument maintenance work is on Wilshire Boulevard between Rodeo and Bedford Drives. Work hours on Wilshire Boulevard are from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on weekdays. On residential streets off Wilshire Boulevard, work hours are on weekdays from

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8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

As the TBMs advance, 10 foot poles with surveying instruments are temporarily installed on sidewalks in order to monitor for ground settlement and movement. These instruments, called "total stations", are anticipated to be moved with the TBMs as tunneling progresses. Installations have been completed on Lasky Drive, Charleville Boulevard, and Spalding Drive, and work recently started on Wilshire Boulevard. Work hours are weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The city has released a request for proposals for the design of the north portal at Wilshire Boulevard and Beverly Drive and anticipates awarding a contract for the work by the end of the year.

Traffic and Parking Commission Discuss Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program

On Oct. 7 the Traffic and Parking Commission provided feedback on proposed traffic calming measures to include in a citywide Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP).

Traffic calming is the implementation of physical design elements to improve community safety by reducing speeding and cut-through vehicle traffic in residential neighborhoods. A NTCP consists of policies, procedures, and specific traffic calming measures that can be applied in situations. The traffic calming toolbox serves as a resource to identify traffic calming options needed to address traffic-related concerns in a specific location.

On April 20, the City Council adopted the Complete Streets Plan, which identifies high-priority projects for installation. The plan recommends the development of a NTCP as a resource to the community.

Traffic calming measures are engineering tools that work to alter driver behavior to minimize neighborhood cut-through traffic and reduce speeding.

Currently, the city offers a limited number of traffic calming measures; primarily speed humps, lane narrowing, and vehicle speed feedback signs.

The program will be focused on residential streets and does not apply to commercial streets because the traffic calming measures for residential streets are not usually appropriate for use in commercial areas.

The commission will meet at a future date to discuss policies for implementa-

BHUSD Board Applications Due Friday

The BHUSD Board of Education is currently accepting applications to fill the vacant seat due to the resignation of Board Member Tristen Walker-Shuman. The appointee will hold office for the remainder of the term, which expires on Dec. 22, 2022.

Anyone interested in applying to serve on the board can submit their application through bhusd.org/boevacancy/ by 4 p.m on Oct. 15.

To be eligible to apply an individual

must be at least 18 years old, a resident of the BHUSD, be a registered voter in California, and not be disqualified from holding civil office. To verify residential eligibility the BHUSD school finder map can be used on the BHUSD website under School Finder. An employee of the BHUSD may not be sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of the board unless they resign as an employee. If they do not resign, the employment will automatically terminate upon being sworn into office.

Some questions being asked on the application are; "have you worked on any school committees or participated in any school activities recently"; "why do you want to be a school board member; what do you see as the basic purpose of the public schools"; "what is the role of the school board in the fulfillment of that purpose"; "how does the board's role differ from that of the superintendent"; and "what do you see as the strengths of our district", among many others.

At the Oct. 4 special board meeting Board of Education Member Noah Margo asked "has a resignation ever been rescinded?"

Jabari Willis, the district council responded by saying a resignation has not been rescinded after it has been submitted to the county superintendent. Walker-Shuman will not be able to rescind her resignation.

The Board of Education will interview candidates and make a selection at an upcoming board meeting.

City Council Denies Request for Review of Architectural Commission

At their Tuesday Study Session the City Council denied a request from Councilmember John Mirisch to discuss whether to order a review of the Architectural Commission's decision conditionally approving a front yard fence and gates on the multifamily property located at 332-336 North Oakhurst Drive.

On Sept. 20, the commission conditionally approved a request for a front yard fence and gates for the properties located on North Oakhurst Drive. The project is currently subject to final review and approval of the following conditions by the city's urban designer: the northern and southern fence returns should include pilasters at the termination points; the fencing overall shall be a maximum of four

feet in height; a selection of a low-growing Bougainvillea species in the front setback and further review the planting palette to revise the specification for the Sansevieria (Snake Plant) proposed, and a final landscape plan shall be provided and additional trees shall be added.

The City Council may order a review of any decision made by any commission, board, or official of the city.

An appeal of the Architectural Commission's decision was filed by Steve Mayer on Oct 3.

Since the City Council did not call the item up for review, Mayer may elect to pay the remainder of the appeal fee to appeal the item to the City Council for further review.

Design Review Commission Approve Wetherly Drive Project

At their Oct. 7 meeting the Design Review Commission approved a project that will allow the construction of a two-story single-family residence located at 115 North Wetherly Drive and is situated ad-

jacent to a commercial structure.

The proposal is for the construction of a new two-story single-family residence to replace the existing single-story structure.

The design of the structure incorporates a broken and stepped "butterfly" roof de-

sign with two offset angled roof lines intersecting a central flat-roofed module. The materials include a horizontal wood cladding in a dark finish on the upper portions of the façade and in conjunction with a cantilevered awning element at the central entrance and a standing-seam metal roof. The metal-framed glazing units are specified with a bronze anodized finish and the landscape plan also includes a palette of drought-tolerant plantings

with a large tree placed in the front.

The project requires mailed public notice within 100 feet, and an on-site notice at the subject property be posted 20 days prior to the hearing. The public notice for this project was mailed on Thursday, Sept. 16. A posted notice was also placed on the site.

City Council Approves Amendment for Homeless Engagement Service

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council approved an amendment to the agreement between the city and Step Up on Second for engagement and outreach services in support of the Changing Lives and Sharing Places (CLASP) program and approved a purchase order for Fiscal Year 2021-22 in the amount of \$106,449.

Step Up on Second is a social services agency that delivers support to people experiencing homelessness and serious and persistent mental illness to help them recover and integrate into the community.

The contract provides for an outreach and case management team entirely allocated to the city and trained to work with individuals new to homelessness as well as individuals with mental illness. The team develops individual plans to support people in meeting their specific needs.

The CLASP program is the foundation of Beverly Hills' social service safety-net to meet the needs of homeless individuals challenged by persistent and serious men-

tal illness. The outreach team operates out of the Human Services Division's office and the team spends their time engaging individuals who have been long-term homeless in Beverly Hills as well as individuals new to the area before they anchor in the parks and streets.

Local businesses and residents continue to express concern regarding the impact homelessness has on the city's quality

of life.

This agreement was first approved on June 16, 2020, and the amendment is to include the consideration for each additional year.

City Council Approves "City of Beverly Hills Dance and Fitness Blast"

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council approved a free public event, "City of Beverly Hills Dance and Fitness Blast" that will be held on Sunday, Jan. 30 and an event-related street closure on North Crescent Drive.

All Seasons Fitness Media sought the Rodeo Drive/Special Events/Holiday Program Committee support for the event, at their Aug. 30 meeting. The event proposes to celebrate the city's birthday and city staff by inviting members of the public to participate in free exercise and wellness classes, booths with activities and give-aways, as well as live music.

A similar event was held in 2018 and 2019: Beverly Hills 5K-10K Walk/Run and Fitness Blast.

The event will require a street closure of the 400 block of North Crescent Drive between North and South Santa Monica Boulevards for the duration of the event, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., including setup and tear down.

The event will include dance and fitness

classes in the courtyard of City Hall, yoga in the early morning, music, and booths with offerings from sponsors, including healthy food options.

The program is intended for the community to enjoy for free, including residents, visitors and city staff and their families. Several hundred attendees are expected. Local instructors and businesses, residents, and sponsor vendors will also be participating, following all current health protocols relating to events of this size.

Board Approves New CBOC Members

At their Tuesday meeting the Board of Education approved three new members to the Citizen's Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC).

The board interviewed five candidates to fill the vacancies on the CBOC and approved applicants Harry Kraushaar, Marc Carrel, and Celina Serrano.

The CBOC is charged with overseeing bond fund expenditures and ensuring they are used for their intended purpose. The committee also reviews Measure E bond expenditures and presents an annual report to the board.

Seven members serve for a two-year term without compensation and for no more than three consecutive terms. The committee must include; one member who is active in a business organization representing the Beverly Hills business community; one member active in a senior citizens' organization; one member who is a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the district; one member who is both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the district and active in the PTSA; and one member who is active in a bona fide taxpayers' organization.

The newly appointed members will be filling the vacancies of Jason Rund and Richard Schreiber.

Rent Stabilization Commission Amend Urgency Ordinance

At their Oct. 6 meeting the Rent Stabilization Commission adopted a resolution to amend an ordinance regarding the temporary moratorium on evictions and rent increases during the period of a local emergency.

On Sept. 13, in a 4-2 vote, the commission voted to recommend to the City Council that the Ordinance be amended to end the moratorium on no-fault evictions, and the moratorium on annual rent increases, at the same time as the state's eviction protections established by Assembly Bill 3088 end, which was Sept. 30. Commissioners Kathy Bronte and Donna Tryfman voted against the resolution.

The Ordinance imposed a moratorium during the period of local emergency on evictions for non-payment of rent by residential tenants who are financially impacted by COVID-19; no-fault evictions, unless necessary for the health and safety of tenants, neighbors, or the landlord; and annual rent increases.

Nothing in the Ordinance relieves the tenant of liability for the unpaid rent, which the landlord may seek after the expiration of the local emergency. The Ordinance provides that the tenant must pay in full all back rent within one year of the expiration of the local emergency.

AMCHA Denounces Newsom's Signing of Ethnic Studies Bill

The AMCHA Initiative Director, Tammi Rossman-Benjamin, issued a statement in response to Governor Gavin Newsom's signing of AB 101 on Oct. 8, a bill to make ethnic studies courses a high school graduation requirement.

According to the organization's website, AMCHA is the Hebrew word meaning "your people" and also connotes "the masses," "grassroots," and "ordinary people."

The AMCHA Initiative is a non-profit organization whose sole mission is to investigate, document, and combat antisemitism on U.S. college campuses.

"Having closely monitored and studied the ethnic studies scene unfold on college campuses for years, particularly in California, to say we are deeply concerned is an understatement. While certainly not all in the ethnic studies field fall into this category, there is a vocal and active faction of extremists who have long been seeking to inject their antisemitic and anti-Zionist agenda into our nation's classrooms, and today that faction succeeded. This is a dark day for Jewish students in California and the dozens of other states that historically follow California's lead," Rossman-Benjamin said.

AB 101 would require high schools to offer ethnic studies courses beginning in the academic year 2025-26 and make

the course a graduation requirement commencing in 2029-2030.

"The fact that no less than seven 'guardrails' were deemed necessary for preventing AB 101 from facilitating the widespread promotion of antisemitism is itself a stunning indictment of the bill and the dangers it poses for Jewish students and the Jewish community. And by law those so-called guardrails are purely optics. They carry zero weight when it comes to preventing school districts from bringing the rejected and blatantly antisemitic original ESMC curriculum or its far worse Liberated cousin into the classroom," Rossman-Benjamin said.

According to Cal Matters, some lessons provided in the curriculum include, "Migration Stories and

Oral History," "#BlackLivesMatter and Social Change," "Afrofuturism: Reimagining Black Futures and Science Fiction," "US Undocumented Immigrants from Mexico and Beyond," "The Immigration Experience of Lao Americans" and "This is Indian Land: The Purpose, Politics, and Practice of Land Acknowledgment."


"Making matters significantly worse, California's teachers' unions and public universities' ethnic studies departments proudly support those overtly antisemitic curricula. Both the original ESMC draft and Liberated's curriculum are endorsed by California's two largest teachers' unions and ethnic studies departments and faculty on Cal State and University of California campuses," Rossman-Benjamin said

The curriculum was written by the for-profit organization, The Liberated Ethnic Studies Model Curriculum Institute (LESMCI). They referred to Israel as an apartheid state and claimed it violates international law. They also called the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions movement a "global social movement that currently aims to establish freedom for Palestinians."

"This bill could and should have been stopped at the legislative level and must not be forced on the Jewish community to fight in each of California's 1,300 school districts. We surely hope that those who guaranteed the guardrails would prevent antisemitic curricula from seeping into our state's high schools stand ready to fulfill their commitment since this enormous responsibility ought to fall squarely on their shoulders, not on parents and students," Rossman-Benjamin said.

The bill was authored by Assembly-member Jose Medina (D-Riverside).

"Requiring ethnic studies in high schools is an integral part of cultivating a classroom environment that is accepting of diversity. It is vital for young people to learn about their history, it is also important for them to feel like they can con-

"In light of the recent earthquakes that have occurred globally, the City is committed to ensuring both the public and its staff are prepared if a disaster occurs. We encourage all residents and businesses to participate in this year's drill so that they can take the correct action when the time comes to do so," said Meena Janmohamed, Emergency Management Manager.

The "Great ShakeOut Earthquake Drill" will occur throughout the nation and several countries worldwide. Participants include schools, individuals, businesses, government agencies and other groups.

City Council Approves Lease with Tommy's Beverly Hills

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council approved a lease agreement between the Parking Authority and Tommy's Beverly Hills, LLC located at 235 North Cañon Drive. The tenant intends to deliver an upscale full service restaurant and wine bar.

The space is currently vacant and the proposed lease includes an initial term of

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twenty years. Monthly base rent is initially \$30,000 per month and will increase annually by 2.5% through the entire term. The Tenant will also be required to pay a fixed operating expense amount and percentage rent.

Over the 20-year term, the lease will generate \$9,196,077.36 in revenue from monthly base rent. Over this initial term, staff also estimates the lease will generate \$1,034,865.12 in revenue for the tenant's share of building operating expenses and an additional \$150,000 in parking revenue.

In addition, the tenant will also be required to pay 5% of its gross sales for any first floor business that opens prior to the rent commencement date until the sooner of the second floor restaurant opening or the rent commencement date. Beginning on the first anniversary of the rent commencement date, the Parking Authority will also collect 5% of any amount by which the tenant's annual gross sales exceed \$11 million. This threshold of \$11 million will increase annually by 2.5%.

Beverly Hills Celebrates National Pedestrian Safety Month

In an effort to promote pedestrian safety, the city has joined the U.S. Department of Transportation's (DOT) National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and Federal Highway Administration to celebrate National Pedestrian Safety Month throughout Oct.

DOT data shows that in 2019 more than 6,000 pedestrians were killed in traffic crashes. The annual campaign encourages road users to be aware of their surroundings and that vehicles take extra precaution when pedestrians are present.

The City of Beverly Hills has initiated numerous projects aimed at improving the pedestrian experience such as; installing additional "Leading Pedestrian Interval" timing throughout traffic lights which allow for pedestrians to get a four-second head start to begin crossing and adding additional bike parking corrals which free up sidewalk space for improved pedestrian travel.

Additionally, the city recently partnered with BHUSD to promote 'National Walk to School Day' on Oct. 6 which encouraged children and parents to utilize the crosswalks and sidewalks as a safe mode to get to class.

In 2022, the city will also participate in its very first CicLAvia in Beverly Hills which will open a segment of North Santa Monica Boulevard for walking, cycling, and other modes of non-motorized transportation.

Board Approves Cost Estimate with Department of Toxic Substances Control

At their Sept. 28 meeting, the Board of Education approved the annual cost estimate with the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for regulatory oversight activities at Beverly High.

On Aug. 11, 2015, the Board of Education approved entering into an agreement with DTSC for oversight of the testing program required as part of the CEQA process at the Beverly High site. Since that time, DTSC has provided the district with annual cost estimates to continue the oversight of the testing program.

On Feb. 23, the Board of Education approved an updated cost estimate that expanded the scope of work to include a site conditions report and workplan that documents the investigation and remedial work conducted for areas at the site and outlines the additional investigation efforts proposed for the site, a methane mitigation system design for proposed Building C and a Remedial Action Plan for the former Venoco facility.

The cost estimate has been updated to include all of the approved scopes for the next fiscal year 2021-2022 at a cost of \$121,046. The fees for the oversight would be paid for by Measure BH.

Board Approves Amendment for Agreement with HMC Group

On Sept. 28 the Board of Education approved Amendment No. 14 to the agreement with HMC Group for architectural and engineering services for El Rodeo School Seismic Retrofit and Modernization Project.

On April 18, 2011, the district entered into an Agreement with HMC Group for architectural and engineering services for the El Rodeo School Seismic Retrofit and Modernization Project. The Board of Education had previously approved Amendment Nos. 1 through 13. Amendment No. 14 would authorize HMC to develop floor plans for Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment (FF&E) for all building spaces at El Rodeo School, based on the District's FF&E standards, and support the District with procurement and placement of the FF&E for a fee of \$50,564.

The fees associated with Amendment No. 14 would be paid with Measure BH funds budgeted for El Rodeo School Modernization.

BHUSD to Sell Back Old IPads

At their Tuesday meeting the Board of Education approved an agreement with Diamond Assets to sell back old ipads.

BHUSD technology has around 560

older iPads no longer being used in TK-2 classrooms. The iPads are assessed as being in good or excellent condition and are less than six years old.

The estimated buyback value is \$82,500.00. Additionally, there are 36 iMacs at the high school with an estimated buyback value of \$5,325.00. The total buyback is estimated at \$87,825.

This will extend Measure BH technology replacement funds.

The fiscal impact is estimated to add to technology replacement dollars in the amount of \$87,825.

"As Good As Gold" Closed at Theatre 40

On Oct. 3 a broken pipe on the second floor of the Theatre 40 building caused the stage to sustain water damage, necessitating mandatory repairs. The performance of "As Good As Gold" has subsequently closed.

It is anticipated that the next show of the Theatre 40 season, "Good People," will open on schedule on Nov. 18.



At their Oct. 4 special board meeting the Board of Education entered a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with

the Beverly Hills Education Association (BHEA), the teachers' union, regarding the reopening of schools despite relatively low levels of transmission among students.

According to the -BHUSD website, as

of Friday, there are currently three active cases among all district students and 31 total cases for the 2021-2022 school year. There are currently two active cases among district staff with a total of 11

cases for the 2021-2022 school year.

Pursuant to the MOU, students must now wear masks at all times on district

> including property, outdoors and at recess. Masks may be removed when eating and drinking and must be put back on immediately. cording to the county website, they do not currently require outdoor masking for stu-

dents. The agreement also grants BHEA the authority to require mask mandates even if the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health guidelines or requirements change.

The changes come as some jurisdictions are loosening their rules. San Francisco announced they will be lifting their indoor requirement mask for indoor gyms and offices by Oct. 15, if everyone inside is vaccinated.

Regardless of vaccination status, any visitor, including but not limited to parents, volunteers, temporary workers, and delivery persons entering any

BHUSD site for more than 15 minutes for vaccinated students and staff. must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test result dated within one week of entering campus. Should they not have this, security will refuse entry and send them to BHUSD to test immediately in order to return.

The district will require proof of COVID-19 vaccinations for all staff, faculty, regular workers, contract workers, and substitute teachers,

as well as for all eligible students. The district will require all vaccinated em-

ployees, staff, faculty, regular workers, contract workers, and substitute teachers to test weekly at BHU-SD. Unvaccinated students will also be required to participate in weekly testing and vaccinated students will be tested at random.

According to the county website, they only recommend regular screening testing for unvaccinated students and staff, not

BHEA unit members will receive a separate \$300 check to "compensate for their additional work during the COVID pandemic in the 2021-22 school year.'

BHUSD has stricter guidelines than those required of other school districts by the County's Department of Public Health.


