"Police and Fire Endorsements for Council"

Every Beverly Hills City Council Candidate has been warned by the City Clerk that pursuant to California Government Code §3206, uniformed city personnel, such as police and firemen, are prohibited from participating in any political activities when in uniform. And candidates have been further warned that they are therefore forbidden from having campaign photographs taken with uniformed city employees.

It is a good law which prohibits a candidate from projecting a false affiliation or city endorsement.

Despite this longstanding statutory prohibition, some Beverly Hills City Council candidates have circulated campaign photographs of themselves with uniformed city employees. Since the law as framed places the prohibition on uniformed city employees, action will not be taken against the candidate. And since the photos were supposedly taken prior to the campaign, the uniformed city employees are not chastised. However, the use of such photographs reflect on a candidate's ethics.

Similarly, despite the statutory prohibition against uniformed city personnel participating in political activities, they or their unions make it a practice to endorse candidates in back room deals to benefit candidates who have either voted for or agreed to vote for the greatest employee benefits.

Last, despite the prohibition against using the city shield, a candidate designed a lawn sign to look like the city's shield, circumventing the prohibition by leaving some curly cues off and slightly changing the shield. Then the candidate ran the sign by our assistant city attorney who failed to consider the misleading nature of the sign and simply opined that the use of the modified shield did not violate the city's trademark.

Further, instead of the sign listing the candidate's name for city council, the word "for" was left out, suggesting that the candidate is already seated on the city council.

For the sake of the future of Beverly Hills, may the most ethical candidates win.

City Council Orders Review on Roxbury Home

The City Council debated whether to order a review of the issuance of a Certificate of Ineligibility decision that was approved by the Community Development

Department for the residence located at 1001 North Roxbury Drive, at their April 12 meeting. The City Council ultimately voted unanimously to order a review of the issuance of a Certificate of Ineligibility.

On March 2 a Certificate of Ineligibility was issued for the residence. Subsequently, Councilmember John Mirisch requested that an item be placed on the March 15 agenda to consider a call for review of the Certificate of Ineligibility. During the March 15 meeting, two previously unknown publications with articles that discussed the residence were brought to the Council's attention by Cultural Heritage Commissioner Jill Collins. Due to the fact that there was not sufficient time to review the articles and determine if they could have a material impact on the City Council's discussion, the City Council continued the item to the April 12 meeting.

The two articles that were discovered were in a Russian version of Architectural Digest and Luxe Magazine.

The residence was built in 1942 for Mildred R. Naylor and designed and constructed by Carleton Burgess, a locally recognized Master Architect, in a Regency Revival architectural style. Burgess was the designer and contractor and, although not an architect, he is included on the List of Master Architects for his contributions to the urban development of the City.

Since the March hearing, both staff and the City's historic consultant, Jan Ostashay, have reviewed the two articles in order to determine whether they appear to meet the criteria for publication. After a review of the two publications, it was determined that it would not alter staff's original decision to issue the Certificate of Ineligibility.

Harvey Englander from The Englander Group, who is representing the property owner, accused Collins of purposely misleading the Council into thinking the two publications were architecturally significant.

"The Council deserves an apology. Cultural Affairs Commissioner Jill Tavelman Collins appeared to deliberately mislead you at last Tuesday [March 15] night's Council meeting," Englander said in a letter addressed to the Council.

Englander also said that the Council should ask for Collins to resign.

"I know that if I came before you as a legislative advocate and made statements that were false and misleading in the way she did, my career would be over. Ms. Collins abused her position as a Commissioner and there should be consequences to those actions," Englander said.

Collins said that Englander was lying about her and that he is actually the one who should lose his job.

"This is insulting. This is what we have been asked to do from the City Council and the fact that I only got the information the night before from a previous owner is not my problem. I in good faith brought it in. I would have been remiss in my duties had I not," Collins said.

The City Council will continue this discussion at a future meeting.

BHEA Announces Election Results

The Beverly Hills Education Association (BHEA) has announced that Beverly Vista STEM teacher Alana Castanon has won the 2022 BHEA general election for BHEA president. This is her second twoyear term. She ran against Horace Mann music teacher Judith Chan, who received 62 votes. Castanon received 142 votes.

Castanon recently claimed at a Board of Education meeting that community members have threatened her career.

City Council Approves Resolution Opposing Ballot Initiative

At their April 12 meeting the City Council adopted a resolution opposing Ballot Initiative 21-0042, which would limit the ability of voters and state and local governments to raise revenues for government services.

In 2018, the "Tax Fairness, Transparency and Accountability Act", was being circulated to qualify for the Nov. 2018 ballot. This initiative would have drastically limited local revenue authority. Through the successful work and advocacy of the League of California Cities and its coalition, the measure's proponents withdrew the initiative from the ballot in June 2018, according to the staff report.

On Jan. 4 the California Business Roundtable filed the Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act. This measure would decimate local and state services to the benefit of corporations, according to the staff report.

Cal Cities has joined a broad coalition that includes the California Professional Firefighters, SEIU California, California Alliance for Jobs, AFSCME California, and the California Special Districts Association in strong opposition to this proposed ballot measure from the California Business Roundtable. The proponents have until June 1 to gather 997,139 valid signatures to qualify this ballot initiative for the Nov. election.

The initiative would limit voters' ability to pass voter-proposed local special taxes by raising the vote requirement to twothirds; eliminates voters' ability to advise how to spend revenues from proposed general tax on the same ballot as the proposed tax; and expands the definition of "taxes" to include certain regulatory fees, broadening the application of tax approval requirements amongst other impacts for state and local governments to raise revenues for government services.

On Feb. 3 City staff received an email from Cal Cities requesting each city consider adopting a resolution to demonstrate how harmful this ballot initiative would be to their community.

On March 8 the City Council Liaison/ Legislative/Lobby Committee, which includes Vice Mayor Julian Gold and Councilmember John Mirisch, recommended the City Council consider adopting a resolution opposing this ballot initiative.

"Per the State's Legislative Analyst Office, local governments generally face greater restrictions to raising revenue than the state. By expanding the definition

of taxes and restricting administrative changes to fees, this initiative would make it somewhat harder for local governments to raise revenue. Consequently, future local tax and fee revenue could be lower than they would be otherwise. The extent to which revenues would be lower is unknown, but fees could be more impacted. The actual impact on local government revenue would depend on various factors, including future decisions by the courts, local governing bodies, and voters," according to the staff report.

Arts and Culture Commission Approves Plaque Placement

At their Tuesday Special meeting the Arts and Culture Commission approved the placement of a plaque at the Civic Center parking structure for a donation that was made by the Courtright family to the City in 1987.

The Millard Sheets' mural" El Camino Real" was originally installed in the motor court of the Beverly Wilshire Hotel. The owner of the hotel, Hernando Courtright, was a close friend of Millard Sheets and Howard Ahmanson, founder of the Home Savings and Loan Association.

Ahmanson had commissioned Millard Sheets murals for the facades of several of his buildings. Courtright's wife, Marcella Cuillery de Courtright, as designer for the Beverly Wilshire Hotel, chose to create an atmosphere that is elegant and welcoming for the driveway of the Beverly Wilshire Hotel, since that would be the first point of contact for the guests.

Marcella and Hernando Courtright chose to name the driveway "El Camino Real" and even placed a bronze reproduction of a California Mission Bell commemorating the original marking system that was utilized and displayed all the way up the coast.

They commissioned Millard Sheets to recreate the mural El Camino Real, which was to depict a scene of early California life.

"Not only were the Beverly Wilshire Hotel guests welcomed right away with the warm saying "Mi Casa es su Casa" over the driveway portico, but they were also given a glimpse into another time, a gracious scene based on historic accounts of California history," according to the staff report.

El Camino Real was part of the hotel for more than 15 years and was removed after the Hotel was sold to Regent International Hotels. The Courtright family donated the mural to Beverly Hills in 1987.

The mosaic was placed in storage for several years and in 2012 the Fine Art Commission decided to restore and install this piece of art in an effort for it to be seen by hundreds of people each day.

The City Council also designated the Millard Sheets mural El Camino Real a Historic Landmark in 2012.

The Arts and Culture Commission and the City Council hosted an art dedication for this mural on Nov. 2, 2013. The mosaic had been installed earlier that year above the Civic Center parking structure.

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Millard Sheets' son Tony Sheet requested the placement of the mural to be low on the wall so that the artwork could be easily seen.

The Commission decided to keep the plaque at the same location but it will be updated to include a donor's recognition.

'Unfortunately, the Courtright family was living abroad at the time of the installation of the mural in its current location at the Civic Center and were not able to view the mural in its current display until last summer when they reached out to us. They were very pleased and moved to see the beloved artwork on display and they asked if it would be possible for the City to place a plaque recognizing their family's donation," according to the staff report.

Hernando Courtright Jr., who now lives in New York City, could not be reached for comment.

Ed Buck Sentenced to 30 Years in Federal Prison

Edward Buck, a businessman and longtime figure of West Hollywood politics, was sentenced on April 14 to 360 months in federal prison for providing fatal doses of methamphetamine to two men who died at his apartment after he injected them with the drug.

At the conclusion of a nine-day trial in



July, a federal jury found Buck guilty of two counts of distribution of methamphetamine resulting in death, four counts of distribution of methamphetamine, one count of

drug-involved premise, and two counts of enticement to travel in interstate commerce for prostitution.

Beginning no later than 2011 and continuing through Sept. 2019, Buck engaged in a pattern of "party and play," in which he solicited men - some of whom were homeless or struggling with drug addiction - to consume narcotics that he provided and perform sexual activities at his apartment, a ritual that prosecutors argued was "more than a fetish - it was a lethal and unchecked pattern of reckless disregard for human life.'

In these party-and-play sessions, Buck distributed drugs, including methamphetamine, GHB (the "date rape" drug), and clonazepam. In some instances, Buck injected victims with drugs intravenously in a practice known as "slamming."

He exploited the wealth and power balance between himself and his victims by offering them money to use drugs.

Buck solicited his victims in various ways, including using social media platforms, dating and escort websites, or via referrals from his prior victims, to whom he offered finder's fees.

Once the men were at his apartment,

Buck prepared syringes containing methamphetamine, sometimes personally injecting the victims with or without their consent. Buck also injected victims with more narcotics than they agreed to take, and sometimes he injected victims while they were unconscious.

At trial, victims described how Buck put sedatives in their drinks or in the injections, causing them to lose consciousness or control over their bodies. While they were unconscious, Buck sexually assaulted his victims.

On two occasions, Buck's party-andplay fetish turned lethal. Buck killed Gemmel Moore with a lethal dose of methamphetamine on July 27, 2017, and then he killed Timothy Dean with a lethal dose of methamphetamine on January 7, 2019


These deaths failed to deter him from continuing to distribute methamphetamine, and Buck continued distributing the drug to additional victims, including a man who overdosed twice in Buck's apartment but survived after receiving immediate medical treatment.

Buck also enticed individuals to travel to Calif. from other states for the purpose of engaging in prostitution through partyand-play sessions. Buck purchased a plane ticket for Moore, who had moved to Texas, so Moore could travel to Los Angeles in July 2017 to party and play at Buck's apartment. In Sept. 2018, Buck similarly purchased a plane ticket for another victim to fly from Iowa to Los Angeles.

In 2016, Congressmember Ted Lieu (D-Torrance) selected Buck as a presidential elector.

AN AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL PLAN TO ADOPT AN UPDATED SAFETY ELEMENT

This project consists of an update to the Safety Element of the General Plan of the City of Beverly Hills. State law requires that every jurisdiction's General Plan includes a Safety Element to address the mitigation of short- and long-term risks resulting from disasters such as wildfire, flooding, and earthquakes. The City's current Safety Element was last updated in 2010, and is now being updated to include a Climate Vulnerability Assessment, which addresses the issues of climate change adaptation and resiliency, in compliance with recently adopted state laws. At this public hearing, staff will present an update on the status of the Safety Element Update, including revisions made to the Safety Element and the review process with state agencies, and present the Safety Element for final adoption by the City Council. The revised Safety Element documents were previously reviewed by the Planning Commission at their March 24, 2022 meeting, and the Commission unanimously adopted a resolution recommending approval of these documents to the City Council.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to qualify for a Class 8 Categorical Exemption (Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment) in accordance with the requirements of Section 15308 of the State CEQA Guidelines, which is applicable to actions taken by regulatory agencies, as authorized by state or local ordinance, to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of the environment where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the environment. This project consists of the adoption of new or updated regulations related to the protection of the environment through the mitigation of natural and manmade hazards. Accordingly, the City Council will consider a recommendation to find the project categorically exempt, pursuant to Section 15308 from further environmental review under CEQA.

COVERSTORY EIGHT QUESTIONS WITH THE CITY COUNCIL CANDIDATES

Candidates SHIVA BAGHERI, VERA MARKOWITZ, AND SHARONA NAZARIAN did not respond to the Weekly's request for their questionnaire.

Why are you running for City Council?

Darian Bojeaux: Because I disapprove of the city council majority's raising building height limits and decreasing parking requirements via the mixed use ordinance; the intention of city council members to further raise building height limits and further decrease parking requirements; and the city council majority's failure to



make it easier for residents to build guest houses over garages and other ADU's. The

majority has increased buildheights ing and decreased parking re-

quirements, via the mixed use ordinance, which rezoned for three times the amount of RHNA new housing required by the state. Further, the council majority unfairly cheated residents out of their referendum petition rights by passing the ordinance during the height of the pandemic and refusing to allow any concessions to residents who needed more time to gather signatures to place the issue on the ballot for residents to decide. The council majority also improperly passed the ordinance during an afternoon study session instead of a formal evening meeting, in violation of the rules in the City of Beverly Hills City Council Policy and Operations Manual, to try to keep their actions under the radar. Further, comments made by two incumbents at the Chamber of Commerce candidates forum implied that they would like to increase building heights and decrease parking requirements even further along the main streets in our city.



Licht: Overall the City Council is doing a great job but it's time for new thinking. One of the incumbents is running for his 4th term. What will he accomplish serving 17 years on the City Council that he could not do in his first, second, or third term?

Mirisch: I think we are doing a pretty good job on any number of issues. As a City and a nation, we have been faced with a series of unprecedented challenges in the past two years that nobody could have ever predicted. For the most part, I believe we have navigated them as a City and as a Council fairly well. That said, nothing is so good that it can't be better, and in addition to meeting the ongoing public safety crisis head-on, as we are doing with a united Council, there are a couple of areas which need significant improvement, including fiscal responsibility, providing better value-for-money for the taxpayers' dollars, preserving and protecting our neighborhoods, and

guarding against overdevelopment. Rowe: How is the current City Council doing? The preventable Nessah synagogue vandalism, the smash-and-grabs, the ghost storefronts on Robertson boarded up for a decade, a 40% police budget increase resulting in less public safety, the class action lawsuit against the City for racial profiling by the police, millions of tax dollars diverted into schemes to delay construction of the subway, the multi-use zoning law passed to create affordable housing that created none, the opaque and unpredictable City permits system that business owners say seems like extortion. All these City blunders happened under the current City Council.

The City Council has a history of voting unanimously 5-0. It was shocking, during the recent Chamber of Commerce election forum, to hear my opponents, whether incumbents or first-time candidates say our Mayor is their favorite Beverly Hills politician. They are making campaign promises to approve whatever the Mayor asks. Do such City Council candidates serve any useful purpose?

Wunderlich: I think the current City Council has done an excellent job, both responding to the challenges of the last few years and proactively positioning the city for the future. We had two years of pandemics, demonstrations of many types, and a regional increase in the crimes that affect you viscerally. I understand that being safer is not enough. We have to be safe on an absolute scale. I am proud of what we have done, but we have to and are doing more.

We have substantially increased our police budget and are aggressively recruiting additional police. We reinforced our BHPD with private security. We are planning for police substations at the coming Metro stops. We added 1000s of video cameras around the city and supplemented them with drones. We already are extremely effective at arresting those who commit crimes and are increasingly using our officers and technology to prevent crimes before they happen. City Council unanimously called for the recall of District Attorney George Gascon.

Many businesses, individuals, and the city felt the economic hit of the pandemic deeply. Despite these challenges, we are emerging strong from the pandemic. At the city level, we reacted by cutting operating expenses, providing incentives for voluntary resignations, and reducing capital expenditures. The result is that we managed to continue to provide exceptional services, including increasing our spending on police and fire.

We have been proactive in seeking out new businesses that fit Beverly Hills and retaining our existing businesses. We established our Open BH program, reduced parking requirements for certain businesses to be similar to our surrounding cities, allowed rooftop dining, allowed for certain increased medical uses, enhanced our business concierge services, and adopted other means of fostering a commercial sector that fits Beverly Hills. The results are apparent. Our property values have increased. Retail sales are back to pre-pandemic levels. Our hotel occupancy is returning. Our streets are more vibrant than they were pre-pandemic.

For our residents, we provided protections from the financial impacts of the pandemic and from challenges that exist unrelated to the pandemic. We put into place a moratorium on evictions and rent increases, from which we are now emerging. We established a fund to pay landlords directly on behalf of renters. We protected our residential neighborhoods from the increased development made possible by SB 9, in which two duplexes would be allowed on a single single-family lot, by adopting objective criteria allowed under SB 9. We outlawed fractional ownership to preserve the community feel of our neighborhoods. We protected our hillside areas by adopting ordinances that prohibited excessive development that would have destroyed the character of our hillsides. We put into place slow streets and other measures to help keep our neighborhoods quiet. We have begun a collaboration with our schools for Beverly Hills to excel at early childhood education, a valuable benefit for our residents and an important attractor for families to move here.

To mitigate climate change, we were a founding member of the Clean Power Alliance and now the default option for residents in Beverly Hills is to receive their electricity from 100% renewable sources. To ensure reliable resources into the future, we completed an extensive rehabilitation of our water treatment plant and are drilling additional wells so that 25% of our water needs will be met by local supply, a substantial increase.

Had you been on the Council, would you have voted to support the One Beverly Hills Project (or for the incumbent candidates, why did you vote the way you voted)?

Bojeaux: I am not saying that the One Beverly Hills Project is all bad, however, I would have voted against it because it allowed for an 11 story building across the street from El Rodeo School, which will throw shade on the school; it allowed for substandard parking which was also decreased by 1/3 from what was previously agreed to be provided for the site; the development agreement was pre-negotiated without any concern for the opinions of and input from residents; the development agreement was not well-negotiated, and the council majority exempted the project from our city-wide 10% requirement for affordable housing in all new building projects although it would have been a good idea to require some affordable housing for city workers and senior citizens.

Bhatia: Yes I would have voted to support the One Beverly Hills Project as this may create employment and revenue opportunities for the city.

Friedman: For many years there was the hope and desire that the Hilton and old Robinson's-May parcels of land could be unified as a single project. One Beverly Hills Project did that and created a project with 8 acres of publicly accessible open and green space accessible to our residents and guests. The project's location has been called out in our General Plan for more height, residential and commercial development. It abuts Century City, which is why the General Plan calls for more height there. This project would only be acceptable as a gateway project bordering Los Angeles without having adverse impacts on our residential communities. One Beverly Hills will not only have world class architecture with its residential and hotel buildings but will ensure the economic stability of Beverly Hills because of the \$100 million guaranteed development fee as well as the ongoing property and business taxes the area will generate. None of the previous development agreements on the Robinson's-May property ever produced any money. So, based on this analysis, I voted ves.

Kugley: Yes, with a caveat for subsidized housing for police officers. It's ridiculous that officers have to drive in from their homes 30 miles away. Voters want their police officers to live in Beverly Hills.

Licht: Yes, and I voted for it as a Planning Commissioner.

Mirisch: I am and was on the Council and was the only Council member who voted against the project. I do feel it's too big for our Community, though its unique location is a mitigating factor. However, the biggest issue for me was the lack of provision for affordable housing, on site or off site. Here's a project whose average (I repeat: average) projected condo price is upwards of \$13.5 million. My feeling was and is that the developers profiting so richly from this upzoning should have provided affordable housing in the City themselves. As an alternative, purchasers of these ultra-luxury condos should have been asked to pay an additional 2% fee which would have been earmarked for affordable housing, including supportive housing that we desperately need for our seniors.

Rowe: Hotel taxes are a chief source of revenue for the City of Beverly Hills. Without luxury hotels, the City would have little choice but to increase taxes on residents.

The one Councilmember who voted against the \$2 billion One Beverly Hills Hotel upgrade said he opposed it because it includes no affordable housing. Should the City want affordable housing to be built inside a luxury hotel? What sort of logic is that?

When it comes to where affordable housing should be built in Beverly Hills, the City Council has no plan, no workable ideas. I have an affordable housing building plan that supports Beverly Hills workers.

When some politicians say "affordable housing" they are thinking of something else. Subsidized housing is not the same as affordable housing. Those politicians who favor subsidized housing would build cheap, low-quality housing in our city to be given away to the unemployed and homeless. I would build affordable housing for workers and house those who work in Beverly Hills.

Wunderlich: I voted to support the One Beverly Hills Project because I thought it was an important aspect of providing for the economic sustainability of the city, while preserving our residential quality of life because of its location immediately adjacent to Century City. It is important to remember that it was not a decision between One Beverly Hills and no project, because there already was an approved project for that site. The decision was between a world-class project that would make improved integrated use of the entire site versus a substantially inferior project.

Our city has the financial resources to provide exceptional police, fire, and other city services in large part because of the vibrancy of our commercial sector. Visitors staying in our hotels, eating in our restaurants, and shopping in our stores is our economic engine. We compete on a global scale for those visitors. Past success does not ensure future success. We cannot become stagnant. I worked to improve the project. I was successful in improving access to the public garden portions of the project for our residents to enjoy. I opposed allowing fractional ownership in the project.

Will you vote to approve the Cheval Blanc project as proposed?

Bojeaux: No. A building that ascends to 9 stories in height is too massive and destructive to the village feel in our golden triangle and would create too much traffic on little Santa Monica and in the triangle. Also, the developer calling for a reconfiguration of our alleys, to the detriment of residents and adjacent retailers, is unreasonable. I would only vote in favor of the Cheval Blanc project if it were limited to 3 main stories; a 4th story set in significantly on all sides; with adequate code-compliant parking, and without reconfiguration of the alley. However, it would be a shame to lose the lovely existing buildings which are presently in that location

Bhatia: Yes, I would vote to approve this as this will create employment and revenue opportunities for the city.

Friedman: In order for the Cheval Blanc project to proceed the developer is going to have to address the concerns raised [by the] Planning Commission regarding the building's height and traffic circulation. While having a five-star ultra-luxury hotel similar to the Cheval Blanc in Paris would be a significant asset to Beverly Hills, these and other resident concerns must be addressed.

Kugley: Not as it stands. The leader of the Beverly Hills North HOA and home-owners are against it. I am with the voters, not big business.

Licht: From what I have seen, the Cheval Blanc project is beautiful. As chair of the Planning Commission, it would be irresponsible for me to opine until I have heard all of the testimony from the public and my colleague's thoughts. The design of the hotel is one of a kind and their inclusion of public art will make the hotel a destination for people around the world.

Mirisch: I have serious concerns about the project as proposed. In fact, the development process is meant to be an iterative one. All too often, major projects seem to be approved substantially as submitted and that to me is an indication that the process isn't working as it should and that special interests are running the show. While I love the idea of a Cheval Blanc hotel in our City, the devil is often in the details and we still need to work those out.

Rowe: To avoid increasing taxes on residents, I generally support building luxury hotels and the revenue that brings to run the City.

Yes, the City needs a hotel something like Cheval Blanc to replace the lost revenue from the Luxe being shuttered last year. Cheval Blanc is the Louis Vuitton luxury hotel project that would be built near where the Luxe Rodeo Drive Hotel was. However, without seeing the proposal, I can't judge whether I should vote for Cheval Blanc. I'll need to hear all sides first.

Wunderlich: I do not think it is appropriate for a City Councilmember or candidate for City Council to announce a position on a particular project that will be before City Council for approval. When City Council reviews a project, it is operating in a quasi-judicial capacity, the same as a judge listening to all the evidence before reaching a conclusion. Similar to nominees for the Supreme Court discussing their principles of decision-making rather than saying how they would rule in any specific case, I can describe how I make my decisions regarding development projects in general.

In my mind, any development project must fit the city and bring positive benefits. Our commercial sector provides approximately 65% to 70% of our operating budget. However, that does not mean that all developments are good for the city - only those that fit us – that are the right development in the right place. Commercial vibrancy cannot come at the expense of our residential quality of life. During the Vietnam war, an officer famously said: "We had to destroy the village to save the village." That is the opposite of what we have to do. We have to strike the balance to ensure the commercial vibrancy of our city and preserve its character. Questions I ask myself include: Would the project be distinctive and world class, substantially adding to the city? What would the project be replacing? Is the site already developed or would it be reducing green space? Would traffic impacts be similar to what is already there versus bringing increased traffic?

A three-term term limit initiative is on the ballot, do you support it? Why or why not?

Bojeaux: The only reason I will vote against it is that it was designed to, and it will prevent council member John

Mirisch from continuing to run for city council, and he is the only city council member who actually cares about what residents want, is against overdevelopment and wants to treat residents who live in all areas fairly. He also is brilliant and digs into subjects instead of just asking a few questions to staff.

Bhatia: Yes, I strongly support this. The reason why I support this is because I feel leaders feel more pressure to deliver results and leave office with a positive legacy and also changing leadership encourages a rising generation of political leaders, fresh ideas, and possible policy changes.

Friedman: The reason that a threeterm term limit measure is on the ballot is so the community can decide whether they believe it is in the best interests of Beverly Hills to impose such a limitation. Three terms is generally 12 years in office and should be enough for any individual to accomplish the goals they have set out to accomplish. Term limits opens seats, allowing others to participate in government. Public participation in government should be encouraged, term limits is one way to promote engagement.

Kugley: Yes, I'm against career politicians.

Licht: I support term limits in general and believe that 12 years on the Council is enough time for any one individual to serve. I believe it is important to always have new blood on the council in order to bring new ideas forward, so I will be voting in favor of term limits.

Mirisch: I do not support it. This initiative was clearly directed at me in an effort to silence my unique voice which is not mindlessly pro-development. The proponents are cynically claiming that term limits would "reduce the influence of special interests." The irony is that ex-mayor lobbyists who are often the proponents of overdevelopment and paid lobbyists for the special interests of large commercial property owners are the ones signing the ballot statement and trying to make this argument. Serving on the Council is not an executive position like the President and Governor, where term limits are appropriate. "New blood" does not equate with "new ideas." In fact, many new ideas can be the direct result of valuable experience, and I would argue that I lag behind no other candidate when it comes to proposing new and relevant ideas for our Community. If we don't agree with an incumbent or a candidate, the remedy should be to vote against that person -- not to make that person ineligible for election.

If we really want to put something on the ballot that would allow the residents of Beverly Hills to have better representation, we should put an initiative on the ballot that would elect the Council by districts. The areas south of Santa Monica have more than 2/3 of the population of the City, yet it is entirely possible that after the June election there will be not one single councilmember who actually lives south of Santa Monica.

Rowe: I proposed term limits when I first ran for City Council in 2020. Yes, I

plan to vote for term limits on the ballot. Term limits are not a cure-all. Antic-

ipating they may be removed if term limits happen, Incumbents are already running candidates in this election to be their proxies. Voters who believe in term limits should not vote for any candidate endorsed by the Incumbents. Some candidates not backed by the Incumbents apparently wish they were, have said they would vote the same as the Incumbents. Voters who believe in term limits shouldn't vote for any of those candidates either.

Wunderlich: I personally do not support term limits for legislative elected positions, but did vote in favor of placing the question of the ballot for the public to decide. There are advantages and disadvantages of longevity in office. Longevity brings knowledge and skill and a public track record by which the public can evaluate an elected official. A non-incumbent can bring new ideas and energy, but does not have the public record to document how the individual will actually vote when confronted with the challenging decisions in which the public may have mixed views. I think the public can weigh the pros and cons. If the public likes an elected official, I think they should have the ability to vote for the person.

How would you evaluate the job City Manager George Chavez is doing?

Bojeaux: George Chavez has worked for the city for many years, and has always been a kind, competent person whom I like. However, I have not endeavored to investigate or evaluate the job he is doing, and nor have I become aware of any complaints about him.

Friedman: Beverly Hills City Manager George Chavez rose through the ranks of our city government. He started in the Building Department, gained experience there, then in Public Works and ultimately in Policy and Management. He has a great deal of experience in city government and is recognized for his hands on approach to governing. George is well respected and successfully implemented the reorganization of departments so they are run more efficiently. An excellent leader, approachable and available to all residents and business owners, George is the example of what every city could hope for in a City Manager.

Kugley: Poor. Non-police departments within the city in 2020 tried to cite businesses and citizens for not following a mask mandate. Also, instead of hiring police officers the city has hired security companies which can do no more than call the police. Overall city management should have hired more police instead of hiring security companies that can only call the police. Beverly Hills, being one of the most affluent cities in the world should have the highest cop per capita rate of any city.

Licht: The City Manager is doing an excellent job.

Mirisch: George Chavez is doing an excellent job. He is unquestionably the best City Manager I have worked with

during my time on the Council. I hope he will be with us for many years to come.

Rowe: The inner workings of the City are not revealed to the public. To have an informed opinion on anyone's actual performance, I need to get elected to City Council first and to hear all sides.

Wunderlich: George consistently does an outstanding job. He is a fount of knowledge and good judgment, skilled at managing employees, empathetic and caring as [in] regards [to] our residents, responsive to our businesses, and diligent and hard-working.

What would you say is the single biggest issue facing the City at this time?

Bojeaux: Preventing the burglaries, robberies, and shoplifting in our city, particularly the events which include violence or breakage of windows. Comparatively speaking, our city is safe and well-policed, but we want everyone to feel safe from violence and property loss, and we want our reputation to include that criminals cannot get away with crime in Beverly Hills.

Bhatia: The single biggest issue facing the City at this time is safety of residents and homelessness on sidewalls. As a candidate my first priority is to resolve these issues.

Friedman: Safety is the issue facing our city and our county. We are experiencing a regional increase in criminal activity which has impacted all of us. Our police department has done an excellent job of catching the criminals after they have committed crimes, only to see that the criminal justice system is unresponsive in dealing with these criminals. We must make those who commit crimes responsible for their actions. As Mayor, I took steps to begin to fill the open Police positions, expand the closed-circuit television system, license plate readers and put private patrols in all of our neighborhoods. As a city, we must continue to give our police department the tools they need. We must continue to hire more officers, expand our cameras and license plate readers. We've begun to add cutting edge technology such as camera equipped drones, which can be at a crime scene immediately and need to expand this resource. And by adding more patrols on our streets, especially foot, bicycle and motorcycle, we will be in a preventive posture rather than responsive. I believe we must do everything possible to make our residents feel safe in their homes and when frequenting our businesses.

Kugley: Crime, and the current city council is weak on crime.

Licht: Definitely crime and homelessness. Both of these issues impact the quality of life for our residents, but also for the numerous people that come from outside our community to our restaurants and shops. These outside visitors are central to providing the economic lifeblood for our community and they need to feel that Beverly Hills is the safest community in all of Southern California. And of course, those that live here need to know

that it is!

Mirisch: Public safety is the biggest issue right now, followed by the threats to our Community from Sacramento politicians who want to take away Community-based decision making (and in certain instances they are connected). The Council has made it clear that public safety is the number one priority and that we will make no compromises when it comes to our Community, both for the businesses and the residents. There are no silver bullets, and with the new Chief as the right leader, we are pro-actively pursuing a combination of policies to make our City safer, including hiring additional officers, additional foot and bike patrols, enhanced use of private security, and the use of technology -- cameras, automatic license plate readers, etc. -- as a force multiplier. I'm also supportive of an expanded reserve program for our residents, a citizens' patrol, that has been employed successfully in other cities, as well as adding mobile command centers so that we can strategically deploy our resources no matter what or where new situations may arise within the City.

Rowe: Public safety is the election hot button issue. All the City Council candidates are running on the issue of public safety, including me. I'm different because I understand public safety from the perspective of having implemented America's national security.

The best way to handle a crisis may be to prevent it happening. I designed the DARPA Artificial Intelligence crisis detection and monitoring system installed at Department of Defense command centers including NORAD. Within seconds, in real-time, that AI detects a crisis forming and automatically alerts the relevant analysts to handle it. Later, under the U.S. Director of Homeland Security, I was chairman of a subcommittee that defined best practices for securing America's banks and manufacturing sector.

Other candidates are making justspend-more campaign promises to give the police chief any amount of money he asks, to increase surveillance of everyone living in Beverly Hills, to build police substations and checkpoints, and to maximize incarceration. They don't say how an additional \$10 million or more a year increase to the police budget will get paid. They would make Beverly Hills secure like a prison. Is that what we want?

Wunderlich: The most immediate challenge facing the city is public safety. We are experiencing a regional increase in some of the most egregious crimes, the ones that affect us viscerally. We are not immune to what is happening around us. Beverly Hills remains safer than our surroundings, but I understand that safer is not good enough. We must be safe on an absolute scale.

We already have done a lot to provide for public safety and we have to do more. I addressed some of what we have done already in my answer to the second question above. During a second term on City Council, I will prioritize adding additional officers – for current needs, to replace those who retire, and to add officers with the coming of Metro – and increasingly being proactive to prevent crimes before they happen - working with the Chief to consider alternative deployment strategies such as foot and bicycle patrols, increased real-time monitoring of our video cameras, and increased use of artificial intelligence. We also have the challenge of a relatively young police force both because of our recruitment efforts and retirement of long-standing officers. We have to have an emphasis on training to ensure the continuance of the high standards we have - training to operate in a community policing mode, to be able to de-escalate situations, to call in social workers or other non-police resources as appropriate, and to police in the Beverly Hills way.

What one thing do you want the voters to know about you before they cast their ballot?

Bojeaux: That I will do everything in my power to preserve our low building height limits and adequate parking requirements, which are a large part of the reason why our city is lovely, peaceful, and well admired, because I prefer that we create more housing by building guest houses over garages and other ADU's, and facilitate adaptive re-use of existing large commercial buildings to mixed use.

Bhatia: I want residents to know I am running for city council so I can make this city safer for you and your families. As a father of two young kids, the current situation troubles me, and that's why I will strongly support the recall of George
