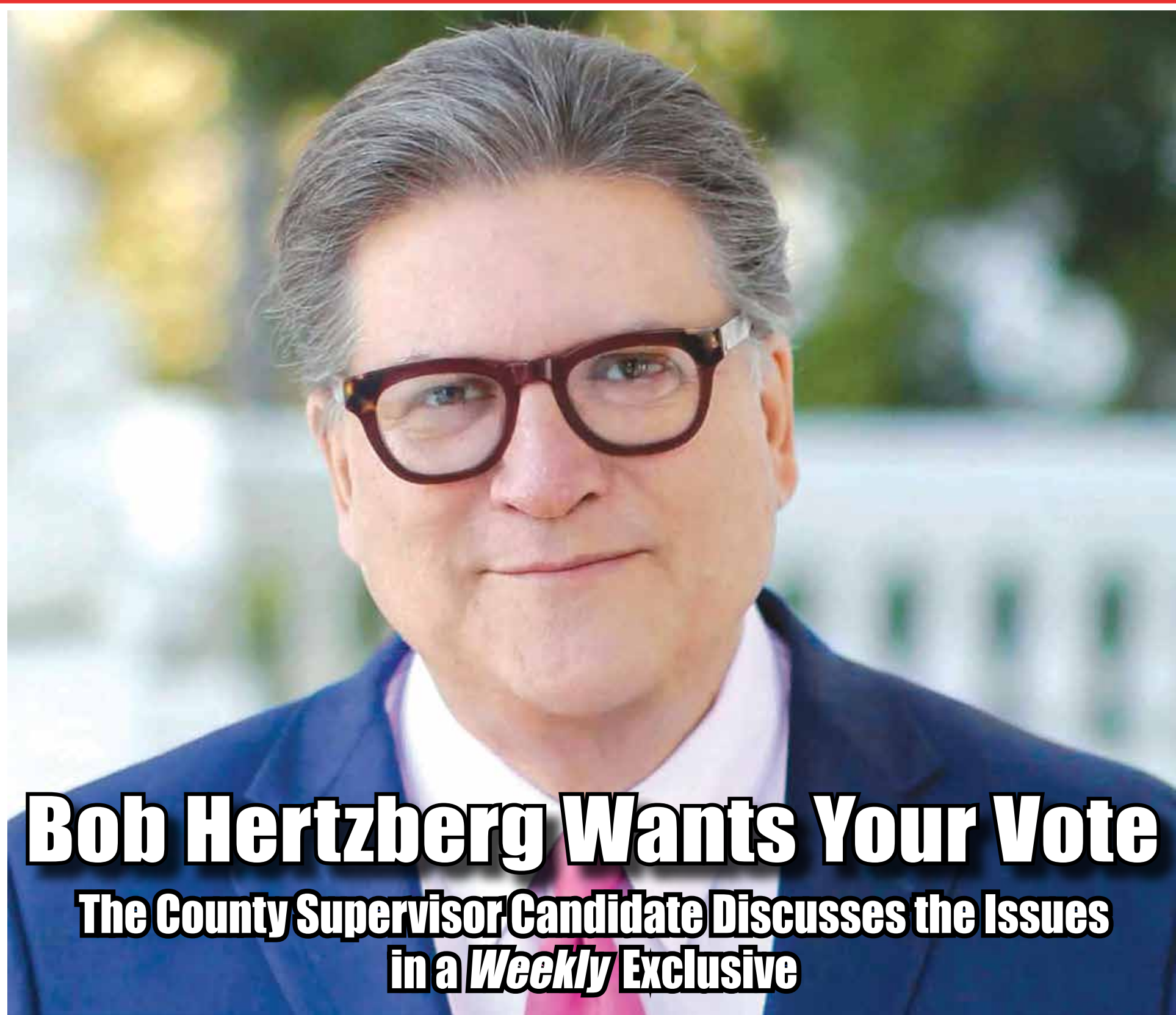

## “Beverly Hills Transit Study”

I am writing solely as a resident and not on behalf of any other group to provide some background about the status of a proposed Beverly Hills Transit system that will soon be considered by the City Council.

The idea for such a system came from the Citizens Advisory Committee (“CAC”) established by the City Council to provide input for the long delayed Climate Adaptation and Action Plan (the “Plan”). The purpose of the Plan is to make recommendations for the reduction of Green House Gas Emissions (“GHG”) attributable to the City.

Approximately 50% of the City’s GHG comes from automobiles traveling within (not through) the City. Accordingly, the CAC has recommended that the City consider a system that will change the driving habits of Beverly Hills residents. For reasons that I do not pretend to understand, the City’s Department of Public Works (“DPW”) leaders have from the outset undertaken to “derail” (pun intended) or delay indefinitely a serious attempt to develop such a transit system. Notwithstanding the opposition of the Department of Public Works, the CAC developed a comprehensive proposal for a safe, reliable system with frequent service over a fixed route system that would include at least two east-west routes and at least two north-south routes, perhaps supplemented by on demand (not inefficient and expensive dial a ride) service throughout the city. Notably, there currently exists substantial Metro east-west service which will increase when the new subway stops are completed, one as soon as mid-2024.

The proposed Beverly Hills Transit system, as designed by the CAC, would fill the huge service gap that exists because of the absence of any north-south service and provide an internal east-west service that will be reliable and safe (which is not the perception, right or wrong, that Beverly Hills residents have about current Metro service).

Another feature of the proposed system was to provide means for Beverly Hills residents to access the new subway service to and from their homes. Notably, even though the new subway service has been planned and under construction for at least five years, neither Metro nor the DPW (or any other City agency) have done anything meaningful to allow or even facilitate such access. Further, the Plan proposed for consideration potential east-west routes along Charleville and El-evado that would serve the BHUSD campuses, that would be restricted to students, with enhanced security. The importance of safety, security and frequency and reliability of service of Beverly Hills Transit

cannot be overstated. Metro offers none of these characteristics which is an underlying reason that so few Beverly Hills residents do or will use Metro.

When the City Council, under the direction of then-Mayor Bob Wunderlich, scheduled a study session, the CAC proposed a route system and suggested that we obtain costs estimates from the vendors to whom the City would outsource the provision of vehicles, drivers and cost estimates (and any suggestions for the operation) and then seek public input respecting specific proposals. The DPW proposed that the City hire consultants (because DPW has no relevant in-house expertise and DPW had a mistaken view that it would somehow be improper to obtain information from potential vendors) who would seek public comment and report back once this was accomplished. I and other CAC members predicted that this would take several months, give rise to substantial costs and produce nothing of value because an undirected effort to get public input in the abstract would provide nothing of value. Another concern was that consultants who were not from Beverly Hills (or even from the Los Angeles region) would have no relevant experience. The Council accepted this DPW proposal and provided that the “home” for this project would be the Traffic and Parking Commission (“TPC”) and directed that the TPC work in conjunction with the CAC.

Now, we have the consultant’s proposal that was presented to the TPC on October 6. This proposal has borne out the predictions that all that would be accomplished is the expenditure of time and City funds with random public comments that do not reflect any in depth thinking or other helpful information. There was no effort to seek input for the proposal from the CAC beyond an overture that CAC members and any other member of the public attend the TPC public meetings. I saw no value in such undirected meetings and did not attend. I do not know whether any of the other 13 non-TPC CAC members attended. This of course was no substitute for making a comprehensive presentation to the CAC. I have invited that and hope that the TPC will avail itself of this opportunity.

Substantively, I have the following existential concern about the current proposal.

The proposal includes a route system that involves nothing more than a single circular route along Olympic Blvd, a small section of La Cienega Blvd, a small section of Robertson Blvd, a section of Burton Way, small section of Beverly Blvd and a section of Beverly Drive.

It does not serve any part of the City north of Santa Monica Blvd or any part of the SW part of the City.

More than approximately 75% of the residential area of the City is ignored.

While the proposed circular route of some type is necessary it is far short of sufficient to accomplish the goal of changing well-established behavior patterns and improving mobility of our residents. This very limited proposal may be expensive but it cannot possibly succeed

in attracting any significant level of ridership. On the contrary, it seems intentionally designed by DPW to ensure failure. Notably, consultants hired by the DPW invariably tell DPW what it wants to hear, not what it needs to know.

Shortly before the TPC meeting, the consultant who wrote the report, contacted me ostensibly to obtain my comments about his thoughts, not the report which I did not see until the day before the TPC meeting. At the instance of DPW, they consistently referred to a “pilot” program. I did tell him that without meaningful service, including N/S routes throughout the City. And I emphasized that it should be a “pilot” only as to time, not scope. That is, that we should try a fully developed route system for a limited period. If it works, great. If not, we can scrap it. My distinct impression was that he was in complete agreement with my expressed opinion that a limited route system would fail. Unfortunately, the proposed system in the consultant’s report is so limited that it cannot succeed and should not be attempted.

What DPW and the Council need to hear is that a car without an engine has no purpose; a monitor without a computer is useless; 1/3 of a loaf is not better than none in this case.

We should do Beverly Hills Transit right or not do it at all.

## “Beverly Hills Art”

I spoke with the Gagosian gallery in New York. Judy is not well known any more and the price of \$500,000 is too much. It is also one of three, so not original. The color will fade in time like the Kusama and need to be repainted. I feel some of the past purchases have not been up to standard. We must have people on the art commission with knowledge of what is happening in the art world. The mayor should not be pushing for a piece.

On another subject, we have too many tour buses, especially in midday. We don’t need more publicity about us. Robberies

## Board Candidates Take the Stage at Forum

Beverly Hills Weekly Publisher Josh Gross moderated a BHUSD Board of Education candidates forum last Thursday for the Nov. 8 election. The event was sponsored by the PTSA, KBEV, and Beverly Hills Weekly.

A wide variety of topics were discussed, including the construction program, declining enrollment, and reconfiguration, among others.

Candidates were asked if they were concerned regarding the challenges faced by the District's construction program, including a shortfall of funds.

"I grew up here in a construction family and my mother has a saying 'you get what you inspect not what you expect.' It appears to me that the Board and the District have placed too much trust and have relied on what they've been told rather than walking the job sites and really seeing what's being done," Michal Amir-Salkin said.

Amir-Salkin said the District needs to be walking the job sites and planning out what is going to be accomplished and really focus on their goals.

Candidates expressed their stances on BHUSD reconfiguration, which took effect in 2019.

"Four years ago I ran on the platform of a reconfiguration. Having been in the school district for 50 plus years, I saw what was happening in the classroom with the number of students. I in fact had

classes with students that had eight or nine students in them and this was a waste of our taxpayer dollars. I felt that we needed to move where we could put more kids together, offer more classes, more honors classes, and more electives. I was definitely a person that was in favor of the reconfiguration," Rachele Marcus said.

Marcus said that you can't blame the pandemic for how reconfiguration didn't come out quite as planned because that put a glitch in the program. However, Marcus said it's coming back now, the kids are happy, and the schools can finally zero in on the education of the students at each level.

Candidates were asked how they would address declining enrollment.

"Math Proficiency in the BHUSD is at 61 percent now and has been declining for the past seven years. The United States is ranked 36 in math out of 79 countries participating in a program for international student assessment. We're below even third world countries. Our students can't compete on a world stage. If I'm elected, I will advocate for results-oriented math reforms and I'll make sure our students have a clean facility to learn in," Janessa LaVoice said.

LaVoice also said she will advocate for art because she said research shows that when students are exposed to different art forms, it enhances their cognitive ability and SAT, math, and reading scores.

"I'm the only one that has a plan. I would like to do a five-year going-back analysis to figure out what are our specific

weaknesses. Teachers, students, schools, in other words - who has actually fallen behind and why, and how and when and where? Then I would like to implement an actual response - a data-driven response. I'd like to provide support for students with a robust one-on-one tutorials system they need to recover from the pandemic loss. We need to exceed grade level standards," Judy Manouchehri said.

Manouchehri also said she would like to provide support for teachers with leadership from the administration and to connect them with other teachers who have been consistently scoring well. She said the District needs to have an actual plan.

Candidates were also asked what specific professional or personal skill they would bring to the board.

"I think one of the challenges that faces the district today is that we are a currently fractured Community. It's been very hard after COVID, there was a lot of isolation. We need to really build back up in terms of our community togetherness. In my 10 years of experience as a leader in this District, I am known as a consensus builder and a community engager. I work with the whole Community, not just part. During reconfiguration, I was part of the HMP-

TA leadership to help cement and solidify that Community. During covid I was continuing to be part of HMPTA leadership as well as starting my presidency at Beverly Hills Education Foundation," Farrah Dodes said.

Dodes said she will continue to do what she has been doing for the past ten years to build a sense of togetherness with the community.

## Traffic and Parking Commission Discusses Potential Transit System

At last Thursday's meeting the Traffic and Parking Commission discussed a draft Transit Feasibility Study and directed staff to develop a pilot program.

At their March 15 study session, the City Council directed staff to begin developing a transit service plan with the Traffic and Parking Commission as the advisory body.

The transportation planning firm of Kittelson & Associates Inc. was chosen to prepare the transit needs assessment, which will serve as the foundation for the operation of a transit system.

About 430 surveys were received in response to a transit survey released. A summary of the responses include: about 28% of respondents indicated that they are current or past riders of transit within the City; 43% indicated no experience as transit riders and expressed an interest in using public transit in the future; and 29% indicated no interest in using public transportation.

Kittelson also conducted interviews with Westside transit stakeholders, including West Hollywood and Culver City, to gather insight on local transit services,

tion to the upcoming Metro stations. The greatest transit circulation need is for north-south connectivity, according to community input. Kittelson also believes time-limited fixed route service could be effective during morning and afternoon peak-hour activity to connect parts of the city with the greatest concentrations of students to Beverly High and that connecting the Flats region to the upcoming Metro stations as part of a pilot program may be considered.

North-South Corridors would likely include Rodeo, Beverly, Canon, Rexford Drives, and Robertson Boulevard.

Microtransit is an option for geographies/terrain more challenging for fixed-route transit. Kittelson believes a microtransit pilot is likely to be the most successful service strategy for portions of the city north of Santa Monica Boulevard. It uses apps to offer on-demand routing between more widely spaced origins and destinations using smaller transit vehicles.

Vice Chair Ron Shalowitz questioned why the City should try to compete with Uber or Lyft and implement a microtransit system.

"When we didn't have Uber or Lyft, I could see why we needed microtransit, but we have Uber and Lyft, so now are we just basically competing with those services?" Shalowitz said.

The commission agreed to move forward with a pilot program. Staff will move forward with developing details for the following considerations: route(s) and stop locations, operating hours, performance and safety standards, passenger capacity, and power options.

Chair Sharon Ignarro said she would rather have more frequent service on a fixed-route circulator model as part of the pilot program. This model typically operates shorter routes targeted to local circulation needs in the community.

"I think starting with one circulator is a wonderful thing. I know that the recommendation from the CAC was to have two, and I would love to see as many as possible but with cost constraints - starting with one is important. Especially because we want to make sure that one comes as fast as possible," Ignarro said.

The preliminary estimated cost is estimated to be \$3.5 million for a one-year pilot program with one microtransit vehi-

and with the Metro Westside planning group for NextGen operations and next steps. Each organization indicated ridership is trending toward shorter, faster trips with higher frequency.

West Hollywood operates a combination of fixed route service to supplement the Metro transit network and specialized on-demand service for individuals over 62 years of age and disabled persons of all ages. In June their City Council approved a proposal to explore a microtransit pilot project to transition away from the dial-a-ride system to provide a general-public microtransit service with priority given to seniors and residents with disabilities served by the current dial-a-ride program.

Kittelson believes a fixed-route transit and microtransit system are best suited for the City.

Fixed route transit operates like conventional public transportation, operating defined routes on defined schedules, and serving defined stops.

According to the staff report, public input received over the course of the study indicates that interest is for fast connec-

tion and one circulator route.

## City Council Approves Resolution Condemning Government of Iran

The City Council unanimously approved a resolution condemning the government of Iran for the actions of its morality police in the beating and death of Mahsa Amini; calling for an impartial investigation into her death and to bring those liable to justice; supporting sanctions against the Iranian Government and Iran's morality police; and urging the government of Iran to implement meaningful laws ensuring fundamental human rights for all its citizen.

The Council also called on President Joe Biden, Secretary of State Antony Blinken, and Members of Congress to engage in all efforts to increase sanctions against Iran and cease current and future negotiations, including negotiations related to oil exports, and to not release any assets frozen in the United States, until there is a regime change.

On Sept. 13 Amini was arrested by Iran's morality police who accused her of breaking Iran's law requiring women to fully cover their hair with a hijab, or headscarf, and their arms and legs with loose clothing. She was reportedly beaten after her arrest by Iran's morality police and transferred to the Vozara Detention Center in Tehran.

On Sept. 16 Amini died in a hospital after spending three days in a coma. Since her death, demonstrators have taken to the streets in many cities, including Tehran, Ilam, Isfahan, Mahabad, Saqez, Sari, and Tabriz, to demand accountability for her death and calling for an end to violence and discrimination against women and girls in Iran.

Beverly Hills City Hall has been illuminated in the evenings with the message "Justice for Mahsa Amini" since Sept. 29.

"I will never be afraid to stand up and speak out and we need to call out everyone by name," Mayor Lili Bosse said. "We are all in this together and we in Beverly Hills will be the beginning of the change that will help around the world. This Council and community is united. We need to be the role model for the world. If not us, then who? If not now, then when?"

The resolution also calls upon the United Nations to expel Iran from the United Nations Women's Rights Commission.

## City Council Continues Discussion on Power Outages

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council continued their discussion on the recurring dissatisfaction in service with Southern California Edison.

On Aug. 23 Edison presented to Council regarding how they measure service and scheduling for upcoming infrastructure projects. The City Council originally requested Edison to return in Nov. for a progress report, but on Sept. 9 a power outage that affected 213 customers in Trousdale occurred, which extended beyond 24 hours until Sept. 11. Subsequently, Mayor Lili Bosse requested Edison to return at the first meeting in Oct.

The City has taken the following actions since Aug 23: sent a letter dated Sept. 6 to the California Public Utilities Commission in care of the Public Advisor; submitted a claim on behalf of the City for costs incurred by the power outage that began on Sept. 9, updated the City's website to include information about Edison claims; assisted in coordinating customer communication of the outage that followed the extended outage in Trousdale to make the permanent repair; and met twice with representatives from Edison to discuss how to effectively move forward.

"As far as I am concerned, this is a mass

failure. It's a failure at least on four levels. It is a failure of your [Edison] infrastructure. It is a failure of your customer service. It is a failure in your communications, and frankly, it is a failure in your resolution of the issues," Vice Mayor Julian Gold said.

Edison currently has a plan in place they say will improve the situation in Beverly Hills. This scope of work will take place until the end of the first quarter of next year which they believe will improve reliability. The end of quarter one is March 31, 2023.

A number of claims had also been filed by residents where they were denied. Edison is now reevaluating the claims that were rejected.

"To say this was a massive fail is being generous," Mayor Lili Bosse said.

Edison will return to the Council next month with updates.

### City Council Approves EqualizeHer Now! Event

At their Tuesday Study Session the City Council approved a request for a temporary street closure of the 9300 Block of Civic Center Drive and permission to use the City Shield for marketing materials for the proposed "EqualizeHer Now!" and Live Nation Street Fair on Saturday, Dec. 3.

This inaugural event is intended to build a collaborative community of powerful young women to create opportunities in various music industry fields such as producers, songwriters, managers, engineers, and artists.

The street closure is from 7:00 p.m. on Friday, Dec. 2, to 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, Dec. 3, with the event itself from 12:00 p.m. — 5:00 p.m. on Saturday only. The road closure will be for a free street fair open with live music performances, panel discussions, food trucks, and workshop activities. A total of 500 - 2,000 total attendees are expected to attend.

The Community Services Department will also be hosting a public daytime Holidays at Greystone event on Dec. 3. The Holidays at Greystone event will utilize City trolleys to shuttle guests between the Rexford parking garage and Greystone to allow people to travel to both events on the same date.

### City to Host Preferential Parking Permits Town Hall

The City is currently enhancing its parking program and will be hosting an upcoming Preferential Parking Permits Town Hall on Thursday, Nov. 3, from 6 p.m. - 7:30 p.m.

The Preferential Parking Permit Program governs parking in residential areas for all hours other than the overnight parking prohibition of 2:30 a.m. - 5:00 a.m.

Residents within a permit zone may currently purchase up to three daytime parking permits. Preferential Parking Permits expire Sept. 30 of the following year and require renewal.

Due to safety concerns, the City has had an overnight parking prohibition to address public safety concerns since 1927.

The City currently provides overnight

parking exemptions and permits to qualifying residents. Qualifying residents in multiple-family units are able to purchase annual overnight parking permits if there is a lack of off-street parking. Residents in multiple-family residential areas may also obtain up to 13 monthly overnight parking exemptions per household through the City's parking exemption.

The current permits will be automatically extended until Dec. 31 and residents will receive notifications once details become available.

## BOB HERTZBERG WANTS YOUR VOTE

### The County Supervisor Candidate Discusses the Issues in a *Weekly* Exclusive

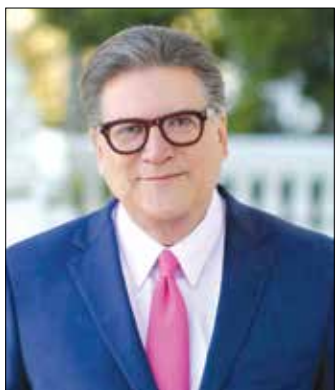
*Candidate Lindsey Horvath declined to be interviewed on Beverly Hills View, and by Beverly Hills Weekly.*

#### What are the key issues in this race and why are you the preferable candidate?

The key issues are public safety, public safety, public safety. People are scared and nervous for good reason. You see these smash

and grabs, you see the home invasions that are happening. Everywhere I go I hear horrible stories of people that don't want to go out, or go shopping. If they go to a restaurant or go outside they take all their jewelry off. You shouldn't have a society that does that. I have been supported by every police organization - the Beverly Hills Police Officers Association, Santa Monica, San Fernando, LA, and every one of them because I believe we need strong neighborhood policing and I am willing to increase those numbers. That doesn't mean that

you are just going to be tough on crime. As I said, constitutional policing is really important. That does not mean police officers shouldn't be disciplined, [or that] they shouldn't be transparent. We aren't responding to every mental health crisis with a gun and handcuffs, but it does mean people have to feel safe.

#### You served in the State Legislature for many years. How has that prepared you for this position?

This county is 10 million people. The county is basically the storefront of the state. We pass state laws on mental health, healthcare, foster care, and then the counties actually implement what we do. I have worked on every issue that the county works on. My role in the legislature in the few years I served in the assembly, and the few years I have served in the Senate - I was gone for 12 years in between working for a renewable energy company overseas and in South Los Angeles - I have been the speaker and majority leader, so I have had to have real responsibility to get things done. I think it's very important and it's essential to understand those issues and to have those skill sets and those relationships to be able to get things done in the county.

#### During the JusticeLA candidate forum, you said you support giving people capital so they can grow rather than universal basic

income. Can you elaborate on that? Every time there is a problem - let's tax the rich more and more, and it creates this horrible divide. Giving somebody a check for universal basic income does not solve it. I want to give them capital. One of the programs I am interested in is to give down payment assistance to buy a new house. So, we will give you a loan

and when you sell the house you pay it off. That way you get to build equity, you get to build ownership, and you are part of the community rather than paying a higher rent bill every year. It is a way to create wealth. We have to deal with the wealth gap, and we have to deal with the poor-rich divide. It is tearing our society.

#### West Hollywood City Council recently defunded the Sheriff. What are your thoughts on that?

[I] don't like it. I think it's wrong on every level. I think it sends the wrong message. It was not

just that they sought to defund the police, they did it at a time when the crime rate was at its highest. I talked to people in the community and they are so angry about it. I was there for the day of the closing of the Starbucks that was being closed because of crime. People are telling me they don't want to walk the three blocks, they don't feel safe. It's a problem. I just don't support it and I think it is one of the big factors that distinguishes me from the person running against me.

#### Do you think the County shut down too long for COVID? Why or why not?

I don't know. It felt like it was too long. Leadership - one of the other arguments in addition to public safety and homelessness - is leadership. Leadership means taking things by the reins and exercising leadership and getting things done, which are not being done now. When you have a director of a department and they tell you what to do, you take their advice and you make the decision. There were a lot of instances where there were businesses that they wouldn't let open that clearly had the protocols. Disneyland, for example, had protocols to open but Universal City could not do it, and yet it was working at Disneyland. I was a little worried about that. I am not someone who sticks fingers in someone's eyes and who looks back and criticizes. But, I am somebody who going forward will be very mindful of all the competing social interests, the mental health on children with schools, the business interests, and the community when we make these kinds of decisions when we are faced with something like this going forward.

#### Your son Daniel Hertzberg is running for your old State Senate seat. What's it

#### like to run as a father at the same time?

Hard, I want him to win more than I want to win myself. He's my son, he's brilliant and hardworking. He's actually so much better than I am in terms of understanding politics and how to work with folks. He is more progressive than I am, as you might imagine, he's 30 years old and I am not. It's hard, I am running my campaigns at the same time and peo-

ple are trying to leverage one against the other and so it kind of lends to some of the ugly gamesmanship that occurs in politics.

He is doing extremely well. He works his heart out, and I think he is going to win.

#### What one thing do you want the voters to know about you before they cast their ballots?

That I will tell the truth. That I will take risks to get things done. That I am not going to calculate politics over getting things done. I will take those risks to make things happen. I will make those hard decisions with respect to homelessness. Do I have compassion for the people on the street? Yes, but it is a moral crisis. I have traveled the world and I have never seen it like that. San Francisco is pretty bad but it is just not LA. It is not who we are. The second thing that I want people to know is - what I have learned in government is we always look at the issue that is on the front page today, but tomorrow there is going to be a new problem. I am always working on today's problems and tomorrow's problems. On water - very big issue to make sure we have a water supply. On jobs, all this extra money we have in economic development came in through these last couple of years, it's going to start drying up. I have lived through the experience of things going up and down. I have been through that. I want to work on economic development. We do that partly by building on all the green infrastructure through local jobs. The bottom line is, you're going to see someone who is responsible, who is going to tell the truth, and show up in your community and work my guts out for folks. It is what I do and it's why I chose to serve rather than go back to the private sector and make a living.
