City Council to Revisit Open Air Dining Ordinance

At their Aug. 15 meeting the City Council is expected to discuss a draft ordinance regarding the OpenBH program that was started during the Pandemic to ease regulations related to open air dining. The draft ordinance is currently scheduled to end in Sept.

The City Council previously directed city staff to work on changes to the program. The draft ordinance incorporates the proposed code changes that would update regulations pertaining to the City's existing program.

In order to develop a permanent program the City Council previously established the Code Changes and Fees Subcommittee

The primary change would be to update the existing regulations to allow more types of open air dining proposals to be approved, and to allow director-level review of the majority of other dining

City Holds Picklefest

The City held its annual Picklefest Sunday. There were 20 entries in the contest that took place at the Farmers' Market.

Coldwater's layout did not meet design standards, according to the staff report. Residents have also identified several safety concerns associated with the layout, including speeding and illegal pass-

Subsequently, the current striping was replaced with a layout that removed the center section, creating 10.5-foot travel lanes and 9.5-foot parking lanes. The left-turn pockets to intersecting side streets were shortened to the minimum safe length to maximize the availability of street parking.

To help determine the new layout, the City mailed surveys in Feb. 2021 to all owners and occupants along Coldwater and asked whether they preferred to have a center turn lane for left-turns into driveways or on-street parking, because the roadway cannot include both. Most respondents said that they would prefer to have on-street parking over a center lane.

The Fire Department previously expressed concerns about response times without a center lane and that parked cars may obstruct visibility for cars exiting driveways.

Residents have also expressed a desire to see the left-turn pockets removed to provide more on-street parking, according to the staff report. Several residents also expressed concerns about the safety of crossing the street as there are no marked crosswalks between Beverly Drive and Monte Cielo Drive.

City staff recommend retaining the left-turn pockets along Coldwater in the

final design at all locations except at Cabrillo Drive as it only serves as access to two properties. This would provide an additional 15 parking spaces, for a total of at least 80 parking spaces.

The City has identified three possible locations for crossings: South of Monte Cielo Drive, Lindacrest Drive, and Loma Linda Drive.

According to the staff report, a crosswalk at Lago Vista Drive is not feasible due to reduced sight distance, and a crosswalk at Cabrillo is not recommended due to proximity of other proposed crosswalks.

The second change proposed by the subcommittee was in relation to right-of-way lease fees and other processing fees that are required to be paid for the use of public property. The proposed fees will be reviewed by the City Council.

The Subcommittee also recommended allowing restaurants to extend their outside dining area beyond the facade of the restaurant. The code currently allows open air dining to be located directly adjacent to the building of the restaurant;

however, there are some existing parklets that extend beyond a restaurant's frontage. City staff is not recommending that the proposed code changes allow this type of configuration due to the complexity of property use rights.

The temporary program also allowed the use of the public right-of-way for non-dining uses, such as temporary setups of outdoor hair salons. The City Council did not direct staff to include these types of uses in the permanent update to the code.

The Planning Commission previously reviewed the draft ordinance and recom-

mended changes, including the removal of the parking requirements for all open air dining located on private property, and to add a threshold that would require discretionary review for open air dining areas located closer than a certain distance from residential properties.

The Planning Commission also directed staff to create a guideline for aesthetic standards to be used in the architectural review process for permits. The Commission did not come to a consensus on whether or not to allow a discretionary request for the Director of Community Development to approve the extension of

open air dining areas beyond the restaurant's facade and in front of adjacent tenants' facades. The Commission decided to forward the draft ordinance with no amendment to this provision. The City Council is expected to make a final decision on this matter.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING ARTICLE 47 OF CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 10 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING NON-STOREFRONT, DELIVERY-ONLY MEDICAL CANNABIS RETAIL AS A CONDITIONALLY PERMITTED USE FOR PROPERTIES LOCATED IN PORTIONS OF THE C-3 ZONE AND ADDING ARTICLE 23 TO CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 4 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING REGULATORY AND OPERATIONAL RESTRICTIONS FOR SUCH RETAILERS AND MAKING A DETERMINATION OF EXEMPTION FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

In September 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance 17-O-2734, adding Article 47 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) to generally prohibit the establishment of commercial cannabis uses and activity in the City, with certain exceptions as required by state law, and made findings that prohibitions on commercial cannabis activity were necessary for the preservation and protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City.

In 2022, Senate Bill 1186 ("SB 1186"), referred to as the Medicinal Cannabis Patients' Right of Access Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") passed in the state legislature and was signed by Governor Gavin Newsom on September 18, 2022, adding Chapter 26 (commencing with Section 26320) to Division 10 of the Business and Professions Code. The Act prohibits local governments, beginning January 1, 2024, from adopting or enforcing any regulation that prohibits or effectively prohibits, the delivery of medicinal cannabis to patients or primary caregivers within their jurisdictions.

The draft ordinance incorporates proposed code changes to the BHMC for SB 1186 compliance and will be presented to the Planning Commission for their review and feedback. The draft ordinance proposes code changes in the BHMC, that may include but are not limited to the following:

· Adds Article 23 to Chapter 2 of Title 4 to establish regulatory and operational

- Adds Article 23 to Chapter 2 of Title 4 to establish regulatory and operationa requirements for non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail businesses.
- Amends Section 10-3-1604 of Article 16 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 to add "Non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail" as a conditionally permitted use, with the remainder of Section 10-3-1604 to remain unchanged.
- · Adds paragraph "E" to Section 10-3-1654 of Article 16.5 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 to prohibit non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail uses in a pedestrian oriented area with the remainder of Section 10-3-1654 to remain unchanged.
- · Amends paragraph "B" of Section 10-3-3800 of Article 38 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 to add non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail as a conditionally permitted use with required findings with the remainder of Section 10-3-3800 to remain otherwise unchanged.
- · Amends Section 10-3-4701 of Article 47 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 to add definitions of certain terms.
- · Amends Section 10-3-4703 of Article 47 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 to add paragraph "D" providing an exemption from the general prohibition on cannabis activity for certain non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail, with the remainder of Section 10-3-4703 to remain unchanged.

· Adds Section 10-3-4705 to Article 47 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 to specify the standards and requirements for non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail use.

Staff will present a draft ordinance for the Planning Commission to review and will recommend that the Commission adopt a resolution recommending the approval of the draft ordinance to the City Council. Once the Planning Commission has completed their review, the draft ordinance will be presented to the City Council at a future public hearing for discussion and adoption. At such time, any associated application and inspection fees will also be presented to the City Council for review and adoption.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. The project will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment; and the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects, which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA. The businesses authorized under this zone text amendment are similar to already existing permitted general uses such as retail, with the only difference being the product sold (i.e., medical cannabis and medical cannabis products). The draft ordinance does not change the zoning for any properties, meaning that they do not create negative environmental impacts or result in physical changes to the environment. Accordingly, the Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to find the project categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

ment to allow for the construction of a new three-story commercial building with rooftop uses, at 8633 Wilshire Boulevard.

On July 23, 2020, the Commission adopted a resolution which allowed for the construction of a new three-story commercial building with rooftop uses and a Minor Accommodation to allow improvements in the setback area required between nonresidential and residential sites.

On June 28, 2022, an application was submitted to amend the previously approved entitlements along with a new Zone Text Amendment to redefine "alternative parking facility" and a Conditional Use Permit to establish an alternative parking facility within a subterranean garage. The applicant also requested another Minor Accommodation for a wall located in the required setback adjacent to a single-family residential property.

The entitlements for the 2020 Project are set to expire within three years from the date of approval, July 23, 2023. The applicant is seeking a one-year extension for the previously approved entitlements. The request is being processed separately from the current project and will be reviewed by the Commission at a future meeting.

The proposed 2023 revisions consist of minor modifications to the architectural

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design of the building, minor modifications to the rooftop uses, and the removal of retail uses from the ground floor, according to the staff report. There is also a request for a Conditional Use Permit to allow for an alternative parking facility to accommodate required parking.

The project was required to provide a total of 74 parking spaces. A total of 76 parking spaces were proposed in 2020 for design feasibility within four levels of subterranean parking.

Since approval of the Project, Assembly Bill (AB) 2097, became effective on Jan. 1, 2023, and prohibits public agencies from enforcing any minimum parking requirement on certain projects that are located within half a mile of a transit stop. The project site is located within half a mile of the future Metro D-Line station. However, the 2020 Project is required to provide parking in compliance with the resolution.

The proposed alternative parking facility would use a robotic system, which would reduce the number of subterranean parking levels from four to two. The total number of parking spaces would remain as previously approved.

The Planning Commission is expected to conduct the public hearing and possibly approve the project.

City staff is expected to bring the proposal to the City Council for final approval at a future meeting.

"Fun Run" Coming Sept. 20

Vice Mayor Les Friedman and Councilmember Lili Bosse reviewed a request from Hawthorne Elementary School PTA for the approval of "Fun Run" street closures and waiver of applicable fees for the school fundraiser to be held on Wednesday, Sept. 20.

The students run or walk, wear Vikings school spirit gear and raise funds. The street closures will allow the 450 students, 50 parent volunteers, and school staff to safely participate.

The requested street closures will be the 600 block of North Rexford Drive between Carmelita Avenue and Elevado Avenue, and the 9700 block of Elevado Avenue between North Rexford Drive and North Alpine Drive.

BHPD will reroute vehicles to Carmelita Avenue, which will stay open on the North and South ends. The alleyways adjacent to the location can be used as a detour. Traffic Officers will assist residents on the 600 block of North Rexford Drive.

The sidewalk on the East side of North Rexford Drive in front of the school, will be privatized. The PTA will be utilizing a portion of the sidewalk for check-ins, hydration stations, and cheer sections. The West side of the sidewalk will remain open and pedestrians will have access to it

The Hawthorne Elementary School PTA will post no parking signs 72 hours ahead of the event.

City staff will bring the proposal to the City Council for approval at a future meeting.

I think by using my landscape background, we're able to kind of do that in a way that's projected for suc-

What is a botanical designer?

A botanical designer works with plant or plant-like material to create bespoke pieces of artwork from living plants and natural materials. While I work primarily as a Landscape Architect, botanical design allows for artistic creative expression to create something unique that can be the finishing touch for the right project or client.

What is the commission working on right now?

We had our restaurant subcommittee meeting [on June 30]. That's for new restaurants coming into the City. I think that the pandemic hit everybody really hard. But we're starting to see some of the vacant buildings being leased and we have new restaurants coming into the City from New York and around the world. It's really special to have that in Beverly Hills and to kind of see these pockets in the City develop that are really restaurant focused. I think we have a lot of retail and entertainment zones that are very successful, but it's very exciting to see these new restaurant corridors show up around the city.

What are some of your hobbies?

[My] hobbies include paddle boarding in Marina del Rey, putzing around in the garden, farmers markets, outdoor concerts, a good seasonal cocktail, [and] spending time with [our] dog. My husband Zac Skipp and I adopted a six-yearold rescue lab last week named Brando. He was a stray found in Lancaster and was connected to us through Fetchin' Retrievers Rescue. We are thrilled to have him join our family.

What are your goals as chair?

I'm hoping to continue to change the way that people approach plant material in these projects. Where people sometimes think that a project is just a building renovation, I think there's always room for plant material and I'd like to change the idea that plants are temporary. I think that plants really should be around for a while. There are a lot of hidden mechanics that are involved to give the outward appearance that everyone's looking for. I think the same can be said for the building design as well. I'm hoping to continue to really play to the strengths, talents, and backgrounds of everybody on the Architectural Commission to really bring what they know to the table and to set these projects up for long-term success.

What is one thing you wish residents knew about in regards to the City's architecture?

The residents of Beverly Hills are very knowledgeable. I think that they appreciate it a lot. As we move forward, development is inevitable. I think that there's a way where we can do it with a certain sensitivity. We really want to zero in and focus on building adjacencies and what's happening on the block. If a commercial building is backing a residential area, we really are considerate of adjacent neighborhoods and understand that a lot of the citizens of Beverly Hills, and their families have lived there for a long time [with] different generations. We really do take that into consideration even though we're focused on commercial buildings and multi-family residential. We really do think about the single-family residential neighborhoods that are around these projects.

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BHPD Promotes Back to School Safety Month

As students return to the classroom. the Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) is reminding parents and residents to slow down, follow the speed limit, and be extra careful driving through school zones.

"Please drive like it is your child, grandchild, niece, or nephew walking or riding their bike to school," BHPD Chief Mark G. Stainbrook said. "Pick-up and drop-off times can be hectic, but it's important to be patient and stay safe as children get to and from school. It is better to be slow than sorry."

If you are behind a school bus with a stop sign and flashing red lights, drivers need to stop so students can safely get on and off the bus, according to the BHPD. Drivers must remain stopped while the red lights are on. Drivers in both directions must stop on any two-lane road without a median or a center turn lane.

The BHPD has offered the following tips to stay safe around schools: • Slow down and follow the speed

- Adhere to school policies and pro-
- cedures for dropping off and picking up
- Stop for school buses. Watch for children rushing to catch the bus or ex-
 - Whenever possible, avoid blocking the crosswalk while waiting to make a right-hand turn.
- For parents with children walking or biking to school, teach them safe walking and riding behaviors, such as looking both ways before crossing the street, using sidewalks when available, and crossing at marked crosswalks with stop signs or signals.

Labor Day, Sept. 4 looking for drivers suspected of driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. The additional efforts to prevent impaired driving are part of a national enforcement campaign, Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over.

"The community's well-being is our top priority, so we're asking that if you know you'll be out drinking, have a game plan for how to get home safely," Chief Mark G. Stainbrook said. "There is never a good excuse for driving after drinking or using drugs that impair."

The Department is also

asking residents to take the necessary precautions to protect yourself and your family by buckling up, avoiding distractions behind the wheel, following the speed limit, and not driving impaired.

In addition to patrols, the BHPD will hold a DUI Checkpoint on Sept. 8 from 7 p.m. to 2 a.m. on North Santa Monica Blvd. at Crescent Drive.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 13,384 people were killed in drunk-driving crashes in 2021—one person every 39 minutes.

The Department is also reminding residents that driving while impaired is not just from alcohol. Prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications, and cannabis products may also impair.
