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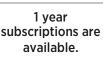

"Beverly Hills Firefighters' Association"

The Beverly Hills Firefighters' Association would be more accurately named the Beverly Hills Firemen's Union.

I and many other residents are very appreciative of our firemen's work in our city, however we do not appreciate the firemen's union's interference in our elections.

Last year, during the election on the proposed Cheval Blanc Hotel, the firemen's union lobbied for Cheval Blanc. Their only interest was to increase city income, having been promised by pro-developer council majority members that their benefits could be increased if Cheval won. As non-residents, our firemen did not need to concern themselves with the ramifications such a massive development would have had on our city and the residents who live here.

Prior to our city council elections, firemen's union representatives agreed behind closed doors to endorse city council candidates who have promised that they will vote in favor of increasing firemen's benefits. However, since our city council negotiates for firefighter services, salaries, and benefits, the union should not be interfering with such negotiations by taking candidates aside and entering into quid pro quo agreements in exchange for endorsements. Such conduct involves a conflict of interest in which a candidate puts his or her interest in being elected before our city's interest and bargaining position in negotiations with firemen. That is why our more ethical officials, including council members John Mirisch and Craig Corman, have indicated that they will not engage in such arrangements.

Residents recently received a letter from the firemen's union selling backdraft ball tickets for \$500 each and seeking other donations up to \$2,500. The letter was personally signed by past mayor Barry Brucker who according to city legislative advocate (lobbyist) records, capitalized on his past mayorship to earn in excess of \$100K lobbying for Cheval Blanc. Prior to that, he was a paid lobbyist for the Hilton development.

I recommend that residents should refrain from donating to the firemen's union unless and until the union agrees to refrain from lobbying for developers and unethically influencing negotiations with the city council in exchange for election endorsements.

It would also be very nice not to receive obnoxious robocalls urging residents to vote for a candidate who has compromised our city's bargaining position in return for such an endorsement.

Planning Commission to Discuss Renovations for Beverly Hills Hotel

The Planning Commission is expected to discuss a conditional use permit for the conversion of dining functions and lounge areas within the Beverly Hills Hotel, at its Thursday meeting.

The proposed project involves modifications in the southwestern area of the hotel.

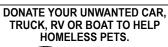
Specifically, the project would repurpose a 2,700 square foot function room, known as the Sunset Ballroom, into a 2,216 square foot restaurant and bar; add a 42 square foot indoor café in the lobby area, repurpose a 3,045 square foot indoor/outdoor bar/terrace into a 1,126 square foot function room, and repurpose an existing hotel room into an 846 square foot veranda bar on the first floor of the southwesterly wing

"The project encompasses a series of enhancements to the hotel's facilities designed to attract guests and visitors to an area of the hotel that is currently less frequented than other areas. Modifications include the removal of an existing boardroom, vestibules, bedroom suite, and the relocation of an existing publicly accessible bar along with the addition of a new private function room, veranda bar, café counter and lobby lounge, and a new publicly accessible restaurant and bar with dedicated kitchen," according to a city staff report.

The existing veranda bar, known as the Bar Nineteen12, would be replaced with a new 1,126 square foot function room, known as the Anderson Room, to be used for private dining and screenings.

The project would not modify any existing landscaping on the hotel and most of the modifications would be internally contained with limited modifications to exterior areas of the hotel.

According to a city staff report, staff has received two phone calls, one email, and seven letters in support of the project in ad-





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rant and bar. A phone conversation with a nearby resident also identified concerns over street parking on Crescent Drive and rideshare waiting/staging.

Cultural Heritage Commission To Discuss Six New Golden Shield Award Nominees

The Cultural Heritage Commission was expected to discuss six new potential nominees to recognize sites and buildings that have cultural significance, and approve three nominees to be brought forward and finalized at a future meeting. The discussion was expected to take place after the Weekly's deadline.

The first recommendation the commission will review is Arturo Shoe Fixx. Arturo Azinian began learning the craft of shoemaking at the age of 11 under the guidance of his father and other shoemakers in Buenos Aires. Upon relocating to Los Angeles with his wife Calliopi, they collaborated to repair shoes for department stores such as I Magnin, Bullocks Wilshire, and Neiman Marcus. Eventually, they established their own shoe repair shop in 1957. Their first Beverly Hills location opened in 1988.

The second recommendation is for Beverly Hills Garage. The Beverly Hills Garage, or previously known as the Beverly Drive Garage, was one of the earliest automotive shops in Beverly Hills and was later replaced by the existing multi-story bank building. The Garage was originally purchased by Daniel Quinlan in 1919 and was one of the few filling stations between mid-Wilshire and Santa Monica. The garage also serviced racing cars from the nearby Beverly Hills Speedway.

The third recommendation is for the Beverly Hills Athletic Club. The athletic club was originally located at 120 South Roxbury Drive. The building, which is no longer extant, was designed by Master Architect William Gage with alterations undertaken by Master Architect Douglas Honnold.

The Commission will also review Mr Chow, which opened their second location in Beverly Hills in 1974. Michael Chow, born in Shanghai in 1939, is a master chef and artist. His father was a Peking opera grand master and inspired the concept that "Life should be like musical theater", to which Chow adds that one should "never bore the audience," according to a city staff

The fifth recommendation is for Van De Kamps Holland Dutch Bakery. Brothers-inlaw Theodore Van de Kamp and Lawrence Frank built a chain of "Van de Kamp Holland Dutch Bakery" stores throughout Los Angeles during the 1920s. They came from

Milwaukee and opened a potato chip stand in 1915 with a \$200 investment on Spring Street in downtown Los Angeles.

The final recommendation is for Trader Vic's. Opened in 1955, Trader Vic's was established in conjunction with the Beverly Hilton Hotel, owned by Conrad Hilton and later purchased by Merv Griffin and held by him until 2004.

In 2012, the Beverly Hills City Council initially approved a Historic Preservation Ordinance.

Vigil for Dr. Benjamin Harouni Held in Beverly Hills

A vigil was held in Beverly Hills last Sunday after the murder of Dr. Benjamin Harouni, a dentist who was killed while working in his office near San Diego on Feb. 29.

His family is establishing a charity, Hearts Over Hate, which is intended to "support families affected by violent crimes, offering them much-needed counseling and support, particularly for those who lack the resources to access these services" in hopes of "preventing such tragedies from recurring.

> This ordinance underwent updates by both the Planning Commission and Cultural Heritage Commission, which was later adopted by the City Council in 2015. The revised historic preservation ordinance aimed to enhance the criteria for potential individual designations and offer clearer guidelines for establishing eligible historic districts.

> According to a city staff report, an historic district comprises a collection of buildings, structures, sites, and spaces that share historical, architectural, and/or cultural connections. Such a district may encompass either a portion or the entirety of a neighborhood, varying in size, and can

represent diverse architectural styles. Additionally, historic districts may incorporate significant public amenities like streetlights or landscape features that contribute to defining the neighborhood's character.

A prospective district could range from a residential zone featuring multiple buildings constructed in a cohesive architectural style to a city area linked with the initial stages of urban development.

To date, the city has undertaken three historic resource surveys. Alongside these surveys, individual properties have also been assessed either by city personnel, external consultants hired by the city, or other agencies in conjunction with development proposals.

During the 1985-86 survey period, a total of 2,790 properties were included in the assessment. Among these properties, 371 were identified as potential historic resources. These properties underwent further evaluation utilizing the Department of Parks and Recreation Historic Resources Inventory.

In 2004, the city examined additional properties that seemed to satisfy federal, state, or local criteria for acknowledgment, either on an individual basis or as part of a district. A total of 622 multi-family and

commercial properties were looked at as part of this survey.

In 2006, the city assessed further commercial properties that appeared to meet the criteria for recognition at the federal, state, or local levels, either as individual entities or as part of a historic district.

The Cultural Heritage Commission was expected to discuss the outcomes and provide final feedback to Staff, which would potentially move forward to the City Council for final review and approval.

Beverly Hills Man Pleads Guilty In \$18.4 Million Cannabis Scam

A Beverly Hills man pleaded guilty to federal criminal charges for causing investors more than \$18 million in losses – while he was completing a sentence in a prior criminal case – by duping them with false claims about his companies that purportedly invested in hemp farms and cannabis-infused retail products as well as a sham bottling business.

Mark Roy Anderson, 69, pleaded guilty to two counts of wire fraud.

According to his plea agreement, Anderson engaged in two separate schemes that swindled victims, which he committed shortly after his release from federal prison but while on home confinement and, later, while on supervised release for a previous fraud conviction.

In the first scheme, from June 2020 to April 2021, Anderson tricked investors into providing funding for his company, called Harvest Farm Group, to harvest and process hemp grown on his farm into medical-grade cannabidiol (CBD) isolate – a chemical found in marijuana – to be sold for a substantial profit.

Anderson convinced investors to invest in Harvest Farm Group by falsely representing that, through the company, he owned and operated a hemp farm in Kern County. He also lied that had already completed successful and profitable harvests of hemp from the farm. He also falsely said he was using his own machinery and equipment to convert the hemp into CBD isolate and Delta 8, a psychoactive substance that, like CBD isolate, could be used in consumer products ranging from olive oil to body cream.

According to a press release, Anderson attempted to maintain a veneer of trustworthiness by taking steps to assure investors Harvest Farm Group was legitimate and he was not the "Mark Roy Anderson" with multiple prior fraud convictions. Anderson concealed that he had been convicted of multiple federal and state felony crimes, including mail fraud, wire fraud, grand theft, forgery, preparing false evidence, and money laundering. He also concealed that he was still serving a criminal sentence and was on supervised release at the time he was soliciting investments.

To stall victim investors from making collection efforts and reporting him to law enforcement, Anderson falsely told them that sales of products derived from hemp grown at the farm had been delayed because of the COVID-19 pandemic, misleadingly promised that he would pay the victims money from purported sales he had made to Canadian companies, and falsely promised that

he would otherwise return their money.

In the second scheme, which ran from April 2021 to May 2023, Anderson deceived investors by soliciting money for Bio Pharma and Verta Bottling, two of his sham companies, by claiming that these businesses successfully manufactured, bottled, and packaged commercial products.

Specifically, Bio Pharma purportedly manufactured and sold products infused with CBD, including products such as CBD-infused avocado oil, olive oil, pain cream, gummies, tequila, and chili oil. Anderson also claimed that Verta Bottling manufactured and sold beverages and a variety of food products.

Anderson falsely stated that his bottling companies owned and possessed millions of dollars' worth of assets, including – in Bio Pharma's case – hemp biomass, CBD isolate, CBD oil, and – in Verta Bottling's case – manufacturing equipment and an assignable lease for a warehouse to manufacture and sell its products.

Anderson's other lies to investors included false claims that his bottling companies had at least \$10 million in purchase-order contracts from suppliers. He drafted fake legal and business documents, which included fabricated purchase order contracts purporting to show agreements with third party companies to purchase tens of millions of dollars' worth of products manufactured by the Anderson bottling companies. Anderson also provided victims samples of products purportedly manufactured by his purported bottling companies.

Instead of investing victim funds as he promised, Anderson instead used their money on personal expenses. He has agreed to forfeit his ill-gotten gains from these schemes, including 15 cars — one of them a Ferrari — and real estate in Ojai.

In total, Anderson solicited more than \$18.8 million from 45 victims for both schemes, causing victims to lose approximately \$18,376,150.

Literary, culinary, visual art, film events, and craft activities will be held across the city at a variety of venues including the Beverly Hills Farmers' Market, the Library, Greystone Mansion and Gardens, and both La Cienega and Roxbury Community Centers.

According to a city staff report, Community Services curated a series of events and educational programming throughout May 2023, celebrating Jewish American Heritage Month.

The compilation of month-long programs from last year included the following:

- Book and audiovisual display at the library.
- E-resources and links on the library webpage.
- Weekly movie screenings celebrating at Roxbury Park Community Center.
- Online Classic Babka Making Master Class.

"Anita de Monte Laughs Last is a propulsive, witty examination of power, love, and art, daring to ask who gets to be remembered and who is left behind in the rarefied world of the elite. In 1985. Urgent Repair on Key Water Pipeline to Impact Traffic in Beverly Hills

Commuters and residents who use North Santa Monica Boulevard are urged to avoid or allow more time to travel through a twoblock portion of the thoroughfare as crews from the Metropolitan Water District urgently repair a leak in a major water pipeline.

Water service to residences and businesses will not be impacted by the leak or construction activities.

Only one lane will be open in each direction on North Santa Monica Boulevard between Moreno Drive and Wilshire Boulevard, where Beverly Hills borders the city of Los Angeles, through at least Saturday, April 13, although repairs may extend beyond that date.

"We will work as quickly as possible to address this issue to protect the region's water supplies, as well as public safety," said Shane Chapman, Metropolitan assistant general manager of operations. "We appreciate the public's cooperation during this urgent repair."

The leak was discovered in Metropolitan's Santa Monica Feeder, a 24-mile pipeline that delivers water to the cities of Glendale, Burbank, Los Angeles, Beverly Hills and Santa Monica.

Metropolitan crews will excavate to inspect the pipeline and immediately repair the leak.

In addition to the traffic impacts, local residents and businesses may notice increased noise due to construction and excavation

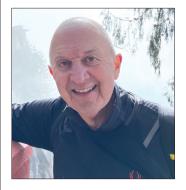
Sings, a benefit concert and after-party on Friday, April 12, at 6 pm, at Colburn School's Zipper Hall in downtown Los Angeles.

Are We Ready for the Metro?

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transit Authority (Metro) announced last week the completion of all tunneling for the subway D Line from the current end of the line at Wilshire and Western to the VA Hospital in Westwood.

This includes an extension of over nine miles and seven new stations, including two in the City of Beverly Hills, at La Cienega and Rodeo, and one very nearby station at Constellation in Century City. This is the successful and safe conclusion of a massive tunneling project over many years (including a 20 year pause to ensure that tunneling could be safely done without methane gas disruptions in the La Brea Tar Pits area). Now, all that remains is completion of the construction of the stations themselves, a non-trivial but finite set of projects.

The total cost of the project will be the jaw dropping sum of \$9B paid for 50/50 by Metro and the federal government according to Metro spokesperson **Dave Sotero**. The city of Beverly Hills has not contributed to the costs of construction of the tunnels and will not, absent a change that I will get to, contribute to the costs of construction of the stations.

Metro is a Los Angeles County agency with massive resources and responsibilities.

In 2023, the system had a total County-wide ridership of 284,901,000 and had a ridership of 907,500 per weekday as of the fourth quarter of 2023.

Metro operates around 110 miles of subways and light rail trains. That will be closer to 120 miles when the D line is completed. Base fare is \$2.50 and "senior" (over a youthful 62) fare is \$0.35 to \$0.75

In recent decades, Metro has spent billions to improve regional quality of life by creating better, faster public transportation to enable residents to travel faster and less expensively and to reduce traffic or at least slow increases that are reflective of a growing population with finite space for roads and the like.

New D Line service from DTLA to La Cienega is scheduled to begin by the end of 2025. Service through to Constellation by the end of 2026 and to the Westwood VA by the end of 2027. Although schedules are still being developed, Mr. Sotero estimates that this trip from DTLA to La Cienega station

will take less than 20 minutes. When the line has been completed, he estimates that a trip from DTLA to UCLA will take only 25 minutes, unaffected by street level traffic.

Bottom Line: after many delays, the subway is coming to Beverly Hills!!

So it occurred to me that this is an opportune time to review the current stage of preparations for the arrival of this service.

For a sensible review it is important to understand what Metro does and does not provide. Metro provides the route of travel (in this case miles of tracks and tunnels), the trains, the operators, and the stations. I understand that the Rodeo station, in particular, will be spectacular. Metro will handle the operations and maintenance of the D line

Metro does not provide parking around its stations, does not provide restrooms on the trains nor in the stations and does not provide for transportation to or from the stations.

Those important items and local law enforcement are the responsibility of the cities in which the stations are located.

During the recent City Council campaign, all candidates focused almost entirely on one subway related issue – security. Security of our City is of vital importance particularly in the short run when La Cienega will be the end of the line and passengers who may use the subway for shelter must exit the passenger cars and the stations.

Very little was said during the campaign about an equally important issue – how to facilitate use of the subway by City residents, shoppers, workers and visitors. While security is of vital importance, use of this subway is also important. Given the enormous investment, it would be most unfortunate if the new subway line were underused or simply drew away passengers from the extensive east/west bus service that Metro already provides to the City.

To state the obvious, security throughout the system is important for more than one reason. First, passengers must be able to have a safe comfortable experience. Beyond that, City residents are not going to even consider a ride on the D Line unless they are confident that they can reach their destinations without unduly unpleasant experiences.

Security on the trains and within the stations is entirely the responsibility of Metro. This is at present far from perfect. I understand that this is improving and that a substantial grant was recently announced that will, in part, be used to improve security. In any event, that is beyond our control.

In terms of security outside of and beyond the stations, at this point BH-PD's plans include "use of the City's Real Time Watch Center, an extensive network of cameras and the drone program, [which] provide security coverage throughout the City including the areas near the new Metro stations. In addition, security resources will exist both at and below street level", according to Lauren Santillana, City Public Information Manager. She added that "the City's MOA with Metro dictates staffing requirements to ensure 24/7 security coverage."

While it may appear that nothing specific has yet been planned, Ms. Santillana points out that "the City will continue to assess what additional staffing resources may be needed near the stations." There is no question in my mind that our outstanding BHPD will continue to keep us secure.

We should communicate ideas for enhancing security to the City Manager's office, our Commissioners or our Councilmembers. An obvious question is what to do about toilets at or near the stations. In specific cases, Mr. Sotero advises, Metro has allowed private companies who provide and maintain portable toilets to operate them at or near Metro's stations.

So we turn to the question of what is planned and what should be done to facilitate use, bearing in mind that the stations are more than a mile apart. If no parking is provided at the stations, how will passengers travel to and from the subway stations to their homes, jobs or other City destinations? This is often referred to as the "first mile/last mile" issue referring to getting to and from the stations to destinations. In the case of Beverly Hills, this is somewhat of a misnomer given that many residents and many office workers and tourists are going to or coming from substantially more than a mile away. Of course, they could take an Uber or a long walk but, more likely, they will not abandon their cars or other modes of transportation.

Notably, the City has some services that could take senior citizens to and from their destinations and Metro has a first/last mile plan that includes traffic calming, curb extensions, street trees and landscaping; signal timing for pedestrians and cyclist bike lanes, bike parking and bike share stations; wayfinding signage to key destinations and transit connections; and new or improved sidewalks and crosswalks. All of these are nice as is the City's Complete Streets Plan but none are likely to change behavior patterns or attract subway passengers.

So what specific actions can we sug-

gest?

In at least one instance, a potentially available short walk may not be available. The Constellation station is a very short distance from the rear of Beverly Hills High School. For security reasons, this shortcut will not be created. According to BHUSD Superintendent **Michael Bregy**: "At this time we are not planning on creating a pathway from the back of the high school to the entry points. Currently the walking pathway from the subway station to the entry areas at BHHS is just under a mile and a 14-17 minute walk."

Dr. Bregy speculates that this mile distance will not likely be close enough to attract faculty or student passengers. I think that he is correct about that. I am informed that studies show that people are willing to walk between ½ and ½ mile to and from their destination and a station but not much more than that. Nonetheless, it may be prudent to survey potential usage by students, faculty or staff of a much shorter pathway from the back of the high school to the station.

According to Mr. Sotero, cities that can coordinate between their own transit systems and the Metro stations have the best opportunity to attract new passengers to subway or light rail. Uniquely among our neighboring cities, the City has no transit system beyond special purpose programs. Santa Monica, Culver City and Los Angeles have their own established systems. West Hollywood has recently implemented its own. Actually, one of the purposes of one of the new West Hollywood transit system is to link the City directly with the Hollywood and Highland station on Metro's B line which is located in Los Angeles.

My suggestion is that the City explore partnering with West Hollywood, Santa Monica or Culver City on instituting transit routes (using appropriately sized fuel efficient vehicles) custom designed to get potential passengers to and from the new stations.

While it may be premature before the Rodeo station is open, should we look at how we might provide at a reasonable cost a small bus that would travel an east/west route along Charleville and a north/south route from Sunset to Olympic along Beverly Drive that would help passengers get to and from the station?

Contracting with a vendor to provide and operate portable toilets could be a way of assessing needs in the first and subsequent stages without undue capital expense.

Should we be looking now at how to deal with the undeniable need for toilets near the stations rather than waiting until the stations are open?

There is apparently one somewhat open issue relating to the BH stations. As currently designed the entry and exit "portals" for the Rodeo station are located only on the south side of

FROM BEVERLY HIGH TO POLITICAL EXILE

Ilene Graham Médecin Discusses Her New Memoir: Arrested: A Memoir of the American First Lady of Nice, France and the French Riviera

Raised in Beverly Hills with two famous uncles—a cosmetics tycoon and a well-connected mob figure—Illene Médecin's upbringing paved the way for a life of romance and glamor as the American First Lady of Nice, France and the French Riviera. "Arrested" chronicles Illene's journey, from her marriage with Jacques Médecin, a Medici Count also known as "King Jacquou," who represented the final chapter of a long-standing political dynasty.

You graduated Beverly High in 1966. Tell us about growing up in Beverly Hills in the 1960s.

It was wonderful. Everything was safe and we didn't lock our doors at night. I was at Hawthorne [school], and my best friend at the time was Stephanie Cohen, who is now Stephanie Blackmore. She used to be an actress on *Dallas*. At that time, everybody was pretty laid back and cool and I enjoyed it. I enjoyed Beverly High better than I did Hawthorne. I still [maintain connections] with my gram-

mar school and high school friends and [I still] keep in touch with Merry Elkins, Leni Corwin, Kerry Ross, and Michael Lloyd, who I think is a billionaire now.

How did you get to France?

I ended up meeting and marrying [Jacques Médecin],

who was the Mayor of Nice, France, President of the French Riviera, Member of French Parliament, and Minister of Tourism under Valery Giscard d'Estaing. I met him by chance in Beverly Hills when he was married and I didn't think I'd ever see him again. I went out with him and he ended up getting divorced, which took two years. We got married and there were 800 people at our reception. Then I became the First Lady of Nice, France and the French Riviera.

Was it hard to adjust to a new country?

Yes. In the beginning I was being hidden all the time because Jacques was going through elections and when the scandal came out that he was going to get divorced and marry me, it was all over

the European papers, as well as a lot of press in LA and it was difficult. I had to learn the language and Jacques had said to me "Americans don't learn any other languages." All somebody had to do was say to me that you can't do something and I'll do it. So I learned the language and that was difficult.

There was opposition, as well as adulation and I was constantly in the public. I used to be a model and that helped me a lot because I was used to being in public but I wasn't used to speaking. So all of a sudden I had to learn how to give speeches, not only in French but in English.

Tell us about your late husband Jacques Médecin and his political career.

The Médecins were in Florence and when Italy united, they were in the middle, right next to France, and they had to vote to become either Italian or French. They thought that they could get a better deal at the time with the French side,

because Napoleon was the big leader. But the French never really accepted Nice becoming part of France. They always looked down on them because they're basically Italian. So one of the Médecins came down to Nice and married a governor there and they

started to rule. That was one of Jacques' relatives. Then the Médecins took over the rule of the Cote d'Azur and Nice and his father was mayor before him. So it's been a dynasty there ever since Nice became French. They had ruled as the President of the Cote d'Azur, which is the French Riviera, as mayors, governors, members of parliament, and senators. They wanted Jean Médecin, Jacques' father, to run for president. He didn't want to but he came in second on the ticket, even though he wasn't running.

Jacques wanted to run for president but there were big scandals and everything. He decided to go on the ticket with Valery Giscard d'Estaing and campaigned for him, and he became minister at that time. He ruled the Riviera and Nice with an iron thumb and was a pheARRESTED

nomenal leader. Even the Socialist president when they got in in the 80s said that Jacques was the best mayor in all of France. And that's pretty outrageous coming from a Socialist president because Jacques was very right-wing.

Jacques came from a prominent political family but ended his political career in exile and subsequently landed two years in jail. Tell us about that.

Jacques had a mole in the Socialist Party telling him what was going on. When the Socialists came in they wanted his territory because he ruled it and it was right-wing and France had turned Socialist. So there was an underlying campaign to arrest him and throw him in jail. We were supposed to go to Japan and at the time, I was not well. I had obtained a very rare golden staph and I couldn't go with them to Japan. From Japan, he was going to escape and leave us in the Pre-

fecture, which is the palace, so that would divert the Socialist from thinking that he wasn't coming back. From Japan he wanted to go to Argentina because he had a relationship with [former President Carlos Menem], and Menem

was up for another election but he didn't want Jacques to go there because the scandal was all over Europe. And so he went to Uruguay and we were living in political exile there. When I was better, I went to join him. Then I left and he had been put under house arrest because they got him on criminal charges, which was unjust. It was horrendous because the Socialists lied and they did whatever they wanted. And so, he ended up in prison in Grenoble and I was arrested in Nice. After he was out of prison, he was supposed to stay in France and stand for another trial, but he escaped through Italy and then went back to Uruguay. I thought everything was safe, and I went to visit my dear friend in England. He was the ambassador at one time from England, and then he was the Consul in Marseilles. And when I left, I didn't

know anything was going on and I went to Nice and they arrested me and put me in prison.

Tell us about your memoir: Arrested: A Memoir of the American First Lady of Nice, France and the French Riviera.

So in the beginning, it starts out with my uncle Max Factor, who's the cosmetic magnate, and my other uncle, Jake "The Barber", who was a mafia mob lord. They built the Stardust Hotel in Vegas, and we used to go out there. I ended up being close with my uncle Max Factor, and I write about that and about Beverly High.

We were sister cities with 22 cities around the world and we traveled everywhere. I got pregnant in Dubai, which is in the Emirates. And because the Muslims wanted to build on the French Riviera they had to go through Jacques and they wanted to guide us. I write about [some really] bizarre and wild things [that happened over there].

[In another instance], there was a big fundraiser for us and they invited us to Paris. So the host and hostess said, "Finish your desserts and we'll meet you in the other room." So we figured the guys were going to smoke or something. The butlers took us to the room, opened the door, and the host was naked. The hostess was also naked and she was chained to a bed, where the host was whipping her, with chains and a shammy. And Jacques and I were like, "What the hell?" And so the rest of the party, they're in there and they start stripping. We're talking about some very important people here. They start stripping and they're doing all of this kinky, crazy stuff with machines, bottles, and whips and chains. I was fascinated. I did not believe it, you know, I was young. And Jack grabbed me and

he said, "We're out of here." So I talk about things like that.

I also talk about my affairs with an Italian businessman. I talk about Nino Cerruti, an Italian designer and how I almost had an affair with him, as well as Sergio Leone.

I'm very honest. I tell the truth and I always have. It's been pre-sold now and it's going like hotcakes, which I'm really, really grateful for. I was also presented with the Grand Humanitarian Award for my social services. The only other American who received that was Grace Kelly. I tried my best to represent America well

It goes from one thing to the next. And so everybody said that they have all these emotions reading it. They're riveted. They're shocked. They're crying, they're this and that. My daughter had cancer. I went through that with her and I explained what happened. I also almost died and I explained my near-death experience. So it's packed full of stuff.

Wilshire. Some have urged that a portal on the north side be added as many passengers traveling to the City will be here to visit shops, stores or physicians on the north side of Wilshire. The City has agreed that if it requests that Metro

add the north portal, the City and Metro will split the cost 50/50. Assuming that the City's share will be substantially in excess of \$50M, should this be done?

If you want to travel from the City to UCLA or Downtown Los Angeles or anywhere along the way, the D Line will be much, much faster and far less expen-

sive when you consider costs of parking or taxi or Uber fares. What more would it take to induce you to give it a try?

To date, substantial thought and planning has been expended in aid of making the Metro D line a great success and I am not at this point critical of any aspect. It is, however, time to get more

granular and specific and I am certain that City officials (and I) would be pleased to know your suggestions.
