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Mayor to Deliver State of the City Address Tonight

Mayor Steve Webb says "City is in Good Hands"

Mayor Steve Webb will present his State of the City Address tonight, where he will speak on various topics regarding the well-being of Beverly Hills.

"Each year the chamber provides a platform for the mayor [to speak]," said Dan

Walsh, CEO of the Chamber of Commerce. "We are delighted to do so and it is a valuable opportunity."

Webb will discuss current plans to remodel the ground floor of city hall. The city council and the city's management team are working together to make city hall more "user friendly" for Beverly residents and the business community.

"All of us on the council and the city's management team understand that we still need to further improvement in making our city government the best it can be," Webb said. "And in particular, our ability to politely, efficiently and properly provide the necessary services to the residents and business community."

The city is also preparing to unveil a new service to residents and businesses that will allow them to pay all utility bills and renew business tax registration on-line.

Webb plans to commend the cities emergency personnel and will discuss some of the ongoing improvements in the fire and

police departments including emergency preparedness exercises and training events.

The Chamber of Commerce will also be recognized and Webb will explain how their leadership team is working with the business community on South Beverly Drive as well as their involvement with the Bon Appetite Program, which is celebrating the 50th anniversary of the *Bon Appetite* Magazine.

In October, Webb will be combining with the city manager, the Chamber of Commerce and the conference and visitors bureau as a delegation for the annual New York Sales Mission and CEO Luncheon. He will discuss some of the issues and goals that will be debated at the luncheon.

Webb's main focus for the evening will be centered on the city's completion of the update of the General Plan.

"As we are now looking forward to the next one hundred years, we need a general plan that will meet the needs of the community during the 21st century," Webb said. "This document must address our quality of life. That includes the economic vitality of this community in order to sustain our services and lifestyle."

The Planning Commission has received countless recommendations on the proposal which deals with land use and redevelopment, from a series of public meetings, General Plan Topic Committees, consultants, staff and comments from Team Beverly Hills.

Recent discussions have centered on updating the General Plan. The main focus: determining whether any of the proposed

land use alternatives should be recommended for further testing.

The Planning Commission is working with the city council to plan testing at each of the 14 sub-areas to determine the environmental, traffic and economic impacts it will have on the city.

Some of the underlying issues to be considered for the General Plan include but are not limited to, plans for the old railroad right-of-way which runs the length of Big Santa Monica Boulevard, revitalization of East Wilshire Boulevard, issues of local serving businesses on South Beverly Boulevard, the fate of the Robinson's-May and Hilton sites, and discussions on mixed use, which would allow for residential development in commercial zones.

Webb will discuss his concerns on the General Plan and what he believes should be the policy on commercial development for the city, as well as the issue of some major businesses which have or are in the process of moving away from Beverly Hills due to their need for expansion.

Webb will present numbers from the past and future general fund budgets and will comment on some of the underlying issues facing the financial arena of Beverly Hills.

Lastly, Webb plans to discuss some of the economic issues effecting Beverly Hills including photo radar enforcement of city speed limits and increased traffic on the Westside as well as expansion possibilities for the Red-Line through Beverly Hills and Santa Monica.

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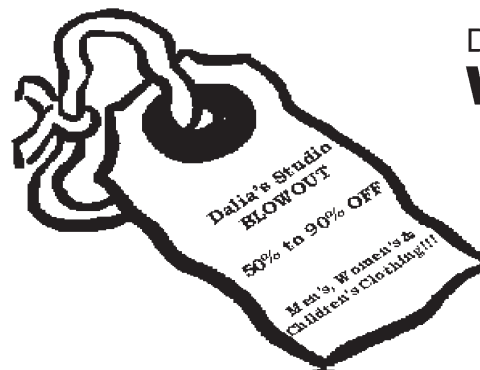

Philanthropists Women Honored by Friends of Sheba

The Friends of Sheba will present three women with the "Women of Achievement" Award on Wednesday, Sept. 13 at the 20th annual Women of Sheba luncheon.

The honorees are Sue and Rita Brucker, wife and mother of Beverly Hills councilmember Barry Brucker, and female plastic surgeon, Dr. Elizabeth Morgan.

The luncheon is scheduled to be held at the Four Seasons in Beverly Hills and all proceeds will support the Center for Newborn Screening at Sheba Medical Center, located in Tel Hashomer Israel. The hospital is the largest and most comprehensive in Israel and the Middle East.

"The Israel Center for Newborn Screening at Sheba Medical Center will allow over 150,000 babies born in Israel annually, regardless of race, religion or social status, to be tested for 20 treatable genetic diseases," said Ruth Steinberger, Women of Sheba chair. "With early diagnosis, children afflicted by one of these diseases will be able to lead normal, healthy and long lives."

Sue Brucker has served as PTA president at both El Rodeo and Beverly High. She has also served on the Jewish Federation Anti-Cult task force, was president of the Concern II Cancer Foundation, board member of the Friends of Sheba Medical Center and of the Beverly Hills Education Foundation. She is currently the president of Temple Emanuel of Beverly Hills.

Rita Brucker has been a volunteer for over 50 years and is a cancer survivor. Rita, also known as "Bubbe the Clown" has painted the faces of children with cancer at many community events. She has also served on the PTA, the Camp Fire Girls, the Avon Breast Cancer walks, and she was a Volunteer of the Year for the American Cancer Society's Reach to Recovery Program.

Dr. Elizabeth Morgan is among the leading female plastic surgeons in the nation. She graduated from Harvard and the Yale University of Medicine and wrote the best-seller, "The Making of a Woman Surgeon." She also became know worldwide in 1987 after she spent 25 months in jail because she would not allow her six-year-old daughter to go on court-ordered visits with her ex-husband. She alleged he sexually abused her daughter. Congress passed two laws after the case.

Death Penalty to be Discussed at Town Hall Meeting

Assemblymember Paul Koretz (D-West Hollywood) will lead a Town Hall meeting from 6-8 p.m. tonight, regarding the death penalty and the possibility to initiate a death penalty moratorium.

The meeting will be held at the National Council of Jewish Women, Los Angeles Auditorium.

Topics to be discussed include whether innocent people are guaranteed not to be executed, whether the death penalty is an effective deterrent, possible alternatives to the death penalty, if it is applied fairly, and whether lethal injection is an ethical or cruel and unusual punishment.

Recent questions have been raised regarding the death penalty due to advances in science and DNA evidence which has led to many exonerations.

Others who will join the panel for discussion include Gloria Killian, Executive Director of the Action Committee for Women in Prison, who was convicted of murder and was exonerated after serving nearly 18 years in prison; Stephen Rohde, former ACLU-SC president and an expert on Constitutional law; and Larry Greenfield, California Director of Republican Jewish Coalition and an attorney.

Geldert has over 40 years of firefighting and administrative experience in California and nationally. He started as a crash rescue firefighter for the U.S. Navy in 1960 then moved to the Inglewood Fire Department where became battalion chief.

"Dale's vision and experience is just what the City needs to take an already outstanding and professional department to the next level," said City Manager Rod Wood. "He will help get the City ready to respond to the kinds of threats we face in the 21st century."

Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger appointed Geldert to head the CDF in 1004, which encompasses the functions of state fire chief, state forester and director of the state fire marshal's office.

Geldert attended the University of Redlands where he received a B.A. in public administration and also received a master's of public administration from the University of San Francisco. He is married to Vista City Manager Rita Geldert.

Time to Protect the Protectors

And Noyes on Passings, Polls and Events

It was certainly more convenient when this column was able to disagree with writers to be found in this publication and not have to look outside. Frankly, I miss **Gerald Lunn, Jr.**, and our weekly, mostly, but not always, polite tiffs.

Gerald Jr. was, of course, more certain of his opinions, and far more touchy about our differences. I always have envied people who see things so clearly that they can harbor no doubts.

I remember when I made some mildly facetious comments about Gerald Jr.'s devoted loyalty to the Minnesota Twins. I suggested our own dear Dodgers and Angels needed rooting for the home teams, forgetting that when the Red Sox arrive in Anaheim, the Los Angeles Angels at Anaheim seem to be playing an away game. Gerald Jr. actually posted my attempt at humor on the Twins website, and you should have read the nasty letters I received from the Land of the Lakes folks. The word Twin frightened me because just maybe it meant that there was a duplicate Gerald Jr. somewhere.

But enough about history, we now have to look at other publications for fun and games. Along comes my colleague and friend **Cliff Smith** of the Courier with one of the more convoluted opinion pieces I have read since he once proclaimed, in an attack on then presidential candidate **John Kerry**, that the Democratic nominee "carried the endorsement of **Yasser Arafat**."

Certainly, when **March Schwartz** ran his opinions on page one of that paper, it had more immediate impact. Smith does his work in a more subdued manner on an editorial page in the back, so you may have missed the reason for this effort at response.

Here goes, it seems that Smith is very agitated about the costs of the retirement packages the city provides its employees. In a very carefully structured opinion, and you have to read carefully, the worst offenders are those working in the police and fire departments. In one sentence he warns of their political power and their ability to defeat their enemies and at

the same time, praises them for their fine service in protecting us.

However, Smith should know that the associations representing our protective service staffs have only once in their long history worked to defeat any candidate. Yes, they often endorse, but do not target or even mention those they don't. And the one time they actually worked against an incumbent the issues really had nothing to do with retirement benefits.

Smith has asked the city to provide him with information regarding "retirement and benefit costs" and has concluded, even before the city can respond, that those packages will "surprise" the voters with their "skyrocketing costs." The publisher also warns that candidates in the next council election will be too frightened of the associations to even discuss the problem, labeling the "unions" the "third rail of Beverly Hills politics."

What makes this even more fascinating is that here I am an unreconstructed liberal Democrat coming to the defense of the providers of law and order from wounds inflicted by a very conservative right wing Republican – only in Beverly Hills.

The late, great former **Mayor George Slaff**, who was also president of the Foundation of the American Civil Liberties Union and who was a cheer leader for the community gen-

darmes, said once, in jest: "The people of Beverly Hills are militant supporters of civil liberties – for all the people of Pasadena."

No, we do really support civil rights and civil liberties and our police are sensitive to those standards and are better protectors because we also give them the backing they need. It's all interrelated, but think of it this way:

Show police respect and support and they will be better at serving and protecting.

Candidates aren't really frightened of the associations and many have run and won without their backing. The same can be said of newspaper endorsements.

However, Smith has touched a nerve and it needs a response. In the mix of cost studies, other factors need consideration. Could we in fairness change the rules under which men and women have served and planned their lives and careers? Isn't there a difference between asking people to risk their lives and serving in some business where the only danger is a Wall Street tumble? And most important, how do the benefits we give compare with those of other cities? Can we remain competitive in recruiting the best unless we have attractive job incentives?

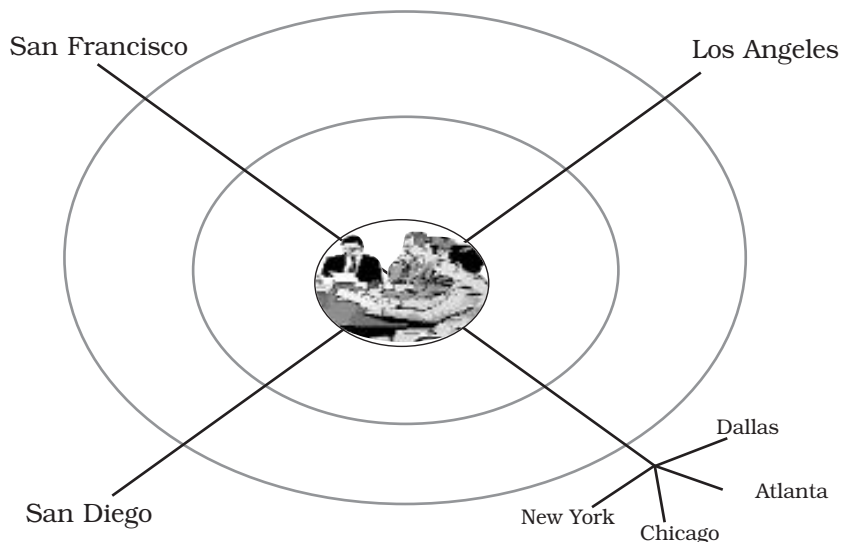
Smith's editorial should not be ignored, even by some on the council and the community who are equally worried about association and newspaper support. He deserves a full discussion. I do appreciate Smith's militant support for Israel, he's even more outspoken than the right wing Likud.

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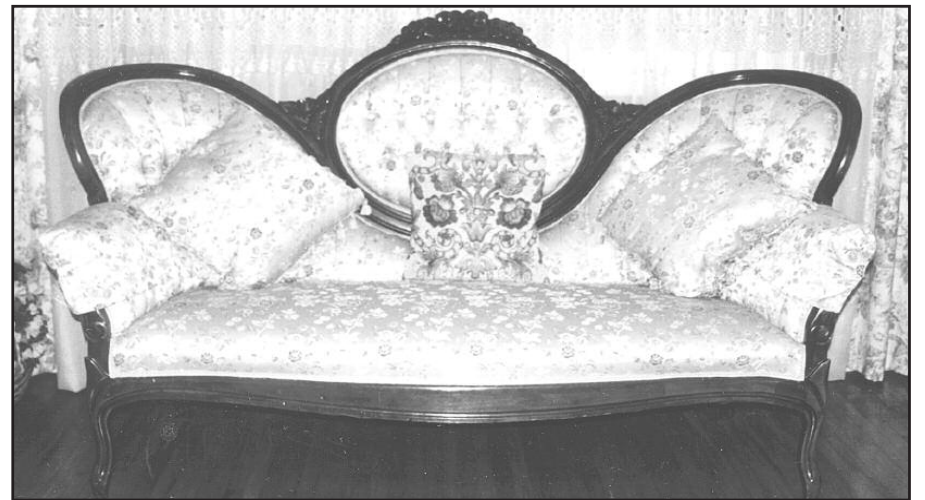

the council on proposals to adopt more stringent rules on ethics, that I thought I too would give it one more shot.

What is really behind the "ethics" rules movement is concern about the role of former councilmembers, who are all former mayors, in representing clients before the city council.

Should an ex-mayor jump from the council chair to the microphone minutes after giving up his seat? Probably not. But will an ordinance solve the problem, not exactly. It is impossible to legislate the kinds of controls that would make the process completely hands-off and unfortunately, it would most likely inhibit the more honest and not those who would find the means of circumventing the rules.

Not every ill can be corrected by passing laws and it might be well to remember Jefferson's admonition, "that government is best that governs the least."

We, as a society, have ambivalent feelings about government. Ask the average American what nation has the best system of government, and the immediate answer is almost always, "ours." In the same breath, ask the next question: "What do you think of politicians" and the usual answer is "they are all crooks."

Well, the men and women who have and do serve us have had an incredible record of never once being charged with any malfeasance while in office. Never in our history. In fact, the strongest ethics rules are those adopted by the Congress, and we know how effective that has been.

Most of those who enter elective service are, and this opinion may shock, dedicated to making their world a better place. Yes, some cave in to special interests, some forget their ideals, but there are more people with integrity in political life than any profession I can think of.

Back to Beverly Hills. I can not say I would oppose any and all proposals for an ethics ordinance. In fact, a preemptive rule that candidates would accept before election might even make more sense: They would agree not to become legislative advocates for two years after leaving the council.

Unfortunately, one of the most admired former mayors has set all this in motion by coming back too quickly to talk to his colleagues. The perception and the impact on city staff is too pervasive.

On the other hand, one of the strongest advocates of an ethics ordinance, and a person with whom I often disagree but admire, once had his own taste of a smear because he had a very minor role with a developer while he was mayor! You should have heard what the then anti-council forces said about him.

We lost two long-time residents and valued members of our community last week: **David Simmons** and **Philip Marantz**. David, an aircraft company executive, shared with wife **Barbara** a years long dedication to community service. Phil was one of the first presidents of the Maple Counseling Center and a partner in a Beverly Hills law firm, Freshman, Marantz, Comsky and Deutch. I had the pleasure of serving with Barbara on the Greystone Foundation, she was one of the original mem-

bers and Phil was the first person to introduce me to **Richard Stone**, about to launch a campaign for city council.

Historic note, and a test of my acumen. When the three partners of the yet to be formed Freshman firm had lunch with me to seek advice on joining forces, I told the recent law school graduates it would be a very bad idea. Seek jobs in established firms and much later go into business for yourself, I opined. Fortunately for Sam, Dave and Phil, they didn't listen and started one of the most successful firms in our city. Incidentally, Sam's third edition on real estate syndication has just been published. It is considered the bible of the field.

Two strong and effective women leaders will be honored next Wednesday by "Women of Sheba" the "Friends of Sheba Medical Center" support group at the Four Seasons.

Sue Brucker, wife, and Rita Brucker, mother of Councilmember Barry Brucker, have outstanding credits of community service quite independent of their elected official relation.

Normans Open Football Season With Victory

BHHS Squad Set To Play at Palos Verdes Friday

Beverly Hills High School began what could well be one of the most challenging of its 80 football seasons with a 34-20 victory at Long Beach Cabrillo in a nonleague game Friday night.

Ramon Judkins ran for 167 yards and four touchdowns on 21 carries and Darrian Richardson caught a 33-yard pass from Meyer Linter for the other score for the Normans, who led 34-6 in the fourth quarter.

"I thought it was one of our best opening games since I've been here in terms of discipline [and organization]," said Carter Paysinger, Beverly Hills' coach since 1990 and a Norman assistant from 1980-89. "I was impressed our ability to execute with such precision, considering our practice circumstances."

Linter completed 10 of 13 passes for 137

yards and the one touchdown. "I thought that Meyer Linter ran the offense really well," Paysinger said. "His leadership is invaluable."

Judkins and Gerald McGee, who ran for 52 yards on 10 carries, ran "extremely hard and played very, very well," Paysinger said. The first touchdown Beverly Hills allowed came after an unsuccessful fake punt in the first quarter, while the other two were in the fourth quarter when the outcome of the game was not in doubt.

"Defensively we played extremely well," Paysinger said.

Norman defensive lineman Brandon Kim and linebackers Sae Bin Park and Benji Rosen drew praise from Paysinger for their play.

The victory extended Beverly Hills' regular-season undefeated streak to 11 games,

its longest streak since a 16-game winning streak from 1995-97.

The Normans have a 9-5-2 on-field record in their openers since Paysinger became coach. Beverly Hills was credited with a forfeit victory in its 2001 opener after an on-field loss at South Torrance, which used an ineligible player.

The Normans have qualified for the Southern Section playoffs seven of the previous eight seasons they have won their opener under Paysinger. The only year the trend did not hold was in 2000.

Because of the installation of an artificial turf surface at Nickoll Field, Beverly Hills won't be able to practice on campus until around Oct. 15 and are expected to play only one regular-season home game, Paysinger said.

None of the Normans' practices this season were on a lined field, denying them the opportunity to work on their spacing. Friday's opener was originally scheduled for Nickoll Field. Sites for an Oct. 6 game against Pasadena Blair and the Oct. 13 Ocean League opener against Hawthorne, which were to have been played at Nickoll Field, have not been set.

What's Next?

Beverly Hills is scheduled to play a nonleague game at Palos Verdes Friday. The opening kickoff is scheduled for 4 p.m.

The Sea Kings were 6-5 in 2005, finishing second in the Pioneer League, losing in the first round of the Southern Section Division X playoffs.

"We think we have an advantage with our

speed," Norman coach Carter Paysinger said. "We want to go in and establish the tempo of the game. [If] they're able to slow the game and run the ball inside the tackles and keep our speed off the field, then it could be a long afternoon for us. Our game plan is to speed the tempo up to get as many offensive plays off as we can and to give our guys with speed to make plays."

Palos Verdes coach Pat Fresch said Beverly Hills is "probably a little faster than us."

"In past years we've struggled with that, so it is a little bit of a challenge for us this week," Fresch said.

The Sea Kings utilize a "fairly balanced" pro-style offense, with lots of drop back passes and 4-4 defense, according to Fresch.

Palos Verdes quarterback Andrew Trudnowski is beginning his third season as a starter and has drawn recruiting interest from California, Washington State, Fresno State and San Diego State, Fresch said.

His receiving targets include Stephen Peres, listed at 6 feet 4 inches, and Ryal Jagd, listed at 6 foot 3 inches.

When asked if Beverly Hills had an advantage because it has played a game this season and his team hasn't, Fresch said, "Some ways yes, some ways no."

"It gave me an opportunity to scout them," Fresch said. "The other side of the coin is that they've got their feet wet and they've gone through the whole game package, so they have a little bit of an experience edge on that."

Paysinger said he thought playing a game gave his team an advantage.

"In practices and scrimmages, you control the situation," Paysinger said. "In regular games, you don't. It gives you a better opportunity of what your guys can do. We have a better idea of what are strengths and weaknesses and a better idea than they have of themselves.

The Normans scheduled a Week 0 game because of the difficulty of scheduling a Saturday game during Week 3 to avoid complications caused by Rosh Hashana, the Jewish new year, which this year falls on a Friday, Sept. 22, when high school football games are traditionally played, Paysinger said.

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

LEGACY MIXED USE PROJECT APPROVED

City Council Overturns Planning Commission's Decision

Just before midnight on Tuesday, the Beverly Hills City Council voted unanimously to overturn the Planning commission's decision not to allow the mixed use project at 9200 Wilshire Boulevard.

"There comes a time when you just have to say let's try it, let's do it," Councilmember Linda Briskman said.

There was a strong division in opinions about the project from neighbors on the north and south areas of Wilshire. More than 30 people signed up to speak both for and against Legacy Partners proposed land use. Some of the supporters of the project included former Beverly Hills Mayor Les Bronte.

South Maple Drive resident Anitra Eskovitz, told the council, "You really need to be responsible to the southside neighborhood, and I have to tell you, Legacy is responsible."

Eskovitz who described herself as usually being anti-development had been opposed to the lands prior approved use as a luxury hotel. "That aura and glitz are what is needed in that neighborhood is really insulting to the developer and the neighborhood. What we need in our neighborhood is control and calm. The prior hotel that was approved disgracefully would have given us chaos and traffic."

Another resident who strongly supported the Legacy project was Mark Babst, a resident of 300 block of South Palm Drive said that Legacy had approached him and his neighbors to get their opinions.

"This is a wonderful project. It is the right size. In the right space and a wonderful project for this community. It is an asset to the community only if it is built upon and turned into something," Babst said. "They (The Legacy Partners) seem to have more concern for our quality of life than does the Planning Commission."

Although there were residents who spoke out against the Legacy project and a 234 local resident signature petition was submitted to the council, Mayor Steve Webb said it was the strong community support by the most affected areas that impressed the council. "You have a circumstance where neighbors who more often than not oppose development are supporting this," Webb said.

Webb was quick to point out that the decision has not approved the entire project. It has only approved the mixed use concept for the land.

Instead of optioning to send the remaining issues involving the project back to the Planning Commission for a decision, Webb said the council has decided to set a special public meeting and to discuss the loose ends such as the height, density, parking and loading zone locations.

"Once we've defined the project, then we can take a look at the development agreement," Webb said.

The time and date for the meeting have yet to be determined.

The reason the city has chosen to keep the decision about these details in their own hands rather than turning it back to the Planning Commission, according to Webb is because he felt it would be unfair to both sides.

"With respect to the Planning Commission's decision it's unfortunate and unfair to unnecessarily criticize them," Webb said.

Although the council overruled the Planning Commission's earlier decision, Webb said that Tuesday's meeting was the

first time that the city council had addressed the issue of mixed use properties in that area.

Webb said that some of the planning committees opposition may have come from having a residential project in an area that had traditionally been commercial.

"Nobody has been able to come forward and build on that site," Webb said. "If in fact it was meant to be commercial only, nobody has said so."

In her presentation, Planning Commission Chairperson Stacy Marks admitted that the Planning Commission had expressed hope that a more lucrative interest would come up

such as a talent agency or a film company.

In response to this, Briskman pointed out that the lot has been vacant for the last 17 years and any film companies or talent agencies that could be interested in the site have had plenty of time to take an action.

Marks pointed out that after extensive research, the commission felt that residential space would not be able to offer the same revenue to the city as commercial space would.

This could mean up to \$78,000 less in the first year of revenue than an office building might bring in. This is something that Legacy Partners would have to compensate for.

Neighbors voiced opinions that maximizing the lot would help to destroy the commu-

nity while others felt that the mixed use was a good idea to encourage community growth.

Speaking as residents of the area, City Treasurer Eliot Finkel and Planning Commissioner Shahram Melamed both voiced opposition toward the project.

Melamed had abstained from voting on the project because of his proximity to it, but said he strongly opposed the mixed use.

In her presentation, Marks pointed out that the mixed use wouldn't exactly be cutting down on traffic. "Will the restaurant busers be living in those condominiums?" she asked. "Is that the type of housing we

want?"

Finkel and Melamed named two of the main concerns about the project that most of the other opposing residents voiced. The increase in traffic it may cause and the proposed height, which at 60 feet is 15 feet higher than the city's 45 foot height restriction.

In response to this, Briskman pointed out that the city building height restrictions had been mandated several decades ago and may no longer reflect the current needs.

This issue is not new to the city. The property, which has sat vacant for 17 years has changed ownership several times over the past few years.

In December of 2001, the council had approved a 133 room luxury hotel "The Bell Jardin," to be built, but the building never met code and the financing later fell through forcing the owner to declare bankruptcy. Ellas Properties purchased the lot in August 2003 and then in November of 2004, the Legacy Project submitted the application to build.

The hotel, which was greatly opposed by neighbors was one of the examples Dale Goldsmith, the attorney for Legacy Partners used to support the 60 foot height.

Goldsmith said the heights measured of existing buildings in surrounding areas of compatible height. Even a number of commercial that exceed the height. The proposed hotel which had been approved in the past was in excess of the 60 foot height on the corners.

The building planning takes setbacks along Palm and Maple which would not be required if a commercial project was undertaken.

One of the other concerns Marks expressed was that this is the first time the committee had looked a project that is vertically fully integrated all into one.

Goldsmith pointed out that mixed use is neighborhoodly compatible. He said the height translates to intensity benefit of better quality retail and height of restaurants.

"Ultimately the site is going to be developed," Goldsmith said. "It's not an issue of preferring an empty lot to a 60 foot building. It's about balancing all of the needs of the community and being the least negatively impact."

Members of the legacy partners could not be reached for comment, but speaking on behalf of them, Goldsmith said, "It's an absolutely essential step and one we're pleased the council has made," Goldsmith said. "It was a threshold consideration. The council taking a bigger picture and broader view balancing community issues."

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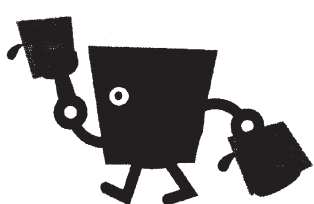
