## Friends Remember Daniel Levian

### Resident killed in Beverly Hills car accident; brother in hospital

Beverly Hills resident Daniel Levian, 25, died in a single-car crash only a few feet from his home on North Hillcrest Drive on Saturday night, just days before his 26th birthday.

The driver of vehicle, Sam Moghimi, 31, suffered injuries and was arrested on suspicion of vehicular manslaughter while intoxicated, according to Beverly Hills Police.

Daniel's brother and fellow passenger Korosh Levian is in critical but stable condition.

Alcohol was a factor in causing the wreck, police spokesperson Lt. Tony Lee said.

The afternoon before the accident, Levian was at a pool party at a friend's house, thrown in honor of Levian's upcoming birthday, according to a family spokesperson. Levian had arrived at the party

in a taxi, with the intention of taking a taxi home as well.

Reportedly, as the party wound down Moghimi offered to drive Levian, his brother Korosh "Kro" Levian back to their home on North Hillcrest Drive. Moghimi had allegedly been drinking at the party.

The brothers accepted the ride offer. Daniel Levian sat in the back seat of the car.

As they turned onto North Hillcrest Drive, Moghimi hit a mailbox and then crashed into a solid brick wall, said the family spokesperson.

Levian's mother and father heard a loud "boom" and rushed outside to find the crushed car, according to

Daniel's cousin Alex Levian.

Paramedics arrived at the scene at 8:25 p.m. to find the lone car at the crash site and pronounced Daniel Levian dead at the scene at



8:30 p.m.

Levian died of "multiple blunt force injuries," according to the autopsy report as reported by the Los Angeles Times. Daniel's brother, Korosh Levian, was taken to Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in critical condition. A day later, he was considered "responsive," according to the family spokesperson. Korosh Levian is still at the hospital.

"[Daniel] was such a positive person. He always called to make sure everyone was alright," said Alex Levian.

One of her favorite memories of Daniel was made in the days leading up to her recent graduation from UCLA.

"He called me every day to count down the days. He told me he couldn't wait to celebrate with me," said Alex Levian. "He was like my brother. He always wanted everyone to be happy. Even the day that [he died], at the party he was giving me hugs to make sure I was alright."

Many others have similar memories of

Daniel.

Almost immediately after the accident, two Facebook Web pages went up in honor of Daniel's memory. Almost 70 of his friends and peers had commented on the page, with fond memories, prayers and wishes for the family. He was remembered as an "amazing person" and expressed shock and grief at his death.

Daniel Levian's funeral was held Tuesday at Eden Memorial Park in Mission Hills. All attendees were asked not to wear black, "to keep his spirit alive," said a family spokesperson.

A prayer service was to be held for Korosh Levian last night at the Iranian American Jewish Center in West Hollywood.

There is an on-going blood drive for Korosh Levian being held at Cedars-Sinai Hospital (8700 Beverly Blvd., Los Angeles) in the South Tower on Street 4 in the Blood Donor Facility. Those wishing to donate should call (310) 423-5346 and make an appointment, according to project organizer Talia Amiri.

## Police Shoot One, Capture Pair After Attempted Robbery at Lawry's Restaurant

An attempted robbery at Lawry's Beverly Hills restaurant ended in the shooting of one of two gunmen wanted for a series of robberies who were then captured by the Los Angeles Police in the early morning of July 11 at the intersection of San Vicente and Fairfax boulevards.

Selton Kyles Bradford and Floyd Nelson, who were both armed with handguns, entered Lawry's Prime Rib restaurant on La Cienega Boulevard and allegedly held up the chef at gunpoint, according to several news sources. They then took off in a pick-up truck toward Miracle Mile.

The suspects had been under surveillance by both the Beverly Hills Police Department and the Los Angeles Police Department for some time. The LAPD had been watching the men at the time of the robbery.

The LAPD attempted to pull over the fleeing suspects' car. Then Bradford pointed a handgun at one of the officers and the officers fired one round and hit Bradford in the left arm at 6 a.m., according to police reports. Both men were then arrested. Bradford was taken to a hospital for care. No officers were injured.

"These were brazen robberies committed by very dangerous criminals," said Lt. Tony Lee, spokesman for the BHPD. "We feel fortunate that none of the Lawry's employees were injured. LAPD's extensive investigation paid off as they captured some prolific robbers."

Bradford was arrested for attempted murder of a police officer; Nelson was arrested for possession of a firearm by an ex-felon. Both were charged with conspiracy to commit a crime and second degree robbery. Nelson was arraigned on July 15 and Bradford was arraigned on July 16 in the Los Angeles County Courthouse, according to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

## State Board of Education Mandates Algebra 1 For All Eighth Graders

All eighth graders in California will now be expected to take an Algebra 1 test after the California State Board of Education adopted Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger's proposal last week.

Within the next three years, all California eighth graders will be tested and assessed in Algebra 1, which has been set as the eighth-grade math standard statewide with this new mandate effectively making algebra an expected course in the grade's curriculum.

The Algebra 1 end-of-course exam is now the sole test of record for federal accountability purposes under the No Child Left Behind Act for eighth grade mathematics, as a result of the State Education Agency directing the State Board of Education and California Department of Education staff to work with the U.S. Department of Education (USDOE) to develop an compliance agreement.

"I don't know [the new mandate] will benefit all the children. Some may be forced into algebra before they are ready. But Beverly Hills won't be affected by this like other cities in the state. We've been focusing on algebra already in the classrooms with our mathematics initiative," said BHUSD Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Brian Tash. "We didn't [focus on math in elementary schools] because the state forced us, we did it because we knew the kids could be better prepared. The state is just giving us greater urgency."

While Algebra 1 has been a state-recommended course for eighth graders, in 2007 only slightly less than half of eighth graders statewide took Algebra 1, according to EdSource.com, an independent Web site the covers

California education.

California now has the highest math standard for eighth grade in the country. Before this mandate, districts and schools could place students in General Math, regular Algebra I, or a slower-paced, Algebra I course spanned over two years. Depending on the math course, students either take the Algebra I or the General Math California Standards Test (CST) at the end of the year, according to Tash.

The Fire Department has elected the Friends of Beverly Hills CPR group. The BHPD chose the Marvin D. Iannone Foundation, earmarked for the care of Emily Cornelius, the daughter of

Sgt. Brad Cornelius. Emily was in a near-fatal traffic accident last month and is currently in a coma.

In addition to the monetary awards, a plaque will be presented to each honoree.

"The Beverly Hills Masonic Lodge existed since 1923. We feel a need to be close to the city and provide services to the city. We recognize the police and fire departments are necessary and welcome their assistance to the community. We want to be part of that," said Berry Griffin, worshipful master of the Masonic Lodge.

## Beverly Hills Tops County Chart for Increased Property Value

Beverly Hills had the highest percentage increase of assessed value last year in Los Angeles County, according to the Los Angeles County Assessor's Annual Report for 2008.

Beverly Hills saw an increase of 11.8 percent in the assessed valuations performed by the county assessor, putting the city at an approximate \$2.1 billion new value.

The money associated with transfer of real property was the largest reason for the property value increase, said LA County Assessor's Director of Administrative and Roll Service Gil Parisi. Of the \$2.1 billion total, \$1.7 billion came from transfer of properties in Beverly Hills last year.

Over 25 percent of that came from the transfer of ownership at the 9900 Wilshire site, which was valued at \$500 million when it was sold in April 2007, according to Parisi.

The money tied to new construction in Beverly Hills, which totaled \$108 million, was the second largest value driving the increase.

"The city continues to experience high valued residential transfers with an active luxury construction market for both new homes and renovations," the report states.

Los Angeles County's property values increased as a

whole by 6.9 percent.

Despite its increased valuation, Beverly Hills ranked eighth in assessed valuations within the county. The total assessment, a composite of the 9,895 real property parcels and business property assessments in the city, was \$14.266 billion.

## Council Authorizes 'Stage A' Voluntary Emergency Water Conservation

In a unanimous vote, the Beverly Hills City Council approved putting the city on a Stage A alert for voluntary water conservation.

"We're not asking for a huge sacrifice," said Councilmember Linda Briskman. "We're just asking people to be responsible."

The Stage A level of water conservation is a voluntary alert stage in which residents are asked to conserve 5 percent of their water use. It will not affect water bills.

Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger recently declared a drought in Southern California and the city's main water supplier Metropolitan Water District is working with a



decreased water supply from the State Water Project. As a result, members (like Beverly Hills) and cities are being asked to conserve.

Some ways to conserve include turning off the faucet when brushing teeth, watering landscapes after dusk and avoiding hosing down sidewalks or streets.

The city will fix any water leaks or problems and the city will also request that restaurants only serve water to patrons who ask for it.

"The governor and the Metropolitan Water District have asked local communities to make conservation a priority to avoid water rations next summer," said Mayor Barry Brucker. "It is our responsibility to monitor the City's facilities and operations, as well as encourage our entire community to play their part. I am proud that last year the City of Beverly Hills used 8 percent less water and we are asking the community to be aware of their water use and step up their efforts to conserve," he continued.

As part of the request for conservation, the City has created an advertising campaign, "Think Outside the Sink" to educate residents, businesses and visitors on the small steps they can take to achieve a 5 percent reduction in water use. Campaign elements include newspaper ads, signage in public restrooms and at fountains, banners and school book covers.

#### Kids Get Lesson in Wildlife at Greystone

#### Maple Center Starts Farsi-Speaking Therapy Group

The Maple Counseling Center is creating a weekly therapy group for Farsi-speaking Iranian men and women.

Titled "Men and women's interpersonal therapy group," the series aims to create a safe and confident space for people to discuss emotions and receive feedback from their peers.

"Because we're just getting started, we are leaving [the focus] open. As we move forward, we will see what the needs are and channel the group appropriately. As of now, it will most likely deal with rela-

tional and interpersonal difficulties as well as acculturation difficulties," said Yassi Zaminsefat, one of the trained facilitators coordinating the group.

Zaminsefat and co-facilitator Delaram (Delly) Enayatima are both Farsi-speaking Iranians, who were born in Iran and grew up in the U.S. The pair plan to encourage attendees to identify how the past influences the present and then learn to develop coping strategies and new ways to interact with others.

The group will be held from 6:15 to 7:45 p.m. on Thursdays at the lower level of the Maple Center, 9107 Wilshire. It will begin once three people are confirmed to attend the sessions. Sessions cost \$30 each, but a sliding scale is available to those who need it.

Anyone wishing to join the group needs to call the Maple Center and speak with one of the facilitators before joining.

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## Are Hilton Opponents Really For A Vote

Other assorted, sordid subjects

It might be safe to call it hypocritical. Some, but not all, of those who demanded that the "people have a right to decide" the fate of the Hilton Revitalization Plan, marched on city hall earlier this month to now demand that there NOT be an election.

As you know, opponents of the Hilton development proposal, which includes a Waldorf=Astoria addition and condominiums, obtained sufficient signatures to force a referendum which would reverse a council majority approval.

What argument did opponents most often use when soliciting signatures: "This will only make sure the people have a chance to vote on the project."

Yes, some people signed because they opposed the project, but most probably thought it was a good idea to have an election.

The council had some options. It could

place the issue on the ballot or it could rescind its vote and, in effect, kill the Hilton plan. Yes, I thought some compromise could be reached, the plans for the condos modified, the Waldorf=Astoria saved and a costly, divisive referendum avoided. Turns out that was not legally possible. The referendum, once it qualified, prevented any and all of the elements of the plan from going forward without an election.

However, to now find some proponents of the "let the people vote" campaign demand the council reverse itself and not hold an election has to be an historical turnaround seldom heard even in our often contentious community. They now argued for what they said they didn't want: A council decision.

I congratulated the supporters of the referendum for successfully obtaining sufficient signatures to force an election. They

apparently used volunteers and not paid circulators, but that was how the system is supposed to work. **Hiram Johnson**, the state's populist governor and United States Senator, the author of the initiative and referendum for state, county and city governments, wanted to assure the right of the electorate to overturn almost any and all elected officials actions or lack of it. He never envisioned that special interests would hire paid petition circulators to put measures on the ballot.

Which brings us to the merits of the referendum. It is now up to the proponents and opponents of the Hilton to convince the voters. Because the council opted to place the referendum on the November general election ballot, more people will actually decide the Hilton's fate than voted on Montage – and that's in the public interest.

But there is something very new to consider: As political junkie **James Carville** once explained during the first **Bill Clinton** presidential campaign: "It's the economy, stupid."

The downturn in business will inevitably impact city tax revenues. What the Hilton can and should very carefully explain is the amount of money the city will receive immediately from initial pro-

cessing fees as well as continuing revenues from the transit occupancy (bed tax) and other tax benefits. The sums are enormous and could well prevent major cuts in basic city services.

You, as residents and business people, have a major stake in this election. Your vote could make sure we continue to have the best in police, fire, paramedic and other fundamental services we have come to expect as well as fulfilling our commitment to the historical Joint Powers Agreement, school funding grants.

It would be totally irresponsible to defeat the Hilton plan and not accept responsibility for not having sufficient tax dollars to keep our city safe. The validity of that argument should be the deciding factor in the vote.

According to the city's very conservative estimates, the construction phase alone will bring \$19,553,000.00 to our treasury! Later taxes and fees are also staggering amounts.

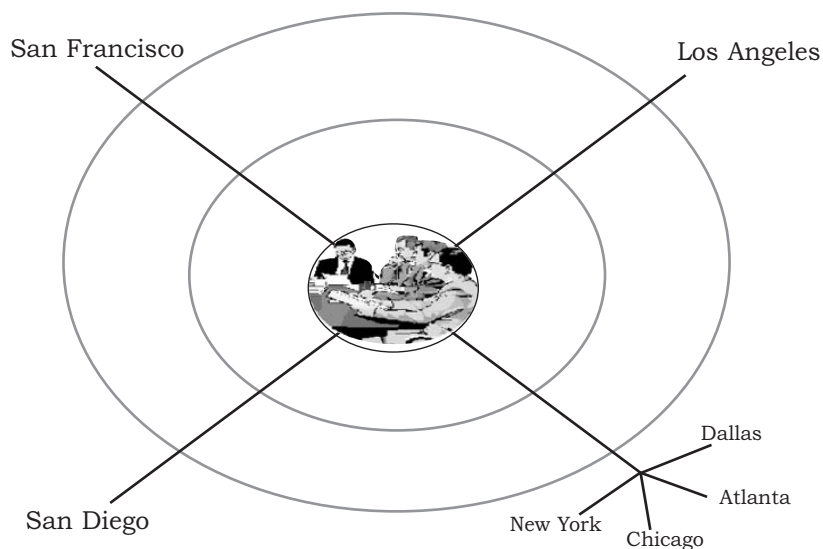
But what about cumulative impacts, height limits and traffic generation? First, a vote against the Hilton has absolutely nothing to do with any other council action including approval of other projects. A "NO" vote on Hilton will not turn back or stop any other development and, not even by the furthest stretch of political double talk will it reverse any other development or set precedents for future planned projects.

The height allowances are not being approved for some intrusive, residential abutting development. The Hilton is our

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most isolated existing major hotel. (Only the Montage is as far from residential). The Beverly Wilshire and even the Peninsula are very close to residential. As for the Beverly Hills, it is entirely surrounded by and, mostly, in harmony with some of our most expensive homes.

Hotels occupants do not create traffic, that comes from banquets, restaurants and other uses. As for condos, they are the least traffic generators of any possible use. The proposed Waldorf=Astoria has no major public assembly uses, none.

Actually, the Hilton today has far less traffic generators than it had in the past under different owners. Early, during the **Conrad Hilton** era, the hotel had a fine dining room on the roof, a major night club on the first floor, two restaurants and a cocktail lounge on the ground floor and, of course, the world famous and highly successful **Trader Vic's** where the Waldorf=Astoria would be built, and a lobby bar. Today, there is a cocktail serving area on the first floor, one restaurant and a cocktail lounge on the ground floor and no night clubs or dining on the roof. (Yes, history buffs will remind me that the roof restaurant was also, for a time, an active night club, dance floor.)

Are there legitimate concerns on construction impacts? Of course, but those are very temporary and require us to examine whether the Hilton is a responsible corporate citizen.

This sense of being responsible does and should matter. **Beny Alagem** has been a model corporate citizen and the Hilton a good civic partner. Beginning with running a union shop that has first

rate worker relations and even winning awards from a very militant trade union to his undeniable sense of community responsibility and support of local charities, Hilton owner **Alagem** could be a role model for business leaders in our city.

He does have a vision for his project and it is exciting. The Waldorf=Astoria, he assures anyone who will listen, will be one of the leading hotels in the world. His and the hotel's record of community service should give us a sense of comfort on how they will approach construction – the record is all we have to rely on. Beny is not some outside speculator or developer – he has deep roots here.

Note to renters: As first pointed out here during the Montage and 9900 condo element discussions, construction of condos on commercial property lessens the likelihood of demolition of low-cost or affordable housing for conversions.

\*\*\*

It is time to go back to traditional practices on when city council and school boards meet. The council took on a heavy load of extra sessions during the 9900 and Hilton deliberations, and they deserve our thanks for the enormous time they gave. But to now change meeting dates so often to accommodate travel or vacation plans is not what has been the practice.

Council meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of the month. If a councilmember has a conflict, they can be excused, but this does not mean a constant shifting of meeting dates just to make sure that every member is present

for every meeting. This is unfair to citizens who want to speak or participate, city staff who also has to change night time plans. Only in recent years was there a shuffling of meeting dates.

Equally important is an end to conflicting meeting dates of the school board and city council. There is no excuse for holding them on the same Tuesday. The board should meet on the second and fourth Tuesday and not the same day as the council and the council should abide by its scheduled Tuesdays.

\*\*\*

Some interesting emails and phone calls on our comments about local retailers. As expected, most had to do with Rite Aid. I heard some new woes on service, but also some concern about losing what some people consider an important supplier of basics. Not to worry, no matter what appears here, the chain's people have told me the Beverly Hills shop is one of the biggest revenue producers in their company.

Simple solution: Change the name to Wrong Aid.

\*\*\*

We have had some great city managers who took over at exactly the right time in our city. The chaos and disorder ended when then Chief of Police **Ed Kreins** became city manager and restored a sense of professionalism and support for city employees. He defended and backed the troops when that was most needed. **Mark**

**Scott** was probably our most community sensitive city manager. He shared many city values, had strong aspirations of enlarging cultural resources and was carefully attuned to city support of police and civil liberties – a needed mix at the time.

As for our current city manager **Rod Wood**, he has a very different management style that has empowered senior staff to accept responsibility and take leadership personally, and he supports them totally. First, the guy is brilliant and is one of the most respected professionals in the field, especially outside our city.

Wood is smoothly dealing with one of the most contentious city councils we have had in many years. He stands firmly for what he believes, backs his people and will not give in to demands by special interests, even those with major political clout and influence. If any councilmember retreats from supporting Wood because they are under some special interest pressure, the voters will not respond with favor. Wood has the confidence of the community even when they disagree with his options. No, I don't always agree with Wood, but I never question his intentions, integrity or amazing intellectual skills.

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

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## BHHS Girls' Basketball Team Wins Tournament

### Comeback after sluggish start gives Normans title.

The Beverly High girls' basketball team won the Troy Tournament, defeating host Fullerton Troy 36-34 in Sunday's final, overcoming early 10-0 and 15-2 deficits.

The Normans took a late one-point lead when sophomore forward Morgan Mason grabbed an offensive rebound of a missed free throw and scored. Beverly Hills increased its lead to three when Mason made a fast break layup off a steal on the ensuing possession.

"For the last 25 minutes of the game we were excellent," said Normans coach Charles Solomon, whose team trailed 18-13 at halftime. "It is difficult to wonder why we start the games off so slow. If we start the games off well, we destroy teams. The good part is we have a special group of girls who never quit."

The Normans were 3-0 in pool play, beginning with a 58-43 victory over Villa Park Friday in a game they led 30-10 at halftime.

"I thought we played the best half of basketball that I've ever seen any team play," Solomon said. "It was flawless — running, defense, rebounding."

Beverly Hills routed Garden Grove, 77-36, Saturday. Later in the day, it defeated Huntington Beach, 48-43, in a game where it never led until there were two minutes to play.

"It was the first team that played us in a zone in a long time and they really gave us a lot of trouble and we had no answers," Solomon said.

The Normans were outscored, 16-3, to start the game, then rallied to cut the deficit to 19-11 at halftime.

In the second half, "we got comfortable, we started hitting the high post and then we kind of took over the game."

Solomon called sophomore guard Natalie Moy the catalyst to the victory by making two 3-point baskets, the second tying the score, 41-41.

In a game the Oilers' zone defense "really gave [Mason] problems," senior guard Sophie Payson also made two key 3-point baskets, sophomore center Chelsea Austin "had some nice plays in there" and senior guard Didi Younesi also had some key baskets and played well, Solomon said.

The Normans reached the semifinals of the 32-team tournament last month, losing to Los Angeles Washington.

#### Desert Resorts Classic

The Normans finished fifth in the 32-team tournament at Cathedral City High School June 20-22, defeating Glendale, 43-32, in a first-round game; San Diego Horizon, 65-21, in a championship bracket second-round game; losing to eventual champion Lynwood, 48-41, in a championship quarterfinal; then defeating Huntington Beach Marina, 48-26, in a fifth-place semifinal; and Rancho Cucamonga Los Osos, 46-40, in overtime in the fifth-place game.

"I thought we did a great job," Solomon said. "I was very proud of the girls' efforts playing in that kind of heat."

Younesi was named to the all-tournament team.

#### Redondo Union High School Girls Basketball Varsity Summer League

Beverly Hills defeated Burbank, 73-50, June 25, playing what Solomon described as its best offensive game of the summer, but giving up too many points.

The Normans defeated Torrance Bishop Montgomery, 54-39, June 23.

Mason and Payson drew praise from Solomon for their play.

#### Saugus Summer Shootout

A short-handed Norman team finished

fifth in the 16-team tournament at Saugus High School.

Beverly Hills, which had just six players, defeated Valencia, 54-47, in a first-round game June 27, overcoming a 10-point deficit with 10 minutes to play; lost to Oxnard, 48-41, in a championship quarterfinal game June 27, squandering a nine-point lead with five minutes to play, as they were outscored 17-1 to close the game; defeated Newhall Hart, 58-36, in a fifth-place semifinal June 28; and Sherman Oaks Notre Dame 58-43 in the fifth-place game June 29.

"I thought we played really well," Solomon said.

Mason, Payson and Austin drew praise for their play from Solomon.

## HOW ARE RISING GAS PRICES AFFECTING BEVERLY HILLS?

Residents, employees find new ways to commute

Beverly Green Drive resident Susie Roberts says she couldn't afford to drive her daughter to her summer job orientation almost 40 miles away in Malibu every day with gas prices at over \$4 a gallon. Her daughter wasn't receiving paychecks yet and the family was losing money in the deal. So, Susie Roberts did what any mother would do—kept her daughter home from work.

Mitchell Schwartz commutes from his home on South Swall Drive to Downtown every day. His wife, Jennifer Schwartz, is a pharmaceutical representative who travels to Orange County and San Diego on a weekly basis. Even though Jennifer's company compensates her for 38 cents every mile, the cost of gas is still starting to cut into their weekly budget, she said.

Beverly Vista teacher Mark Frenn drives 18 miles from South Pasadena to Beverly Hills. The cost of his tank of gas shot up by \$20 recently. With such a long commute and no viable public transportation system to get him from his home to work, Frenn says he simply has to continue driving the way he has been and absorb his rising gas bill. As a result, he's found himself cooking in more and eating out less.

These are only some of the people in Beverly Hills who are feeling the effects of rising gas costs. And like the others who share their struggle, it's sending them looking for better ways to get around. Some are looking to carpooling, others are going so far as to consider moving.

Beverly Hills gas prices are among the highest priced in Los Angeles County, which has some of the highest prices in the country despite the slip down by a few cents recently. In a survey of the four gas stations in Beverly Hills on July 11, the least expensive was \$4.49 for one gallon of regular gas the Exxon station on Robertson. The most expensive was \$4.79 for a gallon at the Mobil station on Wilshire.

"With the cost of gas at the end of June, I started to see things with a different eye," said Roberts.

She has made some lifestyle changes to help offset the \$100 price tag that comes on her full tank of gas.

"I'm a huge walker. If it's

close enough, I walk there. I've started meeting people at half-way points [when I drive]. And when I run errands, I don't run them one at time, I run them in a circuit," said Roberts.

Roberts considers herself lucky to live in Beverly Hills where everything she needs is close by. But some Beverly Hills workers live outside city limits and have looked to carpooling to help share the burden of the price of gas.

The City of Beverly Hills even offers to its employees a carpooling program that comes with added incentives. The city orchestrates the carpools for its employees and provides preferential parking with six total dedicated spaces in the Civic Center Parking Structure, which registered groups can use with a special permit.

Employees who use this rideshare method but cannot use their method to travel home due to an unexpected emergency or unanticipated overtime are eligible for a guaranteed ride home, on the city's tab. Employees are eligible for a reimbursable one-way taxi trip for up to 75 miles and 10 percent tip, up to four times a year.

"With the increase in gas prices, there has been more interest [among employees] in carpooling, public transit and other options," said Beverly Hills' Deputy Director of Transportation Aaron Kunz. "We're looking into ways to respond to that."

About 10 percent of city employees used either public transportation or carpool as their method of transportation to work, according to the most recent study survey conducted by the city in August 2007.

Public transportation is seeing record-high ridership, proving that some residents and workers are leaving their cars at home and 'going Metro.'

"As gas prices increased, so did our ridership," said Metropolitan Transportation Authority's General Manager for the Westside Central Service Sector Mark Maloney.

The three bus lines—the 20, 720 and 920— that travel through Beverly Hills on Wilshire Boulevard have the "heaviest ridership in the system," according to Maloney. However, bus ridership has gone down since last year, which Maloney attributed to a rise in fare prices.

But still, the cost for a bus ticket outweighed the cost of a full tank for Drew Brooks. Brooks, who works at a bank in Beverly Hills, calculated that paying \$1.25 for a bus ticket was better than the alternative when commuting ten miles to work from Sherman Oaks everyday.

"I have a car. But between gas prices and traffic, I'd rather take the bus. And you can read a book on the bus," said Brooks.

The Metro Rail Red Line subway saw an increase of 12.9 percent, with an average of 153,928 passengers on a weekday. The Red Line, the main rail corridor that connects all other lines and travels from Downtown Los Angeles to North Hollywood through Hollywood with a spur to Wilshire and Western nearest to Beverly Hills, makes up almost half the entire ridership on MTA's rail lines.

And if it's higher gas prices that are pushing people to public transit, then the high use of subway lines makes sense.

"Over time we've found that first-time discretionary riders their first step into transit is usually toward the rail and then they get used to the system and work themselves to getting familiar with the bus," said Maloney. So an increase in subway riders may lead to increases in future bus riders.

The MTA also offers a vanpool program that at least a handful of Beverly Hills workers take advantage of. One vanpool stops in Beverly Hills. The MTA has 640 vanpools in operation in the county.

Club Metro is the MTA's answer to a frequent rider card. People who carpool, walk, bike, or take public transportation to work at least eight days a month are eligible to join. Members receive a \$15 gift card to Starbucks Coffee or Best Buy upon enrollment. They are also entered into a one-time drawing for a \$100 gift card for the month first enrolled, followed by ongoing quarterly drawings for \$100 gift cards.

One hundred twenty six Beverly Hills residents take part in Club Metro, according to a spokesperson for the MTA.

Alternative transportation isn't the only way people in Beverly Hills are maneuvering around higher gas costs.

Some companies are beginning to reduce the amount of days employees must commute to work. Compressed work weeks are a form of decreasing driving and gas use.

Over 75 percent of City employees are on a compressed work week, confirmed Kunz.

The Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce also works on a 9/80 work week, in which employees work 80 hours within 9 days instead of 10.

For some people, prices are also beginning to affect where people choose to live or work.

Take for instance Kelly Kwan.

Kwan works at a human resource firm in Beverly Hills, but she travels an hour and half to work every morning from her condo in Long Beach where she lives with her boyfriend. Her employer recently gave her a raise to help ease the burden from her gas payments each week, but the mounting cost and painfully long commute are beginning to take their toll Kwan, who recently put out an ad looking for a carpool buddy.

"At some point, we might have to sell the condo and move or I might have to start looking for a new job," said Kwan, who lived in Santa Monica when she began her work at the firm three years ago but moved to Long Beach after rent was raised. The commute from the affordable condo in Long Beach is just too expensive, to her quality of life and her wallet, she says.

All in all, gas prices have just recently begun to shoot up and many people are finding themselves doing only having to change little things in order to adjust. But analysts predict prices could go as high as \$7 for a gallon in the next two years. And many people who now only have to make a few changes will really be hit hard and some forced to think twice about driving at all.

In a certain way, Mark Frenn finds hope in the spike in gas prices.

"I've found that there are fewer cars on the road. In the afternoons now, the freeways are flowing. So maybe that's the upside to the gas prices," said Frenn, half-heartedly joking. "But really, I hope it triggers our government into looking into alternative fuels. Maybe [higher gas prices] will make it clear that we've got to move toward alternative fuels."
