## “Goldman moves to strike Beverly Hilton’s lawsuit as SLAPP case” [Issue 494]

As residents of Beverly Hills and neighbors of Ken Goldman, both since 1981, we would like to add our voices to the chorus of those who have publically deplored the intimidation tactics of the Beverly Hilton.

Ken has been a tireless, volunteer community leader without peer in the efforts to preserve what is left of the gentle environment of Beverly Hills, while at the same time always acting as a statesman of the first order in advocating for the commercial and land development interests we all know must be part of the balance of a vital city. To underscore, Ken has donated his time and ability for decades now to benefit both business and residential interests.

In fact and with hindsight, it is hard not to wonder based on the Hilton’s behavior whether it purposely schemed to pre-empt Ken from using his considerable talents as a community spokesman. The Hilton’s flimsy lawsuit is a transparent attempt to threaten Ken and others so situated with financial punishment for exercising their First Amendment rights to petition the govern-

ment to protect their own family’s personal interests, and to advocate in the political sphere in favor of the community’s interests, too. Fortunately, the Legislature allows our courts to weed out without delay such obvious SLAPP lawsuits, which represent a further blight on our community.

Shame on the Hilton, which campaigned by arguing that the city could not afford to reject its massive project, ignoring the traffic gridlock that already grips the city. Now it wants others to pay for the cost of its slim victory at the polls.

## “Hilton Referendum”

Shortly before the November election, the Beverly Hilton, with a big publicity splash, ostensibly committed a sum in excess of three million dollars over 30 years to the Beverly Hills Education Foundation. There were some people who suggested that the commitment was nothing more than an election ploy to predispose voters in favor of the Hilton Project. The essence of the “commitment” of the Beverly Hilton (assuming Measure H passed) was that each condominium sold on the Hilton property would be charged a monthly fee of \$100.00 for thirty years. This meant if 90 condominiums were sold, BHEF would receive a total of \$9,000.00 per month from the condominium owners, for a total of \$108,000.00 annually during the 30-year period.

It has never been reported, nor has anyone stated, that the Hilton commitment was in writing, binding on the Hilton and any future owners of the real property, and irrevocable. In order to be binding and irrevocable, the commitment would have to have been in writing and recorded with the Los Angeles County Recorder. Has that been done? Does the commitment really exist? Samuel Goldwyn, in his own inimitable style, said it best: “A verbal contract isn’t worth the paper it’s written on.”

It would be interesting to know what the facts are.

## Former BH City Manager Mark Scott leaves S.C., returns to CA

Former Beverly Hills City Manager Mark Scott (1990-2003) announced last week he would be leaving his position at Spartanburg, S.C., where he has worked as city manager for the past six years since leaving Beverly Hills, to return to California.

Scott will begin his term as Culver City Manager in June.

"I loved being in South Carolina. On one hand, I am sad to leave this wonderful city, but very excited to be back on the west side working with people I grew up with. Culver City is an exciting place," said Scott in a phone interview Monday.

Scott's decision was largely based on his need to be closer to his family, who reside in Fresno.

Paysinger is currently Beverly High's athletic director, and has been head coach for BHHS football since 1991. Paysinger graduated from Beverly in 1974.

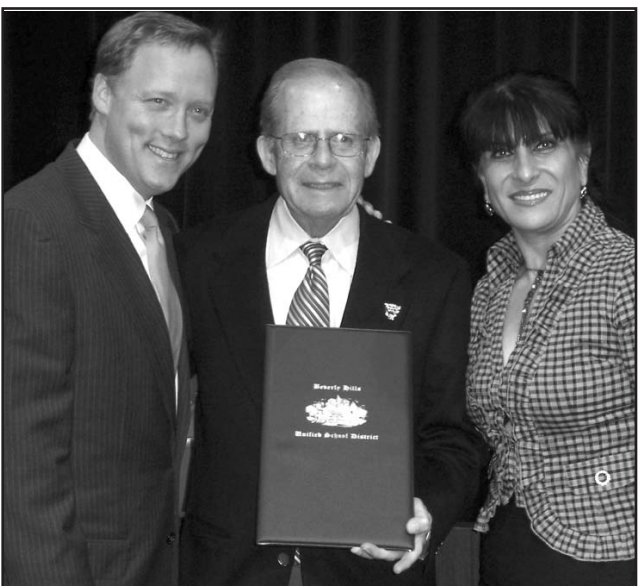
Tedford, a former Beverly English teacher, will return to Beverly Hills after a little under one year as assistant principal at Malibu Middle School.

## Highlights from Board of Education Meeting



Frank Fenton, former Board of Education member (1983-91) was recognized Tuesday evening. Fenton's son, Steven Fenton and Board President Nooshin Meshkaty presented Fenton with the award. He was joined by his wife, Judie Fenton (not pictured).

The board also unanimously approved recommendations from the Math Advisory Committee. This teacher-led and teacher-driven program addressed the low math scores in the past few years.

6th through 8th grades will be the most affected, through programs aimed to prepare students for high school level math and assist students in improving algebra.

"I'm very excited," said board member Dr. Brian Goldberg. "It's a great collaboration between site teachers and administration, and a model that we can follow. I appreciate the work of everyone involved. This is a good step forward in trying to address a specific problem."

The program will focus on two components. The first will be to tackle the math portion through problem solving and learning concept strategies. The other, would focus on teaching students different learning techniques and styles.

The recommendations also include support before and after school in some cases, and bringing all schools together for a consistent program.

## Baseball royalty coaches Little Leaguers

## Parking officers becoming more aggressive

Beverly Hills parking enforcement officers appear to have been working in high gear in 2008.

The number of citations handed out last year by Beverly Hills' parking enforcement increased by 19,000 over the year before, more than six times the amount citations increased from 2006 to 2007.

"As a member of the [Traffic and Parking] commission, we hear a lot of complaints about lack of enforcement in the residential areas with regard to time-limit violations. I think that what you see in the jump between '07 and '08 numbers also reflects our responsiveness to the residents concerns," Traffic and Parking Commission vice chair Kenneth Goldman told the Weekly.

According to Parking Enforcement reports, 158,089 citations were issued in 2008. Payments for those tickets raised an additional approximately \$700,000 for the city's general fund, pushing the total amount earned by parking citations to \$6.9 million for the 2007-2008 year.

Forty-seven percent of the total revenue comes from credit card operated parking meters, according to Traffic and Parking Commission meeting notes.

The city raised \$6.2 million in 2006/2007. In 2006, 136,236 citations were issued and in 2007, there were 139,656 handed out.

Last year, the most citations, at 27 percent of the total, were given for meter violations. The second highest numbers of citations was violations in permit zones, then overnight parking violations in third.

The city attributes the increase in citations to a push

toward "constant manning," according to city spokesperson Cheryl Burnett, and not as a tactic to raise additional revenue for the city.

The parking fine payments are currently part of the General Fund and have not contributed to the Parking Enterprise Fund.

As the Parking Enterprise Fund is currently in deficit, Beverly Hills City Council in December chose to subsidize the Parking Enterprise Fund and backfill those funds with adjustments to parking violations.

Those adjustments included increasing the cost of parking in a red zone or no stopping zone from \$70 to \$85; street cleaning from \$50 to \$60 and permit violations by \$10 to \$50. A staff report anticipated these changes will raise an additional \$700,000 for the city annually.

The cost of parking in a disabled parking space jumped by \$305; from \$45 to \$350. While parking in a white zone dropped from \$335 to \$45. The use of an invalid disabled placard costs you \$500.

Those increases now place Beverly Hills as one of the most expensive Westside cities to receive a parking ticket. Beverly Hills ticket prices now place above West Hollywood and Santa Monica (and with the exception of a few violations with which Beverly Hills ties, above Los Angeles as well).

On Feb. 17, the City Council adjusted parking fines again. This time, in response to an increase in State Court Fees of an additional \$3 assessed to the City based on the total number of citations that are paid.

According to a staff report presented by Director of Parking Operations Chad Lynn, "If the city does not amend the parking fines to account for these new expenses, sixty percent of the projected revenues generated by the rate adjustment in December 2008 will be used to pay these new fees."

The new fines are \$48 for meter violation, \$53 for permit violation, \$53 for overnight parking, \$48 for excess time limit, \$63 for street cleaning, \$88 for red zone, and \$88 in a no stopping zone.

## Libow Math Lab dedicated at BHHS



Local real estate agent and resident Michael Libow saw his name stamped on Beverly High's new Science and Technology Building when the Beverly Hills Education Foundation and the BHUSD dedicated the first floor room as the Michael Libow Math Lab last Wednesday.

A 1981 Beverly High graduate, and UCLA alum, Libow wanted his donation to "coordinate with my major in college," which was mathematics.

"Beverly Hills is a big part of my life; it's always very exciting to give back," said Libow.

## Board appoints new COC members for Measure E bond

The BHUSD Board of Education agreed to interview all

eight applicants for the Citizens Oversight Committee (COC), a volunteer community group to ensure bond expenditures are used properly, for the \$334 million general obligation bond, Measure E, passed in November last year.

The Board's original deadline for COC applications was extended after they received only three at the first cut-off. While they gained an additional five applications during the extension, the Board is still short for COC members.

A COC is typically made up of 11 members. If no other applicants come forward, it is likely the Board will ask current COC members if they'd care to stay on for another term.

Legally required under Prop.39, through which Measure E passed, the COC is made up of resident and BHUSD community members from different backgrounds, specified by the proposition.

The Measure E bond monies are earmarked for safety and security upgrades at the five district campuses.

#### Horace Mann Green Day at the Grove raises money

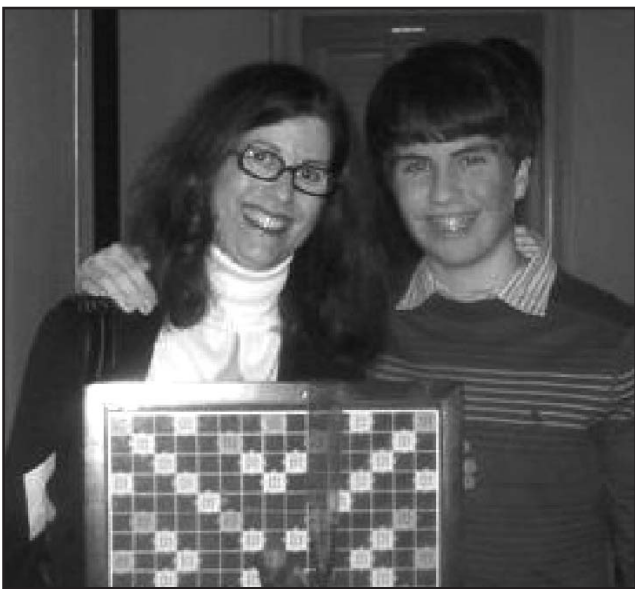

#### BookEnds brings in over \$50,000 for low-income schools

The Beverly Hills chapter of BookEnds, a nonprofit organization dedicated to fighting illiteracy and bringing books to underserved schools, raised \$52,000 at its Scrabble Challenge fundraiser earlier this month. Proceeds will enable BookEnds to place \$250,000 worth of gently used books on the shelves of Los Angeles

school libraries in need.

Co-organized by Patti Tanenbaum, wife of former Mayor Robert K Tanenbaum, the event brought in more than 100 people to play friendly games of Scrabble. The winner at the end of the night was Lauren Steiner and her son, Nick Steiner, whose names will go on the inside cover of all books donated from the event's proceeds.

"We sold out and so far have netted at least \$52,000. Who says people aren't supporting charities? I think our relatively reasonable price and the Scrabble idea worked especially well during these more upsetting times," said Tanenbaum in an interview.

#### Beverly Hills police take down popular BBQ truck

Kogi Korean BBQ received a citation from police last Wednesday afternoon while parked in front of Myspace headquarters on Maple Drive.

According to Lt. Tony Lee, several people called to complain, which forced police to take action.

"You know how new we are," founder Mark Manguera told the LA Times last week. "We didn't know that we needed 50 million more permits here than anywhere else." Then he added, "You know, Obama is in Beverly Hills today, so there's a huge police presence."

Manguera also stated he would file for all necessary permits and hopefully resume operating in the next 14 days.

The taco truck, which has been operating for the past month, was cited for not having an appropriate business permit for the city of Beverly Hills.

"We encourage them to come back to the city once all the necessary documents are taken care of," said Lee.

#### Alleged predator sentenced to almost 4 years in prison

Javier Arturo Guzman was sentenced to three years and eight months in state prison after pleading guilty to charges of annoying a child and possessing child pornography on Thursday, according to Beverly Hills police.

"Once we get information about any possible criminal activity, we are extremely aggressive in detective follow-up," said Lt. Tony Lee.

In October and November of 2008, a male Hispanic driving a white pick-up truck was observed photographing students at Beverly Vista School. Beverly Hills Police Detectives conducted a detailed investigation that led to the arrest of Guzman, 40, of Venice.

On March 19, Guzman pled guilty to both charges at the Criminal Courts Building, Department 31 before the Honorable Judge James Bianco.

"We apprehended this man before he could commit an atrocious crime," said Lee. "It is a testament to the good work of our officers."

Guzman remains in custody and has now begun serving his sentence in state prison.



#### A Quiet Hero

Derek Cope, a seven year employee of the Beverly Hills Fire Department was recognized by the American Legion Monday.

Both the Beverly Hills Fire Department and Police Department attended the dinner awards ceremony held in Pacific Palisades.

Derek saved three people from possible drowning while on vacation with his wife and two children last year. According to Mark Embry, Deputy Fire Chief, the incident only came to his attention through a friend of Derek's to whom he told the story.

Other notes of moderate value

Former Beverly Hills City Manager **Mark Scott**, who left in 2003 to take a similar job in Spartanburg, South Carolina, will return to Southern California soon to become City Manager of Culver City, according to our sources.

The official press release from the City of Spartanburg said Scott was resigning to “return to Beverly Hills” to be closer to his family. Well, not exactly; that would indeed come as a shock to City Manager **Rod Wood**. Scott does have family in Southern California, but unlike Wood, who does make Beverly Hills his home, Scott never actually lived in Beverly Hills: he and his family lived in Glendale.

Although there was no mention of the Culver City job in the Spartanburg release, our Culver City sources indicate it is a done deal.

Side benefit: If Scott does return to our area, he will join Wood on the western region council of city governments which is an association of elected and appointed

officials representing west Los Angeles cities.

What began as an exciting addition to our city, the 9900 Wilshire Boulevard condominiums with some commercial elements, was one of the first victims of the world-wide economic melt down, and no amount of recovery in the financial markets is likely to make the visions of the British owners a reality anytime soon.

The young developers, the Candy brothers, who had a remarkable success record including a world-class housing project in London, and who did everything right in assembling an outstanding team of architects, landscape artists and construction firms, first debacle was the failure of their lenders, an Icelandic bank. The Candy's paid a record amount to the original developers, Beverly Hills based New Pacific, who conceived the plans for prestigious condominiums on what had

been the home of Robinsons-May.

The first hurdle was in rezoning the property from commercial to residential, but that successful effort may now come back to plague the Candy's. Traditionally, Beverly Hills, short on housing elements, has been very reluctant to rezone from residential to commercial, even when that meant going back to the original zoning.

The Candy's have floated some feelers on the possibility of a “prestigious” new hotel for the site, but that too would be very difficult to achieve. Financing for condos, where the return is quicker and more secure, is far easier to obtain than for hotels, one of the reasons almost all new hotel projects have condominium elements.

One obvious escape route for the owners would have been to return the property to retail. However, now the most successful retailers are massive discount stores such as Wal Mart. Aside from the zoning challenges, the city would be very unlikely to favor a discount store at one of our most important gateways.

There are “prestigious” hotel chains/operators such as Plaza Athenee that have long expressed an interest in coming to Beverly Hills. Twenty years ago, that hotel group was exploring a site

at Wilshire and Linden, and was even proposing a plan that could have made Greystone a kind of adjunct to their hotel. Neither scheme met with much enthusiasm.

While there is real concern about the future of 9900 and much admiration for what the Candy's were planning, and now sympathy for their financial woes, a hotel development is simply not likely to fly. This community has reached a breaking point on any more hotel construction. The new Montage Beverly Hills and the planned Waldorf=Astoria on the Hilton property has probably made any other massive hotel proposal dead on political arrival.

Hopefully, and no one wants the land to remain as it is: a vacant department store, a condominium project will again be feasible. We also don't need another underused or abandoned section of Wilshire Boulevard vacant for decades, as has happened to the land just east of the Beverly Hilton on Wilshire and to Linden Drive. Contributing to the problem was the loss of CAA and the closure of the Friar's Club.

\*\*\*

**Eli Broad**, one of the most successful housing developers in the nation, and a remarkable philanthropist and art collector, is proceeding, at least so far, with plans for a museum at Wilshire and Santa Monica to house some of his collection, as first reported in this column last year.

He did what any developer, no matter the project, does when they come to Beverly Hills: Hire a land use lawyer who was once a mayor of the city. In this case, **Thomas Levyn**.

Broad is well along with his project and has been spending a fair amount of pre-development money on architects and others, but there are still doubts that he will actually complete a museum.

There are really three separate land owners of the transportation zoned property off Little Santa Monica in what is being called the Gateway project, and they shared the costs of an Environmental Impact Report and other pre-hearing needs.

One of the most desirable of the plans is for the land owned by the Brittan family, the western most parcels near our city's border. This development would be mixed use with moderate priced apartments – one of our city's most critical needs. Low density, within height limits, the plan should not be delayed simply because another adjoining, and separately owned property has an equally exciting possibility – and that is what the Broad museum is.

What has not happened are upscale improvements near the Peninsula. The arrival of one of the world's leading hotel names was supposed to lead to attracting high end retailers to the area and to the removal of the eye sore, empty land adjacent to Santa Monica Boulevard in the T Zone. The Gateway projects, whatever their possible use, could finally make that a reality.

Although there are hopeful signs the economy will soon turn around, marginal retailers in Beverly Hills are having problems surviving. Even successful companies such as Sotheby have made major cuts in operations and staffing. Loss of small shops and convenience stores and the pressure to lease to less attractive uses could impact the look and feel of our business district.

Good news department: The city has completed a lease deal that will keep our only hardware store, Pioneer and Lucerne, on city owned property on North Crescent Drive. This combination and merging of two historic hardware store names, now owned and operated by the Tilem family, is a real community asset.

Side note: You can help by shopping

in your own community, keeping tax dollars in city coffers.

Of course, Beverly Hills changed forever when some creative property owners and retailers conceived and implemented Rodeo Drive. Suppose instead of some of the most prestigious retailers in the world, the street had become a magnet for fast food stores, pawn brokers or electronic discount stores? This would not be the same Beverly Hills.

Before people such as **Fred Hayman, Dar Mahboubi, Don Tronstein, Jerry Magnin** and others had the vision to demand only high end uses, Rodeo Drive was another sleepy street with a few restaurants, office buildings and moderate priced shops. Yes, there is a Frank Lloyd Wright building on Rodeo and the original Friar's Club once occupied space nearby, but it was the creative genius of Hayman, Mahboubi and others that changed our community forever.

Sometimes we take for granted the interdependent elements that define our city: First rate city services including the best in police and fire protection, outstanding public education, an attractive, outstanding and well maintained residential area, world class hotels and stores and property owners committed to excellence. Take away any one of these, and our whole community would suffer.

Hayman's Giorgio, where even his distinctive shopping bags became a collector's item for tourists, and the Mahboubi's Rodeo Collection, set the tone for the arrival of the world's leading retailers and shops.

Now, if we must make cuts in city services, we need to understand how important those services are to our city. As an example: code enforcement. One of the reasons our business districts are so attractive and not copies of shopping areas found in cities all around us is monitoring of esthetic codes, including signage.

Put another way, Rodeo Drive makes residential property more valuable and there could not have been a Rodeo Drive without attractive residential, expensive homes.

\*\*\*

School Board Member **Dr. Brian David Goldberg** made a very good comment about the work of the board at Tuesday's board meeting: Even though the board often disagrees, as they did on

out of district permits, they are more often united in decision making than the community perceives.

It is a well functioning board with strong opinions but also a willingness to disagree without allowing those differences to prevent a coming together on basic goals and objectives, Goldberg pointed out. It was a good reminder for the education community.

One issue did separate Goldberg from his colleagues and School Superintendent **Dr. Jerry Gross** Tuesday night: the approval of hiring a boss for the school's maintenance workers. Goldberg wanted the same money this would cost used for retention of teachers, but the board said this was not good administration policy. What was most interesting was the strong position taken by Dr. Gross. Few recent school superintendents ever spoke out as forcefully and as clearly as Dr. Gross.

**LOCAL HERO:** Most often that honor goes to less well known people in our community in the private sector or in government who go the extra mile to make a difference, but this week we honor one of our best known denizens, **Wolfgang Puck**, the international food conglomerate with a one name identity.

You want to advise people where they can see a real celebrity? Take them to lunch at Spago and on almost any lunch time, Wolf will visit their table. Puck has to be one of the busiest people in the food industry, but he never forgets his base: Spago.

That alone is not a reason for the Local

Hero nod. This is: Recently Puck sat down at my, or rather Fred Hayman's table, where I was an incidental addition, and I asked him about his busy life. Quite casually, Puck mentioned that he was involved that night in a fund raiser for Alzheimer's research. Why no publicity for his support of a restaurant owner's support group? Not his style.

Although Spago will certainly have some benefit from having the Montage Beverly Hills just down the street, that hotel will also be a competitor with two fine dining rooms. That did not prevent Puck from being one of the most important supporters of the project.

For what he has done in helping re-fine our restaurant industry, for his countless charitable contributions and for always being an upbeat and gracious host, Wolfgang Puck is this week's Local Hero. (If this doesn't get me a good table, there is no hope for columnists.)

Craig played in all 29 of Hawaii Pacific's games, starting 25, helping it to a 14-15 record, the best in the program's three-season history.

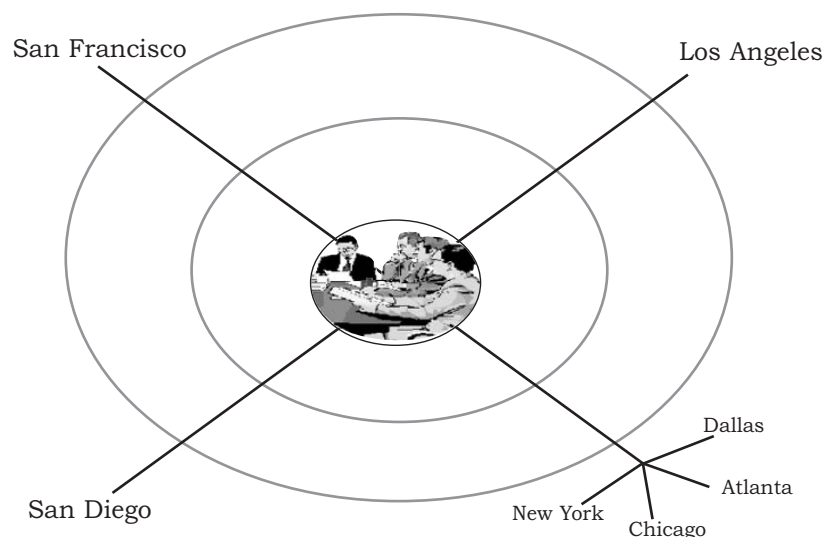

## TOP COP

### Assistant Chief Robert Curtis retires his badge after 32 years

#### How many years have you been with the Beverly Hills Police Department?

April of 2009 will be 32 years that I've been with the City of Beverly Hills Police Department. Prior to that, for five years I was a reserve officer for the Los Angeles County Sheriff Department. After working as a reserve, even though I had another job, I knew it was something that I wanted to do full time.

In fact, I wanted to be a deputy sheriff, but they had budget problems and a hiring freeze. So I sent out resumes to other departments. I couldn't be happier that it worked out to come to the Beverly Hills Police Department. In April of 1977, I was hired as a full time police officer. It has been a great experience, and I retire with mixed emotions. I love my job and I love the city. But it's time. We have a lot of young talented up-and-comers, and the department will be in good hands when I leave.

#### Could you highlight some of your career experiences?

During my 32 years here, I have been a captain or above for 19 of those years. I made captain in 1990, I made sergeant in five years, I made lieutenant in eight years, and I made captain in 13 years. So over half of my career, I've been a captain or above.

I have worked for four different police chiefs here, none finer than our current chief David Snowden. It's been a pleasure working with him for the past five years. He has so much experience. You know, with our pension system, you max out your benefits. Many officers leave after 30 years. But, it's been such a pleasure working with him that I stayed an extra two years.

The first chief that I worked with was Ed Kreins, who later became city manager here. I enjoyed working under him. He came in at a time that was a little difficult for the department and he did some very good things here. The next chief was Lee Tracy, who I really hit it off with. He promoted me to Sergeant in 1982. Unfortunately, he became ill and died of cancer very young.

It's just such a great city to work in. You have outstanding community support, great support from the city council over the years, and we've got great city staff to work with. There's enough to keep it interesting for a police officer. It's a great city. When people

wave at you, they wave with all five fingers, not just one.

#### Tell me about your family and friends

Even though my family and I don't live in the city, my wife [Sandra Olivencia Curtis] and I are very involved with the city, as is my daughter [Lisette Curtis]. To me, although we don't live here, it's like our home. My

son Jeffrey is 35 and married to Sarah Curtis, he is a video coordinator for Anschutz Entertainment Group, and my daughter Lisette will be graduating from Beverly Hills High in June.

My wife and I are very involved with BHEF, she is on the board of directors, we've done PTA, and we go to all the football games, so we feel like we really belong to the community here.

My wife goes by her maiden name more than my last name because sometimes, we deal with same people. She will continue to work for the city after my retirement. Most people know we're married, but it just kind of keeps us separate.

We've made great friends here, and we will continue to have those friends after I retire. We've made so many friends, not only through the department, but through school system and parents of friends of my daughter

and still has a "Beverly Hills" feel in my opinion. The crime rate was much higher then; over the years the crime rate has gone down. People think nothing happens here, but crime does happen. When we do have something major, we have the resources to aggressively pursue it.

#### Are there any conflicts being a police officer in the vicinity of your daughter's school?

Every now and then I make a traffic stop, and one of the questions I hate to get from the kids is, "Are you Lisette's father?" because here you're stopping somebody that she might know.

There's been so much in the paper recently about permit students. When you work for the city, your children are allowed to go to Beverly Hills schools, so my daughter has been in these schools since kindergarten. It's been really great, she is really active, and has already got accepted to many colleges.

#### What will you miss most?

I really love the people that I work with. I'll miss the camaraderie with the officers and fellow co-workers the most.

#### How has the police department changed over the years?

We've grown in numbers. When I was hired in 1977 we had 97 officers as I recall, and now were up to 140. The nature of the city has changed. It's still a great communi-

ty recovered stolen vehicles and arrested suspects based on this device.

#### What are some of the most intense situations you've been in?

Fortunately, I've never had to fire my weapon in a street situation throughout my career.

Of course there have been situations, like a bank robbery where you draw your weapon, where there's always the potential of something happening. But with the good training that we've had and the good equipment that we've had, the ability to talk to people is the best weapon.

Most of my career has had a lot of ups and not very many downs. One very stressful situation was in 1986, the Van Cleef & Arpels jewelry store robbery. Some jewelers and employees were killed by a suspect, and we did hostage negotiations with the suspect for thirteen hours. He's on death row now.

I was a captain during the Rodney King riots [in 1992]. We had half of our department watching over the city to make sure we had sufficient coverage. I remember the fire at La Cienega and Pico. We deployed so many people. On a normal day there would be a few arrests, but for these three days, we arrested over a hundred people.

#### What are your plans upon retirement?

I still have a lot of things I want to do. I'm a Rotarian, I'll be on the board of directors for the Rotary in the beginning of July, so I'll be active in the city. Ride my motorcycle, maybe take up golf. My wife and I love to vacation, so we'll probably take a celebratory cruise sometime this summer.

#### If you weren't a police chief, what field of work do you think you would be involved in?

I got my degree from [Cal State] Northridge in Marketing, so I'd probably be in the business world in some way. Before I worked here, I worked for the county of Los Angeles as an administrative assistant, in the department of communications.

#### What is one thing that most people may not know about you?

Well, I think that when most people meet me, they think I'm very serious. But I think once people get to know me, we have a lot of laughs, and I do have a sense of humor.

#### Looking back, what is one of your favorite moments?

One of the best memories that I have is first I putting on the Beverly Hills uniform. I was very proud, as I am today. I am sitting here today in a uniform, and before I retire, I'm going to wear the uniform as much as I can. It's like when an athlete puts on a jersey for the first time. I'm proud to be a Beverly Hills cop.

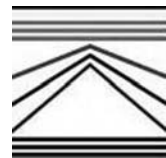
