## State officials ask districts to put a moratorium on risky bonds

Just two days after the Board of Education held a town hall regarding a possible Measure E bond acceleration, California Treasurer Bill Lockyer and State Superintendent Tim Torlakson sent a letter to school districts asking education officials to put a moratorium on controversial bonds, known as capital appreciation bonds

(CABs).

“In too many cases, CAB deals have forced taxpayers to pay more than 10 times the principal to retire the bonds. Also, the transactions have been structured with 40-year terms that delay interest and principal payments for decades, resulting in huge balloon payments and burdens on future taxpayers that cannot be justified,” the letter states.

Capital appreciation bonds are bonds that allow borrowers to delay payments until the bond’s maturity at a higher interest rate. They are used when there is not enough tax rate capacity to support current interest payments.

About 200 school districts in the state of California have used CABs, according to a Los Angeles Times analysis -- the most notorious case possibly being San Diego’s Poway Unified School District who chose to use CABs in a \$105 million bond in order to keep a promise to voters that it would not raise taxes. Poway faces close to \$1 billion in debt in principal and interest at the time of the bond’s maturity.

The Beverly Hills Unified School District currently has \$60.5 million in capital appreciation bonds, about \$60 million of which came from the first series of Measure E bonds, according to Keygent Managing Director Tony Hsieh. The first series of bonds issued by Measure E was a total of \$72 million.

During the bond acceleration town hall on Jan. 15, Board of Education Vice President Noah Margo presented a plan which would accelerate the issuance of the remaining Measure E bonds and increase the tax rate

for property owners from the current rate of \$49.71 per \$100,000 to \$111 per \$100,000 of assessed value. The acceleration plan would reduce the repayment schedule by 22 years and save taxpayers approximately \$2 billion in the long term, according to Margo.

Margo said accelerating the bond would allow the district to issue 50 percent of the remaining \$262 million in current interest bonds, in which districts make interest and principal payments semiannually and at a lower rate. The remaining 50 percent would be in capital appreciation bonds.

Hsieh said they are trying to make a structural change in the program to try to minimize the amount of CABs in future deals. Hsieh also said they planned on making the CABs callable, meaning they could be refinanced into current interest bonds in the future, pending interest rates.

CABs are illegal in the state of Michigan and the California state legislature may soon present reforms in regards to CABs.

The letter warns that CABs with terms exceeding 25 years "place the repayment obligation on future taxpayers who likely will not benefit from the capital improvements financed by CABs" and "reduce those taxpayers capacity to finance construction and modernization projects their own children will need."

Lockyer and Torlakson asked districts to put a moratorium on all CABs until Gov. Jerry Brown and the state legislature have decided on reforms in the current legislative session.

## Board of Education scales back construction plans at Beverly High

The Board of Education discussed construction at Beverly High during an afternoon study session on Tuesday. The Board directed consultant Tim Buresh to look into and bring back a proposal to the Board involving the removal of Building E, Konheim Athletic Building, for the implementation of a CIF regulation oval track, to look into turning the district office space on Lasky Drive in to a performing arts space, and removing Building A, the building that houses Theater 40 and the planetarium to the left of the Science and Technology Center.

Buresh said it would be possible to renovate Building E, but it would be short of enough athletic program space and would need to be removed if the Board expressed interest in converting the track to a regulation track.

Board member Lewis Hall said he found Building E to be claustrophobic and supported removing the building. He also said he would support a regulation track. Board member Lisa Korbatov agreed.

Board member Brian Goldberg said the academic core was his priority and that he would rather see a regulation size pool than a regulation size track. Goldberg also said if they could not afford all aspects of renovation, he would prioritize funds toward academic functions.

Board of Education President Jake Manaster said prioritizing would be for a different discussion and compromises would need to be made in the future.

Board Vice President Noah Margo said he did not think having a regulation track was necessary and he supported keeping the current configuration of the area.

Manaster said he knew people would not send their children to schools without regulation athletic space. He said leaving Building E limits parking in the area and thought it was "disgusting" that the school does not satisfy its Title IX requirement.

"I think it's substandard for us to keep the building around. The Konheims are pissed off enough as it is. They want \$600,000 back that they gave because they think it's an embarrassment that we did not do what we said we were going to do," said Manaster.

Buresh said his goal was to complete all high school improvements for \$150 million.

Hall said he wanted to know how plans at the high school fit in with the rest of the district. He said he didn't want the Board to move forward with \$150 million if it meant they couldn't address new desks or needs of the other schools.

"I think that we shouldn't be trying to spend the entire bond money, but we should have some set aside in case the San Andreas Fault goes off and we have to do some repairs or there's something else that comes up in 15 years that we need to go and do," said Hall.

Buresh asked for direction on whether Building A would be renovated or removed entirely.

Buresh said renovating Building A, which includes the library, planetarium, and cafeteria, was less expensive than rebuilding,

but not by much. He also said that renovation may come with surprises and higher costs than expected. Buresh said structurally Building A is in good condition, but its problems are architectural.

Hall said he supported keeping Building A. Goldberg also supported keeping the building noting significant savings in keeping the building because they would then also keep the parking. Margo said he was also inclined to keep Building A, but agreed to give consensus on removing building A, so a proposal would return to the Board.

Manaster said the envelope of the building was a bad one and he does not think it will last 50 to 80 years. Manaster acknowledged the savings in keeping the parking, but said the parking is substandard and poses a security risk he cannot agree with. Korbatov agreed with Manaster and noted rising costs associated with renovation.

Buresh also suggested moving performing arts to where administration is currently hosted – the idea being that all places the community is likely to use would be on the south end of campus leaving the northern end strictly for academic use, which also would provide for efficiency and security. The majority of board members agreed. Goldberg said he was also in favor of a pool athletic space in that area.

Buresh said they had just completed destructive testing of Beverly High's historic Building B, which confirmed the integrity of the wall system installed in the 1930s. Buresh said testing was not technically finished and a report would be made available

in a week.

However, Buresh said that the testing was good so far and meant that Building B could be renovated, which aligned with previous consensus from the Board to preserve the building. Buresh also said he was meeting with the facilities advisory committee today to work on more details, narrow down options and bring it back to the Board at a later date.

## Board of Education gives direction on creating a public relations program

The Board of Education directed staff to look into implementing a public relations program for the BHUSD at the Board of Education meeting on Tuesday night.

The idea was presented to the Board as the result of a unanimous resolution from the District Finance Committee from the committee's Dec. 17 meeting recommending the implementation of a "robust PR program" in order to address misinformation in the community about how the district handles its affairs.

"The district finance committee brings up a great point. Education in the last 10 years has gone through a huge deficit in terms of PR nationally," said Superintendent Gary Woods. "Unfortunately, the economic conditions of our state and country have led to some of this and it's also unfortunate that most of the characterizations of public education today are rather negative."

Woods said that a necessity exists to tell the story with a "positive framework," which

would be something that requires skill.

Within the resolution the committee recommends that a staff member or consultant be responsible for implementing or coordinating the program, sensitivity to false impressions from the community, professionally crafted press releases, special programs on KBEV, outreach to the Beverly Hills business community, communication with PTA and student families, liaison with the City council, and coordination with the Beverly Hills Education Foundation and the district's advisory committees.

Board of Education member Lewis Hall agreed with the necessity of the position, but asked the committee whether it had a recommendation of how to pay for the program.

District Finance Committee Chair and former Board President Mel Spitz acknowledged the difficulty in hiring a community relations officer while the district faces budget cuts, but felt the position was a true necessity to the district.

"Just to give you an idea of the urgency and the importance of it, let me say this: during the years that this district was recognized as one of the top three school districts in the nation, there was at all times a comprehensive public relations program supervised by a full-time community relations officer," said Spitz. "Consequently, the community was always well-informed regarding district matters and any misinformation was very quickly corrected."

Spitz also said he knew firsthand that the program was considered indispensable by the school boards and superintendents.

"There are indications that there are broad segments in the community that are unin-

## Plensa dedication today at 1 p.m. in Beverly Gardens Park

The Fine Art Commission and Beverly Hills City Council will be hosting a dedication ceremony for *Endless V* by Jaume Plensa at 1 p.m. on Jan. 24 in Beverly Gardens Park on Santa Monica Boulevard in between Rodeo and Beverly Drives.

The project has been a work of about three or four years, according to Fine Arts Commission Chair Terri Smooke. Smooke said she had proposed commissioning a work by Jaume Plensa and the opportunity finally presented itself to move forward with bringing the piece to Beverly Hills.

"One of the other reasons why we are so pleased to have it is it's a beautiful seated figure, it's open, [and] it's made of interlocking letters of eight and our City is home to people who speak so many different languages," said Smooke. "This work is contemplative and there's also a significance to the fact that all these alphabets really do represent all of the different backgrounds from the people who live here and the people who visit here."

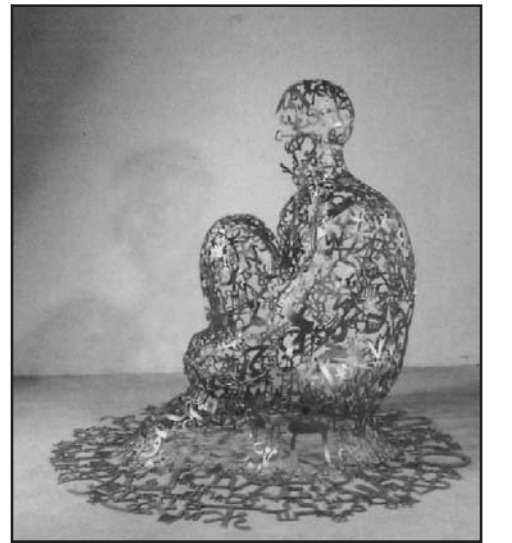
Mayor Willie Brien and the city council are expected to attend the dedication as well as Paul Gray, director of the Richard Gray Gallery in Chicago and New York, from where the piece was commissioned. Franklin Sirmans, LACMA curator of contemporary art, will be speaking at the dedication.

The event will be followed by a reception sponsored by Sotheby's.

The piece has been installed in the same area as Yayoi Kusama's *Hymn of Life: Tulips* and is located to the piece's right. Roxy Paine's *Erratic* has also been moved from its previous location in Beverly Gardens Park along Santa Monica Boulevard between Rexford and Crescent Drives to the same area as the Kusama and Plensa pieces to form a sculpture garden.

"Moving [Roxy Paine's *Erratic*] to the western quadrant of that block, it's just transforming," said Smooke. "The piece looks wonderful and we've also been seeing, it's framed by trees and it's reflecting the light of the different colors of the leaves. It's really quite beautiful."

Smooke said *Erratic* has been also been repositioned and the commission has seen a good response and has seen more people looking at the piece and posing with the piece.

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formed and misinformed at present in district matters," said Spitz. "Solid community support that you will need urgently to pass a parcel tax, for example, is questionable at best at this time."

Other committee members collectively agreed the community would not rally to support the district without proper communication and the cost would be an investment.

"I believe the story we have to tell is a worthy one and the narrative doesn't have to be spun. I think this board should conclude that we are losing a PR battle because we're just not in the game and we're not advocating our position and when there's a void, other people will fill it. It's chaos or misinformation or people's political agendas that fill that void," said Board of Education member Lisa Korbatov.

Korbatov said the person could also be someone who works with the BHEF or PTA to raise money for the district.

Board of Education member Brian Goldberg said he "couldn't agree more." Board Vice President Noah Margo said that after the bond acceleration meeting he was tasked with, he was made aware of how apparent the necessity of the position is.

"I am not a professional PR person. I am also not a bond advisor. We do the best with what we've got," said Margo.

Margo did say that all meetings are open to the public and are all noticed. He felt the

various committees and Board do a respectable job trying to inform the community.

"I don't think what we're looking at is from a lack of effort," said Margo.

## Six properties may join the Beverly Hills Hotel as local landmarks

The City Council will vote on six resolutions that would designate six local properties as local landmarks at the formal meeting today at 4:30 p.m.

The properties, already vetted by the Cultural Heritage Commission, are the Virginia Robinson Estate and Garden, Beverly Hills Women's Club, Greystone Mansion, the Beverly Hills Post Office, Anderton Court on Rodeo Drive, and the Karasik House at 436 Spalding Drive.

All of the properties up for consideration appear on the National Register of Historic Places and pending City Council approval will appear on the Local Register of Historic Places.

The Virginia Robinson Estate and Garden built in 1911 is historically significant, because it's original owners were Harry and Virginia Robinson, owners of Robinson's. The Beverly Hills Women's Club built in 1925 was designed by master architects Gable and Wyant and played a role in the social history of the City. Greystone Mansion, which was constructed in 1927,

is historically significant for its connection with Edward Doheny Sr. and because it reflects early residential development in the City.

The Beverly Hills Post Office on Crescent Drive is significant because it was built in conjunction with City Hall and represents early formation of the civic center and is an example of Renaissance Revival architecture. The post office is being renovated as part of the new Annenberg Cultural Center.

Rodeo Drive's Anderton Court, designed by master architect Frank Lloyd Wright and built in 1954, is significant for its unique architectural style. The 1960- constructed Karasik House at 436 Spalding Drive was designed by Frank Lloyd Wright, Jr. or Lloyd Wright, also a master architect. The house is reflective of his expressionist work.

The three other properties that appear on the National Register of Historic Places are the Saban Theater, the Beverly Wilshire Hotel and the Harold Lloyd Estate, but have been continued by the Cultural Heritage Commission at the request of the property owners.

### Board of Education approves City Liaison proposal to fill budget deficit 5-1

The Board of Education voted 5-1 to approve a proposed plan in conjunction with the City council that would address the BHUSD's \$3.5 million budget short-fall for the 2013-2014 year at the Board of Education meeting on Tuesday night.

Student Board member Jason Friedman voted in favor of the plan. Board member Brian Goldberg dissented.

The plan, pending City council approval, could provide up to \$4.05 million in one-time revenue and funds that would be specifically earmarked to fund programs slated to be cut in a list provided by the district prior to the November 2012 election.

Board member Brian Goldberg said he was concerned because the plan does not address the problem facing the district.

"This is a band-aid at best – an important

band-aid and I don't mean to minimize the work of my colleagues or city council in coming up with this—but as my colleagues know and the City council knows, we have to prepare a three year budget, and the reality is this only gets us back even," said Goldberg.

He said the plan lets the parent community "off the hook."

"I won't be supporting this budget short-fall proposal," said Goldberg. "The number one factor affecting our ability to provide the quality education or an even better education that we're providing for our students is our funding mechanism and this is a short term, one-time, and quick fix solution and just kicks the can down the road. We have to end this cycle."

The plan, formulated by Board President Jake Manaster and Vice President Noah Margo on behalf of the district and Mayor Willie Brien and Councilmember Julian Gold, consists of various components.

The BHUSD is entitled to \$1 million as part of the developer fee in association with the 9900 Wilshire Boulevard project. If approved, the City will advance the payment of \$1 million using funds in the \$10 million City surplus. When the developer breaks ground on the project and the BHUSD receives \$1 million, the district will then in turn give that money to the City.

The City would also pay \$1.25 million to the district for use of additional space the City does not currently have access to under the Joint Powers Agreement. This money would also likely come from the City surplus.

The remaining revenue to the district would come from a turf fund of \$1.2 million, which has already been negotiated as part of the JPA. The fund was meant for turf field improvements, but because those needs are expected to be met with Measure E funds, the district and City would agree to release half of the funds -- \$600,000 -- to the district's general fund. The remaining \$600,000 would only be released when and

### Fencing to be installed around Hymn of Life: Tulips in Beverly Gardens Park

The Fine Art Commission has sent fencing around Yayoi Kusama's *Hymn of Life: Tulips* out for bid.

"We have signs that say do not sit, do not touch, do not climb and people just disregard all of the signage and they have also been disregarding the landscaping which was planted on the ground in order to protect the work from people climbing," said Fine Art Commission Chair Terri Smooke.

The piece, which has been recently renovated, is frequently climbed and sat on, said Smooke.

The commission is considering a fence about four feet high. The fence would be a perimeter of steel posts with horizontal rows of steel cable in between the posts.

"It's not what was ever intended," said Smooke. "It's not what we want, but we need to protect this work of art. It's a valuable work of art growing more valuable every year and it's our responsibility to take care of it."

The commission has also discussed commemorating former Fine Art Commissioner Barbara Jacobson with a plaque on a bench near the Kusama at the commission's meeting on Jan. 17.

"[She] was instrumental in bringing the Kusama to Beverly Hills. She worked tirelessly on this and she passed away. She's the one who through perseverance and strength of will made it go forward," said Smooke. "We want to have a bench with a small plaque to honor what she did and honor her memory."

Smooke said staff has identified a bench and the commission will work on what the plaque will say.

Smooke said the commission hopes that work on installing the Millard Sheets Mural over the civic center parking lot will begin in late January or early February with probable completion in April.

Smooke also said Michael Ovitz, Chairman of the Creative Arts Agency, which is now located in Century City, will be making a payment to the fine art fund to satisfy the fine art obligation of the former CAA building on Wilshire Boulevard in Beverly Hills.

The Joel Shapiro sculpture satisfied the obligation of the property before Sony became the tenant. The work of art has been removed from the property. The City's fine art ordinance requires building developers to install fine art of a designated value at their properties, or contribute to the public fine art fund in lieu of installing art on site.

"When a work is installed to satisfy the obligation, the work must stay with the property because that's how the property got the certificate of occupancy -- by satisfying all the City conditions," said Smooke.

The building is no longer in compliance with the fine art obligation. After a lengthy conversation, said Smooke, Ovitz will pay the City the value of the original obligation.

"Unfortunately, the work of art became more valuable through the years, but because the ordinance was not written up to the standards we hope for today, he was able to comply by paying the amount of the original obligation rather than replacing the price for the work that was removed," Smooke.

Smooke said the commission has been working on the Fine Art Ordinance to ensure there is no future confusion or misunderstanding about the developer's responsibility. The commission is also working on drafting a deaccession policy so the City has guidelines for selling or donating existing public art.

"That is another reason why it's so important to clean up and update the Fine Art Ordinance so this kind of thing can't happen again," said Smooke.

The Fine Art Commission will be reviewing a final draft of the Fine Art Ordinance at the next commission meeting. The most recent final copy has been presented to the commission.



## Inside City Salary Story And Comments on Tender Subjects

You may have read a report on City employees' salaries and benefits in another publication with mixed reactions: surprise at the "high" pay levels or a perception that this was not public information.

On whether this is fair game, yes it is. Also, newspapers should and can question fiscal policies and monitor spending, including pay and benefits, for City staff. Government, unlike private industry, has to be more open to citizen scrutiny.

However, there is much missing in all of this, and without other facts and information, the reports on city employee benefits and salaries are not very meaningful.

1. How does our pay and benefits compare with other cities?

2. With private industry?

3. What savings and benefits have been enjoyed by the City because of low turnover?

No report, by the City or in the media, is complete without reference to all three points, and more. Following a very cursory look at comparisons, I think the data will show that in most or many categories we are about average.

While it is appropriate to make this a matter of public interest, there is a balancing consideration that we must always remember: for generations, the community and the people who serve us have had a most unusual and mutually appreciative relationship. People who come to city hall know and feel the difference: City staff actually enjoy serving and working in our community. We need to be very careful not to diminish that special relationship.

Some facts we need to remember: Our police and fire departments receive applications from those working in other cities – seldom do we lose any to other agencies. That is not just because of benefits; it is the professional work environment in Beverly Hills.

If we retain experienced, competent staff members because of benefits and enjoyable work conditions, we make enormous savings in recruitment and training. Consider your reactions to constant changes in staff where you do business, and apply that to city hall. In fact, the years of continued service in many city agencies is remarkable.

What about high salaries for top City managers? The best examples are in the protective services. We have, in Police Chief **David Snowden** and Fire Chief **Tim Scranton**,

two of the best administrators in the state or nation. Morale in their departments is extremely high, and their outreach to the community is extraordinary. We would never want to lose either because their pay and benefits were below standards.

Also, the City made significant changes and savings in benefits and pay during the most recent rounds of union negotiations - a tribute to the responsible leadership of the employee associations and City leadership.

There is something else very lacking in these discussions of fiscal policies: the enormous successes by this city council and our staff financial team in keeping us solvent without important reductions in city services. As one example, in many neighboring communities, library services are being curtailed, hours of operation reduced and staffs cut. Not in Beverly Hills. We have actually made tremendous improvements in library services including the most recent addition: an exciting new, children's section.

It is irresponsible to cite fiscal issues without pointing to the reality of successes the City has enjoyed in the face of an uncertain economy and political divisions in Washington.

Obviously, a major part of this success is because of the healthy condition of our business community. Yes, protecting the residential quality of life is an important objective, but we should never, ever forget that we are able to sustain a three minute response time by police, fire and paramedics, in part, because our hotels are near occupancy. It always amazes me when people fail to grasp the reality that their property taxes pay only a fraction of city costs and that seventy five percent or more of revenues are generated by the business community.

Yes, this is not the most fascinating subject, but if the system falls apart and or is diminished, it would be. So, when you look at those surprising figures on benefits and pay for City workers, remember we don't have the full story: comparisons to other government agencies and the private sector or the benefits we all enjoy because we retain experienced and competent City staffers.

I do not mean to suggest that there aren't improvements that could or should be made in some City departments. However, we need to send one important message to the people who

said the matching component of the plan was healthy and said he felt it was an important first step. Hall said he was hopeful the district could raise more than \$600,000.

"I appreciate the generosity of the City and their leadership and it is our tax dollars and it's good to know that it's staying in the

work in City government and who express such an appreciation for being an integral part of our community: This community and its residents appreciate your service.

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For that small percentage of residents who will actually vote in the upcoming City elections, we are about to enter the second cycle of the campaign: the first were the campaign kick offs and now the candidate forums. These once were standing room only events, but now few people, including even members of the sponsoring organizations, actually attend.

However, the forums, not really debates, are televised and people do watch.

So, is there any real excitement in the election? Most of the candidates are walking, sending out campaign mailers, holding neighborhood meetings and soliciting endorsements, but have yet to really engross the electorate.

Mostly, because there are few real issues, and those that have been overblown and exhausted interest levels; there is no urgency, yet, in the elections. The problem for incumbents in this satisfied environment is that positive voters will not participate. Too often, more people vote to express opposition than support – the more angry the community, the larger the vote. Of course, sometimes this anger turns against critics and results in support for incumbents.

We have six candidates, four we know, and two who are not known or familiar names. The two incumbents, Mayor Dr. **Willie Brien** and Vice Mayor **John Mirisch**, have had differences on issues, but not quite as many as some perceive. The primary challengers are as close to incumbency as possible: **Nancy Krasne** served on two City commissions and as mayor and councilmember before leaving the council and **Brian Rosenstein** is vice chair of the Planning Commission and a past member of the Traffic and Parking Commission. Both, regardless of their differences on challenges facing the City, know city government.

For the record, if Mirisch wins he is slated to be our next mayor. Councilmember **Lili Bosse**, also an experienced hand in government, would become vice mayor. If Mirisch does not win, Bosse would be mayor and Dr. **Julian Gold** vice mayor.

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Now, I am about to violate a self imposed rule: Not writing or commenting on school security. But there is a reason. I feel the safety issues and the school's handling of problems should be very private and limited to parents, students and staff, and not out there for the whole world to consider.

My reasons should be obvious, and not necessary to repeat here. Equally important, school leaders and board members should not be boasting on how safe we are.

So, as long as I am in a lecturing mode, some cautionary words to those who express extremist views on both the right and left side of political discourse: proceed with caution.

Despite being safer and more secure than ever, a rebounding economy with strong improvement indicators across the board and an historic election, there is continuing disapproval of how our government functions or lacks to perform.

Some of this is the inevitable reaction to a divided congress and a far more rigid conservative control by the House Republicans. Many moderate Republicans in both the Senate and House are gone and in their place, are some rigid Tea Party representatives who see no need to compromise or accommodate a president who just won a record setting election – and that should also be a mandate for moving his agenda.

Our inaugurations are a constant reminder of the durability of our incredible democracy – peaceful change without force or revolution. In spite of this viability, the approval ratings for all levels of government are consistently low.

Whatever else you might say about the Republican candidate for president, **Mitt Romney**, he did not run a really horrendous divisive campaign. He did not play the race card, refused to give credence to **Donald Trump's** birthplace nonsense and did not revisit the racist comments of President **Obama's** one-time pastor.

While it is probably true that most voters would reject extremism, the risks are still there. What if a very charismatic candidate for president emerged who truly appealed to all of our nations fears – whether from the right or left? How sure are we that some demagogue might not emerge who successfully plays on our worst anxieties? Remember, we now consider the **Joe McCarthy** era an aberration, but there was a time when polls showed a majority approved of his efforts.

This is a remarkable democracy and we have all the resources needed to make it even better. For those shrill voices here and outside our village, let's be careful out there. Now, more than ever, we need uniting and not division.

It’s an expectation. I know our community can do it.”

## Beverly Hills Patch has new editor, AOL announces platform changes

Beverly Hills Patch local editor Marie Cunningham has resigned from her post. Cunningham launched the local internet news source in April of 2010 and recently was in charge of covering both West Hollywood’s Patch as well as Beverly Hills’.

Cunningham was Los Angeles’ longest running Patch editor, according to reports by mediabistro. The new Beverly Hills editor is Lindsey Baguio. Baguio is also the West Hollywood Patch editor. Baguio is the Los Angeles - area community editor. Baguio was previously local editor of Hollywood Patch.

On Jan. 15, Patch President Warren Webster announced a new approach for the hyper local news sites at the Street Fight Summit, a two day conference on hyper local reporting. Webster was interviewed by *Forbes* reporter Jeff Bercovici.

Webster said the company is aiming to make all of its news sites --over 900 of them-- profitable, and announced the platform will evolve in 2013. AOL has announced that only one in nine sites are currently profitable. About five Long Island Patch sites are testing a platform in which the focus shifts to the idea of a community hub allowing more involvement from citizens in the community.

The Bellmore, New York Patch site (bellmore.patch.com) -- one of the test sites -- allows the user to choose what news he or she finds most important and relevant. There is also a large green “post” button on the top left-hand side of the page, which

allows users to submit their own content or announce an event.

## Nespresso to come back before the Architectural Commission for signage alterations

The Architectural Commission asked Nespresso to come back before the commission for sign alterations at the commission meeting on Jan. 16.

“We just want to see how the building separates from the adjacent building,” said Architectural Commission Chair Zale Richard Rubins. “Other than that everybody really loved the design.”

The commission also sent approval of the construction barricade to a subcommittee, but applauded the design.

“It changed the look of the building,” said Rubins. “I think it has a modulation to it that allows for different lighting effects, so it will light up quite nicely. They’ve done a very nice job.”

Nespresso, which will be located at 320 North Beverly Drive, was previously approved by the Planning Commission for an open-air dining permit. The space will be half retail, where Nespresso Coffee and Nespresso machines will be sold and will also have a café area.

The Architectural Commission also unanimously approved a façade remodel for Leggiadro, a boutique founded by former fashion editor Ann Ross that will be opening on 434 North Canon Drive.

The commission had previously asked the applicant to modify the façade to create modulation in the city scape, said Rubins. Modulation is a slight alteration, so buildings do not all look the same.

“It’s a unit in a single building and they all had the same awnings, they all had the same frontage. This applicant had come in and were changing the awnings and changing the paint and so we asked them to go a little further so that the façade would also be modulated and it was essentially a border around name area [and] using a little color to break it apart from the rest of the building,” said Rubins. “In doing that, we’re starting to create that village atmosphere.”

## BHPD responds to false 911 report at actor Tom Cruise’s house

The Beverly Hills Police Department responded to a fake 911 call reporting an armed robbery in the 1100 block of Calle Vista just before noon on Jan. 17.

The residence belonged to actor Tom Cruise, but Cruise was not home at the time of the response. The call seems to be one of the most recent in a trend of “swatting” at celebrity homes. Swatting is an attempt to trick a 911 dispatcher in sending emergency services to someone’s home. The LAPD responded to a false report at singer Chris Brown’s Hollywood home on Monday.

BHPD Sergeant Max Subin said the Beverly Hills Police Department does not get false reports very often.

“We take them seriously because you never know when there could be an emergency or when it’s not and that’s the unfor-

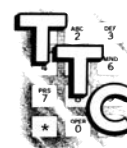
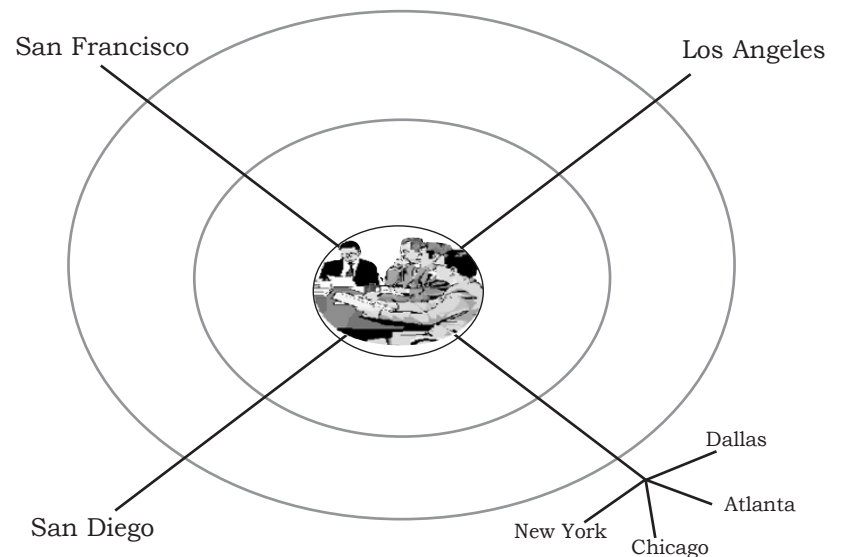

# WILLIE TAKES WASHINGTON

**Mayor Willie Brien discusses last week's U.S. Conference of Mayors**

**What was the highlight of this year's U.S. Conference of Mayors in Washington, D.C.?**

The highlight of this year's U.S. conference of Mayors had to be certainly the vice president of the United States [Joe Biden] speaking. I've seen him before. I've actually met him before, but you know, as the inauguration [was] coming, as you know, the time for reaffirmation of our president and vice president, it's just a very cool thing to see the vice president of the United States sitting in a room talking to you. It's great.

**What did he talk about?**

His focus really was around gun legislation. He discussed the support for gun legislation overhaul, the assault weapons ban; basically the support for Sen. Dianne Feinstein's legislation that would actually take the 1994 ban that she previously had gotten passed along with him because he was writing the crime bill, [which] the assault weapons ban was added. Basically, he said that it was going to go further than before. He also talked about the need for legislation to support mental health funding. Specifically, he talked about school safety initiatives and flexible funding so that schools can use funding for various types of safety resources including psychologists and counselors to help kids who are having mental health challenges.

Sen. Feinstein also was there. She actually discussed her proposal that will eventually be taken forward and clearly has support of the president, specifically naming assault weapons, semi-automatics, armor piercing bullets, mandatory background checks, and I think that the two of them were quite impressive.

**Did the Conference of Mayors pass a resolution in regards to gun control?**

The Conference of Mayors was taking that up. They're having an executive committee meeting. The Democratic

mayors took a position in: one, support of the Feinstein bill and two, ask that all Democratic mayors go back to their cities and actually ask the question - - and we're going to do this -- of where we purchase our guns and ammunition from. Specifically, the reason for that is to decide whether or not we should be purchasing these types of weaponry from companies that are producing things like armor piercing bullets that really only have one goal and that's to pierce the vests of police officers because none of us wear armored vests. The question is do we want to continue to purchase munitions from those companies who produce these bullets and support the positions of the [National Rifle Association] and fund through lobbying efforts the positions of the NRA of preserving armor piercing bullets and semi-automatic weapons? I'm going to share this with my council colleagues and we'll query our purchasing process there and I'll likely share that with other cities.

**Talking about the conference in general, how does networking with other mayors help the City of Beverly Hills?**

So, networking is like everything else. You get a chance to really discuss and share things that you're doing, things that they're doing, the challenges that each of us have and how we overcome some of those challenges. I think that you have small, medium and large city mayors all working in the same room together; talking on the same level, there's no difference between [them]. In fact, one of the safety task forces around school safety chaired by the Mayor of Fresno was where we had people from the Department of Education, the chief of police from Petersburg, and people from Homeland Security talking about ways to make schools, make our community safer. So it just gives you a chance to sit around and say what are you

doing? What are other cities doing?

And I think that some of the things that we've been doing in terms of continuing the use of technology as a way to protect the areas, you can hear, some cities are doing to some degree. Some are now going to be doing the closed circuit TVs, automated license plate readers to look for child molesters and things along those lines, people that have warrants out, and where their vehicles are. These are things that are important for safety. Closed circuit TVs in or around our schools, libraries and things like that can be very helpful and protective and obviously other communication methods from within these schools and public buildings are important, so those are things we talked about.

Other things we talked about were things about the budget because everyone has had their budget trials and tribulations over the last several years. Everyone was touched by the economic downturn and I think getting to share some of the things that we've done with permitting processes, efficiency in government, e-government activities, people were impressed because at the end of the day, you can look and share with people that good sound budget policies, good pension reform, [and] government efficiency is an investment in infrastructure. All the things that we've done in Beverly Hills in the last three and half years has led to a \$10-million surplus and reduced expenditures and reduction in our unfunded liabilities. These are all good things and people were pretty impressed with the alternate retirement medical program that some have heard previously and others heard this time and they were amazed that a City of our size has the budget we have and has the wherewithal to come out of the economic downturn the way we did.

**What other things did you share with other mayors?**

We talked about our various grants that we've gotten through homeland security for interoperability of radios, but more than that, this time, I talked more about the focus around our smart classrooms that Chief [Tim] Scranton is working on through a federal grant that will create classrooms where people can have [fire-fighter] classroom training without having to leave their City. It'll be able to be done through a smart classrooms program that supports and enhances the region. In fact, that's the best way to get grants. City by city, it's hard to do, but what you can do is pool grant resources to support a region, which we're doing. We are successful and will be more successful in getting grants. I think that some of the mayors will have their chiefs contact our chief just to see how and what we're doing. This is not proprietary. These are things that if you can help any region be safer, it's always a good thing.

**What were some of the things you took away from other cities?**

I sit on the standing committee of the transportation committee, so I met with

[Transportation] Secretary [Ray] LaHood and they are going to continue to support and press for appropriation of funds for various transit related projects. In our City, in particular, with the eventual repaving of Santa Monica Boulevard, I think that our light synchronization program is something they're very keen on supporting. Other types of bus projects and highway projects, they're certainly interested in supporting, so these are some the things we'll be looking at ways where we can reach out and work with our neighboring communities as well as the federal government to get additional federal funds for highway road projects through our City, which only benefits the community.

**Did you talk to [Secretary] LaHood about the Metro issue?**

No, not specifically about the Metro issue. We talked more about the fact that the president's administration will continue to support more things in the areas of mass transit, high speed rail, and highway reconstruction. So they're going to continue to do that in support of a continued push for ongoing funding in those areas. Certainly, that would impact the subway.

**Who were some of the mayors you met?**

[Chicago Mayor] Rahm Emanuel and [New York City Mayor] Michael Bloomberg talked also about some of the things that they're doing in pushing particularly around gun control in their own cities. There were discussions from Mayor [Antonio] Villaraigosa and [Philadelphia] Mayor [Michael] Nutter. Mayor Nutter is a great guy and spoke on immigration reform that was coming, but I also had a chance to talk to him about some of the projects he's got going for kids, particularly summer internship projects that we have in the City that I would like to see expanded, so that kids can find both government projects and private partnerships, can get a stipend and get some credit for college classes, maybe even high school classes, that will support them getting exposed to different areas of business and government in the community. I think this is something that's very key to offer the kids in the summertime that want to stay and work in or around the region.

**Did you get to meet other national politicians?**

I got to meet just more on a social level Ambassador [Susan] Rice and Trade Ambassador Ron Kirk and the ambassador to the E.U. [William Kennard]. And then a lot of really great mayors from all over the country, people from South Carolina and Tennessee and Colorado -- a lot of them I've met before, but they're really just nice people. It's fun to sit down and to be able to chat after the meetings are done and just talk about things that people are passionate about outside of government.

**You also attended President Barack Obama's inauguration. How was that?**

Oh man, I got to tell you, that was the



experience of a lifetime. To get to sit there and listen live, going through the inaugural ceremonies and to hear the president get up and speak -- he was eloquent, he was passionate, and it was touching. People were happy in the crowd, I mean, really happy. For him to take on the expansion of civil liberties and laying out the equal pay for women, immigration reform, and sensible gun laws, it was an incredible uplifting day. For him to actually talk about LGBT rights and make that a civil rights issue alongside the fact that

it was Martin Luther King Day, it was just amazing.

**You have about two months remaining in your term as mayor. What do you still hope to accomplish?**

I will continue to work all the way up to my last day as mayor. Hopefully, I'll be re-elected for another term on the council. My goals are to continue making sure that we stay on track with our budgets and priorities. I think [today] you're going to see us talk about the surplus money and

how we can continue to support the needs of our community, enhance public safety, work with our school district and school board, which I think we have been quite successful with, particularly in the last couple of weeks with this additional revenue support for our schools. I think there's a fantastic amount of work to be done and we're going to keep working on those things. We're going to hopefully move to the next step of Roxbury Park [today] expanding the role of our architects and construction management team. I think

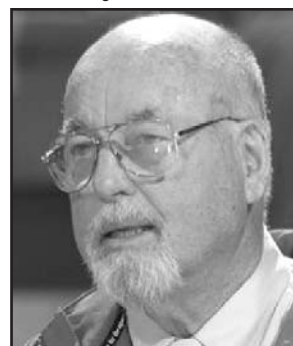
you're seeing a lot of great things happening and again support of green space and setting money aside for land acquisition for green space in the southeast part of Beverly Hills. It's wonderful to be in that position and I hope to see those things addressed [today].

And in the next two months, I think we'll have had a very effective positive year working together and I think that's important.

Former Hawthorne and Beverly High coach and physical education teacher Al Scates spoke to the Beverly Hills Rotary Club on Mon. Jan. 14.

**BHPD arrests two burglary suspects on Jan. 17**

The Beverly Hills Police Department arrested two burglary suspects after a short pursuit on Jan. 17.

"There was one vehicle which was burglarized -- the window was smashed -- and another vehicle was unlocked but because they broke into a secure sub garage of an apartment building, it's considered residential burglary," said Lt. Lincoln Hoshino, spokesperson for the BHPD.

The burglary took place in the 400 block of N. Palm Drive and the BHPD received a call of suspicious persons at 1:15 a.m. on Jan. 17.

When the officers arrived, the suspects fled.

A vehicle pursuit followed and ended in the 200 block of S. Arnaz Drive when the suspects abandoned the vehicle. The passenger was located quickly. The driver of the vehicle was located by the K-9 team at about 6 a.m. within a perimeter set up by the BHPD near Charleville Boulevard and Arnaz Drive.

**City looks to upgrade wireless service coverage throughout Beverly Hills**

At the request of Beverly Hills Fire and Police Departments, AT&T may soon install an Outdoor Distributed Antenna System (oDAS) throughout the City to increase wireless service. An oDAS is a network of small antenna nodes to increase coverage over a smaller area.

"There are holes in our community for cell phones, for our mobile digital computers and our motor officers actually use tablets now that require a cell phone connection within the City," said Sgt. Gregg Mader.

Mader is a traffic supervisor but when he began the project, he was community relations sergeant.

Pending council approval, the proposal includes installing 76 nodes throughout the City of Beverly Hills.

Mader said the police department needs better connectivity to do its job better and utilize the technology that is available.

"In fact, that's consistent with the chief's vision of utilizing cutting edge tools to solve crimes, increase our effectiveness in our jobs and better protect the community," said Mader. "The other aspect of this is to increase connectivity for the public themselves, for those who use cell phones in the North end, AT&T in particular."

The program will improve first responder wireless communication and provide safer 9-1-1 coverage. The equipment will be housed

in a cabinet on the ground and the antennas will be distributed on Beverly Hills street light poles or free-standing poles. Mader said there is also the capacity that other providers could share the cabinets.

Those who use AT&T in the City will have better cell phone coverage within the City of Beverly Hills.

Mader said Palo Alto has a similar system in place, but could not think of any other community in the region who had a system like the one proposed.

Automated license plate readers in BHPD vehicles rely on uninterrupted wireless service. Mader also the system could provide services to future technology as it develops. One area of interest includes installing cameras in police cars that would be able to feed to the department.

AT&T will bear the cost of installation and the City will receive payment from AT&T, but staff hasn't determined what the rate structure will be.

Though the nodes will be installed throughout the entire City and coverage will cover all areas of Beverly Hills, Mader said coverage is currently not as good in the northern part of the City. Mader said the Trousdale area in particular has almost no coverage.

Mader said the city council would consider this in February and if approved, the goal is to have the system running by 2014.

**Some business triangle property owners may see tax refund**

The Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce will advocate at the City Council meeting today for \$2.5 million tax refund to property owners in the business triangle when the City refinances bonds this year, according to a statement released by the chamber.

## Newman Seeking Inclusive Football Coach for BHHS

### Norman boys', girls' soccer teams defeat Morningside.

At least 30 people applied to become Beverly High's football coach by Friday's deadline, co-athletic director Jason Newman said.

Newman, fellow co-athletic director Vonzie Paysinger, Principal Carter Paysinger, a brother of Vonzie Paysinger, and possibly an assistant principal will soon begin reviewing the applicant's resumes, Newman said.

The position became open with the resignation of Donald Paysinger, also a brother of Carter and Vonzie Paysinger, after four seasons.

Vonzie Paysinger, who was the team's offensive coordinator last season, quickly and emphatically said no when asked he applied. He is also the school's baseball coach and said "it is so hard to be the coach in two high-profile sports."

His decision not to seek the football position means the end of the 23-season run of a Paysinger coach the school's football team. Carter Paysinger was coach from 1990 to 2008, until becoming assistant principal.

"We knew that it was going to end," Vonzie Paysinger said. "We knew that he was going to walk away when his son" Cameron completed his high school career.

When asked what he is looking for in a football coach, Newman replied "that because there are so many life lessons to be learned from participating in high school sport, particularly something as rigorous as football and emotional and intense as football, you need somebody who is skillful and knowledgeable in more than just the Xs and Os of how to play.

"You need someone who is going to be mindful of the role high school sports in a student's total educational experience. You need someone who knows and values the concept of inclusivity so that the 50th person on the team feels as part of it and valued as a starter."

Vonzie Paysinger said he is looking for a football coach who "can balance the academic load (and) the athletic load" for the players and rebuild the program "in the right way," by not having long winter and early spring practices and discouraging football players from playing other sports.

triangle formed a special tax district in 2002, which was underwritten through the issuance of bonds. The bonds generated \$13.5 million in street improvements along Rodeo, Beverly and Canon Drives.

The bonds in 2002 were in the amount

of \$16,215,000. Staff has recommended the council refinance the bonds to take advantage of a 3.3 percent interest rate. The current interest rate on the bonds is 4.9 percent. Staff estimates the district will save almost \$3.4 million over the next 15 years, with a net present value of \$1.5 million, according to the City staff report.

During the city council study session on Dec. 4, the City Council were presented with two option on what to do with the savings, one being to use a portion of the savings to fund improvements to the district and the other being to transfer the savings to the property owners. The City Council directed staff to conduct outreach to property owners

in the district. Outreach conducted by City staff found that the majority of property owners within the district prefer being transferred the entire savings via reduced special tax rates.

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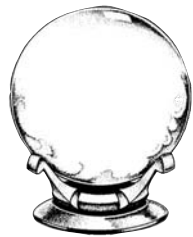
