Vote No On Proposition 10

Imagine going away for the entire summer, and during your 3-month vacation renting out your home only to learn that when you return, you have no right to evict your tenant without first paying relocation fees established by our City. Imagine the plight of your elderly parents who, rather than sell their home in Beverly Hills decide, for tax or other reasons, to rent their home to supplement their retirement or cost of assisted living, and that the income from their then rent-controlled home fails to keep up with rapidly rising medical expenses and living costs – will you have to step in to help or will they find themselves in need of government subsidies?

This November, California voters will have the opportunity to vote on Proposition 10, the so-called and ill-conceived "Affordable Housing Act." Proposition 10 will repeal a 1995 bi-partisan compromise known as the Costa-Hawkins Rental Housing Act, a state law that provided certain exemptions and limited relief to property owners from onerous local rent control ordinances. Now, coming this November, these protections could be abolished.

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OUR DATA SPEAKS VOLUMES



To be clear, if Proposition 10 passes, single-family homes, condominiums and any new residential construction within the City of Beverly Hills and elsewhere could be placed under rent control. If you own a house or condominium, passage of Proposition 10 could and likely will negatively impact not only your property's value, but it could reduce your planned retirement income too. If Proposition 10 passes, only the truly insane would risk staying in the rental housing business or building new rental housing let alone affordable housing – this loss of rental units will merely add to the already existing housing shortages in California.

As California voters begin to understand the details – and devastating implications – of the ironically named “The Affordable Housing Act,” stakeholders across the state are weighing in, and raising the alarm. If passed this November, Proposition 10, the November ballot initiative could have long lasting and devastating impacts on housing here in the State of California.

The San Francisco Chronicle's editorial board expressed deep concerns about Proposition 10's impact on budgets in Sacramento and localities throughout California. Citing the Legislative Analyst's Office's independent conclusion that its passage would cause hundreds of millions of dollars in state and local revenue to evaporate, it notes governments will likely be forced to seek broad – and steep – tax increases elsewhere.

In an article for Forbes, founder and Chief Executive Officer of the L.A. Property Management Group, David Crown, lays out the most basic concern of the issue: “repealing Costa-Hawkins would prove harmful not only to property owners but to California's economy as a whole.” But, do not just take his word for it: He notes liberal economist and Nobel laureate Paul Krugman told the New York Times in 2000 that the folly of rent control is one thing all economists agree on.

And if you are not already convinced, Alice Huffman, President of the California National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, believes that Proposition 10 “...will increase the cost of renting and make it even harder to find affordable housing. Prop. 10 is anything but affordable to Californians...”

Proposition 10 is flawed, and its passage could have devastating and long-lasting implications for all Californians. If Proposition 10 passes, California's housing crisis will be even greater. Proposition 10 is not a solution and will only make California's housing crisis worse. Proposition 10:

- DOES NOT increase funding for affordable housing
- DOES NOT facilitate building housing that local communities have already approved
- DOES NOT provide relief for people facing high housing costs

Proposition 10 will hurt the economy. Passage of Proposition 10 will mean less revenue for State and local government. According to recent economic studies, passage of Proposition 10 will lead to more than \$5.7 billion in lost economic output, more than 38,000 jobs lost, and combined loss of state and local revenue losses of

up to \$1.3 billion annually due to reduced property values and less construction-related economic activity in the state. The only way to make-up for the lost State and local revenue is for the government to tax you more!

This past August, during a study session, our City Council planned to take up the issue of whether to support or oppose Proposition 10. The discussion and proposed vote on Proposition 10 was postponed, but it will likely be addressed by our City Council again very soon.

Just recently, the City Council in one of the most socialist bastions within the State of California, the City of San Francisco, voted 7 to 4 against the passage of Proposition 10.

If passed, we in Beverly Hills and all of California lose. Please tell our City Council not to support Proposition 10. Vote no on Proposition 10 in November.

“City Details Policy Options for Rent Stabilization” [Issue 988]

Elia Weinbach's letter of last week, mockingly critical of the Beverly Hills City Council, the Human Relations Commission (HRC), HR&A Advisors, and the Rent Stabilization Ordinance (RSO), is a warmed over version of an epistle from Weinbach and other landlords to the Council in July. This is the same group that filed meritless lawsuits against the City in both state and federal court alleging that the Rent Registry component of the ordinance is illegal and unconstitutional. Many times they've demanded the City produce data proving the rent stabilization ordinance was in fact “Urgent”. But they don't seem to understand the irony of their posturing: Now that the rent registry enables the City to gather the information landlords claim is vital, they sue the City insisting that it stop gathering that information. Since the plaintiff in the federal lawsuit is the wife of Dan Yukelson, (Executive Director of the Apartment Owners Association of Los Angeles), our expectations of their objective analysis are frankly fairly low.

Weinbach's case is that the landlord group combed through records of the City's Code Enforcement Division from March 2013, through March 2017, and found only seven complaints related to rent increases and eighteen complaints related to eviction. Because there were so few complaints in a city of 7700 apartments, say the landlords, there was no urgency to passing the RSO.

The clear fallacy of the landlord conclusion is that they gathered data during the four year pre-ordinance period when 10% yearly rent hikes were permitted by law, and landlords could evict tenants for any reason (or no reason) with just 60 days notice and no relocation allowance. My own family was among them: evicted once, and later in another apartment slapped with a 10% rent raise.

Like many other families, we never reported the eviction or rent hike to the City because we knew that both were legal. Indeed, why would anyone file a formal

complaint with Code Enforcement if they were told by the landlord's lawyer via a letter citing applicable law, by their neighbors, and by City personnel, that the landlord was within his rights to raise the rent 10% or evict for no cause? Because it was pointless to file a formal complaint prior to 2017, few of us did. So Weinbach's numbers prove nothing.

Another error in property owner thinking was to assume that all inquiries about unconscionable rent increases and no-cause evictions went first to Code Enforcement. In fact, most of those inquiries were initially routed through the HRC or Community Development Department, never reaching Code Enforcement. Thanks to the Rent Stabilization Ordinance, a record of those calls is now kept. A review of that record, titled “RSO Constituent Inquiry Log” for the year July 2017-June 2018 shows that in one single year there were 4901 inquiries. Of those inquiries and complaints, 431 were about evictions and 542 about rent increases. So, it appears that the number of inquiries in this last year was about 150 times more than the number of formal complaints filed yearly with Code Enforce-

ment in the four year pre-ordinance period studied by the property owners. Although this method of data gathering doesn't claim to be scientific, it certainly leads to the obvious conclusion that during the four-year pre-ordinance period of the landlord survey many more renters made inquiries or complained informally than filed formal complaints. If Weinbach wants an explanation why the City “was not really interested in the data we uncovered,” he might start there.

Most disturbing is Weinbach's alarming rebuke of the City Council and HRC, public servants in constant touch with all segments of our community. Before the ordinance ever saw the light of day, many families like mine recited stories at numerous HRC meetings about their no-cause eviction, about churches and synagogues losing members; from school authorities about falling enrollment in our schools, from senior citizens on fixed incomes with nowhere to go. In short, our public servants spent countless hours doing their job. They deserve applause, not derision.

Under the pilot program, the City tested to determine whether or not South Santa

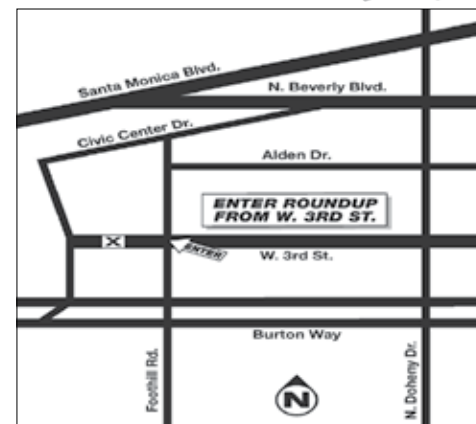

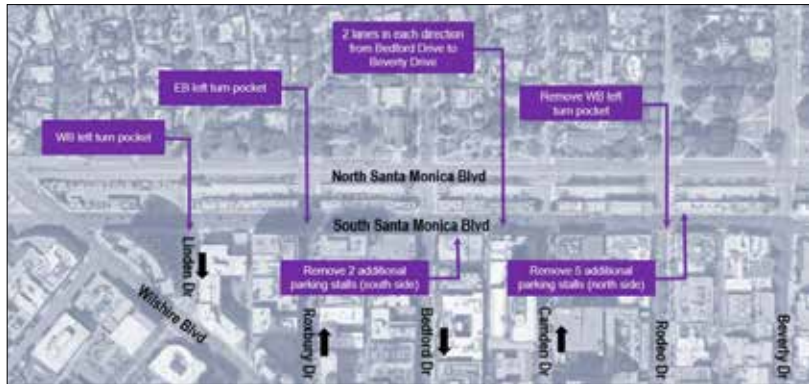

potential redesign of the street to include one lane in each direction as part of the City's Complete Streets program. The pilot program reconfiguration included 8' parking lanes on both sides of the street with 46 on-street parking spaces, one eastbound travel lane between Bedford and Beverly Drives and limited left turn pockets.

The new, restriped version of the street, which the City estimates will be complete in October, will return South Santa Monica Boulevard to its pre-construction configuration.

It will feature two 9' travel lanes in each direction, 7' parking lanes on both sides for a total of 39 parking spaces, the removal of seven parking stalls installed during the pilot project and the removal of the westbound turn pocket at Rodeo Drive.

The commission appeared to take a different stance on the pilot program from the Council, debating whether or not they believed ending the program would resolve any of the traffic issues that were reported on South Santa Monica Boulevard previously.

"It's still going to be bad. This isn't going to change anything. We're just going to lose parking," Commissioner Jake Manaster said. "Seven spots, that's what we're losing."

"We're going to lose parking and also the funding spent on striping and, now, going back and restriping," Meshkaty said. "That's the Council's decision, so it is what it is."

Manaster responded by pointing out

that the pilot program was not a commission-created project, but was instead developed by City staff as an attempt to address traffic concerns like congestion and pedestrian crossing.

"We looked at a hybrid which the City Council out of hand rejected. I personally think they out of hand rejected it because

they didn't understand it, but there was a middle ground between these two that they didn't take," Manaster said.

"Part of the reason is that the agenda item for that came up at around midnight at that Council meeting," Meshkaty said.

"Well, to quote [former Mayor] Nancy Krasne, nothing good ever happens after 11 p.m. in the City Council chambers," Manaster said.

In the future, Commissioner David Seidel suggested items like the pilot program be left off of the agenda for commission meetings.

"Our role is to be as helpful and useful to the City Council as possible, but if we're going to spend hours and hours over months working on an issue where our contribution is zero that's not good for anyone. As we plan future meetings, I say we keep items like this off the agenda or include them at the end in the staff report," Seidel said.

Athletic Alumni To Induct Five Into Hall of Fame

The Beverly Hills Athletic Alumni Association (BHAA) will induct Warren Tetly, Deena Newman, Alby Silvera, Steven Fenton and Ryan Karp into its Hall of Fame on Saturday.

Tetly, a Beverly High 1965 graduate, played football, basketball and baseball while in school. He was a 4-year letterman in baseball and was selected All-League in basketball during his junior year. He also received the Most Valuable Player award in basketball and football, as well as the Exchange Award for baseball. After

graduation, Tetly went to the University of Utah and lettered on the freshman football team. He was voted Most Improved Player on an 8-2 team during his senior

year at Utah before beginning his career as a history and physical education teacher and coach. He has coached football, basketball, baseball and girl's softball. He was voted Elementary PE Teacher of the Year in 2016 after 40 years of teaching. Newman, who graduated from Beverly in 1975, was a four-year varsity starter on the basketball and volleyball teams in high school and held a 45-year record for most rebounds in a game. At Beverly, she also served as captain of the volleyball team and co-captain of the varsity basketball team. Newman attended the University of California, Davis for the first two years of college. She was a starting volleyball player both years and was picked to be on the all Northern California soccer team. She transferred to the University of California, Berkeley her junior year and began to take an interest in dance, yoga, kung fu and tai chi. She went on to study the Alexander technique, a reeducation process that results in greater coordination and ease as hidden patterns of tension are released, and later used her knowledge of the subject to help others overcome pain. Newman now works as a movement specialist and Alexander technique teacher and is working on a graphic novel about her experiences as an anthropologist.

Alby graduated from Beverly High in

1981. During his time in school, he played as quarterback on the football team and was voted Player of the Year for high school baseball. He played in the area all-star baseball game in his senior year and was honored as Player of the Game. After graduation, he played baseball for the University of Southern California Trojans, where he beat Barry Bonds' batting average by one point. He was selected during his junior year of college to play for the USA National team and later went on to play professionally for the minor leagues in Washington.

Fenton graduated from Beverly High in 1988 after serving as co-captain of the Beverly High varsity soccer team and as a First Team All-League and First Team All-West Side Baseball Player. In high school, he broke the single season school record for hits. He later attended Pomona-Pitzer College where he was co-captain of the baseball team, was named a four-time All Conference Second Baseman and two-time regional All American, and smashed the school record for career hits. He later worked for 15 years as a talent manager at the William Morris Agency. In 2009, he became the youngest Board of Education President in Beverly Hills history. Currently, Fenton is president of Leeza Gibbons Enterprises and lives in Beverly Hills with his wife, Leeza Gibbons.

Karp graduated from Beverly High in 1988 after playing for the school's football, baseball, and basketball teams. During his senior year, Karp was named to the All CIF Southern Section for his baseball accomplishments in hitting and pitching. He later attended Los Angeles Harbor College where he was a JUCO All American in 1989 and won a State Championship in his sophomore year. His post-collegiate career highlights include signing a minor league contract with the New York Yankees, being named New York Yankees Minor League Player of the Year in 1993 and, in 1995, making his Major League debut with the Philadelphia Phillies. He retired in 2000, finishing his Major League career in 16 games with a 1-1 record and 5.29 ERA. Currently, Karp is the Vice President of Global Tax Technology for State Street Corporation in Boston.

Famed Food Critic Jonathan Gold to be Inducted into Beverly High Hall of Fame

Jonathan Gold, the Pulitzer Prize-winning Los Angeles Times restaurant critic and Beverly High 1977 graduate who informed the world about the city's vast culinary offerings, will be posthumously inducted into the Beverly High Alumni Hall of Fame, the school's Alumni Association recently announced.

Gold, who died of pancreatic cancer in July at age 57, wrote about restaurants for four decades, focusing largely on street food, ethnic restaurants and hole-in-the-

wall eateries. This focus made him a pioneer in the world of food criticism, which previously focused on Michelin starred and high-end restaurants.

Gold spoke about his decision to highlight off-the-beaten-path eateries in his work in a 2015 interview with Vice, noting that he hoped to break down barriers that

prevented Angelenos from venturing outside of their comfort zones.

“I am trying to democratize food and trying to get people to live in the entire city of Los Angeles,” he said. “I’m trying to get people to be less afraid of their neighbors.”

His earliest reviews appeared in L.A. Weekly, where, in 2007, he became the first restaurant critic to win the Pulitzer Prize for criticism. Gold is the only food critic to have ever won the award and was named a finalist for a second time in 2011. Gold’s other awards include the M.F.K. Fisher prize for distinguished writing and the Craig Claiborne Distinguished Restaurant Review Award.

During his stint at the Los Angeles Times, Gold wrote more than 1,550 print stories and headlined several of the newspapers annual events, including the Gold List, Food Bowl, and the three-day Taste festival.

Gold is survived by his wife, Laurie Ochoa, and two children.

Residents, Commission Oppose New Whittier Drive Home

Several residents opposed to a proposal for a 41,000 square foot home at 901 North Whittier Drive spoke out against the project at the Design Review Commission meeting on September 6, which ultimately resulted in the commission voting unanimously against the project.

The project, first reviewed by the commission in July, will return again for review after architect John Ruzicka redesigns plans for the home.

As presented, the home would feature

a “stealth-like, highly contemporary design,” according to Beverly Hills Associate Planner Georgana Millican’s report. It was this design that residents opposed

most strongly, claiming it would not fit into the more traditional architecture in the neighborhood.

“There’s no question in my mind that this home is totally out of character with everything that we have in our neighborhood. It’s more like a sister project to the Beverly Center than it is to one of the homes on our street, which we believe is one of the most beautiful streets in all of Beverly Hills,” said Richard Bronson, a residential and commercial real estate developer who has lived on North Whittier Drive for 18 years. “It’s way too big. Who needs 42,000 square feet in a home? Beyond that, it would change the character of what we have which, as I said, we think is beautiful.”

In a letter read out loud by his wife, Lucy Billett, North Whittier resident Stu Billett echoed Bronson’s remarks, noting he thought the proposed home was much too large for the neighborhood, which is currently home to residences in the 9,000 square foot range.

“Our block consists of single-family residences all in the 9,000 square foot range, all of which were built in various decades from the 1920s to the 1960s. Yet, we are all compatible with each other due to the size reference of our lots,” Billett wrote in the letter. “To even entertain the inclusion of a 41,000 residential dwelling into this mix is unbelievable. While I believe in new ideas and concepts I cannot comprehend that my city would allow this proposed project to move forward. I strongly oppose this proposed new project.”

Norman Namerow, who has lived with his wife on Whittier Drive for 43 years, agreed and referred to the project as an “abomination” that both he and his wife felt did not fit in with the neighborhood aesthetic.

Other residents appeared less concerned with the proposed size of the home and more concerned about keeping in tact historical homes constructed by well-respected architects like Carleton Burgess, who crafted the home immediately adjacent to the project site at 907 Whittier Drive.

The owner of the 907 Whittier Drive property, Munsman, questioned how it was possible for such a large, contemporary home to be considered for the street when, during the construction of a home

gym at his property, he was made to keep the “integrity of the street” by using all of the original materials and brick at his home.

“I’m adding on a gym to my house and the conversation we had when it was proposed was about keeping the integrity of the street and keeping all of the

same, original materials. It was told to me that I couldn’t even drill into the brick because we don’t want to hurt the aesthetics of the house because it’s an original,” Munsman said. “To put this on our street

with the way it looks, on a street with homes built by some of the finest architects in history, is inappropriate. It’s going to stand out as such a sore thumb that I can’t even express it to you.”

The commission itself was especially concerned with one of the more unique aspects of the design, which featured two options for either a vertical wooden screening device or a partially twisted horizontally oriented metal shading screen.

Commission Chair Ilona Sherman questioned whether or not the applicant had looked at designing the home without inclusion of either element, noting that without the screen the project would be less of a “massive contemporary structure.”

“We have studied it without the screen and that elevation is in here, but I think it’s unfair to look at it without the screen because it has always been involved,” Ruzicka responded. “I think the owner is attached to it, as are all of us on the design team. Removing it makes the house look a little bit naked.”

Commissioner Mahnaz Sharifi suggested that Ruzicka take a look at the commission’s criteria for proposed projects before bringing a redesigned version before them again on October 4.

“I understand that with the reaction you’re probably wondering what to do next, right? I think when you do the design next time you need to have some consideration of the neighborhood, obviously, and you know, in terms of materials we have the criteria that we judge our projects on,” Sharifi said. “I think you should look at these and question whether or not your design is really answering to prevailing site design patterns. You don’t have to be exactly colonial or exactly traditional, but you need to have respect for the rest of the neighborhood.”

Music and Religion: The Winans Family

Beverly Hills Board of Education candidate Marvin Winans Jr. comes from a long line of gospel musicians with deep ties to the religious community in Detroit.

Winans’ great-grandmother, Laura Glenn, performed as a singer with the Congressional Church of God in Christ, and it was her influence that led his grandparents, Delores and David Glenn Winans Sr., to pursue music together as “Mom and Pop Winans.”

David Winans, better known as Pop Winans, was both a gospel music singer and band manager, best known for managing the gospel group ‘The Winans,’ which starred Marvin Winans (Candidate Winans’ father) and his brothers Ronald, Carvin and Michael Winans, and as the father of daughter CeCe and son BeBe Winans, who have established themselves as gospel music notables in their own right.

Pop was also known throughout Detroit as a preacher and philanthropist. He founded a youth organization in 1968 dedicated to keeping children off the street by involving them in activities like Little League baseball, a track team, and arts and crafts. His wife, Delores Winans, was also musically inclined. Together they received a Grammy award nomination for their CD “Mom & Pop Winans” in 1989.

In August, Winans spoke about Pop Winans when he attended an event at the White House to discuss prison reform with President Donald Trump and a group of 17 urban pastors.

“When you were speaking, you talked about how important faith was to community and how it helps the family,” Winans told Trump, according to The Detroit News. “My grandfather did that, working odd jobs – was a taxi driver, he cut hair, he did everything possible, but he also had them in church and he kept them together. Our family was able to do

things a lot of families weren’t able to do without the assistance of having faith and church.”

Church undoubtedly played a role in Winans’ life as his father, also named Marvin Winans, founded The Perfecting Church in Detroit in 1989 after he left “The Winans” musical group. Music and religion often intersect for Winans, who has released two albums featuring his church’s choir and, in 2007, released “Alone but Not Alone,” which was nominated for a Grammy award for Best Contemporary R&B Gospel Album. In February 2012, he preached the eulogy at Whitney Houston’s funeral at New Hope Baptist Church in New Jersey.

Vickie Winans, Candidate Winans’ mother, debuted her own solo album, entitled “Be Encouraged,” in 1987. The album resulted in a Grammy nomination for Best Contemporary Soul Gospel Album, a Stellar Award for Album of the Year, and an Excellence Award for Best Female Contemporary Artist. She received another Grammy nomination for Best Contemporary Soul Gospel Album for her third album, “The Lady,” and later earned a third Grammy nomination for Best Soul Gospel Album after releasing 1997’s “Live in Detroit.” She also received two Stellar Award nominations for Best Female Vocalist and Best Video after the 1997 album release. She has continued making music and released her latest album, entitled “Thy Kingdom with the Clark Sisters” in 2018.

Candidate Winans carried on his family's musical legacy from the age of 16, when formed his first-ever singing group, "One Way," with his cousin Michael Winans Jr. and friends, Karl Jackson and Lance Bennett. They made their first-ever appearance on New Year's Eve in 1996 at Perfecting Church in Detroit, where Winans' father serves as pastor. He and Michael later joined "Winans Phase 2" with their cousins Carvin Jr. and Juan.

"Winans Phase 2" debuted at #1 on the Gospel Billboard charts, sold over 250,000 records, and performed shows in the United States, Germany, Holland, London, and Amsterdam. They also performed on The Oprah Winfrey Show, Donnie & Marie, and the Queen Latifah show. In 2002, the group toured the U.S. as part of the Winans Family Tour. Winans released a solo album, Image of a Man, in 2008.

More Than 52K Parking Citations in 2018 So Far

Approximately 52,975 parking citations were given out by the Beverly Hills Police Department in the first seven months of 2018, according to the department's most recent traffic report.

There were 9,207 citations in May alone, followed by 9,166 citations in June and 6,688 in July. Fewer parking citations were awarded in colder months. January, for example, saw the fewest number of citations for the year at 5,312.

The City is working to mitigate problems associated with parking and parking enforcement through the development of Preferential Parking Permit zones. Traffic and Parking Commission Chair Nooshin Meshkaty said in August that the commission felt unifying parking regulations would be the make enforcement significantly easier for the police department.

"We want to make these parking zones and regulations as unified as possible because right now each street has a different permit area. That's very difficult to enforce," Meshkaty said. "Once they're

unified, enforcing rules becomes easier." On August 9, the commission voted unanimously to consolidate 100 blocks south of Wilshire Boulevard between Spalding and South Camden Drives into one zone, called the "AD" zone. Included

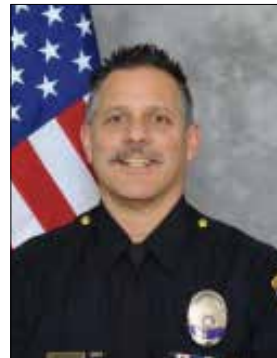
in this zone is the 100 block of McCarty Drive. Now, the City is looking at establishing preferential parking zones in other areas to allow "fair access to parking, the preservation of the character of residential blocks, increase the rate and effectiveness of parking enforcement, and allow the Traffic and Parking Commission and Transportation Division to devote time and resources to broader issues of traffic and parking across Beverly Hills," according to material distributed in July.

Other data included in the report showed that there were a total of 9,740 red light photo citations, 3,270 signed citations, 96 speed violations, and 149 DUI arrests in the first seven months of the year.

As part of the instructional class, attendees are taught to use 'Stop the Bleed' emergency kits, which include a military-style tourniquet, compression bandage, gauze, protective gloves, and instructional material on bleeding control.

Earlier this year, Beverly Hills became the first city in the nation to place these kits in all government and school district buildings.

"Beverly Hills is the first city in the country to have all of its civic buildings and schools completely equipped with the kits," Les Bronte, former Mayor and Vice President of Beverly Hills CPR, said. "It's a great program that was designed to

The Weekly's Interview with Beverly Hills Bar Association President LaVonne D. Lawson

Tax attorney LaVonne D. Lawson, of the Law Office of LaVonne Lawson, will be named President of the Beverly Hills Bar Association (BHBA) at the organization's annual Installation and Awards Dinner on Tuesday, September 25. She spoke with the Weekly on Wednesday about her goals for the upcoming year and BHBA's community outreach programs.

Every spring the Beverly Hills Bar Association gives scholarships to law students who have demonstrated an ongoing commitment to legal public service. What role will you as president have in awarding those scholarships?

We're very proud of being able to offer those scholarships through the Beverly Hills Bar Foundation. They really drive the process of awarding those. BHBF President Linda Spiegel does a great job with it and she will actually be the one to put together a team of people to look over applications and give interviews to those who apply. I have previously been a part of that interview process and I anticipate that I will probably be asked to be involved in that again this year, but that's very much in the Foundation's domain, so to speak.

What do you hope to accomplish during your one-year term as President of BHBA?

This is an exciting time for me personally, but it's also a very interesting time for all of us. This year, I want to really recognize the change that has happened in the legal community in terms of the practice of law and the changing role of bar associations in general. My goal is to look at and examine our member's needs so that we can figure out how best to respond to those needs, which include things like technology, new areas of

practice, how to deal with competitors. We really want to take a look at things on the ground and respond so that we are a bar association for the current century. I also want to make sure that we are nurturing our relationship with other bar associations, but also with legal and non-legal organizations. So, what I really mean there is that I'm hoping we can do more outreach and connect more within our community so that we are seen as a go-to resource for information. I think we're doing that well by developing teams within our community, by which I mean that association itself, to make it stronger.

You currently provide counsel to businesses and individuals in tax controversy and litigation and previously focused on issues impacting start-up companies in addition to serving on the Board of Trustees of the Los Angeles County Bar Association. How will this background help you in your role as BHBA President?

I think it really has to do with the issue of engagement. In my work, I deal a lot with other people and their personal and business needs. I have to interface with a lot of people, and I think that the fact that I like doing that will help inform my leadership this year. I'm all about empowering people and recognizing the needs that actually exist and need to be addressed. I like to figure out ways to connect with people and help them solve their problems or, in other words, empowering them to be active on a committee or join one of the more specialized groups that we offer to address concerns they might have. So, I think my background will help me connect with people and get them to engage with the organization, but also with each other.

BHBA offers several community

“Our goal is to get as many buildings and civilians equipped with these kits as possible,” Bronte said. “Then, we want to train citizens, and especially children in high school, on how to treat those who've been wounded as a result of a tragedy.”

More than 125 Beverly Hills residents attended the last ‘Stop the Bleed’ class. Other courses offered by Beverly Hills CPR include adult CPR, infant CPR, automated external defibrillators (AED) training and first aid and Heimlich Maneuver trainings. The full list of classes and class schedule are for viewing online

service programs, like the legal clinic at Roxbury Park and Teen Court. Tell me a little bit about these programs.

The Barristers, who are young attorneys very early in their career, once a month, put on the Roxbury Park legal clinic. Anyone in the community can go there and ask any question they might have. Our Barristers will then try to answer that question and offer any help they can. If a question or situation that is brought to them needs more engagement or assistance than they can offer, the Barristers will generally refer the person to one of our other services and help them get connected. The Barristers also have a program where they go, make a meal and feed the homeless once a month. Another one of the services we offer is Teen Court. We're very proud of our Teen Court program. It allows young people to act as a court to come up with solutions for teens who otherwise would be put through the legal system.

In terms of things we're doing to reach outside of ourselves and get involved in the Beverly Hills community, we're hosting free programs where we provide information to the community on a wide range of issues. Earlier this year, for example, we held an event on gun control where we gathered together to discuss the issue. We want to be a go-to resource for the community. Another of our new programs that we're hoping to see more involvement in is the Committee on Empowering Women. We started that last year after receiving feedback from our women members who were saying they wanted to learn new ways to address issues they were facing in their careers. They were also asking how they could network and support each other.

There seemed to be some specific needs there that we could meet by developing a committee, so we did that. So far they have done a combination of things, from getting together just for fun to hosting

sessions on marketing and networking and how to grow their practices. It's really a place for women to come together and make themselves stronger.

Did you receive any advice from past BHBA presidents, like Richard Kaplan or Howard Fisher, about the position?

One of the things I really love about our organization is that we are large enough to have access to a lot of tools and resources, but we're small enough that we all really know each other and are able to get engaged with one another. We are also incredibly fortunate to have had very accessible and wonderful leadership. Both Kaplan and Howard Fisher have been very supportive and, really,

wonderful resources for me any time that I have a question or concern. They never hesitate to offer me help or give me advice.

Other officers being sworn in on September 25 are President-Elect Michael R. Sohigian, Adam Siegler, Second Vice-President Anthony Ross, Secretary/Treasurer Malcolm McNeil and immediate past president Richard D. Kaplan.

Outstanding service awards to be presented include the President's Award to Jeffrey A. Shane, the Board of Governors Award to the BHBA Committee on Empowering Women Founding Members, the Chief Executive Officer's Award to William Wenzel, the Barristers Lawrence J. Blake Award to Lauren Rebecca Gabbaian, and the Louis B. Fox Award to Lawrence H. Jacobson.

teach civilians how to be first responders in the event of a major tragedy, shooting, bombing, or any other terrible event like some we've witnessed in the past couple of years. We teach them how to protect themselves and their family and friends, and also how to treat wounds if they are able.”

Bronte also explained that kits in schools and governmental buildings are kept inside of defibrillator boxes, and said that any citizen who wants to purchase a kit for their home can do so at the Beverly Hills CPR Training Center for \$70.

Normans to Play Host to Cerritos in Homecoming Game Two quarterbacks sidelined in loss to Gardena

With quarterback Thomas Recuperero knocked out of the game by a helmet-to-helmet hit on Beverly High's first possession and third-stringer Alex Vaca sidelined in the third quarter, the Norman offense was held without a touchdown for the second consecutive game in a 36-6 loss to Gardena in an intersectional football game Friday at Nickoll Field.

Recuperero suffered what coach Jarrod Bunch called whiplash and was "pulled for precautionary reasons," Bunch said.

With second-string quarterback Nicholas Sullivan sidelined by injury, Bunch turned to Vaca to replace Recuperero.

Beverly Hills trailed 6-0 at the end of the first quarter and 13-0 at halftime, with the Panthers scoring their second-quarter touchdown on a fumble return.

"We had some momentum and that killed our momentum," Bunch said.

After Vaca was injured "it was literally street football," Bunch said.

"We had to find anybody who could

play quarterback," Bunch said. "Whoever thought they could take a snap, we put 'em in and it just didn't work."

The Normans (1-2) allowed 17 points in the third quarter and six in the fourth.

"Our defense was on the field too much and they started getting away from us," Bunch said.

Freshman Dan Menache caused and recovered a Gardena fumble in the fourth quarter and ran 80 yards for Beverly Hills' touchdown.

The victory ended a 24-game losing streak for the Panthers (1-3) dating back to the final game of the 2015 season. The Normans have lost 23 of their past 24 games dating back to the final game of the 2015 season.

"We're going to have to learn to deal with adversity because it's going to come when you only have 22 players," Bunch said.

"There were some things that didn't go our way so it was a learning experience for the team that sometimes we have to play through things that don't work out for us but we still have to make it to our

advantage to get a victory."

What's Next?

The Normans are scheduled to play host to Cerritos Friday at 7 p.m. in a non-league game at Nickoll Field that will be Beverly Hills' homecoming game.

Bunch said he considers Recuperero questionable.

"The doctors say ... he can play if he feels good enough to play," Bunch said.

Sullivan would start at quarterback if Recuperero is unable to play, Bunch said.

A team has scored at least 63 points in each of the Dons (2-2) games this season. Cerritos was a 79-6 loser at Adelanto (4-0) last Friday. It opened the season with a 69-33 loss to Western, then defeated Firebaugh, 63-8, and Bolsa Grande, 68-27.

Bunch described the Dons as a "much bigger team than us."

"A lot of times we're over-matched but we have to figure out a way to win," Bunch said.

Cerritos defeated Beverly Hills, 22-16, in 2017 for their only victory of the season.
