Underutilization of Dog Park leads to proposals

At last Tuesday's Recreation and Parks Commission meeting, City staff presented an update on the community dog park. Planning for the dog park started in 2015 and it opened in 2016.

According to Senior Management Analyst Stephanie Harris, the City receives on average about five new applications weekly from dog-owners registering to use the park.

The demographic of people who use the dog park includes residents, non residents

within the city limits and hotel guests. City Council gave direction to the City to issue 200 tags and key-fobs to non-residents, but only 97 have been utilized.

Out of the 2,128 dogs that are registered, only 794 owners have picked up keyfobs. As of right now, the City only registers one keyfob per household. According to Harris, that number represents a little over 1,000 dogs based on the residents and workers who have the keyfobs.

In July 2018, the City installed a keyless entry system and key fobs were issued to registered patrons of the park. Key fobs are required to allow entry into the park when a Ranger is not present.

According to City Publicist Dana Beesen, City Council voted to install the keyless entry system to address security and registered usage while rangers were off-duty.

"In an effort to ensure safety while keeping operating costs efficient, a keyless entry system was presented as an option to allow registered patrons secure entry into the park when rangers are not present," Beesen said.

The City can track park visitors with its keyless entry system. According to Harris, the system logged 7,098 recorded dog visits since January 2019. Peak hours at the park have shown to consistently be from 8:00am — 10:00am and 4:00pm — 6:00pm.

Harris relayed the two major concerns about the dog park that have been brought to City staff by patrons; namely, the amount of shade available, and issues with the use of decomposed granite as ground material.

As the hottest months of the summer

are approaching, concerns about shade were discussed. Currently, the park offers shade from trees and standard patio umbrellas that are placed around the park--concentrated mainly around benches.

According to Harris, the umbrellas are not the best option, as they frequently need to be replaced. The City wants to look into options for a more permanent shading structure.

In the past, the Recreation and Parks Commission recommended the surface material and City Council approved it. Over the years residents have complained that the material has resulted in cuts in dogs' paw pads.

According to Harris, the City has ad-

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dressed issues regarding the coarseness of the material that's caused cuts. But she said the material does get kicked up by dogs running around, creating dust that residents disapprove of because it clouds the air and coats the dogs' fur.

Harris summarized some alternative options to decomposed granite that the City has considered in the past. Grass was not feasible in earlier years because of Southern California's drought. Artificial turf was extremely costly, and also heats up considerably when exposed to sunlight for long periods of time.

The use of wood chips as a ground material for the dog park was immediately ruled out-- as small insects and bugs get caught in them and travel with the dogs. Dogs also sometimes ingest the wood chips and get sick.

Commissioners agreed that the decomposed granite posed an issue and approved the City's efforts to research a more suitable option.

According to Harris, many of the issues that have emerged with the dog park are due to funding restrictions.

Most commissioners felt strongly about the importance of the community dog park and were disappointed at its underutilization.

"This park has a very unique offering in that it's monitored by a ranger and that means people can bring their dogs safely and know that aggressive and unregistered dogs will be removed, which is not true in other parks," Commissioner Julian Javor said. "That's a huge asset, and to have this be underutilized at this point merits a re-visiting. I would be in favor of looking at other [ground] options and shade options."

Commissioner Judie Fenton recommended that the City create a "Friends of the Dog Park" group to garner additional funding. Commissioners agreed, since now that specific projects have been outlined for the project, fundraising will be easier.

"There's so many other things that can be done in that dog park, but if you're constrained by the cost, it is what it is," Fenton said.

The Commissioners prioritized the items that they would like Harris to provide more research on when she brings forward her next proposal, they were: new

ground coverage, shading options, the possibility of a Friends of the Dog Park group and dog exercise equipment.

Harris will bring the issue back to the Commission sometime in August with a proposal packet outlining clear direction on specific issues that will then be brought to the City Council if endorsed.

Survey finds residents in favor of bringing pickleball options to city

At the Recreation and Parks Commission's previous meeting on May 28, Planning Commission Chair Andy Licht presented the communities desire for pickleball.

The Commission then agenda'd the issue for the most recent meeting and discussed the survey results at their meeting last Tuesday.

Pickleball originated in 1865 and is a combination of ping-pong, badminton, and tennis. In 1984, the USA Pickleball Association was organized to perpetuate the growth and advancement of the sport on a national level; with the first rule book published in that same year.

By 1990 pickleball was being played in all 50 states. Currently, the sport is growing in popularity within community centers, PE classes, YMCA facilities and retirement communities.

City staff revealed that the overall consensus of the survey showed a positive interest in and desire from the community for bringing pickleball to Beverly Hills.

Pickleball can be played both indoors or outdoors on a badminton-sized court and a slightly modified tennis net. The game is played as doubles or singles game, with a paddle and a plastic ball with holes. As pickleball is played on a small court, players do not have to move around as much, which is why many retirement-aged adults like to play.

Older residents play pickleball for exercise without having to play on a larger course that a sport like tennis requires. The USA Pickleball Association esti-

mates that about 3.1 million people play the game nationwide.

As part of an agreement with the City tennis concessionaire The Tennis Place INC., conducted and completed an evaluation that assessed the feasibility of including pickleball in their operations.

City staff also presented a short video to the commissioners that included recorded interviews with retired community members in other parts of the state who talked about the advantages of having pickleball courts in their neighborhoods.

"Pickleball is exploding in popularity, and the courts are fairly easy to set up and take down," Recreation Services Manager Jennifer Lev said, "With the survey in consideration, what we are looking to move forward with for pickleball is adding some temporary courts to the Roxbury tennis sites."

Commissioners heard from residents during the public comment section. According to avid pickleball players, a good solution would be designating specific times for pickleball and certain time for tennis. Lines may be painted in a different color on the existing tennis courts that set the parameters for pickleball.

Pickleball courts are much smaller than tennis courts, and the players don't need to move around as much to play.

The results of the survey also found that residents were in favor of incorporating pickleball, but not at the cost of losing tennis courts. According to Lev, the City plans to take that into consideration by making the pickleball courts easily transitional -- so residents can use the courts for both sports.

Commissioners were generally supportive of testing out transitional pickleball courts in the City.

"I'm willing to experiment with it as long as it does not push other [tennis] players out," Commissioner Susan Mishler said.

To move forward with offering pickleball, City staff will evaluate a location, select court times, consider the amount of courts to feasibly offer, determine the online infrastructure for pickleball reservations, as well as prepare and have City tennis concessionaire provide equipment sales, workshops, lessons, and tournaments for community members.

The City plans to have a minimum of two pickleball courts available for play by January 2020.

Commissioners unanimously approved a plan moving forward that include a trial period for transitional pickleball courts at Roxbury and La Cienega Parks.

Greystone Mansion to undergo improvements

Greystone Mansion Venue Coordinator Sara Scrimshaw presented on various updates and restorations that are scheduled or underway at Greystone during the Recreation and Parks meeting last Tuesday.

According to Scrimshaw, there is a new event under development that will be held in conjunction with Holiday BOLD in

December. Details are still being determined, but there will be free admission to the event.

An anonymous donor provided funding for tree planting along with some landscaping and irrigation on the west side of the grounds right near the mansion, replacing some eucalyptus trees were lost

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in heavy rains in past years. An original cedar tree planted by the Doheny family was recently lost due to heavy winds but has been replaced.

Various maintenance and restoration projects within the grounds are ongoing efforts to waterproof balconies, restore the mansions original theatre, maintain brick paths, update shelving in the library, restore woodwork and update the mansion's back pantry.

"Some of the brick paths are 90 years old at this point—the soil has been eroding and squirrels have made holes in them and we don't want any potential hazards," Scrimshaw said.

Each restoration and maintenance project has been approved by the City Council before beginning.

"Roughly how much does the City net from *Phat Cat Swinger*

all of the events [held at Greystone]," Commissioner Frances Bilak asked.

Scrimshaw said that Greystone generally brings in around \$400,000 to \$500,000 in revenue for the city each year.

Greystone is available for rental events by the public, and is usually rented out for weddings, corporate events, commercial and private photoshoots and filming.

They've recently started a new City program called "Inside the Mansion" to promote the mansion. Friends of Greystone also hosts open houses, courtyard concerts, "Hollywood Revisited," and Beverly High tours.

The City hosts a range of events at the mansion as well. There's "Music in the Mansion," "Classics in the Courtyard," father-daughter and mother-son dances, Theatre 40's "The Manor" and The Beverly Hills International Music Festival.

Residents also visit the grounds to enjoy the park where a variety of wildlife can be appreciated. According to Scrimshaw, park wildlife includes coyotes, deer, squirrels, butterflies and a number of different bird species.

During the recent statewide super bloom, many people visited the mansion to get a look at the many blooming flowers on the grounds.

The construction of the mansion and grounds was completed in the late 1920's, and the Doheny family moved in during 1928. The mansion was sold in 1955 before being purchased by the City ten years later. After the City's purchase of the property in 1965, a 19-million gallon reservoir and parking lot were constructed within the grounds.

Greystone was dedicated as a city park in 1971 and used by the American Film Academy (AFI) from 1969 to 1981. In 1976 Greystone was added to the National Register of Historic Places, and in 2013 the City pronounced it Beverly Hills Local Landmark No. 4.

Architectural Commission approves Gucci's request to install new signage

At the Architectural Commission's June 19 meeting, approval was granted multiple requests made by the high-end retailer Gucci. Gucci's building is located within the Golden Triangle, at 353 N Rodeo Drive.



The request was for a façade remodel, building identification signage, a sign accommodation to allow multiple business identification signs and a construction barricade graphic.

The new storefront will create a contemporary façade designed to complement the adjacent storefront to the south. The design incorporates a riveted metal framing design for the storefronts and façade and an opaque shadow box panelized glass treatment is specified as a specialty façade treatment.

The entry will be highlighted by an inverted glass atrium design and the predominant tone for the entire elevation is a pale green, to match the neighboring

storefront. A

recessed marble entry apron, to match the neighboring retail location, is proposed and ne signage is incorporated along the upper edge of the extended parapet.

Finally, the use of construction barricade was proposed to announce this new retail location during the construction phase for this project.

The property's façade remodel proposal included metal-framed glass cladding panels, exterior lighting fixtures, an ultra-clear glass storefront and entry system, individual channel-letter signage in marble veneer and a construction

barricade graphic.

All of these elements are in compliance with the Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC).

The two new business identification sign will include one 12 square feet sign located on the primary construction barricade elevation and as six square foot sign on each construction barricade return. The third installation will be a brand-specific graphic.

The Architectural Commission unanimously approved the Gucci's request to make improvements to its Rodeo Drive storefront.

Public Works Commission discusses Integrated Water Resources Master Plan

At last Thursday's Public Works Commissions special meeting, the City's Integrated Water Resources Plan (IWRMP) were discussed. The plan was for the commissioners to discuss the plan, potential outcomes and project priorities.

The IWRMP is a comprehensive analysis of the water resources systems in the City. The IWRMP aims to provide actionable and achievable capital improvement plan for the existing water system, sewer

system, and stormwater system.

The plan addresses key issues such as local water supply, emergency storage, and aging infrastructure. The IWRMP will be a roadmap for addressing the needs of the City's water resources systems.

The current water system in the City



includes 173 miles of pipelines, ten reservoirs, and ten pump stations. The sewer system includes 98 miles of pipelines. The stormwater system includes 47 miles of pipelines, culverts, and channels.

Another important aspect to the project is addressing aging infrastructure. 31% of the City's water system was built before 1930 and 49% of its sewer system was built in 1930.

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Q&A Frank Mirahmadi

Santa Anita Racetrack Announcer

You've worked as a track announcer at many well known horse-racing tracks in the past. Tell us about that.

Absolutely! I grew up in Beverly Hills and my dad used to take me to the track a lot as a kid. We started by going to tracks like Santa Anita, Hollywood Park and occasionally down at Del Mar. I called my first race ever at Hollywood Park in 1992. I had learned as a young man how to imitate voices and I started imitating track announcers and that's how I got my first break, by imitating a couple of Hollywood Park announcers on their closing day-- Christmas Eve of 1992. A couple of years later I was working in advertising but I kept traveling and pursuing my dream and eventually my first job that I got was as a fill-in at Hialeah Park in Miami. In 1996 they hired me full time and that was my first [announcing] job. So I left a pretty good job that I had at the time for a company that sold advertising on cash register recipients. So anyway, I left that and got the job at Hialeah which was a great fortuitous time to be in that area. After that I travelled a lot and was working all over the place-- a little place in Kentucky for a couple of quick seasons, a fair in Massachusetts and then eventually I needed up in California calling the Northern California Fair Circuit. My first real big job was in Arkansas at a track called Oakmont in 2012, I got a chance to call American Pharaoh when he won two big races before he won the triple crown. That was a great opportunity. Eventually I got to come back home to my favorite track in the world, Santa Anita. It's been quite an experience traveling around the country?

What has your experience as an announcer for Santa Anita track been like?

It's the track that I grew up loving, the chance to call Santa Anita is the absolute ultimate dream come true. As a teenager I became a really big fan of the racing at Santa Anita. My favorite announcer of all time, a gentleman named Trevor Denman who was the announcer at Santa Anita for over 30, was my idol. To be able to call races where he used to call

them is as good as it gets.

What advice did retired Santa Anita track Trevor Denman give you?

The best advice he gave me always was just basically "open your eyes and tell the fans what you see. Don't be intimidated by the fact that you're at the biggest track. Be open, describe what you're seeing and don't think about how big the stage is." He told me to show my love for the horses, jockeys and place and stay focused. He's been a huge supporter of mine from the beginning, he wrote a recommendation letter for me before my first job that I still have.

When did you first start becoming interested in horse-racing?

My dad loved going to horse-races and so he would take me and my little brother and my mother on the weekends. I became a fan immediately-- by far the biggest fan with me. Even when I connected with some of my friends from 7th grade at Beverly Vista [school], and some of them remember me reading the horse racing section of the newspaper. I just loved it-- it was a lot of fun and it was exciting, there was a lot of pageantry and I loved getting autographs from the jockeys. It became an immediate passion for me but I don't think I was planning on becoming an announcer. I actually always wanted to be a doctor but for some reason, I think it was just meant to be. I used to imitate announcers all the time so you would think that someone who's imitating them all the time would be thinking that's what they want to do. Also, when I was young,

we lived on Oakhurst and we had a pool, I remember there was a show in the afternoons called Horse & Jockey where you could listen to a guy who would recreate the races. My brother and I would swim in the pool and try to guess who would win and we'd even pretend to be horses in the pool racing against each other.

You played the role of Santa Anita track announcer in 'Seabiscuit,' what was that like?

That was an incredible experience. The reason they called me was because they wanted somebody who could imitate an old-style announcer. They didn't want me to imitate the guy that called those races, but they wanted somebody who could adjust their style a little but to do it. They flew me to New York. That year a horse names Sunnyside was going to the triple crown and all the producers were there. They brought me into a studio with a huge screen where they showed me a race with Seabiscuit a few times and gave me some names to use and had me call it several times. They liked what I did and they gave me that opportunity which is something I'll certainly never forget.

Santa Anita has had a lot of criticism lately, how do you respond to that?

I would say that there have been a lot of factors to what has been in the news. Santa Anita has taken initiative to put out some brand new safety protocols that are being embraced by the entire industry. I know they are taking the initiative to do that and they are absolutely committed. I'm very proud of what the management team at Santa Anita has done because it's not an easy thing to do but they have just made it the number one priority-- the safety of the horse. The things we have done in Santa Anita are all about safety and caring for the horses. I think that a lot of people are starting to recognize just how committed

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ter supply, emergency storage, demand projections, water efficiency, aging infrastructure, or others as identified in the workshop.

• Establish criteria to evaluate project implementation feasibility. Potential criteria include cost, reliability, schedule, emergency resiliency, risk of doing nothing, or others as identified in the workshop.

• Answer questions related to each priority that will dictate project implementa-

tion. It is expected that the following table will be completed by the conclusion of the workshop.

Commissioners were also instructed to take into account the cost of each proposed item, the ways that they might support the reliability of the system, if it will fit into the project's schedule, if the project includes aspects that prevent emergencies schedule and what the risk of not implementing each item would be.

As a result of the workshop with the Public Works Commission, the IWRMP team will move forward in developing

the optimal projects that align with the IWRMP priorities and project criteria rankings.

These projects will be incorporated into a capital improvement plan identifying project costs and implementation year. Out of that, a recommendation will be formed.

The meeting concluded the data collection and workshop phase, and moves the project into analysis and final report preparation. The IWRMP is scheduled for completion in April 2020.

Santa Anita is to maintaining its reputation as the great race place. I always call it the greatest race place. As with everything, it will take time for people and media members to acknowledge what we have done. The industry is very much behind it and today they voted unanimously to have the Breeder's Cup in Santa Anita. I think there were just a lot of factors that led to what happened and thankfully we addressed them. It's way above my pay grade but they're doing the right thing for sure.

You attended Beverly High in the 1980's. Tell us about some influential teachers.

Yes, and I left late in my senior year [1985] and I went to the University of Arizona. I didn't graduate from there but I have a lot of great memories from Beverly High. I still have many close friends from Beverly High, I think it's a great school. I would say [Barbara Zussman] was a good English teacher. There were some people that didn't like her but she was tough and she was good. The most unique teacher by far was a math teacher named [Paul Michalisko.] I'm an impersonator and I can vividly remember the way he used to call attendance, it was very strange. I remember his famous announcements, they almost sounded like a computer talking to you. The reason I remember that [actor] David Schwimmer was in that class was because of how he would say all of our names. I always remember how he would say 'Lawrence Miller' right before he said my name. It was a voice that you would never forget.

Where do you see yourself in a year?

I've landed the job that I've always wanted to have. I'm very pleased to be at Santa Anita and that I'm going to call the Breeder's Cup. I was at the very first Breeder's Cup in 1984 with my dad. I have a fond memory of that. My dad passed away in '87 and that's one of my last memories ever with him at the track. In November when I actually get to call the Breeder's Cup there's going to be a lot of sentiment and reflection on that day. For this to happen is just incredible. There were times that I even times when I took the bus to [Santa Anita] before I could drive of I'd have seniors from Beverly High drive. As far as in the business, Santa Anita is like the top of Mt. Everest so I've reached where I want to be in the horse racing industry and I'm very grateful for it.

Pamela, you and your mother, Renée Strauss, own and operate a company called Wedaways, tell us about that.

Wedaways.com is a luxury travel company and we serve both couples and wedding planners by offering them an invitation-only curated portfolio of five star luxury destination venues for the most refined wedding experiences and romantic travel getaways around the world. Our portfolio includes 250 venues so far in twenty-five different countries and that's growing every day.

How did you come up with this idea?

Wedaways is a marriage of both of our skill sets. My mom being in the wedding industry for 35+ years gave us a foundation in this business. I was living in Israel and working at a start-up, and that gave us the modern and progressive online approach. So we came up with this because there was an obvious hole in the industry and a need for our kind of business. We started our business with Italy, that was our first destination that we featured with venues in our portfolio, and we went to Italy and we met with about 100 different luxury venues and drove around the country for six weeks -- just my mom and I -- basically interviewing properties and understanding what they

wanted for destination wedding business -- and they all said the same thing. They want to reach the North American engaged couple, they wanted American weddings but they didn't know how to get them. So, we developed this online marketplace featuring these venues and marketing to North American couples. And the goal is for couples to choose a venue on our site and run with it. In the last year or so, we've expanded in that now we are a huge resource to wedding planners. We work with about twenty-five wedding planners in the US as their travel concierge team, pretty much. So we help them source the venues for their clientele, we take care of all of the travel logistics- and that brings more business with our properties and helps the wedding planners grow their own business and increase their venues.

Renée is a well-known wedding dress designer and TV personality. Did you expect to go into the same area of business as her growing up?

That's a good question, and I grew up in the bridal salon. It was there before I was born, and into my twenties. Instead of going to preschool, I went to the shop everyday. Even though I helped every weekend into my teens, and I really un-

derstood the business-- because my mom made sure to teach myself and my three brothers the business -- how to balance a checkbook, how to do inventory, how to do customer service -- I never thought I would go into the wedding industry. It was not a passion of mine. So I didn't go into the wedding industry, instead I went to UC San Diego, then I did my master's degree in Israel, and was going into a very different field -- of human rights and conflict resolution. And through that, I kind of entered this tech space, because Israel is so progressive; they're always finding new ways to "solve the conflict."

And there was a big push in technology. So I geared from this direct path of human rights life that I was going into and really loved the startup life. And realized, that truly I'm an entrepreneur, and it doesn't matter what the field of business is, the underlying main event is that I'm an entrepreneur, and when this opportunity arose with my mom and we saw this

amazing business opportunity, I jumped right into it. So it brought me into the wedding industry in a way in a very different way, and in a way I've very much grown to love.

You grew up in Beverly Hills and are a Hawthorne and Beverly High Alumna. Tell us about that.

Yes, I was born and raised in Beverly Hills. And with my parents having

businesses in Beverly Hills, and going to Hawthorne and Beverly High, I had a great experience. It was a very different experience than the people I surrounded myself with later as I grew up and went through my

Associate Planner for the City Reina Kapadia presented the project details from the staff report to the commissioners.

Chanel's temporary store will be located at the corner of Wilshire Boulevard and Camden Drive.



The tenant space at the corner of Wilshire Boulevard and Camden Drive has been long vacant and will be rented by Chanel while their permanent store undergoes construction.

Painting the façade a bright white tone while retaining the existing black storefront, installation of new awning made of white fabric. The proposal includes the installations of six signs on signs, which say Chanel in six-inch high letters—which is less than the maximum (seven inches) allowed by the Beverly Hills Municipal

Code's (BHMC).

The proposal also includes the addition of an elevated business identification sign in the alley. This sign requires approval for a sign accommodation from the Architectural Commission.

The urban design analysis for the project concludes that the proposal would create an appropriate branded location for the temporary location for Chanel at the corner of Wilshire and Camden Drive.

Chanel is in the process of obtaining the necessary entitlements to build a whole new flagship store at the corner of Rodeo Drive and Brighton Way.

"We needed to find a location that had great visibility and great parking so that we could continue to offer our products to not only the residents of Beverly Hills but

the entertainment world and also to the foreign visitors that we get from all around the world," Attorney Murray Fischer, representing Chanel, said.

The project aims to present the storefront with a chic and upscale luxurious style.

"The design really reflect the quality and luxury of the City of Beverly Hills, and it accomplishes Chanel's goals," Fischer said.

According to Principal of MBH Architects Ryan McNulty, Chanel will most

likely be at the temporary location for about two years before it's able to move into the new flagship store.

Some commissioners were confused about the high positioning of some of the business identification signs.

"One of the big things that we're going to be attempting to do as we start building the new store is trying to integrate way-finding to make sure that customers that are coming to the [currently under construction] 400 Rodeo space can find it easily," McNulty said, "putting the sign up at a higher elevation our anticipation is that it will help our customers have a clearer viewpoint to find the store."

According to McNulty, the signs that are positioned lower down on the storefront will also draw pedestrians into the store.

The Architectural Commission voted unanimously for the approval of Chanel's request to remodel the storefront of their temporary location site located at 9560 Wilshire Boulevard.

Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over This 4th of July Holiday

The 4th of July holiday traditionally a time when drunk driving occurrences spike on the road.

According to preliminary data from the California Highway Patrol, seven people were killed and 73 injured in alcohol-

related crashes statewide on the fourth of July last year. Every deadly crash involved a driver who had been drinking.

If you are headed to 4th of July parties, designate a sober driver before heading out for the evening. If you are hosting a party, offer nonalcoholic drinks for designated sober drivers and monitor who is drinking.

Check how people are getting home. Offer to let them stay the night if a sober driver is not available to take them home.

"Driving with just a buzz doesn't cut it," Mader said. "With the rise in ride-share options, there really is no excuse for driving impaired."

The average cost of a DUI arrest is approximately \$13,500, accounting for vehicle impound fees, fines, attorney fees, auto insurance hikes and other penalties.

The BHPD also reminds residents that prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications and marijuana can all cause impairment and land you a DUI, especially in combination with alcohol and/or other drugs.
