

#### City Council Sets Appeal Date for 9229 Wilshire Boulevard Project

An appeal date has been set by the City Council to review the Planning Commission's approval of a development plan review and density bonus permit for the construction of an eight-sto-

ry mixed-use development project with ground floor commercial uses and 56 residential units at 9229 Wilshire Boulevard, at its Tuesday meeting.

Six of the 56 residential units would be reserved for very low-income households. The project site is an approximately 20,665 square foot lot located on the northwest corner of Wilshire Boulevard and North Maple Drive. The commission's approval included waivers, as permitted by State Density Bonus Law, to accommodate the provision of the six proposed affordable housing units, according to a city staff report.

The waivers include the following:

- Building Height: Increased the overall building height from 45' to 83'-11", inclusive of rooftop restrooms;
- Number of Stories: Increased the number of stories from three to eight, inclusive of rooftop restrooms; and
  - Rear Setbacks: Reduced the rear building setback

As part of the Planning Commission's review, the commission evaluated whether the project met the findings for a development plan review, which ultimately they determined it did and unanimously voted to approve the proj-

The City Council previously brought up the project at a past study session and voted to not call the item up for review, citing constraints by state law. At that time, the City Council was not being asked to make any evaluation or assessment of the merits of the project.

Many residents voiced their concerns regarding privacy, a lack of parking for the property, security, construction impacts, safety, zoning, and more.

On Feb. 22, Aria Ahdoot filed a timely appeal of the commission's decision, requesting that the City Council review the approved waiver requests and require additional environmental review.

Specifically, the appeal alleges the following:

- The city incorrectly granted the waivers, which would subsequently have a negative impact on the surrounding neighborhood.
- The amenity space in the project could be converted to additional units
- The project does not qualify for a categorical exemption under the California Environmental Quality Act; and an environmental impact report (EIR) is required.

The public hearing was scheduled for July 2.

who lost their lives during the attack by Hamas on Oct. 7, which also authorized funding for 60-days through May 8.

The City Council also previously requested that city staff return to further discuss the installation. Subsequently,

at its Tuesday meeting, the City Council approved to leave the flags up through May 14 prior to the art show and bring them back at a tentative, future date.

The concept involved creating an art installation whereby one flag for each life lost is displayed, with

each flag being representative of the nationality of the individual.

In collaboration with the Consul General of Israel, the city installed the flags

on Jan. 24 with a dedication taking place the following day. The flags were subsequently removed on Feb. 26.

The city reinstalled the flags on March 9 and removed them on April 8 for land-scape maintenance. The flags were again reinstalled on Friday, April 12, and were set to be removed on Wednesday, May 8, for landscape maintenance and annual Art Show preparations.

The cost associated with each installation and removal of the flags is \$14,000, which includes a contingency for replacement flags and poles. The cost for 24-hour private security coverage for 30 days is \$55,080. When the flag display is removed again, the turf area will need to be reseeded, according to a city staff report. The estimated cost of this is approximately \$2,500.

Thus far, the city has completed the following: hosted a forum of family members of hostages to discuss the events of Oct. 7 and the plight of the hostages; shabbat table art display; flag art display; and approved a special event permit to project images of the hostages during the Vanity Fair party.

Each additional 30-day period costs approximately \$70,000, according to a city staff report.

The City Council indicated that it will plan out a more permanent solution for the flags, as well as explore options for a separate, more permanent memorial site dedicated to Oct. 7, which would be a similar concept to the 9/11 memorial.

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#### Beverly Hills City Council Approves Resolution Condemning Islamic Republic of Iran's Attack on Israel

The City Council unanimously approved a resolution condemning the Islamic Republic of Iran for last weekend's unprecedented attack of over 300 drones and missiles launched at Israel, at its Tuesday meeting.

"Last weekend's attack demonstrates the continued threat that the Islamic Republic of Iran presents to the world," said Mayor Les Friedman. "This Council has always demonstrated its support for Israel and its right to defend itself against all forms of terrorism and aggression. Today, we stand with the people of Iran but in opposition to the Islamic Republic of Iran."

The City Council's resolution condemns the "apartheid, racist, and genocidal Islamic Republic of Iran for its brutality, anti-democratic oppression of its citizens and documented human rights violations, especially against women, students, and minorities." It further demands increased international and domestic sanctions against the Islamic Republic of Iran.

As part of the action, the City Council urged elected leaders, public officials, and the international community to stand with Israel and the civilians of Iran during this critical time and to provide all necessary support to ensure the security and safety of its people.

Finally, the resolution calls for a de-escalation of hostility in the Middle East and for peace to be brokered in the region and the release of all hostages from the Oct. 7 attack by Hamas on Israel.

#### City Council Updates 2024 Legislative Platform

The City Council updated several sections to the 2024 Legislative Platform, at its Tuesday Study Session.

Every year, the city develops a Legislative Platform that consists of legislative themes and priorities for the forthcoming year. This platform serves as a guiding framework for the city's legislative advocates and staff, directing their efforts towards securing initiatives locally, in Sacramento and Washington, D.C.

The Legislative Platform priorities are arranged by category and significance.

The following have been added to the proposed 2024 Legislative Platform:

- Support legislation which repeals existing law that allows the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") to authorize fixed charges on a graduated income basis for residential customers, and instead impose a flat rate system.
- Oppose efforts by AT&T to end its Carrier of Last Resort (COLR) obligation for providing landline services.
- Support legislation which provides better protections to utility customers regarding drastic rate changes and changes to services as well as requires better notifications to utility customers when changes to services are being considered, in order for them to better voice concerns.
- Support legislation that would allow city attorneys to prosecute misdemeanor crimes.
- Consistent with City Council adopted resolutions and the city's strong relationship with Israel, the city unequivocally supports the state of Israel.
- Encourage cities to adopt the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance ("IHRA") definition of antisemitism.
- Support legislation to protect the public from the inappropriate use of AI.

Councilmember Mary Wells also indicated that the city should include a priority that would promote affordable home insurance options for those who live near a hillside area, as current state insurance plans are extremely expensive.

The City Council also added a section to support funding for added security on public transit as a way to protect riders, as well advocating for potential legislation that may permit stop sign cameras.

This Platform is meant to be an evolving document that will be amended each year by the City Council.

#### Shouhed Initiates Yearly Scholarship Opportunities For Graduating Horace Mann Students

Orthodontist Jonathan Shouhed has been working with the Horace Mann administration by finding ways to enrich the lives of students. This has ranged from a donation of a Yamaha Clavinova digital piano to scholarship opportunities for graduating fifth graders.

"We have selected a number of programs that provide maximum impact in providing our students experiences and opportunities that will generate momentum in their lives to be all they can be," Shouhed said.

The piano is valued at \$2,500.

"It has been close to 20 years without a donation of this magnitude to the music department," Shouhed added. "We hope to support the music and arts programs on a yearly basis and have begun discussing how to make maximum impact for the art program next year."

Shouhed's company, West LA Orthodontics, has also started a yearly scholarship opportunity for three graduating fifth graders at Horace Mann as a pilot project, with all the elementary schools of Beverly Hills possibly participating in the near future. The parameters of the scholarship are to submit a form of media, which may be written, picture, video or song, so that the student can explain how they plan to use science and

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West LA Orthodontics is also working towards a five year sponsorship for the science fair in an effort to inspire students to be creative through the use of science and technology.

"The goal is to engage students in thinking about their futures, use their critical thinking skills to solve problems and help students conceptualize how they can use their power to help others," Shouhed said. "We hope to uplift tomorrow's leaders and give them the inspiration needed to reach for their dreams."

Shouhed is a 2005 Beverly High graduate.

#### Cultural Heritage Commission Approves Criteria for Golden Shields

The Cultural Heritage Commission approved the criteria for the placement of Golden Shields within residential zones of the city, at its April 10 meeting.

The City Council requested that the commission review the current criteria due to concerns regarding privacy for the owners of the subject properties or neighboring properties.

The Golden Shield program was established to honor places of cultural or historic merit. The intent of the program is to allow the community to celebrate these places, as marked by a bronze plaque with text.

Last year, 12 new Golden Shield Award nominees were considered by the City Council. Ten of the nominees were granted the award and two sites in the residential zone were not selected due to potential future privacy concerns. The properties were the Lucille Ball and Desi Arnaz house, located at 1000 North Roxbury Drive, and the Rachmaninoff Residence located at 610 North Elm Drive.

The Council has requested review of the criteria for selection of nominees and ways that broader public outreach could be undertaken if further sites in residential zones are to be considered.

recommendation that was discussed was that if the homeowner does not agree to the Golden Shield, then there is no moving forward. If the homeowner and the two neighbors agree, then the three homes directly across the street will be notified. More than 50 percent of these homes need to agree to the shield, which is approximately four out of six residences. #### City Council Approves Amendment of Office Lease with Maple Counseling Center

The City Council approved an amendment with The Maple Counseling Center, as well as a one-time capital assets fund appropriation of \$119,037 related to the amendment for a one-time reimbursement to The Maple Counseling Center for work performed at 1945 South La Cienega Boulevard.

In June 2019, the city signed a lease agreement with The Maple Counseling Center for a section of office space at 1945 South La Cienega. Before handing over the premises to the tenant, the city had to carry out a set of landlord improvement tasks at its own expense. The premises were handed over to the tenant

on Aug. 16, 2021.

Following this, the tenant, at their own cost, made certain improvements to the space before moving in. Additionally, while completing their improvements, the tenant also undertook work that was originally the responsibility of the city.

The majority of the expenses incurred relate to the installation of HVAC duct distribution and the fire alarm system. During the construction phase, both parties concluded that it would be more effective for the tenant to handle the repair and reconfiguration of ductwork to align with the tenant's interior layout, rather than for the city to carry out pressure testing and patching/repairing of the existing ductwork, as originally outlined in the lease agreement.

Regarding the fire alarm system installation, the City of Los Angeles man-

dated that the tenant include a fire alarm system as part of their construction project. However, the city was responsible for executing all upgrades to building systems required by building codes.

# **Greystone Pool Restoration** in the Works

The City Council approved a contract with K.C. Restoration Co., Inc., for the Greystone Pool House Restoration and Waterproofing Project in the amount of \$1,795,479; as well as a construction contingency in the amount of \$269,322, and a a purchase order in the amount of of \$2,064,801, at its Tuesday meeting.

The interior of the pool house had extensive mold due to water intrusion when it rains, according to a city staff report. The first phase of the restoration project involved mold remediation and demolition of the interiors of the pool house, which was completed in 2022.

The second phase of the restoration of the pool house will include restoration of the trellis at the entry of the pool house, new waterproofing on the walls and roof deck, repointing of the grout at the exterior stone walls, and new interior finishes such as countertops, sinks, plumbing fixtures, flooring and paint.

#### City Council Approves Lease with The Paley Center for Media

The City Council approved a lease with The Paley Center for Media, which allows exclusive use of the ground floor room in the Beverly Hills Public Library known as the "Teen Zone" to provide free-of charge access to The Paley Library Collection, an archive of television and radio content that encompasses over a century of historical material, featuring a collection of more than 160,000 titles.

Paley is a non-profit organization based in New York, dedicated to fostering dialogue about the impact of television, radio, and emerging media platforms. Initially established as the Museum of Television and Radio at 465 North Beverly Drive in 1996, it was renamed to become The Paley Center for Media in 2007.

In 2020, the museum located on North Beverly Drive ceased operations. Following this, Paley secured a two-year lease at the Beverly Hills Public Library. The lease included a 192-square-foot study room designated for Paley staff offices, along with a 166-square-foot area adjacent to the study room. This space was intended for offering free access to the public to explore The Paley Library Collection. Subsequently, in 2022, the lease was extended for another two years, with its expiration set for Feb. 29.

However, Paley did not occupy the

premises as planned due to the pandemic and various other reasons. Thus, the study room remained accessible to the public throughout the duration of the lease, as the city continued to make it available for public use.

Paley has expressed their intent to bring the collection to the Beverly Hills Public Library in 2024. After further exploring Paley's goals and utilization of the study rooms and other areas, city staff recommended using the Teen Zone to minimize impacts to the library.

The city would collect \$5 in rent for the first five years and \$5 for the extension term, if extended. Paley would also pay \$650 per month, which would be increased by 3 percent per year, for the estimated cost of electricity, water, and related expenses. The city would not incur any direct costs, according to a city report.

#### City Extends Permit to Install Wireless Telecommunications Antennas

The City Council approved the first amendment of "Permit to Install Wireless Telecommunications Antennas on Light Standards/Poles and Vaults for Supporting Equipment" with New Cingular Wireless, at its Tuesday meeting. This amendment extends the term of the agreement to Sept. 30, 2029, as well as two, automatic five-year extensions.

According to a city staff report, the city provides a nonexclusive encroachment permit to New Cingular Wireless to place its wireless telecommunication antennas on light standards and vaults at several locations.

There are currently five locations where this equipment is placed, including Sunset and Ladera, Sunset and Greenway, Sunset and Beverly, Sunset and Foothill, and Sunset and Hillcrest. The current permit expires on Sept. 30 and there were no further options to extend the term under the agreement.

This amendment will provide a onetime payment of \$9,944. The annual permit fee per light standard will increase from about \$5,070 to \$6,000 beginning in Oct. The city will also collect a total of \$160,874 in annual permit fees for all five light standard locations through the extended date.

# BHPD Promotes Safe Driving Ahead of 4/20

With 4/20 approaching, the Beverly Hills Police Department is reminding everyone to celebrate responsibly and prioritize their own safety and that of others, as driving under the influence of marijuana is illegal.

"Whether it is on 4/20 or any other day, it is unsafe and illegal to drive under the influence of marijuana," Chicf Mark Stainbrook said. "It's important to make responsible choices, especially when it comes to getting behind the wheel."

If you plan to participate in 4/20 activities and consume marijuana, the BHPD is recommending individuals plan ahead, designate a sober driver, or consider staying in and ordering delivery from local establishments.

Studies have shown that the active ingredient in marijuana can slow reaction times and make it more difficult for drivers to judge distances and keep a steady position in their lane. If you see an impaired driver on the road, BHPD recommends you safely pull over and call 911.

# **CITY COUNCIL RESCHEDULES HEARING** FOR BUILDER'S REMEDY **APPEAL**

The City Council rescheduled a public hearing that would have considered an appeal for an application to construct a new 19-story residential and commercial mixed use building at the property located at 125-129 South Linden Drive.

The hearing is expected to take place during the second City Council meet-

City staff previously determined the application was incomplete.

The proposal currently exceeds zoning limits on density and height but the applicant believes the project "maintains vested rights pursuant to the Housing Crisis Act" and that the "Builder's Remedy provision of the Housing Accountability Act applies to the project."

The commercial portion of the proposed project consists of a 73-room hotel located on the first through fifth floors of the building. The residential portion consists of 165 apartment dwelling units, ranging from studio to two-bedroom units, located on the sixth through the 19th floors of the building. Of the 165 dwelling units proposed, 33 of the units are proposed to be reserved for lower income households.

Parking for the project is proposed within a four-level subterranean parking structure that would be accessed from an alley, providing parking for 126 vehicles.

The "Builder's Remedy" relies on the provisions of the Housing Accountability Act, by providing at least 20 percent of the total units in the development to lower income households.

The project is backed by developer Leo Pustilnikov and Ottinger Architects is currently designing the complex, according to Urbanize.

#### **OBITUARIES Dorothy Rice Chase** 1924-2023

Dorothy Rice (aka Dorothy Chase), a long-time Beverly Hills resident and visual artist who shot to stardom modeling for Christian Dior's "New Look" fashion line, has died. She was 98.

Rice passed away April 17, 2023, at her home in Beverly Hills. Rice was interned at Hillside Memorial Park in a private ceremony a few days after her passing.

To celebrate her life and art, her work is being displayed at The Bruce Lurie Gallery: "Dorothy Rice, A Retrospective: Paintings and Photography." The exhibition, which is open to the public, will be held at the 873 Via De La Paz, Pacific Palisades, CA from April 21-28, from 12 to 6 p.m. The exhibition will include selections of Rice's high art fashion photographs and an array of paintings, prints and silkscreens reflecting different periods from the artist's life.

Born in Brooklyn, New York, Rice came from a long line of artists. At age

rapher John Rawlings. Subsequently, she posed for pinups for the renowned painter Earl Moran, as well as covers for fashion, romance and detective magazines. After World War II, Chase traveled for Vogue to Paris to model for Dior's groundbreaking "New Look" collection.

Rice worked with the top high art fashion photographers of the 1940s and 1950s. She appeared in countless magazines, including Vogue, Town & Country, and Cover Girl. In April 1953 Rice was featured in Esquire magazine and described as "the girl who tops the list of the Ten Most Wanted Models.'

Rice also had a sizeable career as an actress. She appeared in more than one hundred theater productions, including on Broadway and off-Broadway, and costarred in several prominent television shows, including the Emmy-winning Fear on Trial with George C. Scott.

Rice was married to producer Stanley Chase who is known for the Tony Award-winning off-Broadway production of The Threepenny Opera, and his acclaimed feature film, Colossus: The Forbin Project. As Stanley's career transitioned into film and television, the couple relocated from New York City to Los Angeles.

Once on the west coast, Rice returned to her first love, painting. She became the first American woman commissioned to paint a mural in Mexico at the University of Guadalajara. In 1975, her Mexican series "Serenata Mexicana" was shown at the renowned Southwest Museum in Los Angeles for three months.

During her 50-year career as an artist, Rice achieved substantial success. "Nevertheless, Dorothy thought she was among many female artists of her generation who were either overlooked or undervalued," said family friend Mark Pittman. Over the decades, Rice's art evolved from painting oils by brush, to painting oils by palette knife, to watercolors, pastels, silkscreens and sculp-

Rice organized her art by collection, including Mexico, Israel, New York, California and International. For one of her most noteworthy collections, Israel, she was hosted in 1987 by the Former Mayor of Jerusalem Teddy Kollek. He proclaimed that Rice's paintings were 'the next best thing to being in Israel."

Her husband Stanley Chase passed away in 2014. Rice left no direct survivors
