

## “William Morris to Move Uptown”

I attended the William Morris DEIR meeting on July 25. Attendance was overflowing. After various presentations there were only three participants from the audience: a friend, my favorite Beverly Hills senior citizen, Rose Norton, and myself. My observations are as follows:

### PARKING SPACES

I believe there is some confusion as to how many are required. The confusion centers on code requirements versus the Bank of America (BA) covenant, and William Morris (WM) spaces at its existing locations. Covenants and existing spaces should govern.

The BA covenant is for 262 parking spaces. The developer believes that BA can do with 189 parking spaces. Why does the developer think that he knows BA customer requirements better than BA?

Although WM has 630 spaces at its present three locations, they only use two locations totaling 450 spaces. The third location consisting of 180 spaces should not be counted as it is leased to a WM tenant.

The retail requirement is 65 spaces and the restaurant requirement is 40 spaces. There also remains 238 spaces at the 265 N. Beverly parking structure. This is a grand total of 1055 spaces. As the project DEIR is proposing 665 spaces, there is a shortage of 390 spaces.

When the 500 space parking structure will be torn down, where will these people

park during the 2-3 year construction period. This was not addressed. It was left to the imagination. However, it cannot be assumed that the Montage garage will be available. That would be double dipping and I am sure Beverly Hills would not like to be accused of that.

Parking spaces appear to be compact and tandem. There is no mention of full size spaces, yet 50% of all vehicles in California are full size. WM executives and clients would not appreciate compact tandem parking, along with an understaffed valet service.

If In Lieu Parking is appropriate for this size project, the city could receive as much as \$12 million from the developer. Yet the money does not have to be spent on providing parking spaces.

### EGRESS

I believe that egress is through the alley west of Beverly Drive. Vehicles must travel north to Dayton, a one way street, then east to Beverly, Crescent, Canon, etc. Once inside the complex, it will be a challenge to exit in less than one half-hour. If anyone remembers, egress was one of the issues that killed the Gelson's Market project.

### TRAFFIC MITIGATION

The model used to evaluate traffic flow was not realistic. It assumed a 1-% per year increase in traffic but no consideration for the huge step increase when the Montage comes on line.

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## 8600 Wilshire Project delayed until October

Proposed development will go back to the applicant for changes after direction from City Council

Audience applause, murmurs and accusations, and banter between Councilmembers filled a Beverly Hills City Council meeting on July 24 because of one project that always brings in a circus: 8600 Wilshire.

With all the commotion, the development project that has been on the drawing board since April 2006 (the date the project was first sent to the Planning Commission) was sent back by the City Council to the applicant Colonial Partners LLC 8600 Wilshire for changes to be made and presented at the City Council meeting on October 2.

As it stands now the City Council is comfortable with some okays: including the proposed height of 61 feet. It is important to note the 61 feet is modulated, there is not 61 feet total it modulates back to soften the look, so the front appearance is more 49 feet. Other "okays" include commercial space of 6,383 square feet, an addition of subterranean parking and 14 additional parking spaces.

Mayor Jimmy Delshad said the project will generate less traffic than a code compliant building, and voters for the last election voiced most concern about the traffic impact to the city.

In the Environmental Impact Report, the alternative project, a code-compliant commercial project would generate an estimated 916 trips per day. The proposed 8600 Wilshire would generate approximately 244 trips per days. All estimated trips are estimated for weekdays not weekends, and are based upon the best estimate of what would occupy the commercial space.

The City Council indicated that they want to see the inclusion of affordable housing. Presented at the meeting, the applicant showed affordable housing with one parking space. Consequently Vice Mayor Barry Brucker asked the applicant to come back with two parking spaces for each affordable housing unit.

Vice Mayor Brucker has also asked staff to see about adding a 50 space public parking structure to the East side, the first public parking structure to be possibly added to the East side in 20 years. Because the development project is larger than code compliance the applicant will pay developer fees and EMS fees. Councilmember Brucker has asked whether those fees can be allocated to build the extra public parking structure, possibly under Stanley.

Councilmember Linda Briskman wrapped up a long discussion between the City Council and Councilmember Nancy Krasne about the town homes on the R-1 lot. What was proposed was two town homes for 4,200 square feet on the R-1 lot, making the total 8,400

square feet. For an R-1 lot, code allows an approximately 4,000 square foot home to be

built. Making the original proposal two times the code. This will be the first time an R-1 lot will be rezoned in the history of Beverly Hills, if approved.

Councilmember Krasne said she was not comfortable with going over what is allowed for the R-1, stating she did not know why the applicant could "not just play by the rules."

"Why buy a Chevy and think you are going to get a Cadillac?" said Councilmember Krasne about the applicant purchasing an R-1 lot and wanting to build more than allowed.

Councilmember Briskman proposed three town homes of approximately 2,800 square feet, one facing Stanley to make the town homes appear more in sync with the appearance of the rest of the homes in the surrounding neighborhood. Although, this proposal is still over code by over 4,000 square feet, Councilmember Nancy Krasne said she was now comfortable with three homes.

The City Council has asked the applicant to return with landscape plans. Vice Mayor Brucker asked the applicant to come back with a landscape plan that is robust on the Charleville side to break up any look of bulk and mass. Councilmember Briskman asked for additional landscape on Wilshire for more of a

cafe look to again break up massing.

Familiar faces of community stakeholders, who attended the June 26 City Council meeting for 8600 Wilshire, made sure to come again and stay until 11 p.m. for the project they are so passionate about. Resident Eileen Finizza who has lived in her home on Charleville and Stanley next to the R-1 lot for 28 years pleaded with City Council not to re-zone the R-1 lot surrounding her home for fear that it might de-value the property. She said when she purchased the property years ago, she was assured the R-1 lots would remain R-1.

"My home is the only thing I have," said Finizza.

A handful of other residents in the area spoke against the project, including Teresa

Chris Bushee, head of the Beverly Hills Education Association, spoke on behalf of the teachers, pleading for the City Council to approve the project on behalf of its' inclusion of affordable housing.

"By approving affordable housing, it will show employees in the district that the city's wants them to be members of the community," said Bushee, who said his mother was a teacher and was able to live in the city she taught in, forming a closer relationship with the community.

Bushee said most teachers cannot afford to live in Beverly Hills on a teacher's salary and are forced to commute. "With gas prices as high as they are, teachers might starting looking for jobs closer to home," said Bushee.

It is unclear whether or not the school district supports the 8600 Wilshire project. During the meeting, a letter from the attorney representing the school district was read into the public comments. The letter stated the attorney, who claimed he spoke on behalf of the school district, urged City Council to reject the Environmental Impact Report. The City Council was unaware of the letter until the meeting.

Vice Mayor Brucker stepped out of the meeting and called a Board of Education member, who said the district was unaware of the letter, and that the Board did not authorize the letter to be written.

Superintendent Kari McVeigh later confirmed the letter was indeed authorized by David Orbach to be written on behalf of the school district.

"Sending this letter the day of the Council meeting was simply irresponsible," said Brucker. "More disturbing is the fact that the Attorney [David Orbach] apparently sent the letter without the knowledge or authorization from the Board of Education. I think Mr. Orbach needs to lighten up on the Tabasco. The project is over three blocks from the nearest school [Horace Mann]. The entire City Council is extremely "school friendly" [both Vice Mayor Brucker and Councilmember Frank Fenton were past Board of Education Presidents]. We would never put these children in harm's way."

Frazer, Amy Simon and had her elementary age daughter, Ruby, spoke out against the project.

The mitigation proposals were items like additions and deletions of traffic lanes and turn lanes. These are cheap lip service items that do little to improve traffic flow. Real mitigation should consideration smart traffic lights, an underpass for Santa Monica Blvd. at Wilshire along with a pedestrian overpass, and believe it or not, vehicles should pay to enter the business triangle during peak traffic hours of 11AM-2PM and 4PM-7-PM. This is called congestion pricing. All new projects should include a fixed percentage of its cost for purposes of traffic mitigation. Mitigation design to be performed by the traffic department or its designee.

### OVERALL PROJECT SIZE

A former city official tried to downplay the size of this project as compared to nearby projects that are two to four times as large. These large projects may or may not affect Beverly Hills. However, Beverly Hills

is a small town, Beverly Drive is a narrow congested street and a 208,100 square feet project is a big deal, especially if not properly configured.

### OVERALL CONCLUSION

I was surprised at the lack of audience participation. Maybe this was due to the fact that the start time conflicted with the dinner hour, lack of interest, or inability to review the DEIR document.

I, as most of us, would like WM to remain in Beverly Hills. However, if this project is approved as is or nearly as is, the traffic, parking, and egress will force people to other areas than Beverly Hills for their needs.

The DEIR, as presented, does not address traffic, parking, and egress in a satisfactory manner. The project should not have been presented to the residents of Beverly Hills in its present form.

## BHUSD to enhance arts education plan with the addition of dance artists

BHUSD was approved by the Los Angeles County Arts Commission to participate in the 2007-08 Arts for All Residency Program, and will use the awarded grant to place dance artists in fifth grade classrooms.

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## City on Overload

A New Play For Theatre Forty

The city's in box is filled. Even a cursory look at all the projects working their way through city hall, both private and city originated, is a daunting effort.

Not even close to complete, but some notes on the good, the bad and some in between.

Of course, negative first. Still under consideration is a proposal to create a one-way street system on Olympic Boulevard, which we can control, and Pico Boulevard, not in our jurisdiction. At the same time, the city wants to decrease parking hours on Olympic. This latter has two neighborhood associations on opposite side.

A one-way program, geared to peak hour traffic could increase, not decrease, traffic through our city. If Olympic is really easier to travel, why would motorists take an unpredictable Santa Monica Freeway? Obviously, the program would also make movement around our high school and

Roxbury Park less manageable, and inconvenience residents going to shops and offices.

As for extending no-parking hours on Olympic, there are two negative impacts: Many of the apartments on Olympic have little or no parking, the end product of then myopic city leaders and greedy developers, and moving cars will create serious hardships. Secondly, if cars can't park on Olympic, there will be more congestion just north and south of the boulevard. Making it easier to rush through Beverly Hills may not be all that beneficial.

There are all kinds of city initiatives that could fill many columns. But briefly, one of the first steps in a closed circuit television surveillance system that could help make us an even safer community, is set for Rodeo Drive. Television's watching eye now covers almost every shop in and around the fabled street, but now the city will have the

added protection of outdoor monitoring. The whole program, first pushed by then Mayor **Allan Alexander**, and modeled after London's very complete eye on the street, will take some years and about \$17 million. But each step in coverage makes us safer.

Of course, if you are taking your associate to lunch and it's not National Secretary's Week, smile – you are on our finest's candid camera.

Greystone may actually soon have functioning bathrooms, not to mention electrical systems that will help you see the accommodations. Now the historic mansion is home to a variety of cultural events, including some great performances by Theatre Forty and it produces considerable revenue from film and television rentals and for special events, but an ambitious renovation program will make the mansion far more marketable.

No, I haven't changed my dream for the mansion – a world class museum, however, the improvements are a significant step in bringing the mansion up to community standards.

Last night, the Recreation and Parks Commission held a public hearing on the city's plans for major changes in Roxbury Park and some less ambitious hopes for La

Cienega. Next week, a closer look at the whole program. City staff has approached the projects in a very responsible, outreach manner.

Private projects coming up? Many have been fully reported and are close to the decision making process. A brief summary and some thoughts:

William Morris: Just north of the B of A and across the street from the under construction Montage Hotel and Gardens, This would be a mammoth increase in office space inside the triangle – some 208,000 square feet of which only 30,875 would be for retailing and a planned restaurant. Obviously, we want to keep our legendary agency within the city, but one of the first conditions we should demand is an assurance that the six floor building will remain as a home for the agency and that they will not find renting to others more profitable.

Although design is certainly very subjective, the early renderings I saw seemed less than what we should expect, especially on a street that will inevitably change once the Montage opens.

9900 Wilshire, the former Robinson's-May property. Now that London's Candy brothers have committed themselves to all the promises of a totally green project, this mostly condominium proposal at the city's western entrance will probably be the least controversial. The Candy's can point with considerable pride to their exciting creation in Great Britain, the One Hyde Park ensemble. New Pacific, the original proponents,

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who sold us on the environmental advantages and beauty of the development, seem to have found a successor willing to stay with the plan. Of course, selling was very profitable.

Hilton/Waldorf. This project has made so many improvements from its original development concept, as to require new thinking by the city and the residents. Far more open space, removal of unattractive parking structures, increase of lanes on Wilshire and Santa Monica and diverse entry parking systems to accommodate the different elements of the project have made this much easier to accept.

The revenue flow from the completed project is enormous and needs a special mention, but briefly the addition of the Waldorf Astoria brand to the Hilton Hotel will add another high rated hotel to our city – not just because of the name, but because of the design, amenities and high level of service.

The Legacy mixed use project at 9200 Wilshire is in the last stages of approval and will end a decades long vision of an empty lot on Wilshire. Not quite so wonderful is another mixed use proposal next to Saks on South Camden. The Planning Commission has sent it back for more EIR considerations of alternatives. This may simply be too ambitious for a south of Wilshire project close to residential.

Many of the Draft Environmental Impact Reports will all come out on the same month. Just slightly more exciting reading than the White Pages.

An almost native son, **Ron Cordova**, who decided to enter politics as a rare successful Democratic legislator in Orange County, will travel to Hungary next year to accept the highly prestige post of Visiting Professor of Comparative Law, faculty of law, University of Szeged in Hungary. The post was through the Center for International Legal Studies.

Ron is the son of **Lya Cordova Latta** and the late Dr. **Reuben Cordova** a former legendary school administrator for whom Theatre Forty's venue is named. Lya is, well, the ultimate community activist, in the best sense of the word, and one of Theatre Forty's staunchest supporters.

Speaking of Theatre Forty, and we seem to do that quite often and with good cause, they have a very good evening of theatre you can enjoy this month.

We saw "Modern Orthodox" last week, and it was really excellent even though you have to adjust to seeing a **Richard Benjamin** look alike in the lead role, made even more noticeable because the original was in the audience for opening night.

**Ross Benjamin** is so like his highly talented father, that it may take a few moments to adjust. But he plays the role of a secular Jewish professional whose life is turned around by the intrusion of an orthodox Jew, portrayed convincingly by **Michael Goldstrom**, with verve. About half way through the play be prepared for another familiar seeming face: **Shari Albert**, who has a **Barbra Streisand** look

and behavior that is very pleasant to the eye and ear. Shari walks a fine line between stereotype and believability as the new found love of the Orthodox romance neophyte.

However, although the cast were excellent, the work of **Robyn Cohen**, was the most true to character: touching, strong and yet many dimensional. This is an incredible talent and she displays every range of emotion in her role as the physician live in girl friend of the lead character, and always with believability – no stretching exaggerations, which could have been understandable.

In fact, although a comedy with a sensitive premise, there is nothing of the self-conscious flagellation often found in **Larry David** or even **Woody Allen's** approach to their Jewishness, For the record, "Modern Orthodox" does not define the play, only a designation given the Orthodox character when a listing of his religious loyalties are placed on a Jewish dating service web site.

The direction by the very creative **Howard Tecihman** keeps the play moving and well paced. All of this under the leadership of Theatre Forty's **David H. Stafford**, the theater's creative director. For info or reservations: 310.364.0535.



## CHANGING LIVES ONE SMILE AT A TIME

### The Weekly's interview with humanitarian physician Dr. Anthony Sokol

**Weekly: How did you first get involved in humanitarian medical work abroad?**

Dr. Anthony Sokol: I currently practice aesthetic plastic surgery, i.e. facelifts, liposuction, breast surgery, etc. In Beverly Hills, as I have done for over thirty years.

As I am a member of all of the local, national and international plastic surgical societies, I learned of the need for reconstructive plastic surgery in third world countries from the American society of plastic surgery as well as some my colleagues. Unlike the USA, these third world countries have no insurance or services to take care of children born with congenital anomalies. Therefore, a child born with a cleft lip or palate, for example, will face a lifetime of isolation and will never have the opportunity to lead a normal life or develop normal speech without these volunteer efforts.

**How are the patients located, and how do you evaluate them beforehand?**

Volunteer organizations, (rotary clubs), medical facilities, i.e. hospitals or doctors, in these third world countries, request a visit by a group of medical volunteers. The request is followed by an on-site visit to establish that there is a need for this surgical mission. In addition the onsite team establishes that there are adequate hospital facilities, sufficient in-country medical personnel, and support services that will accommodate an international team of volunteers. This team will consist of plastic surgeons, anesthesiologists, pediatricians, dentists, speech therapists, nurses and non-medical volunteers.

Once the above need is established and the criteria met, the local in-country hosts proceed to broadcast by tv, radio, and newspapers the dates of the mission. This allows all those indigent and needy children with birth deformities to prepare to come to the mission site for evaluation. These notices go out sometimes a year or years in advance.

After the mission is scheduled, the organizing center arranges for the appropriate number of surgical, medical, and other support personnel that makes of the team that is mentioned above. The team arrives 3-4 days prior to the proposed surgery. Children are evaluated and if they are healthy and meet the criteria, their surgery is scheduled over the next 5-

7days.

**What types of surgeries are most common?**

Surgical missions of this kind, accept children born with congenital defects that can be handled safely and completely within the confines of the schedule. In addition, the patients, are kept long enough in the hospital or adjacent facility



to insure their surgery is successful and any complications are anticipated.

**Give us a few examples.**

The most frequent operations are for cleft lip and palate deformities. There can also be eyelid problems (ptosis), ear deformities and hand and finger deformities.

**Tell us some of the places around the world you have traveled to perform surgeries?**

I have participated in 25 surgical missions over the past 15 years. I generally devote 1 month each year to travel to these third world countries with surgical teams. Some examples are Africa, India, Jordan, Morocco, Russia, China, Ecuador, Bolivia, Colombia, and the Philippines.

**Is it a challenge to find adequate medical facilities and resources in these third world countries?**

Yes it is. Therefore, the country must have certain basic facilities and resources. These countries must have adequate hospital facilities. The team will bring modern and technologically advanced equipment to insure the safety of the children's surgery. There must be in-country plastic surgeons, medical personnel, nurses, and hospital staffs willing to participate in these mis-

100 and 150 surgical procedures.

**What can other Beverly Hills residents do to help out with this type of charitable work?**

The Beverly Hills Rotary Club and its members have raised thousands of dollars to support these missions. This year, the rotary club sponsored a surgical mission to Santa Cruz, Bolivia. The team working out of rotaplast international of San Francisco, consisted of 40 volunteers including the past president, Jerrie Heslov and current president, Brad Robinson, Barbara Sokol, medical record specialist, as well as myself as one of the 4 plastic surgeons, performed 120 surgical procedures.

Another mission is scheduled for 2008 and will include members of the executive committee of the Beverly Hills Rotary as non medical volunteers as well as a team of national and international volunteers as mentioned above.

A surgical procedure costs between \$600-750 US dollars to change the life of a child. A similar operation here in the states would cost \$15,000-\$20,000.

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

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
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
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
