Horvath Votes Against Extension of Contract with LA County Law Enforcement

The L.A. County Metro Board voted last Thursday to extend its contract with the Sheriff's Department for another three years. County Supervisor Lindsey Horvath was the sole dissenting vote.

"We cannot handout tax dollars for services without knowing what we get in return," Horvath wrote on Twitter. "I voted NO on today's law enforcement contract extension b/c we have no specific details regarding deployment & accountability for those agencies."

Horvath said she is working to improve rider experience through a safety strategy that includes Transportation Security Officers, Metro Ambassadors, custodians, homeless outreach teams, community intervention workers, and mental health professionals.

"My expectation is that the negotiated contract includes strong accountability measures, a deployment strategy that makes sense, & ensures bias-free policing policies are used across all agencies. I need certainty that we are getting the most out of our investment of public dollars because too many people are counting on us to get this right. This is not too much to ask for.

City Hosts Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for First Emergency Supply Blox

On Sunday, March 26, members of the City Council attended the Ribbon Cutting of the City's first Emergency Supply Box at La Cienega Park. The event was hosted by the Beverly Hills Police and Fire Department as well as the volunteers from the 'Just in Case BH' program.

Approving the status quo is unacceptable," Horvath wrote.

Beverly High Not Meeting Instructional Minutes, Audit Says

On Tuesday the Board of Education reviewed the 2021-2022 District Financial Audit where it was relieved that Beverly High did not meet the required minimum annual instructional minutes.

A school district must meet or exceed the required number of days, which is 180 instructional days. The minimum annual instructional minutes for grades 9 to 12 are 64,800 minutes.

As a result of starting the instructional day at 8:30am, the annual instructional minutes were only 64,082 minutes. Therefore, the school site was short 718 minutes for the school year, which is approximately 43 seconds each period. This was the only school site within the District that was deemed to be out of compliance.

Since the District is not in compliance with State requirements, they are subject to a total penalty cost of \$135,669.

The auditor recommended that District management review school sites' instructional calendar and bell schedules prior to the beginning of the school year and ensure compliance with State requirements.

The District also did not meet the minimum percentage of 55% of the District's current expenses of education towards salaries of classroom teachers because the District spent 52.52% on classroom teach-

er salaries in the 2021- 22 fiscal year.

The District's current expense of education for the year was \$81,057,734.69 and the total salaries and benefits for classroom teachers was \$42,573,271.95. The District was below the minimum required percentage of 55% by 2.48% which calculates to a deficiency of \$2,010,231.82.

The deficiency amount was due to onetime funding received for COVID-19 relief funds. The District will file for a waiver from the County Office of Education.

Mirisch Appointed as Voting Delegate for General Assembly

The City Council designated Councilmember John Mirisch as the City of Beverly Hills' voting delegate at the Southern California Association of Governments Regional Conference & General Assembly Meeting on May 4-5, with Councilmember Sharona Nazarian as the alternate, at last Tuesday's meeting.

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) is the nation's largest metropolitan planning organization, representing six counties, 191 cities, and nearly 20 million residents. Every year, SCAG convenes to bring together the official representatives of SCAG's membership to set the agency's agenda and to vote on resolutions and bylaws.

SCAG was formed on October 28, 1965, when local elected officials from 56 cities and five counties convened to begin regional planning. Over the past five decades, SCAG has grown to become the largest council of governments in the nation, functioning as the federally designated metropolitan planning organization.

Planning Commission Approves 9900 North Santa Monica Project

At their Thursday meeting the Planning Commission approved a City-initiat-

ed Zone Text Amendment to add surface parking lots, film production staging, construction staging, partial assembly of temporary model building components, and temporary construction offices within the T-1 and T-2 Transportation Zones.

Additionally, the project included a request by the owner Roxbury Managers for a conditional use permit to allow for construction-related parking and staging associated with an offsite project on a vacant lot located at 9900 North Santa Monica Boulevard. This request allows for the project site to be used for construction parking and the staging of materials and temporary offices for One Beverly Hills located to the north of the site.

It was also proposed that the site be used as a privately-operated surface parking lot after the construction of One Beverly Hills has concluded.

The site is currently a vacant lot. It has recently been used for construction and parking for the Waldorf Astoria project. The project site is located within the T-1, Transportation Zone, which is part of a strip of properties that run along the south side of North Santa Monica Boulevard.

The T-Zone Parking Map was established for the allowable uses in the T-1 and T-2 zones. Properties located in the zone were able to establish surface parking lot uses if the property was identified on the map. Originally the map included three city-owned properties. These properties were removed from the map when the properties were rezoned in 1998.

From 1998 until 2015, no eligible properties were included on the T-Zone Parking Map. In 2015, the City Council adopted a resolution to temporarily add 9900 North Santa Monica Boulevard to the map. This amendment allowed 9900 North Santa Monica Boulevard to be used during the construction of the Waldorf Astoria.

Part of the resolution made it so that the map will automatically cease to be in effect at the conclusion of the sixth year, unless the City Council approves an extension.

Since this approval was not renewed prior to its expiration, 9900 North Santa Monica was removed from the map. Subsequently, the map does not identify any eligible properties at the moment.

It was proposed that instead of using a process where properties are temporarily added to allow for parking and construction-related uses, that the municipal code be amended to instead allow these uses be approved through a conditional use permit. This is intended for a more regular process through which the Planning Commission may review each request.

The commission adopted resolutions that recommend approval of the zone text amendment to the City Council; and, conditionally approve the requested Conditional use permit, which is contingent upon the Council's approval of the zone text amendment.

Mobile Parking Payment Option Coming in Spring

At last Tuesday's City Council meeting a Mobile Parking Payment Option update was listed on the agenda as an informational item with an overview of the new mobile parking payment option coming this spring to the Santa Monica Five parking structures.

Mobile payment is intended to offer a convenient option for customers to pay for parking by text or through an app. The use of mobile payment will be extended to on-street meters later this year and to the parking garages next year.

There are approximately 2,600 single space on-street parking meters in the City. There are also 14 parking garages that utilize a Parking Access and Revenue Control System (PARCS) and five parking structures along Santa Monica Boulevard, known as the 'Santa Monica Five,' that are equipped with self-service pay stations that accept credit cards or cash.

Mobile parking payment systems provide customers with a way to pay for parking from their phones. After Parking Services implement mobile parking at the Santa Monica Five structures, they intend to follow with the single on-street space parking meters, which will be enforced with License Plate Recognition and integrated with the PARCS in the parking garages. The parking rates at all meters and garages will remain the same, although a small service fee per transaction will apply.

The City has negotiated an agreement that includes a marketing and public outreach plan intended to familiarize individuals with mobile payment.

The Santa Monica Five is expected to be completed in May. On-street meters are expected to be completed in the fall, and parking garages are expected to be completed by early next year.

Signs indicating the new payment option will be installed at locations in each structure.

The cost is estimated to be approximately \$10,000 for the first year.

City Council Reduces Chamber of Commerce Subsidy

The City Council approved a recommendation to the agreement with the Chamber of Commerce for Business Attraction and Retention Services for Fiscal Year 2022-23. Additionally, the Council reduced the purchase order for Fiscal Year 2022-23 with the Chamber by \$213,505 for a new revised total of \$327,025.

The City contracts with the Chamber to provide a range of economic development programs, that is meant to retain existing businesses and attract new businesses. The Chamber's original work plan included a mix of programming that typically recurs annually, as well as new initiatives that reflect current City Council priorities. Last Oct. the proposed New York Business Attraction and Retention Mission did not occur. Additionally, the proposed Miami Business Attraction and Retention Mission also did not occur.

Furthermore, the City met with staff from the Chamber to discuss the effectiveness of use of the Buxton Economic Support Database tool. It was then determined the Contract was not providing what the City needed and ended early.

The City and the Chamber have mutually agreed that no funding will be provided to the Chamber for the New York Mission that did not occur, which would have cost

Hammer Museum Opens Lynda and Stewart Resnick Cultural Center

The UCLA Hammer Museum held a weekend of celebrations on Saturday and Sunday, March 25 and 26, for the Lynda and Stewart Resnick Cultural Center.

"We are thrilled to welcome everyone to a reimagined Hammer Museum and the newly named Lynda and Stewart Resnick Cultural Center. It's beyond gratifying to see these new spaces filled with powerful artworks spanning an entire city block of Wilshire Boulevard, inviting the community into the museum. I'm grateful to the generosity and support of Lynda and Stewart Resnick, as well as our board chair Marcy Carsey and so many generous donors to our campaign, which have brought us to this milestone that has been more than twenty years in the making. It's been a joy to work so closely with Michael Maltzan all these years and to celebrate this moment together," Museum Director Ann Philbin said.

In 2018, the Hammer announced a \$180 million campaign to fund construction of its transformation and build the museum's endowment. Leading the campaign was a \$30 million gift from philanthropists and co-founders of The Wonderful Company, Lynda and Stewart Resnick, in recognition of which the museum's building was named the Lynda and Stewart Resnick Cultural Center, and a \$20 million gift from Marcy Carsey, chair of the Board of Directors.

City Council Approves Support for Amini Human Rights Act

At last Tuesday's meeting the City Council approved the recommendation from the Legislative/Lobby Committee to support H.R. 589 – Mahsa Amini Human Rights and Security Accountability (MAHSA) Act, and Senate Bill 44 - Controlled Substances

The Mahsa Amini bill would require the executive branch to determine sanctions on Iran's Supreme Leader, the officials of Supreme Leader's Office, the Supreme Leader's appointees, Iran's president, and entities as well as the economic conglomerates affiliated with the Supreme Leader.

Senate Bill 44 would require a person who pleads guilty, no contest, or is convicted of possession for sale or purchase for purpose of sale, including fentanyl, peyote, and other narcotics to receive a written advisory of the danger of manufacturing or distribution of controlled substances and that, if a person dies as a result of that action, the manufacturer or distributor can be charged with murder.

Additionally, the City Council opposed Initiative No. 21-0042 "The Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act" and Assembly Bill 742 - Law enforcement: Police Canines.

The Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act would amend the State Constitution with provisions that limit voters' input and authority; adopt stricter rules for raising fees and taxes; and may make it more difficult to impose penalties and fines for violation of local and state laws, according to the staff report.

Assembly Bill 742 would prohibit the use of an unleashed police dog to apprehend a person and any use of a police dog for crowd control.

City to Host Earthquake Preparedness Month in April

Earthquake Preparedness Month is held each April in an effort to encourage members of the community to take steps to prepare for earthquakes. A variety of activities designed to reach all segments of the community, including residents and employees, will be conducted throughout the month.

The City will focus on the importance of earthquake preparedness with the "When It Rocks...Are You Ready to Roll" campaign. The campaign has two components: Employee Preparedness and Community Preparedness.

The City encourages residents to review their disaster plans, stockpile supplies, and sign up for emergency alerts.

Businesses are encouraged to become Disaster Ready partners. Disaster Ready is a formal recognition of preparedness

efforts taken by the business community. Materials and instructions on how to become an active preparedness partner are available at www.beverlyhills.org/disasterready.


