OpenBH Code Changes and Fees Draft Ordinance to Move to Planning Commission

At last Tuesday's meeting the City Council directed staff to start to prepare a draft ordinance for the Planning Commission's review at a public hearing in regards to the OpenBH program.

The Council previously approved extending the temporary OpenBH program for an additional nine months through Sept. 30 while the OpenBH Subcommittees continue their work.

The City created the OpenBH program in June 2020 to allow businesses to temporarily expand their services to adjacent outdoor areas such as private parking lots, sidewalks, and metered parking spaces, otherwise known as parklets, through a no-fee Special Event Permit. This was in response to the pandemic.

The new proposed fee system provides different fees for open air dining located on the public sidewalk adjacent to the restaurant located in a parklet on the street, and provides different fee rates based on the area the restaurant is located.

The City chose to utilize a tiered fee system because they believed the lease fee should be assessed in a manner that correlates with the location's demand and foot traffic. Locations with higher demand will be assessed a higher lease fee, and streets with lower demand and rental rates will be assessed fees that are slightly lower.

Tier 1 includes North Rodeo Drive, North Cañon Drive, North Beverly Drive, and Beverly Cañon Gardens, and would charge \$1.75 per square foot for sidewalk dining and \$2.00 for parklet dining. Tier 2 includes other streets in the Business Triangle and South Beverly Drive, and would charge \$1.50 per square foot for sidewalk dining and \$1.75 for parklet dining. Tier 3 includes all other streets not listed in Tier 1 or 2 and charges \$1 for sidewalk dining and \$1.50 for parklet.

After the Planning Commission has reviewed the draft ordinance, it will be presented to the City Council at a public hearing for adoption. City staff is aiming to adopt the permanent OpenBH program ordinance by Sept. 30 so it becomes effective before this date.

City Approves Purchase of *Trinity* by Judy Chicago

The City Council approved the acquisition and installation of the artwork, Trinity, by artist Judy Chicago. The "all in" cost of the acquisition is \$550,000 including the purchase of the artwork, fabrication, engineering, inspections, permits, installation and transportation, creation of the base, and lighting.

The selected location is at the Northwest corner of Crescent Drive and South

Santa Monica Blvd. adjacent to the Crescent Drive parking garage elevator structure at City Hall.

The Arts and Culture Council Liaisons had previously reviewed this proposed acquisition and had recommended this location as the preferred location for installation of this sculpture.

On Nov. 18 Chicago joined City staff for a site visit and agreed to install the sculpture at the selected site.

Two significant changes were identified at the time of the artist's visit. The requirement to install the artwork on a concrete base to ensure longevity and protection of the artwork instead of installing the artwork flushed to the grass is one change. The artist also has selected Musky Mulberry as the color to be used for the concrete base which is intended to complement the artwork.

Since these two changes deviate from the original information that was reviewed, the updated information needed further review and approval.

The City Council approved to increase the amount that was allocated for cost from the originally approved amount of \$500,000 to \$550,000, to account for inflation and the recommended integral concrete colored base.

City staff will return to the City Council with information on the value and historical appreciation of other works by Chicago.

Otazu, Tway Accept New Positions

Nestor Otazu, a 25-year employee of the City of Beverly Hills, has been selected as the City's next Deputy Director of Rent Stabilization.

Otazu previously served as the City's Community Preservation Manager overseeing compliance with various property maintenance, land use, building, and health and safety regulations. As Deputy Director, he will administer and enforce the City's Rent Stabilization Ordinance.

"I am very pleased to welcome Nestor to this new role," Director of Community Development Timothea Tway said. "With almost three decades in Beverly Hills and his directly relevant experience working with both our tenants and landlords, I'm confident he will thrive in the position and enhance this critical division of the City."

Otazu joined the City in 1998 as a Building Systems Technician before shifting to Code Enforcement Officer in 2000. He was later named manager of

the division in 2008. During his tenure, he has worked to expand the depth of service and program operations to seven days a week. Otazu has also managed and administered rent stabiliza-

tion codes and tenant and landlord processes.

In 2017, he took an active role working with City leaders in the implementation, rollout and development of the new Rent Stabilization Program and rent registry.

Timothea Tway, Director of Commu-

nity Development for the City, has also accepted the same role for the City of San Luis Obispo, effective June 19.

"I am deeply grateful for my 11 years in Beverly Hills and will tru-

ly miss the people I work with and the community members I have come to know so well," Tway said. "As a San Luis Obispo native with family still living in that City, this is a rare and special opportunity that my husband and I believe is the right decision for our young family. I would like to thank the members of the Beverly Hills City Council and City Manager Nancy Hunt-Coffey for the opportunity to serve as Director."

Tway joined the City of Beverly Hills in 2012 as an Assistant Planner and later served as Associate Planner, Senior Planner, Principal Planner, and City Planner before being named Director in 2022.

The City will announce the process for selecting a new Director of Community Development in the coming weeks.

City Council Maintaining Drought Measures

The City Council decided to maintain drought measures in support of continued water conservation in the region, at last Tuesday's meeting.

This includes continuing "Stage C" of the City's Water Conservation plan, restricting landscape irrigation, and prohibiting the use of potable water for outdoor irrigation between 9am to 6pm.

The City Council previously moved to join Colorado River Municipal Conservation MOU pledging increased conservation action within the service area.

Due to increased rainfall and snow-pack in the Sierra Nevada's and the State Water Project Allocation being adjusted to 75%, Governor Gavin Newsom modified previous issued Emergency Proclamations and made it no longer required to impellent Level 2 actions identified in their Water Storage Contingency Plans and the voluntary 15% water conservation target being removed.

The existing statewide emergency regulations prohibit the following until Dec: outdoor watering that lets water run onto sidewalks, washing vehicles without an automatic shutoff nozzle, washing hard surfaces like driveways or sidewalks that don't absorb water, street t cleaning or construction site preparation unless no other method can be used or as needed to protect the health of safety of the public, filling decorative fountains, lakes, or ponds without a recirculation pump, outdoor watering within 48 hours after

at least 1/4 inch of rainfall, and watering decorative grass on public medians.

Watering decorative grass in commercial, industrial, and institutional areas, including common areas of homeowners' associations, is also prohibited until June.

City Launches New Homeless Survey

The City is currently preparing a homelessness plan and is seeking feedback through a community survey, which is available through June 10.

Some questions asked in the survey include the following:

- Has your experience with the unhoused in Beverly Hills been better or worse than in other cities?
- How many times per week do you encounter the unhoused in Beverly Hills?
- What measures can the City of Beverly Hills take to improve this?
- How would you rate the City's current approach to addressing the needs of unhoused residents in Beverly Hills?

The city currently addresses homelessness through the Beverly Hills Outreach Team (BHOT), who conducts daily outreach on the streets of Beverly Hills and at weekly hot meal programs offered by the local faith community.

City Council Approves Father Day Car Show

At their May 2nd Study Session the City Council approved a request for funding and street closures for the Rodeo Drive Concours d'Elegance Father's Day Car Show to be held on Sunday, June 18.

The Rodeo Drive Concours d'Elegance has become a legacy program held in the City since its creation in 1993. In 2022 both a car rally and stationary car show was held as the transition year out of COVID. For 2023, the Concours event will return to solely a stationary car show along Rodeo Drive.

The 2023 Concours event is scheduled from 10am-4pm on Rodeo Drive. This is one hour longer than past years that usually ran from 11am-4pm. The expanded time is in response to the anticipated growing crowd size.

The event funding will include a combination of sponsorship funds, exhibitor booth fees, City funding, and fee waivers. In previous years, if sponsorship dollars were raised in excess of projection targets, any excess sponsorship funding was to be provided to the City. In 2022, the final event closeout included \$14,512 in funding that may be used to rollover to 2023.

In 2022, the street closure fee was waived for the street closures on Rodeo Drive, Dayton Way, and Brighton Way. For 2023, the street closure fee was again requested to be waived.

For the 2023 Concours event, the requested City funding contribution is \$254,540. Additionally, sponsorship revenue in 2023 is projected to be \$250,000 and exhibitor fee revenue is projected at \$5,000. This is a \$12,070 increase in funding requested compared to 2022 and an \$80,000 increase in sponsorship dollar revenue compared to 2022, with a \$20,000 decrease in exhibitor fee revenue compared to 2022.

Street Closures will be in effect on Saturday, June 17 at 9pm through Sunday, June 18 at 10pm.

New Pedestrian Crossings in the Works

The City is currently evaluating locations to first implement new pedestrian crossings that were previously approved by the Traffic and Parking Commission.

At the February Traffic and Parking Commission meeting, staff presented proposed locations for new pedestrian crossings and potential criteria to prioritize the locations. The Commission provided additional locations to include. City staff have completed collecting data for the new locations and the next step is to evaluate which of the Tier 1 locations will be implemented first using criteria, such as available funding and community support.

The system is broken into three levels of priorities: Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3. Locations in Tier 1 would be recommended as the highest priority and the order of development will come through approval by the City Council.

Robertson Blvd & Gregory Way and Burton Way & North Alpine Drive were identified as Tier 1 streets. Santa Monica Blvd & North Alpine Drive and South Beverly Drive Between Wilshire Blvd & Charleville Blvd were identified as Tier 2, and North Beverly Drive & Park Way is in Tier 3.

The City is working to improve walkability in preparation for the opening of the Purple Line stations at Wilshire/La Cienega in 2024 and Wilshire/Rodeo in 2025, as it is believed the number of people walking in the City will increase significantly.

In 2020, the City began replacing existing marked crosswalks on all street classifications with higher-visibility continental crosswalks. Continental crosswalks are longitudinal stripes designated where to walk across the road.

All crosswalks are scheduled to be converted to the continental style by next year. Construction is also starting soon on five crosswalk projects funded in part through a Metro grant from 2015.

These projects include enhancement of the following three existing crosswalks: Robertson Boulevard/Chalmers Drive, Wilshire Boulevard/South Palm Drive, and the 200 block of South Beverly Drive, and two new midblock crosswalks at the 400 block of North Bedford and 400 block of North Camden.

projects for Fiscal Year 2023/24 funded by Senate Bill 1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (SB 1), at last Tuesday's meeting.

The adoption of SB 1 increased the gas taxes and vehicle registration fees, and provided for inflationary adjustments to tax rates in future years; this is intended to be a funding source for agencies to fund maintenance of infrastructure and street projects.

Since Nov. 2017, the State Controller has been depositing portions of these funds into the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA). The funds are apportioned by formula to eligible agencies for basic road maintenance on the local roads system.

The SB 1 program guidelines require that eligible agencies submit a resolution each year that includes a project list, even if the project list is the same from prior years.

The following projects will be submitted for Fiscal Year 2023/24:

- Copley Place Reconstruction full reconstruction including demolition of existing roadway, full depth excavation, installation of 8-inch Portland Cement Concrete over 8-inch aggregate base, and replacement of all adjacent curb and gutter at Copley Place near Copley Drive and Sunset Boulevard.
- Burton Way Street Improvements grind and overlay 2 to 3 inches, replace damaged curb and gutter (as needed), reconstruct ADA ramps, bikeway striping improvements, and pedestrian crossing improvements. at Burton Way (North side) between North Rexford Drive and Oakhurst Drive, and Burton Way (South side) between South Rexford Drive and South Robertson Boulevard.

In addition to pavement rehabilitation, the Burton Way improvements will include replacing the existing bike lanes with buffered, green bike lanes with protective bollards at certain locations and enhanced intersection treatments.

A project from the prior year's project list – Crescent Drive between Sunset and Lexington – was recently completed and has been removed from the list.

The City has received a total of approximately \$3.22 million dollars in funding, since the inception of the program.

City Council Approves Amendment to Real Time Watch Center Management Agreement

At last Tuesday's meeting the City Council approved an amendment to the agreement with Julius Guay for management of the real time watch center project and as needed consulting services. The Council also approved a change purchase order in the amount of \$70,000 for a total not to exceed \$170,000 for Julius Guay.

The Real Time Watch Center began operation on June 7 as an effort to incorporate technology to help identify and prevent crimes that are in progress. According to the staff report, the early success of the center and amount of cases and data it has produced have necessitated greater oversight with how that information is gathered and re-distributed.

Guay was retained by the Police Department as a facilitator and consultant for daily operational technologies as well as organization and streamlining the Department's software platforms. Guay has prior experience as an LAPD detective lieutenant as well as in the U.S. Army.

City staff believed there has been an increased necessity for these services and thus resulted in a need to encumber additional funds to continue services through the end of the Fiscal Year.

City Forming New Ad Hoc Committee

The City is currently accepting applications from residents to serve on the new Mayor's Citywide Electrical Resilience Ad Hoc Committee.

The purpose of this Committee is to identify and examine ways for the City to become more resilient on energy due to the growing demand for power.

The Committee will be jointly managed by the Public Works and Policy and Management Departments, and will be a five member body. It will consist of two councilmembers, as well as three at-large members. Appointments will be for an initial two-year term.

Helpful skills or areas of interest for Committee members may be the following: technical expertise relating to utilities, engineering, construction, and energy resource management; ability to retain and apply complex state and local Municipal Code regulations to specific defined circumstances; ability to explain the sound general principles supporting recommendations; a good working knowledge of the City; and an interest in public works issues.

Committee recommendations are submitted to the City Council for formal consideration.

City Council to Discuss Recommendations for Community Assistance Grant Fund

The City Council is expected to discuss and possibly approve recommendations for the fiscal year (FY) 23/24 Community Assistance Grant Fund at a meeting in June.

Both the Human Relations and Charitable Solicitations Commissions have jointly-approved programmatic and funding recommendations.

Generally, new funding requests have exceeded the current fiscal year's base budget. Over the last several years, this funding has increased by about a million dollars

For this fiscal year, staff received \$2,760,500 in community funding requests, more than \$775,000 above last year's base budget of \$1,982,375.

The Human Relations Commission ad-hoc committee met on March 20 to review program proposals. The Charitable Solicitations Commission ad-hoc committee also met to review each organization's fiscal status.

On March 30 these ad-hoc committees met to review their findings and to meet with any new applicants where committee members had questions regarding programming or financial information.

The Joint Ad Hoc Committee only makes grant approval recommendations based on the grant criteria, and does not make specific recommendations on the funding amounts.

From the Joint Ad Hoc meeting, a joint report was produced for review by each commission.

A total of 30 complete applications were received for this application cycle.

New BHHS Football Coach Outlines Goals

New Beverly High football coach Frank Leonard is promising a team that will play with tremendous effort and tremendous passion.

Then-coach Marquis Bowling cited issues with effort for three of the teams nine on-field losses in 2022.

Leonard said he and his coaching staff will instill passion in the players through "my passion for the game and my passion for teaching student athletes."

"If you come on our practice field, you will feel the energy," said Leonard, who had coached Trinity Christian, an eightman program in Monterey, since 2013 after being its defensive coordinator in the 2011 and 2012 seasons.

"I think that is the type of energy that inspires players. I think when you let them know what you think they can be and then you teach them the techniques and they start to see bits of success and get that taken the program as far as I can take it."

type of glimpse of what they can be and what the team can be you'll start seeing more players play up to their capabilities.

"Passion is contagious. Electricity, energy within a football team is contagious. I think we'll be a team with contagious energy."

Leonard coached Pacific Grove High in Pacific Grove, between Carmel and Monterey, to a 7-3-1 record in 1997 in his lone season as coach and North Salinas to a 7-3-1 record in 1998 after it went 1-9 the previous season

Leonard also coached the Napoli Brigante and Lazio Marines of the Italian Football League.

Bowling resigned in January after posting a 1-19 record over two seasons in part because of uncertainty over whether he would continue to live in Southern California and his belief that he "may have

Leonard was among 24 applicants for the position, many with head coaching experience, including other current head coaches, according to Timothy E. Ellis, the Beverly Hills Unified School District's executive director of athletics.

Leonard was the unanimous choice of the selection committee, Ellis said.

'When I look for a coach, I look for a person who is first and foremost

'Good for kids," Ellis said. "When our players go home at night and sit around the dinner table and talk about the day, I want the talk to be positive about what we are doing on the football field. I want parents to feel that their sons and daughters will be better people for playing for coach Leonard.

"Second, 'Is he a good fit for our school and community?' Lastly, 'Will he stay for a while?' 'I think Frank checks off a lot of boxes for us "

Leonard said he had been looking for a job in the Los Angeles area for ``the last couple of years," to fulfill a promise to his wife to move there after their only child graduated from college so she could return to the area she lived in for 20 years. Leonard's son graduated from UC San Diego last year.

Leonard said he "had a couple of job offers but they weren't exactly what I was looking for."

"I think Beverly Hills is exactly what we were looking for as a family and myself, personally and professionally," said Leonard, who said he plans to live in the city. "I investigated Beverly Hills High School when (the job) was open and I really saw a great potential. It has outstanding facilities, and they're planning on building new and upgraded facilities.

'It's a community that cares tremendously about their school. Everything they do is extremely top-notch. If you just watch one of their games on film, everything from the presentation to the band to the cheerleaders is absolutely top notch, just the product on the field has struggled.

"If you walk through the school, you see tremendous demonstration and showcase of just great educational work everywhere. Just a lot of talent at that school and I think it's an untapped gem. I just felt it would be a good fit for me."

Leonard said he has set short-term goals of having the expected 10 seniors on the team to have "a great experience playing football at Beverly Hills High School" and for the team "to improve offensively, defensively, special teams and as people.'

The seniors have not had many opportunities to have had great experiences playing football at Beverly Hills High School.

As freshman, they did not play any

games because the 2020 season was canceled because of the coronavirus pandemic. Plans to play a four-game schedule in March and April 2021 were dropped because Bowling had to leave the area because of the death of a relative, he said.

As sophomores, the team went 1-9. As juniors, the team was 0-10, including a forfeit to Leuzinger "because of a lack of healthy available players," Bowling said.

The long-term goals are "a consistent turnout of over of 65 players every year where we have a thriving varsity and second-level program," Leonard said.

Beverly Hills last fielded a lower-level football team in 2017.

A lack of players, at least partially the

result of parents not giving their children permission to play because of a fear of concussions, has been a key reason the Norman football program has struggled in recent years, with players forced to play offense, defense and special teams with little time for rest on the sideline.

The team began the 2022 season with 34 players, the 2021 season with 49, according to Bowling, and the 2019 season with 25, according to then-coach Jarrod Bunch.

Leonard's hiring as football coach was approved by the Board of Education at its May 9 meeting. He has conducted practices the past two Saturdays with 29 players participating. The roster will grow in June with the addition of incoming freshmen.

Leonard>s hiring as a Beverly High his-

tory teacher is expected to be approved by the board later.

Leonard said having a coach who is also a full-time teacher at the school will lead to more students deciding to play football.

Leonard is the team's fifth coach since 2013. Only Charlie Stansbury lasted more than two seasons. The Normans are 8-82 during that span, including four winless seasons. Beverly Hills has not won an Ocean League game since 2015.

Leonard has announced James Lewis will be the offensive coordinator after serving as an assistant coach at Venice High from 2014-21 and receivers coach and offensive pass game coordinator in 2022 at Graceland University, an NAIA school in Lamoni, Iowa.
