Planning Commission to Discuss Open Air Dining

The Planning Commission is expected to discuss an ordinance to amend the Municipal Code that pertains to the development standards and review processes for the City's Open Air Dining program, at their Thursday meeting.

The OpenBH program was started during the Covid-19 Pandemic and intended to ease regulations related to open air dining. It is currently scheduled to end in Sept.

The City Council previously directed city staff to work on changes to the program. The draft ordinance incorporates the proposed code changes that would update regulations pertaining to the City's existing program.

In order to develop a permanent program the City Council previously established the Code Changes and Fees Subcommittee.

The primary change would be to update the existing regulations to allow more types of open air dining proposals to be approved, and to allow director-level review of the majority of other

The second change proposed by the subcommittee was in relation to right-ofway lease fees and other processing fees that are required to be paid for the use of public property. However, the establishment of fees is not within the Planning Commission's jurisdiction. The proposed fees will be reviewed by the City Council at a future meeting.

The Subcommittee also recommended allowing restaurants to extend their outside dining area beyond the facade of the restaurant. The code currently allows open air dining to be located directly adjacent to the building of the restaurant; however, there are some existing parklets that extend beyond a restaurant's frontage. City staff is not recommending that the proposed code changes allow this type of configuration due to the complexity of property use rights.

The temporary program also allowed the use of the public right-of-way for non-dining uses, such as temporary setups of outdoor hair salons. The City Council did not direct staff to include these types of uses in the permanent update to the code.

Arts and Culture Commission Tables 'Beverly Hills Love and Kindness Park' Proposal

At their Tuesday meeting, Arts and Culture Vice Chair Karla Gordy Bristol provided the Commission with a presentation on a proposed 'Love and Kindness' themed park in the City. The Commission ultimately decided to table the discussion and explore the concept further during its work plan review.

This project is proposed to be offered as a way to bring 'positive and joyous' energy to the City.

The space would offer free entry to the public and all installations are intended to encourage community involvement and engagement. This would potentially range from Community Created art to acting as a

Love themed backdrop for commemorative photos. If approved, pieces would be acquired through donations by civic minded artists whose work represents the themes addressed in the proposal.

Cultural Heritage Commission to Discuss Landmark Proceedings for Church of the Good **Shepherd**

At their Wednesday meeting the Cultural Heritage Commission was expected to discuss the consideration for the initiation of landmark proceedings for the Church of the Good Shepherd located at 501-505 North Bedford Drive to determine its eligibility as a local landmark for placement onto the Register of Historic Properties. A decision was not made before the Weekly's deadline.

According to the staff report, the central church structure meets the required criteria for local landmark designation as it remains in a well-maintained condition with no major compromises to its architectural integrity.

The property was designed in 1924 by architect James Donnellan. The building was identified as a potential contributor to the potential historic district defined as the "Beverly Hills Churches-Thematic Grouping" in the City's 1985-1986 Survey and the 2004 Historic Surveys.

The property is individually eligible for listing in the National Register and California Register at the local level of significance.

A property may be nominated and designated as a landmark if it satisfies all of the requirements set forth in Criteria A and at least two of the requirements set forth in Criteria B of the Landmark Designation Criteria in the Historic Preservation Ordinance.

According to the staff report, the building appears that it may possibly satisfy the criteria but further research would be needed in order to determine whether the subject property qualifies as an "exceptional work" or an "exceptional property". The property appears to satisfy all of the mandates of subsection A and one of the mandates under subsection B, based on preliminary review.

Recreation and Parks Commission Supports Potential Well Sites

The Recreation and Parks Commission has expressed support for two future wells at La Cienega Park, at their June 27 meeting.

For the two future wells at La Cienega Park, city staff has identified two potential well sites. The first potential well, Well Site 1, is located at the southwest corner of the park near the intersection of Le Doux Road and Olympic Boulevard.

The second potential well site, Well Site 2, is located at the northeast corner of the park near the intersection of Gregory Way and Gale Drive.

Well Site 1 and the future well building is expected to be outside the field of play at Fenton Field and Well Site 2 is expected to reduce the batting cage area by about 50%.

"I was pleased to see that once the wells are completed, it is rather unobtrusive to the use of the park in any shape, way, or form," Commissioner Julian Javor said.

The City previously celebrated a ribbon cutting ceremony at LCW-1, the former Coffee Bean and Tea Leaf property, on May 8. On June 6 the City Council also accepted the LCW-1 equipping project.

The Sand Pit site monitoring well was sampled on Feb. 9, 2023 and city staff met with the Division of Drinking Water (DDW) on April 28 to discuss the lab results.

The DDW provided feedback and discussed the following:

- DDW stated they would like input from the Regional Board on contaminants of concern that do not fall under Title 22 drinking water regulations.
- Potentially an updated Drinking Water Source Assessment.
- Additional sampling for other concerns.
- The 50-foot control zone and the plan to coordinate with Caltrans and the neighboring commercial business owner regarding future maintenance operations.
- Logistical challenges associated with drilling a potable water well in a small confined space.

DDW has stated that they could issue the City a conditional letter of approval for the Sand Pit site. This letter with draft conditions of approval is anticipated in July / Aug. for the City's review.

The City has also continued its property search for additional well sites. One property along La Cienega is under consideration along with a list of other potential properties. The properties are being evaluated and preliminary results are expected to be discussed at a future Public Works Ad Hoc Meeting.

The Public Works Commission is also expected to receive a La Brea Subarea Update, at their Thursday meeting.

Commission to Discuss Density Bonus Permit for 227 Tower Drive

The Planning Commission is expected to discuss a request for a Development Plan Review to allow for the construction of a new five story, ten-unit multi-family residential building with 13 parking spaces, and a Density Bonus Permit in addition to certain incentives/concessions and waivers from development standards to provide one affordable housing unit at the property located at 227 Tower Drive, at their Thursday meeting.

The project site currently consists of an existing two-unit multi-family residential building and detached three-car

garage. Of the ten units proposed, one unit would be dedicated to a very low-income household.

The Planning Commission is expected to conduct the public hearing and possibly adopt a resolution conditionally approving a Development Plan Review and Density Bonus Permit.

Commission to Review Golden Shield Award Nominees

David Orgell (1921-1987), who was born in England, and learned the silversmith business from his father, Spencer Orgell, who had learned it from his father. Spencer was a master silversmith and had a store in London where their

clientele included the royal family, according to the staff report. The Orgell family left England in 1939, entered the United States in Dec. 1939, and relocated to Beverly Hills shortly thereafter. In 1941, Spencer and his wife Marjorie purchased a home at 614 North Rodeo Drive and he established his silversmith, importing business at 410 North Rodeo Drive. He later moved the store to 9674 Wilshire Boulevard. He created an ornate crest that was placed on all of his silver products as well as on his letterhead and in his advertisements.

Spencer continued his business until his passing in 1966.

The Arthur Murray Dance Studio, Beverly Hills branch opened its doors in 1940 in the upstairs space of 357 North Rodeo Drive. The space had been previously occupied by local architect Harry Werner and the Guy Price real estate office. Dance lessons were offered for beginners and advanced dancers alike.

To serve the Beverly Hills Hotel, the Los Angeles Pacific Company, later Pacific Electric, built the Rodeo line in 1907. The line, 1.378 miles long, was a

single-track, narrow-gauge line, but was converted to standard gauge in 1908. The trolley ran from Santa Monica Boulevard and Rodeo Drive north along Rodeo to Sunset and then east on Sunset to Beverly Drive. Due to lack of passenger

use, with the advent of the private automobile, it was abandoned in 1923 and the tracks were removed.

Located at 450 North Rodeo Drive was the Café Swiss restaurant. It was opened in 1951 as the Mascotte Restaurant by Zurich-born restaurateur Jakob Alfred (Fred) Hug. By 1954, the restaurant was called the Swiss Café and was run by Fred and his tobe-wife Laura Guiseppina Franscella.

In early August 1930, the J.J. Newberry Company took out a twenty-five

year lease on store space in the Dennison Market Building at 418 North Beverly Drive. At that time, there were 325 J.J.

Newberry stores in operation throughout the nation. J. J. Newberry Co. was an American retail chain store that opened

its first shop in Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania in 1911.

Beverly Hills Handbag Studio, located at 149 South Beverly Drive, was owned and operated by Holocaust survivor Leopold "Paul" Page. For over 40 years, Page cornered every writer who entered his leather goods store in an effort to tell the story of German industrialist Oskar Schindler who saved he and his wife's lives and those of 1,200 other Jews in World War II.

The Cultural Heritage Commission is expected to review the six eligible nominees and choose three finalists that will be brought forward for final review.

Planning Commission to Discuss Historic Incentive Permit for 9884 South Santa Monica Boulevard

The Planning Commission is expected to discuss a request for a Development Plan Review and Historic Incentive Permit (HIP) to allow for the rehabilitation of an existing two-story commercial building with a new third story addition at the property located at 9884 South Santa Monica Boulevard.

Proposed Building from Santa Monica

The existing commercial building, known as the "Darrow Office Building," was built in 1946 and was designed by John Lautner and Douglas Honnold, architects listed on the List of Master Architects. The HIP request includes devi-

ations from requirements related to the minimum dimensions for rubbish storage facilities and on-site loading space.

The applicant is seeking to rehabilitate the building and original architectural features that were designed by Lautner. The applicant also wants to construct a new 1,404 SF third story addition over the existing building to provide additional office space on the property and an outdoor terrace that would face South Santa Monica Boulevard and Charleville Boulevard. The new third floor addition would increase the existing height of the building by approximately 15'-3", from a height of 23'-9" to a proposed height of 38'-0".

The property has not yet been designated as a local historic landmark. However, on April 13 the Cultural Heritage Commission previewed the proposed project and determined that the existing building at the project site merits formal consideration as a local landmark. The commission directed staff to provide a recommendation to the City Council for designation of the property as a local landmark.

The Planning Commission is expected to conduct the public hearing and possibly adopt the resolution conditionally

approving a Development Review and Historic Incentive Permit for the proposed project at 9884 South Santa Monica Boulevard.

Transportation Safety Campaign Promotes Stop Sign Compliance for July

In part of the 2023 Transportation Safety Educational Campaign,

the Traffic and Parking Commission is promoting "Stop Means Stop!" for the month of July.

The message is meant to encourage drivers to take a couple seconds to come to a complete stop, in an effort that is

perceived to help save lives, as it is believed to reduce your risk of hitting another person on the road.

The structure of the 2023 Transportation Safety Educational Campaign consists of the following: umbrella slogan for all campaign materials, monthly calls to action for road users, supplemental monthly key messages, communication tactics and rationale, collateral details and placement considerations, and graphic design direction.

The umbrella slogan identified for this campaign is, "We watch out for each other." This slogan is meant to convey the community's sense of pride in their city and support for their neighbors, friends, and business-

es. It is also meant to remind residents that their care for one another translates to their personal actions on the roads. The slogan will be used on all materials developed for the campaign.

Each month, the campaign features a different theme based on traffic safety issues. Each theme will have specific, direct calls to action for road users that are

intended to improve traffic safety by watching out for each other.

Some monthly themes for this year include: pedestrian safety, right-ofway at in-

tersections, speeding, and safety around schools, among others.

Commission to Review Criteria for Golden Shields Within Residential Zones

At their Wednesday meeting the Cultural Heritage Commission was expected to discuss the existing criteria for placement of Golden Shields within the residential zones of the City. The discussion occurred after the Weekly's deadline.

The City Council requested that the Commission review the current criteria for selection of Golden Shield recipient sites within the residential areas of the City due to concerns regarding privacy for the owners of the subject properties or neighboring properties.

The Golden Shield program was established to honor places of cultural or historic merit. The intent of the program is to allow the community to celebrate these places, as marked by a bronze plaque with text.

One of the first Golden Shield Awards selected by the Cultural Heritage Commission and approved by the Council in Nov. of 2019, was the Doña Maria Rita Valdez de Villa Homestead (El Rancho Rodeo de las Aguas – 1838-1854), located at the northwest corner of Alpine Drive and Sunset Boulevard. In March of 2021, the Gershwin Residence previously located at 1019 Roxbury Drive was also selected for a Golden Shield.

Last month, 12 new Golden Shield Award nominees were considered by the Council. Ten of the nominees were granted the award and two sites in the residential zone were not selected due to potential future privacy concerns. The properties were the Lucille Ball and Desi Arnaz house, located at 1000 North Roxbury Drive, and the Rachmaninoff Residence located at 610 North Elm Drive.

The Council has requested review of the criteria for selection of nominees and ways that broader public outreach could be undertaken if further sites in residential zones are to be considered.

The Commissioners were expected to provide input on this topic for staff to

Lawsuit Filed Seeking Certification of Recall Petition

On Tuesday the Recall DA George Gascon Committee announced they have filed a lawsuit seeking to certify the recall petition for Los Angeles District Attorney George Gascon.

The lawsuit is in regards to a 10-month review of rejected signatures, which allegedly resulted in the "discovery of tens of thousands of valid signatures that were incorrectly or unlawfully rejected, negligent and flawed counting processes utilized by the Los Angeles Registrar of Voters, and an inflated signature requirement due to bloated voter rolls," according to the recall campaign.

Last year the Recall Committee submitted 715,833 signatures in support of the recall petition, which was 148,976 more than the 566,857 signatures required to trigger a recall election. According to the Committee, the Registrar said it was the largest local recall petition that they had ever processed.

The Registrar stated that 195,758 supporting signatures were invalid for a variety of different reasons. The Recall Petition had 520,050 valid signatures, which was 46,807 fewer than was needed to qualify for a recall election, according to the Registrar.

The Committee has stated that they have been engaged in a signature-by-signature assessment of the reasons for the rejection. The Committee alleges to have reviewed 94,000 of the 195,758 rejected signatures thus far and that at least 20,587 signatures should have been deemed valid but were incorrectly reject-

ed by the Registrar.

The Committee believes it submitted at least 546,234 valid signatures in support of the Recall Petition, and that the Registrar should have certified the Recall Petition as sufficient, which would have led to a special election.

'Based on the overwhelming evidence gathered by the Committee, an election to recall Los Angeles District Attorney George Gascon should be held immediately. The recall effort, the historical number of signatures gathered, and the unprecedented review of the Registrar's conduct would never have occurred were it not for the victims who stuck their necks out from the beginning to spearhead the recall, the volunteers who engaged in a grueling process despite facing every roadblock imaginable, and the residents and donors who have fought back for public safety in their communities. The Recall Committee and the citizens of Los Angeles owe them a tremendous debt of gratitude, and we will never give up or stop fighting on their behalf," Recall Spokesperson Tim Lineberger said.

OBITUARIES Sarah Morrison 1930-2023

Sarah Louise Voelkel Morrison was born on February 21, 1930 in Pyongyang in what was then Japanese-occupied Korea. She was known in childhood as Sally Lou, as Sally during her adult years up until about age 50 and then as Sarah from then on. She passed away at age 93 on July 2, 2023 in Pasadena, Calif.

Her parents, Harold & Gertrude Voelkel, and her maternal grandparents, William & Sallie Swallen, were Presbyterian missionaries to Korea and so she spent much of her early childhood in Andong, now in South Korea, before the family had to leave Korea due to the outbreak of World War II. The family lived in different places, from Berkeley, Calif, to Princeton, New Jersey, to St Petersburg, Florida, to Los Angeles, where she graduated high school at Culter Academy.



She completed a bachelors degree at Wheaton College near Chicago in 1951 and then spent several years teaching in Muskegon, Michigan, and at Seoul Foreign School back in Korea before finishing a masters in education at Teachers College, Columbia University in New York. With plans to go to Hong Kong as a missionary teacher, she enrolled in a few classes at Princeton Theological Seminary in New Jersey where she met Jim Morrison who was working on a theological degree.

Sarah lived in Hong Kong for five years, teaching English to 6th graders at the Heep Woh Primary School in Kowloon. She put tremendous effort into learning Cantonese, ultimately becoming fluent via the help of a tutor. She also stayed in touch with Jim and, shortly after returning stateside, they were married on November 16, 1963 in Princeton, New Jersey. They settled down in San Diego where Jim was a pastor at First Presbyterian Church. In 1965, they welcomed a son, Jamie, and in 1969 a daughter, Elaine, by which time they had moved to Los Angeles where Jim would serve first at First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood (1969-1974) and Beverly Hills Presbyterian Church (1974-2003). They lived in Woodland Hills, CA for 41 years and moved in 2010 to Monte Vista Grove Homes in Pasadena where she passed away.

As a pastor's wife, Sarah taught Sunday School, led the children's choir, organized women's fellowship groups and raised her two children, while also teaching English as a Second Language in the public schools. She volunteered in the elementary school as a reading tutor, was a Girl Scout leader and helped with Boy Scouts and soccer. Sarah enjoyed entertaining friends and family and hosted many Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners always including those who didn't have a place to go.

In the 1980s, she began studies toward a Master of Divinity at Fuller Theological Seminary, completing it in 1989. With her children grown, she then served on the staffs of churches in central Los Angeles, Woodland Hills, Newhall, Simi Valley and Brentwood. She also made many summertime mission trips to teach English in various locations in China, Mongolia, and Kyrgyzstan.

At age 73, Sarah traveled to South Africa to welcome her first grandson and then again in 2004 when second grandson arrived. She and Jim made many trips to Spokane, Washington, to be with these grandsons and their granddaughters. After Jim's death she continued her passion for travel and took the family on memorable vacations to Idaho, Kauai (to celebrate her 90th) and Encinitas.

Sarah is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, daughter, two grandsons and two granddaughters as well as two brothers. She will be interred at Forest Lawn Hollywood Hills.

Cultural Heritage Commission Chair Marc Teren on the Challenges of Historic **Preservation**

You are the incoming chair of the **Cultural Heritage Commission. What** made you want to apply for the position?

In my years prior to moving to Bev-

erly Hills, I lived in -Washington, D.C. I grew up in a family of real estate developers and I worked 100% on historic homes and residences as a developer and general contractor in Washington, D.C. When I moved to Beverly Hills, there was an opportunity to sit on the other side of the table and be a part of the Commission. It was something that I have significant and unique experience in and so [I] applied to be a member of the Commission.

As you mentioned, you have worked on historic preservation

projects in the Washington D.C. area. Tell us about that. In D.C. almost every home sits within

a defined historic district. It's very difficult if you're looking at working on any existing residences for it not to be sitting in a historic zone. So as such, I've got experience very early on since every renovation, addition, or project I wanted to do needed to go in front of a series of commissions, including going in front of the Commission of Fine Arts, which is the same commission that approves monuments and new museums on the Mall. My first experience in historic development on the East Coast was buying

built in the 1850s, and it served as the headquarters for the not-for-profit Chesapeake Bay Foundation. I put it back to its original form. That was the project

> the Secretary of Interior and overseen by the Parks Department. That was really my first exposure to historic development.

> When a building is especially old, what are some of the challenges involved in preserving significantly older buildings?

> I think the key issue is it's not just starting with an old building, it's starting with a building that represents the historic fabric of that neighborhood or that period. I think any time

that you're looking

look at it from the building standpoint, how that foundation was put in place, and whether the building maintains its original structural integrity and not just its exterior and appearance. I think what you'll find in most older structures is that they actually were built in a way that exceeds the nature of how many homes have been built, specifically suburban homes. It's just really understanding the building process, understanding how these properties have come together, and then a real sense of how they've been maintained over time.

What are some projects the Commis-

sion is working on?

The Commission stays very focused within the framework that's been established with the City. We have a very significant Golden Shield Program which gives us an opportunity to recognize a lot of the history of this City. That program is very well established. We're currently in the middle of updating our multifamily residential survey. That survey is used both for historic preservation decisions and land use decisions. We have a series of ongoing activities which include the development of our community outreach programs that I know the subcommittee is working on now. Under Commissioner [Kim] Reiss, we have a potential landmark that'll be coming up for discussion, which is the Church of the Good Shep-

herd [see brief on page 2] in celebration of its 100 year anniversary. We also hope to be landmarking that building at the same individuals or property

We've [also] been working on some very minor modifications to the ordinance, which would be approved should think about in by the City Council if they adopt it. I think there have been some questions this year, particularly, with the loss of the Burgess de-

signed home at 1001 North Roxbury. I'd love to see us work more closely with city staff and consultants so that we have an opportunity on a property built like that to work before it may become an issue. With not even a code revision, but simple code clarification, I think we would have been able to protect that home. That's a huge loss for the City and I've heard that from so many members. If you haven't read [Councilmember] John Mirisch's piece that he wrote on Facebook - and then was republished after the loss of that property - if we can just protect one more home, building, or church collaboratively with the owners of that property, I think that would be very special and a big accomplishment for the city.

I would say that on the other side, you have David Zaslav's purchase of the Roberts Evans home [where] you have a party that embraces that history. It's always nice to match an owner who has the same goals and objectives. But one way or another. I think that outreach and education will help people potentially embrace the history of what they have, own, and are caretakers of. If we do our jobs correctly, maybe one, two, or three more individuals or property owners will find that historic preservation is important and something they should think about in preserving or updating their own home or property.

What are some of the challenges your commission has that you did not fore-

a part but not a guide to how we think about the future of the community and the protection of the historic fabric. Really for me, it's been an understanding of how we within the community enhance the interest in historic preservation, and how we work hand preserving or updating in hand, not just with the community, but all of the organizations with city staff, city council, etc., to

> make sure that we're all aligned in terms of those goals and objectives. I think that's a significant change from where I've been and it's been a real learning experience. I think we've done some great work over the four years that I've been on the commission, but obviously, we have more work ahead of us.

What do you hope to accomplish as Chair?

I'd like us to get back to our focus on educating and working to preserve the historic fabric of our community. Over the last year or so, we really haven't had an opportunity to landmark as many structures collaboratively as we would like to. The process is one that works hand in hand with property owners, the Commission, and the City. I think that if anything, if you were to ask the commissioners on a whole, that focus would be important to us.
