Abortion Clinic Files Suit Against Landlord

DuPont Clinic, an abortion provider that planned to open a clinic in Beverly Hills, filed a suit against the landlord Douglas Emmett, Inc., alleging Douglas Emmett colluded with the City to delay DuPont's opening and then attempted to "baselessly" rescind DuPont's lease.

The clinic is also alleging that the City interfered with its permits in an effort to run the clinic out of town, and has said they will file a suit against the City as well.

The Clinic claims that City officials met with pro life activists, shared Du-Pont's private information, and "directly and intentionally" interfered with its permits. City Officials named in the letter in-

DuPont Clinic offers elective abortions during the third trimester through 31 weeks and six days gestation. Pro-life activists previously petitioned the City Council in an effort to prevent DuPont from opening up this fall.

"Douglas Emmett's shameful cowardice in the face of protestors and politics has given DuPont no choice but to resort to legal action," the complaint states.

Pro-life activists from the group 'Survivors' petitioned the City Council last month in an effort to prevent DuPont Clinic from opening up its doors in the City. Survivors is a "youth based pro-life activism and apologetics ministry that exists to empower and equip the rising generation to end the abortion genocide in America."

The clinic would have opened up at 8920 Wilshire Blvd.

According to the complaint, On June 30, 2022, DuPont sent a Letter of Intent to Douglas Emmett summarizing its offer to rent the Premises. The Letter identified the nature of the proposed use of the building as follows: "Use: The Dupont Clinic is a private referral center for all-trimester abortion care and ultrasound-guided procedures, primarily for management of abnormal and high-risk pregnancies."

The City received correspondence on June 12 from the attorney for the land-

lord at the property notifying them that DuPont Clinic would no longer be taking occupancy and the lease had been rescinded, according to Deputy City Manager Keith Sterling.

According to the complaint, in late April 2023, the City asked Douglas Emmett for a meeting to discuss DuPont's permits. During the meeting, DuPont believes City officials directly asked Douglas Emmett representatives if there was any way to avoid the opening of the clinic. Douglas Emmett informed the City that it had already signed the lease.

"Emmett representatives later told Du-Pont that the City officials were visibly upset upon learning that Douglas Emmett could not simply prevent DuPont from opening its clinic on the premises. In other words, the City had already decided that it did not want DuPont to open its clinic and in April 2023 was acting to prevent it from happening. The City hoped that Douglas Emmett would do their dirty work," the complaint further alleges.

DoPont is alleging the City purposely delayed issued permits to the clinic, which resulted in "significant time and money and pushed back DuPont's opening date."

On June 12 DuPont received the landlord's notice of rescission of the lease. DoPont states that the lease does not give the landlord the right to issue a rescission notice. The letter did not attempt to offer a return for the benefits conferred by Du-Pont, according to the complaint.

"The June 12 Letter did not properly rescind the lease – it simply sets forth Douglas Emmett's improper grounds for breaching the ease," the complaint states. Douglas Emmett's attorney Stacy Moskowitz did not respond to a request for comment.

City Reconsiders Transit System

The City Council and Traffic and Parking Commission Liaison Committee discussed the potential pilot transit program last week, that would have consisted of a combination of a fixed-route circulator and citywide on-demand microtransit system, and agreed that there was likely no need or demand for this type of system.

The City began a Transit Study last June to determine whether the planned transit services are sufficient to support the needs of the community. The City considered a transit pilot program that would have consisted of a fixed bi-directional route operating approximately every 15 minutes on major streets south of North Santa Monica Boulevard, as well as a demand-based microtransit system.

On March 2 the City conducted a transit circulator test run from 9 AM to 4 PM to allow community members to get a feel for how a local transit system could operate, as well as for the opportunity for residents to provide feedback on the future pilot project.

The test run consisted of two City shuttles traveling the proposed circulator route in each direction with stops at 21 locations south of North Santa Monica Boulevard. The data gathered from the



test was to be used to determine frequency of service, number of vehicles needed, operation hours, and program costs.


Each route loop took approximately 40 minutes to complete depending on traffic conditions. Occasional blockage of a bus stop zone by vehicles was encountered during the test run. Additionally, city staff added a single test run north of North Santa Monica Boulevard to evaluate road grade, potential bus stops on residential street blocks, and distance and timing for a potential northern loop; the loop without stops took about 25 minutes.

Eight community members, including representatives from the Traffic and Parking Commission, Public Works, and Planning commissions, participated in the test. Feed-



The liaison committee, composed of Mayor Julian Gold, Councilmember Sharona Nazarian, Traffic and Parking Commision Chair Ron Shalowitz, and Vice Chair Lisa Kay Schwartz, were in consensus that there was need for a transit circulator and that the challenges faced with such a system would not outweigh any perceived benefits.

"I think that the idea of the circulator is not a good idea. You [city staff] have not convinced me of its benefit. We see the inherent challenges just by looking at what METRO does every day. They are struggling to keep their buses clean and neat, and we would have those same challenges," Gold said.





Community Members Attend Office Hours with Doctor Gold

Community members attended the second in-person Office Hours with Doctor Gold last Wednesday.

The Committee did express interest exploring entering into partnership arrangements with transportation network companies such as Uber and Lyft. This approach may include discounted trips throughout a defined zone, discounted trips originating or terminating in a zone but with discounts available for trips leaving the zone, or discounted trips originating or terminating at defined transit centers.

The City of West Hollywood currently offers a similar type of on-call transportation with Uber and Lyft for a registration required service that is available on short notice, without advanced reservations. They are operating 24/7 and advertise to pick up riders within 15 minutes. It serves anywhere within West Hollywood and up to a 10 mile radius from the border. It is only available for West Hollywood res-

idents aged 62 or older and community members with disabilities at any age, according to the staff report.

"We could certainly subsidize those, especially for this kind of money, and provide effective transportation for essentially anybody who needs it within the City. I think it's a nice perk, and if it gets people to leave their cars at home, it answers the question of 'How do I get to the subway and how do I get home?"" Gold said.

The Preliminary Cost Estimate for a fixed-route shuttle and on-demand microtransit services for a one-year pilot program was believed to be approximately \$3.5 million," according to the staff report.

The City also currently offers free trolley services between Civic Center and Rodeo Drive every Saturday and Sunday between 11 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays. Departures from the Civic Center Trolley Stop occur from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m., every 60 minutes. The Civic Center stop is located on the southeast corner of Civic Center Drive and Third Street. On Sundays, the Civic Center stop is located in front of the Courthouse. Departures from the Rodeo/Dayton Trolley Stop occur from 11:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., every 30 minutes. The Rodeo/Dayton Trolley Stop is located on the southeast corner of Rodeo Drive and Dayton Way.

City Council to Discuss SB 9 Ordinance

The City Council is expected to discuss an ordinance that established objective development standards for projects in single-family residential zones constructed pursuant to Senate Bill (SB) 9, written by Senator Scott Wiener (D-San Francisco), at its Sept. 19 meeting.

At the Aug. 10 meeting the Planning Commission discussed an interim ordinance that allows the City to appropriately regulate urban lot splits and the development of new units that are allowed under provisions of SB 9.

SB 9 supersedes several City regulations regarding single-family residential subdivision and development standards; however, the bill does preserve some authority so that local jurisdictions can enact regulations through the adoption of new and objective zoning regulations.

At their Dec. 7, 2021, meeting the City Council adopted an interim ordinance that created objective standards for SB

9 residential development projects. The standards apply to the ministerial review and approval of a two-lot subdivision, otherwise known as an "urban lot split" and/or development projects with up to two units per lot in single-family residential zones constructed pursuant to SB 9 regulations.

In order to retain the garden quality of the City, the ordinance creates standards for urban lot splits. These standards would generally create a "front" lot that is

A DRAFT ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS TO PROVIDE OBJECTIVE STANDARDS FOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS WITH NO MORE THAN TWO PRIMARY UNITS AND URBAN LOT SPLIT PARCEL MAPS IN SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONES PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 65852.21 AND 66411.7 (SENATE BILL 9, 2021), AND MAKING A DETERMINATION OF EXEMPTION UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

At its December 7, 2021, meeting, the City Council voted to adopt an interim ordinance (Ordinance No. 21-O-2853) that created objective standards for Senate Bill 9 (2021) residential development projects under the authority of Government Code Sections 65852.21 and 66411.7. The standards apply to the ministerial review and approval of a two-lot subdivision ("urban lot split") and/or development projects with up to two residential units per lot in single-family residential zones constructed pursuant to SB 9 regulations. The interim ordinance adopted on December 7, 2021 took effect immediately, and was in effect for an initial 45-day period ending on January 21, 2022. This interim ordinance was subsequently extended for an additional ten (10) month and fifteen (15) day period through the adoption of Ordinance No. 21-O-2856, and for an additional oneyear period through the adoption of Ordinance No. 22-O-2869. The interim ordinance has been extended the maximum period of time possible to provide additional time for staff to review the regulations and conditions in the City, and will expire on December 6, 2023. Staff has worked to study and develop regulations that can be adopted on a permanent basis and would create objective standards for urban lot split projects and development projects with up to two residential units per lot in single-family residential zones constructed pursuant to SB 9.

Staff presented a draft ordinance for the Planning Commission to review during their regular meeting on August 10, 2023. The Planning Commission deliberated, and recommended amendments to the draft ordinance, which were to change the inclusionary housing requirement to be consistent with the City's existing requirement in Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) §10-3-4803, and to exempt basement floor area from the total floor area maximum limitation applicable to SB 9 projects. The Planning Commission adopted a resolution (4-1) recommending the approval of the draft ordinance as amended to the City Council.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. The ordinance is not considered a project under CEQA pursuant to Government Code Sections 65852.21(j) and 66411.7(n) which provide that ordinances that implement Government Code Sections 65852.21 and 66411.7, respectively, shall not be considered projects under CEQA. Furthermore, the ordinance is exempt from CEQA because it can be seen with certainty that there is no potential for such ordinance to have a significant adverse effect on the environment pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). The draft ordinance does not authorize construction and consists of additional regulations on future development, which will be treated ministerially pursuant to the stipulations of SB 9. Accordingly, the City Council will consider a recommendation to find the project exempt from CEQA for the reasons set forth above.

There are provisions in SB 9 that do not allow urban lot splits in very high fire hazard severity zones (VHFHSZ). Properties north of Sunset Boulevard are included in a VHFHSZ, and the urban lot split provisions would not apply in these zones.

After deliberation, the Planning Commission recommended amendments to the draft ordinance, which were to change the inclusionary housing requirement to be consistent with the City's existing requirement, and to exempt basement floor area from the total floor area maximum limitation applicable to these types of projects.

The interim ordinance will expire on Dec. 6. City staff will present the draft ordinance to the City Council for adoption.

BHUSD to Mandate Ethnic Studies Course

The Board of Education has approved updates to high school graduation requirements that will mandate students take an ethnic studies course beginning with the 2029-30 school year, at last Tuesday's meeting.

Governor Gavin Newsom signed AB 101 on Oct. 8, 2021, in order to make ethnic studies courses a graduation requirement. It requires high schools to offer ethnic studies courses beginning in the academic year 2025-26 and make the course a graduation requirement commencing in 2029-2030. The bill was authored by Assemblymember Jose Medina (D-Riverside)

Education Policy Advisor Brooks Allen issued a letter last Wednesday warning schools not to adopt any ethnic studies curriculum that promotes "bias, bigotry or discrimination."

According to the letter, vendors have begun promoting curriculum for local education agencies to use for ethnic studies and the State Board of Education has been advised that some vendors are offering materials that may not meet the requirements of AB 101, particularly that

it should not "reflect or promote, directly or indirectly, any bias, bigotry, or discrimination against any person or group of persons."

The curriculum was written by the for-profit organization. The Liberated Ethnic Studies Model Curriculum Institute (LESMCI). They referred to Israel as an apartheid state and claimed it violates international law. They also called the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions movement a "global social movement that currently aims to establish freedom for Palestinians."

The City Council also passed a resolution at its Aug. 20, 2021, meeting condemning the then drafted statewide Ethnic Studies Model Curriculum because its "poorly created curriculum fails to properly respect the Jewish faith and people" and was "discriminatory" toward Jews.

According to the Jewish Journal, several Jewish groups praised the letter

"We thank Governor Newsom and the State Board of Education for delivering yet again with this letter," JPAC Executive Director David Bocarsly said . "The Governor has been a consistent ally to the Jewish community, particularly throughout the Ethnic Studies Model Curriculum (ESMC) development process." There is still a lot of work ahead to implement robust ethnic studies courses across California's schools that are also free from antisemitism and anti-Zionism. This is a major step in the right direction, and we know the Governor will continue to work with us in this effort."

Beverly Hills Man Arrested for Stealing Almost 2 Million in Goods from Guests at **Luxury Hotel**

A Beverly Hills man appeared in federal court last week regarding a criminal complaint alleging he stole more than \$1.8 million in jewelry, clothing, and accessories from victims at a hotel in Beverly Hills in May then traveled to Florida to sell the stolen goods.

Jobson Marangoni De Castro, 37, is charged with interstate transportation of stolen property after he was arrested at

> Los Angeles International Airport.

According to an affidavit filed with the complaint, two victims - both residents of Brazil - traveled together to Beverly Hills on May 5 to attend a fashion event scheduled for May 9.


On the evening of May 10, De Castro allegedly traveled by Uber to the victims' hotel,

stole six suitcases belonging to them. The suitcases contained jewelry, clothing, and accessories worth more than \$1.8 million.

Later that evening, the victims returned to their hotel room to discover all six of their suitcases were missing. The hotel staff then notified law enforcement about the theft.

De Castro then traveled to Miami and, on May 17, messaged a buyer in Miami on Instagram. De Castro told the buyer that he wanted to sell jewelry – a diamond necklace and luxury watch – and that he did not have papers for them because he had found them in a box belonging to his late mother. The jewelry matched the description of that stolen from the victims in Beverly Hills a few days earlier, according to the complaint. On May 18, the buyer wired De Castro \$50,000, for the jewelry, which De Castro allegedly brought to the buyer's store in Miami.

The name De Castro provided to the buyer was "Jobs Marangoni," the same name he used for his Uber account, the affidavit alleges.

If convicted, De Castro would face a statutory maximum sentence of 10 years in federal prison.

Planning Commission Approves Cannabis Ordinance

The Planning Commission discussed existing regulations that prohibit the establishment of commercial cannabis uses in the City, at last Thursday's meeting.

In Sept. 2017, the City Council agreed that prohibitions on cannabis activity were necessary when the existing Ordinance was adopted. The Ordinance currently allows for the delivery of medical cannabis from a state licensed business operating from another jurisdiction.

In 2022, State Senator Scott Wiener (D - San Francisco) introduced Senate Bill 1186, the Medicinal Cannabis Patients' Right of Access Act. This bill prohibits local governments, beginning Jan. 1, from enforcing any regulation that prohibits the

I have been lucky enough to be friends with Vincente Minnelli for many years. When I moved to California I started working for Ira Gershwin, brother of the composer George Gershwin. George

Gershwin died in 1937 at age 38 and Ira worked to the age of 86 up until 1983. I had a six year period where I was able to work for him as a personal assistant. Ira and his wife Leonore were best friends with Vincente Minto know because of that connection with the Gershwin famiis the goddaughter of Ira Gershwin. So

I've had a connection with the Minnelli clan for a long time, ever since I was in my early twenties. I was always struck by the fact that both of them in different ways were responsible for the introduction of so many pieces of music and it would become part of the fabric of our repertoire, "The Great American Songbook." Vincente Minnelli started his career as a director of Broadway musicals that include such standards, like "All the

Tell us about your upcoming show at Things You Are," "I've Got Rights," and some other songs that became famous. Later when he directed movies in Hollywood, all these great songs were introduced. I found it interesting that when Liza talks about her influences, she always talks about Charles Aznavour. She

> talks a little about her mother of course, but she says that one of the main influences was her father. So that was a thought right there, with the musical legacy of both Liza and her father. I thought it would be an interesting thing to explore.

Your first job in music that got you to Calif. was in Beverly Hills working as Ira Gershwin's assistant. Tell us about that.

Ira was 80 years I was 20 and he had lived in Beverly Hills

since 1936 when he came to Hollywood to write a film score with his brother, George. One of my great influences has always been from my very early memories, of being exposed to Gershwin music. I was thrilled to be introduced to Ira by the widow of the great concert pianist Oscar Levant. So I ended up spending six years taking care of our archive of Gershwin memorabilia and Ira taught

me most of what I know about interpreting the "Great American Songbook traditions" from different celebrities who helped shape my career. Ira's neighbor was Rosemary Clooney. After I met Rosemary, she took me in and called me her sixth kid. So much of what I learned came from the connection to the Gershwins and that time in Beverly Hills meeting the contemporaries of the Gershwins. The "Great American Songbook" is something that appealed to me from the time I was very young, even though it was at first a visceral reaction to the music in the lyrics, and it became my musical specialty. It all goes back to the time that I spent working for Ira and getting to know Vincente and other musical luminaries. So many different people helped

in my musical education. I didn't go to college, but that was my college education - working for Ira those years in Beverly Hills

Tell us about your work on the Library of Congress' National Recording Preservation Board.

I am no longer part of that. I was involved with that since its inception, and I eventually left the board because of spending more time doing other creative ventures. But that board was formed to create a repository of songs that are made by the Library of Congress to its permanent register as being part of American history. So that was fun to work with.

You earned your fifth Grammy Award nomination in 2009 for "The Sinatra Project." Tell us about that.

It always feels good to be nominated. A Grammy nomination is a beautiful acknowledgment that is meaningful because of the connection to other people in the industry. So I've been lucky to be nominated five times throughout the years.

What do you hope your show accomplishes?

With all my performances, the key is the great and important musical legacy of American music. It's like our greatest export, American Popular Song. People know very little about our country, especially if you go back to the days before the Internet, go back 30 years. It was American music that was one of the great cultural influences of the world. The "Great American Songbook" is a very rich field of music, and I love sharing the music because it travels like Shakespeare, Beethoven, Picasso, and Michelangelo. I like to do the songs in the context of having a little bit of history and lots of humorous anecdotes. It's fun when you put a piece of music into a historical context. you can make it more interesting and people will hear it differently. For ex-

ample, "Love is Here to Stay" was written right before George died of a brain tumor, at age 38, and Ira finished the lyric after George died. And so when I sing "Love is Here to Stay," I tell the story about how

Ira and his brother George were soulmates and how the song became Ira's love song to his lost brother because George died so suddenly. So when you tell a story like that, people hear lyrics differently, they hear a song differently. And that's why it's going to be so much fun to put together this legacy program. I'll put the song in context, telling the background about how "New York, New York" almost didn't see the light of day or how "Embraceable You" was Vincente Minnelli's favorite. All of those stories make the music come to life. That's what I hope to [accomplish]. Of course, first and foremost, to entertain, and to also give people a broader context, that also has a lot of emotional resonance and it's also a lot of fun

delivery to patients within their jurisdictions.

A liaison committee composed of Planning Commissioner Myra Demeter, Chair Gary Ross, Vice Mayor Les Friedman and Councilemmber Lili Bosse previously discussed the aforementioned regulations and were in consensus that they would like



the most amount of restrictions possible in order to limit the places this could occur. A city cannot adopt or

enforce regulations, which prohibit the "retail sale by delivery" of medicinal cannabis. This includes any regulation which has the effect of prohibiting patients within the city or their caregivers from purchasing, by delivery, cannabis to meet their demands in a timely and readily accessible manner.

Examples of prohibited regulations include the following:

• Limit the number of businesses authorized to deliver medicinal cannabis in the city

• Limit the operating hours of medicinal cannabis businesses.

• Limit the number or frequency of medicinal cannabis sales by delivery.

• Limit the types or quantities of medicinal cannabis.

• Require the establishment of physical premises within the city.

• Prohibit the establishment of physical premises from which retail sale by delivery of medicinal cannabis within the city is conducted by a licensed non storefront retailer

The City can adopt regulations related to zoning, security or public health, licensing requirements, imposing applicable state or local taxes on retail sales of medicinal cannabis occurring within the city, and regulations consistent with requirements imposed on cannabis businesses by state law.

The current regulations generally prohibits all forms of commercial cannabis activity and use with the exception of allowing for the delivery from a state licensed business located in another jurisdiction and states "any commercial cannabis activity that the City is required by state law to permit within its jurisdiction pursuant to the MAUCRSA."

The draft ordinance contains numerous specifics for each section. The following are some of the highlights from the draft

ordinance.

• Provides specifics for the application that must be submitted, including but not limited to an odor mitigation plan; a safety and security plan; and day care centers within 600 feet of the proposed location.

• Requires the business to obtain a conditional use permit.

• Provides that no cannabis product can be visible from outside.

• Prohibits public access to the location, on-site sales, and the issuance of a physician recommendation for medical cannabis from occurring at the location.

• Establishes security and surveillance requirements.

• Prohibits non-storefront, delivery-only medical cannabis retail from locating in the ground floor of any building.

The draft ordinance will be presented to the City Council at a future public hearing for adoption.

Beverly Hills Police Make Arrest of Murder Suspect

Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) officers arrested a murder suspect who is connected to a Los Angeles City homicide investigation.

On Thursday, July 27, at approximately 5:00 pm, BHPD officers were alerted by an ALPR notification of a vehicle in Beverly Hills connected to the investigation with the suspects described as armed and dangerous.

BHPD Real Time Watch Center (RTWC) personnel located the wanted vehicle and directed Patrol officers to its location. A traffic stop was initiated, at which time a vehicle pursuit ensued as the suspect vehicle fled. The driver of the vehicle lost control and was involved in a traffic collision with a parked vehicle. He exited the vehicle and ran on foot while armed with a handgun. At one point, the suspect discarded the handgun while being chased on foot. Officers eventually caught up to the suspect and took him into custody without using force.

Angel Joel Rodriguez, 21 years of age, male, of Van Nuys was arrested.

The investigation was turned over to the Los Angeles Police Department for

completion.

Planning Commission Approves Rolls Royce Showroom

The Planning Commission approved a Conditional Use Permit for the establishment of a Rolls Royce O'Gara and Coach vehicle showroom, located at 9460

Wilshire Blvd. The showroom will have

frontage along Wilshire Boulevard and El Camino Drive. Rolls Royce would relocate from its current location at 8845 Olympic Boulevard and create additional showroom space for O'Gara Coach. The Rolls Royce showroom is expected to display six vehicles, while the O'Gara Coach showroom would feature seven.

The operation of the proposed project would consist of the sales of new and pre-owned vehicles, vehicle trade-ins, lease returns, and test drive of vehicles. The project would operate from 9:00 AM - 7:00 PM, Monday - Friday and from 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM on Saturdays.

The test drive route would be in accor-

dance with the approved City test drive routes. However, this Conditional Use Permit would authorize the entrance and exit of vehicles onto the test drive route on El Camino Drive.

The applicant anticipates that the new showroom would have approximately 8-12 customers on a daily basis with an expected peak project customer demand of six parked vehicles.


