As construction of the One Beverly Hills residential and hotel development project moves forward, motorists can expect modified traffic patterns that may cause some delays along Wilshire Boulevard.

**The first phase** will consist of a one-lane closure in each direction along Wilshire Blvd. Monday through Saturday from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

The second phase will involve longer-term closures of two lanes on Wilshire Blvd. (alternating between east and westbound directions) while maintaining two lanes in both directions. ## "Beverly High World Language Department Enrollment"

I am currently the world language department Chair at Beverly Hills High School. It seems that there is some concern about recent student withdrawals from world language, level 3 Honors. As we know, with the recent changes to our BHHS world language program, a certain number of students coming from Spanish level 2 in middle school into 3 Honors in the high school decided to leave the class. This can not be attributed to one single reason, but in reality, to a mix of factors that end up with the student deciding to move places in order to find the right class for them.

None of the students who dropped had been invited to leave any class for any level. All the opposite, we always encourage students to give their best and stay if we truly see that the student is at the right level. But sometimes students disappear from classes without allowing us the opportunity to counsel them nor are we informed by the counselors that a student decided to switch schedules before it happens. We simply find out once the student has already changed his/her schedule.

The 3 Honors level courses are taught at the appropriate level, not harder, not easier, following the established newly created curriculum of our newly adopted materials for world language, VISTA higher education. The teacher is not who determines the level in which the class is taught, but instead, the College Board is (AP Spanish or French language and culture). The College Board is the organization that determines what is necessary for our students to know and how to be trained in order to be successful when they arrive at AP and they take the AP language and culture exam every May. In order to be successful, students must not have a high grade of fluency only in one academic skill, but in all 4 mandatory skills to master a language: speaking, reading, writing, and listening.

As interventions to avoid this scenario, we have provided students counseling (some of them drop even after not being referred to), we have started the school year with a review of content to try to reinforce students' skills and knowledge necessary for the class and determine their previous knowledge, we have retaught necessary concepts for that specific level, we have provided students with more than one opportunity to be successful at initial assessments, we have made ourselves available to help students not only during office hours, but during morning, nutrition, lunch and after school as students needed help...etc. Only a few

students have reached out for help.

Grammar entry-level assessments were administered at the beginning of this school year, related to the content learned during the previous year and after conducting a review in class during the preliminary lessons of the curriculum. The goal was to check student preparedness and to monitor student progress throughout the current school year. It was found that around 40% of students enrolled in 3 Honors did not quite master the content from the preceding school year. The number of students who decided to leave the course in total was around 22%.

By differentiating between honors and non-honors classes, we better meet students' needs. Learning a language is an acquired skill, so the pace, rigor, demand, and expectation are not lower simply because it is not an honors class but rather we lean into students' abilities to ensure that they feel prepared to continue if world languages are a passion of theirs. As teachers, it is our duty to ensure students' needs are constantly being met without penalty. On the contrary, we have ensured a program where our stu-

dents know that if they wish to continue taking our classes, but are not interested in honors, they have options to do so.

## Construction Worker At Beverly High Killed in Fatal Fall

A construction worker fatally fell approximately 12 feet during an accident at Beverly High last Friday.

"Thoughts and prayers are inadequate when sharing our deepest sympathy with the family of the construction worker who tragically passed away this morning before school as a result of an accident at the BHHS construction site. Together, Beverly Hills Unified School District, ProWest Constructors, and Fonder-Salari thank the Beverly Hills Fire Department and Beverly Hills Police Department for arriving on scene within minutes of the time of the ac-

cident," Superindment Michael Bregy said in a statement.

No BHUSD students or staff witnessed the accident due to site inaccessibility.

Construction operations were halted for the rest of the day and recommenced Monday with counseling services available.

"The coming days and weeks will be unimaginable for family, friends, and co-workers and we send our heartfelt condolences to everyone affected. Having worked on both BHHS and El Rodeo construction sites over the last few years, he will be remembered for his quality craftsmanship and dedication," Bregy said.

After officers arrived on scene they began lifesaving measures, which were assumed by BHFD personnel prior to hospital transport.

"Currently, there is no suspicion of foul play," BHPD spokesperson Lieutenant Reginald Evans said.

No further information could be confirmed, according to Evans.

Representatives from CAL/OSHA, the state agency that investigates workplace accidents, did not respond to a request for comment in time for the Weekly's deadline.

## Planning Commission to Discuss Private Residential Security Cameras

At their Thursday meeting the Planning Commission is expected to conduct a study session to discuss private residential security cameras on single-family-zoned properties; and provide input regarding whether to prepare a draft ordinance.

Currently, the municipal code does not provide explicit standards to govern these cameras, according to the staff report. However, the Planning Commission previously directed staff to explore this topic further.

Due to an increasing concern for public safety, both the Planning Commission and City Council held several meetings and study sessions the last two years to consider potential adjustments to existing regulations for security on walls, fences, and hedge heights.

The City Council previously approved a recommendation from the commission to amend the municipal code to increase the allowed height of walls, fences, and hedges in the rear yard and alley-facing side yard of single-family residential properties in the Central Area of the city.

Subsequent to those discussions, the



The Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at its REGULAR meeting on Thursday, October 26, 2023, will hold a public hearing beginning at **1:30 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to consider the following:

The property owner at 1169 Hillcrest Road has requested to construct a single-family residence with a daylighting basement and an attached accessory dwelling unit, which would require grading off the existing level pad. The proposed single-family residence would have a total square footage of approximately 18,442 square feet with a total height of approximately 27'-5", as measured from the



proposed grade near the basement, and approximately 14' in height as measured from the proposed finished grade. In 1958, the site received approval for the construction of a two-story single-family residence, which was subsequently demolished in 2013. To facilitate the project, the applicant has requested the following:

**Zone Text Amendment.** Pursuant to Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) §10-3-3901, the applicant has requested to amend BHMC Sections 10-3-2603, -2604, -2605, and -2650 to allow a property owner to request the removal of a second story in order to construct a daylighting basement, and to allow grading off the existing level pad, through a Trousdale R-1 Permit process. The Trousdale R-1 Permit would be subject to specific criteria and required findings and would only be available for properties that are or were previously developed with a two-story single-family residence.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections

21000 et seq.), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to qualify for a Class 5 Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15305 of the State CEQA Guidelines for minor changes in land use regulations, which states that a Class 5 Categorical Exemption may be applied to minor alterations in land use limitations in areas with an average slope of less than 20%, which do not result in any changes in land use or density. The Trousdale Area of the city has an average slope of less than 20%. Accordingly, the Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to find the project exempt from the environmental review requirements of CEQA.

commission did agree to pursue a discussion regarding possible changes to the allowable height for camera poles on residential properties.

Currently, residents are allowed to have a camera pole between 18" to 6' depending on which area of the city the property is located and where in the front yard the pole is proposed. The commission expressed a desire to pursue possible changes to allow for these poles to be taller than existing regulations.

First, the commission is expected to discuss whether they wish to create regulations for private residential security cameras.

If so, the Commission is expected to identify objectives, which may include standards to govern the height of cameras, placement, and aesthetics.



## Several Parents Raise Concerns Over BHUSD Ranking

The Board of Education held a study session last Thursday to discuss school district rankings as some parents have voiced concerns regarding decreased ranking scores.

Currently, the District ranks 1,518 in national rankings, 228 among California high schools, and 100 among Los Angeles Metro Area high schools.

This is considered among the top one percent in the nation, top 15 percent in the state for high schools, and top 15 percent in the County for high schools.

The District currently has a 90% graduation rate.

Comparatively, the District falls behind Santa Monica as they are 736 in National Rankings, 106 in California high schools, and 45 in County area high schools. As well as in Culver City, where they rank 1,321 in National Rankings, 207 in state high schools, and 91 in County area high schools.

The District also falls behind La Canada, which ranks 172 in National Rankings, 22 among California high schools, and number eight in County area high schools.

Former Board of Education member Isabel Hacker spoke during the public comment period where she discussed that some



Conditional Use Permit (CUP)

Renewal of an existing CUP to allow for an existing restaurant located on the ground floor of the L'Ermitage Hotel to remain open to the public and allow for banquets or similar private receptions to occupy the entire restaurant for up to 20 times per year. The applicant seeks amendments to existing



conditions of approval relating to the following areas: 1) the number of tables and chairs in the existing outdoor dining area along Burton Way, 2) the maintenance of parkways along Burton Way, 3) the penalty amounts for violations, and 4) hotel delivery operations.

**Development Plan Review (DPR) Renewal and Amendment.** Renewal of an existing DPR to allow for the existing restaurant to continue to operate open air dining within a landscaped courtyard fronting on Burton Way. The applicant seeks amendments to existing conditions of approval regulating amplified sound and live entertainment in the existing open air dining area along Burton Way.

Extended Hours Permit (EHP) Renewal and Amendment. Renewal of an existing EHP allowing for the operation of the existing restaurant, open air dining, and rooftop uses during extended hours. The applicant seeks amendments to the existing conditions of approval regulating the hours of operation for the ground floor open air dining area along Burton Way to increase the approved hours from 10:30 P.M. to 11:00 P.M. nightly.

Zone Text Amendment (ZTA). A request by LBVH Hotel, LLC to amend the development standards regulating the establishment of restaurants in existing legally nonconforming hotels located within the City's R-4, Multiple Residential Zones (Beverly Hills Municipal Code Section 10-3-1207). This amendment would allow for the expansion of bar and dining area within existing hotel restaurants and the establishment of new bar and dining floor area that is open to the public on the rooftop of an existing legally nonconforming hotel with an existing pool as part of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) request. In addition, the project includes the following entitlement requests associated with the ZTA request:

 $\cdot$  A  $\underline{\textbf{CUP}}$  to allow for increases in the dining and bar area of the existing ground floor

restaurant and a dining and bar area associated with a proposed new restaurant on the existing rooftop of the hotel that would be open to the public.

- $\cdot$  A <u>**PPR**</u> to establish new open air bar and dining areas on the rooftop of the hotel that would be associated with a new restaurant that is open to the public and also to include a determination that the parking required for this new restaurant use would be met with the existing parking supply.
- · An **EHP** to allow for extended hours for the proposed rooftop restaurant and rooftop open air dining area, with proposed hours of operation from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 PM daily and with the ability to allow for dining operations at begin at 6:00 A.M. at a later date. if needed.

The requested CUP, DPR, and EHP associated with the ZTA would not become effective unless the amended municipal code language in the ZTA request is approved by the City Council.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to qualify for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption (Existing Facilities) and Class 5 (Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations) in accordance with the requirements of Sections 15301 and 15305 of the state CEQA Guidelines. Accordingly, the Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to find the project categorically exempt from further environmental review under CEQA.

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teachers may be implementing an "equitable grading system" where 60% to 79% is a B, 40% to 59% is a C, and 20% to 39% is a D. (See photo).

"I strongly suggest that the Board look into this grading system and find out how many teachers are actually implementing this new grading scale. And take some time to educate parents and inform us as to why this scale is better than the one that we grew up with. I don't see any other [purpose of this scale] than to inflate grades," Hacker

Another parent, Michal Amir-Salkin, also discussed the declining national rankings of the district.

Amir-Salkin said that 32 percent of students were not proficient in reading, 39 percent were not proficient in math, and 60 percent were not proficient in science.

"These tests may be long and boring but they are not difficult. They're geared to California's standards of education, which are actually pretty darn low," Amir-Salkin

She added, "Why do we have a 90% graduation rate? Are you just passing them along without caring whether or not they're ready to take that next step? That's setting kids up for failure, not for success."

Comparatively, La Canada has a 99% graduation rate.

Amir-Salkin also said that the district was 82 in California in 2017, and in 2022, the district has fallen to 276.

Assistant Superintendent of Education Services Dustin Seemann said during his presentation that after the fall of 2022, 79 percent of students went off to a two or four year institution. In 2015, that number was 82 percent. Seemann claims that the minor decrease is likely due to impacts regarding

"We have consistently, from 2015 to 2022, had about 20% of our population, year institutions. Whether they're taking a gap year, going directly into the workforce for a family company, or taking time off,"

In 2015, 19 percent of graduating students enrolled in SMC, or other two year institutions. In 2022, that number was 18 percent. In 2015, 65 percent of the graduation class went to a four year institution and in 2022, 65 percent enrolled.

Seemann said that after SMC, many students either attend UCLA or another UC. Which also includes those who enroll right out of high school.

Board President Noah Margo recommended that the District include Cs when they are monitoring student grades in relation to the rest of their grades.

"If it is once in a while, it is an outlier, that's not a red flag to me. It's a C that's accompanying other Cs, that is a red flag to me and those students should have the attention and support [they need]," Margo

He also recommended that there should be a comprehensive proficiency exam for eighth graders in all foreign languages that is not just a multiple choice exam.

"The real crux of understanding foreign language is being able to speak it and listen to it. I would strongly advocate to look into how we get a placement exam like colleges do," Margo said.

## **City Council OKs Beverly Boulevard Bike Lanes**

The City Council expressed support for a recommendation from the Traffic and Parking Commission regarding proposed bike lanes on Beverly Boulevard between North Santa Monica Boulevard and Doheny Drive. The proposed design would not remove any vehicle travel lanes or on-street narking

The Commission approved the recommendation in a 3-1 vote, with Ron Shalowitz dissenting.

the project is a "win-win," as it is believed by some that there are no tradeoffs with vehicle infrastructure. Several commenters in support requested that the bike lanes be protected for increased separation of travel

Reasons for opposition included perceived lack of bicycle connectivity, concerns about impacts to vehicle traffic, and safety concerns. Some commenters in opposition also suggested the bike lanes should be protected for increased separation of travel modes, which will be tested without impacting the number of travel lanes as noted above.

This bikeway would connect with existing bike lanes on North Santa Monica Boulevard, an existing bike route on North

Palm Drive, and planned bike lanes on Beverly Boulevard in the City of West Hollywood, which would close a gap in the regional bicycle network, according to the staff report.

According to the report, between Jan. 1, 2016 and Dec. 31, 2022, there have been 42 collisions on this segment of Beverly Boulevard. Nearly all were injury collisions except one.

Proposed bike lanes on Beverly Blvd are not expected to result in any reduction in the number of vehicle travel lanes, turn lanes, or on-street parking spaces, as there is currently no on-street parking along this segment.

This is also intended to address reported concerns from residents by narrowing the travel lanes to include bike lanes in hopes of addressing excessive vehicle speeds. Electronic driver speed feedback signs will also be installed in an effort to encourage drivers to travel at speeds within the limit.

Staff is also exploring the possibility

of installing narrow delineators on the bike lane lines to create protected bike lanes.

City staff plans to incorporate them into the ongoing Citywide pavement marking project for installation this fall.

## **Man Sentenced For Fraud After Stash Of Cash Found**

## at Defunct U.S. **Private** Vaults

A man who was the leader of a conspiracy that stole more than \$800,000 in COVID-19 jobless benefits was sentenced

week to 97 months in federal prison.

Robert Mirumyan, 31, was also ordered to pay \$804,579 in restitution.

Mirumyan pleaded guilty in June to one count of conspiracy to commit bank fraud, admitting that he oversaw a scheme that used stolen identities to apply for COVIDera unemployment insurance benefits from the California Employment Development Department (EDD).

Mirumyan came to the attention of law enforcement when the FBI executed search and seizure warrants in March 2021 against the defunct Beverly Hills-based U.S. Private Vaults, where investigators discovered a safety deposit box held in the name of Mirumyan's wife that contained \$400,000

U.S. Private Vaults, a private safety deposit box company on Olympic that adver-

tised it was not subject to bank "know your customer" rules, pleaded guilty in 2022 to conspiring to launder money with its customers.

It is alleged that during 2020, and continuing through Aug. of 2021, Mirumyan and others used other people's identities to apply for unemployment benefits through the EDD, according to court documents.

Once EDD approved the false and fraudulent applications, banks issued debit cards containing the funds intended for the false identities. Mirumyan and others used the fraudulently obtained debit cards to with-

"When confronted with the COVID pandemic that has claimed the lives of almost 7 million persons worldwide to date, [Mirumyan] instead saw an opportunity to bilk taxpayers out of the emergency funds their government generously made available to ameliorate job losses," according to a sentencing memorandum filed in this case. "Such criminal opportunism during a global health and economic emergency is egregious."

Judge Percy Anderson described Mirumyan's offense as "galling" and "callous," noting that the defendant took advantage of benefits meant to help the unemployed even while he had the talent and opportunities to earn money legitimately.

'[I]t appears that [Mirumyan] made a decision to pursue riches through fraud rather than to participate in the legitimate econuntil his stash of \$400,000 in cash was accidentally discovered at U.S. Private Vaults based on an unrelated investigation of that business. [Mirumyan] was able to support himself and his family, purchasing a million-dollar home with a swimming pool with his criminal income."

In Issue #1252, the Weekly reported that the Institute for Justice filed two lawsuits on behalf of clients who had property seized from their safety deposit boxes in the FBI raid on U.S. Private Vaults.
