

Fake Blood Thrown on Tuchin's Driveway

Video circulating social media showed a group of about a dozen protesters hurling smoke bombs while holding a banner reading: "F-k ur holiday! Baby killer" and chanted "Hey, ho, the occupation has got to go."

The protesters left bunches of cloth covered in fake blood to symbolize dead babies and spilled red paint along the driveway.

The People's City Council-Los Angeles, which describes itself as an anticapitalist and anti-imperialist group, took credit for the protest, calling it a "holiday wake-up call."

"AIPAC spends tens of millions to control pro-genocide Congress members," it wrote on X. "F-k your holiday, baby killer."

"When I realized they were attacking the private property of my neighbor, I decided to go and try to stop them," said one of Tuchin's neighbors, who did not want to be named, according to NBC.

According to the neighbor, he tried to stop the group from defacing the home.

"They put red paint on the car, on the driveway, on the windows," he said. "They were terrorizing our neighbor."

A confrontation ensued between the group and the unnamed neighbor, who said he was hit from behind with a steel pole, according to NBC.

Tuchin, a 1983 Beverly High graduate, did not respond to a request for comment.

City Council Approves \$8 Million Gale Drive Property Purchase

At last Tuesday's meeting the City Council approved the purchase of property located at 111 North Gale Drive in the amount of \$8,419,000.

The Property contains approximately 6,500 square feet of land. The acquisition adds to an assemblage of City-controlled property spanning the block along Wilshire Boulevard from Hamilton Drive to Gale Drive, according to the staff re-

port.

The City currently owns four other parcels. Parcel A is located at 8423 Wilshire. It was acquired in 2019, and includes the Clock Market historic building. Parcel B at 8421 Wilshire was acquired in 2017, and is used by Metro for construction purposes as part of the larger property often referred to as the Gale Staging Yard. Parcel C at 8401 Wilshire was acquired in March and is also used by Metro and is part of the Gale Yard. The property at 111 North Gale, is also used by Metro.

According to the staff report, the City is continuing to take steps to acquire properties for future affordable housing, parking, and/or economic purposes. Currently, there are no specific development plans. However, the properties may one day be utilized in conjunction with improvements to provide public amenities, retail, and/or residential uses in a mixed use project.

The City has been evaluating options for future use of the property it already owns and has conducted two Gale Yard public forums to seek input on long-term uses of the 8421 Wilshire property. There was a general understanding to maintain the historic integrity of the Clock Market and for the city to acquire additional land for the benefit of a future project, according to the staff report.

A GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT AND DRAFT ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE MIXED USE OVERLAY ZONE REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO RESIDENTIAL CONVERSION OF EXISTING COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS TO MIXED USE BUILDINGS AND AN ADDENDUM TO AN ADOPTED MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (MND) FOR THE MIXED USE OVERLAY ZONE AMENDMENTS

The Mixed Use Overlay Zone (MU Overlay Zone) was adopted in November 2020, via Ordinance No. 20-O-2825, and established development standards to guide future commercial/residential mixed use developments on certain C-3 Commercial Zone properties in the City. The MU Overlay Zone allows for properties to be redeveloped with mixed use projects, or to convert existing commercial buildings to mixed use projects. At their July 18, 2023 formal meeting, the City Council held a study session to review the implementation of the MU Overlay Zone and discussed whether the MU Overlay Zone regulations should be modified in the future. One of the topics considered at the study session was the residential unit density calculation in the conversion section (BHMC §10-3-1888) of the MU Overlay Zone regulations. The discussion identified that the number of allowable residential units in an existing commercial building should be calculated based on the existing building envelope rather than the size of the property. The City Council provided direction to staff to develop a draft amendment of the MU Overlay Zone regulations for the City Council's consideration that clearly allows the use of the minimum unit size of 500 square feet to calculate the maximum density allowed for conversion projects. This modification also necessitates a General Plan Amendment to the General Plan Land Use map to identify the density calculation that is applicable to conversion projects. At the September 28, 2023 Planning Commission meeting, staff presented the draft ordinance and General Plan Amendment, and the Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to adopt the resolution recommending the draft ordinance and the General Plan Amendment for approval to the City Council.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The City of Beverly Hills has previously adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the adoption of the Mixed Use Overlay Zone regulations (Project). The City of Beverly Hills was the lead agency, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and was responsible for the preparation of the MND and related initial study. The previously adopted MND document is available at www.beverlyhills.org/ environmental. If a digital copy cannot be obtained by an interested party, please contact the staff listed in this notice and alternate arrangements will be made. The previously adopted MND indicated that the Project would not result in significant impacts to Agricultural and Forestry Resources, Biological Resources, Mineral Resources, and Transportation/Traffic. The MND also indicated that the Project would result in less than significant impacts related to Air Quality, Cultural Resources, Energy, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Public Services, Recreation, Tribal Cultural Resources, Utilities and Service Systems, and Wildfire, and either no impact or less than significant impacts on certain environmental issues related to Aesthetics, Geology and Soils, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use and Planning, Noise, and Population and Housing.

An addendum to the previously adopted MND for a proposed change to the Mixed Use Overlay Zone has been prepared, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15164. A copy of the addendum will be available as part of the agenda materials for this meeting date, on www.beverlyhills.org/citycouncilmeetings, at least 24 hours

before the meeting. The Project description and location are described above, and the adoption of amendments includes changes that are limited to revisions that will result in greater clarity regarding the application of regulations. The proposed general plan amendment and code changes will include a clarification regarding the calculation of maximum density allowed for conversion projects under the MU Overlay Zone, and a change to the General Plan Land Use map noting this clarification. Since these changes consist of clarifications of existing regulations, the Project will not result in significant impacts to the areas of study in the adopted MND, and none of the conditions in California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15162 have occurred, the City Council will consider the adoption of the addendum to the previously adopted MND.

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version projects in the Mixed Use Overlay Zone.

The proposed amendment to the Mixed Use Overlay Zone regulations would allow a residential conversion project to utilize the minimum unit size of 500 square feet to determine the maximum number of units allowed to be created within a conversion project, in which an existing commercial building located within the zone may be converted to a mixed use project.

The proposed density calculation would be applied to a residential conversion project by taking the existing building floor area, minus the ground floor footprint and dividing this by the minimum unit size, 500 square feet. The existing floor area would be determined after non-residential floor area is defined and the ground floor footprint would not

be included, as the regulations generally require that this area is used for commercial uses only.

This differs from the existing maximum density calculation, which allows one dwelling unit per 550 square feet of lot area, according to a City staff report. However, the proposed change would allow a conversion project to maximize the number of units that are able to be created within an existing commercial building.

On Nov. 17, 2020, the City Council adopted an ordinance to establish standards to guide future mixed use development proposals along specific commercial corridors within the C-3 Commercial Zone.

At their July 18 meeting, the City Council reviewed the progress of the implementation thus far, and discussed

The Project involves amendments to the City's General Plan Housing Element as adopted on February 23, 2023 for the planning period from 2021 to 2029 (6th Cycle). No physical development nor construction is currently proposed as part of the Project. The Housing Element is a planning document that contains programs and policies to guide housing development in the City. The Housing Element includes the following topics: analysis of the City's demographic characteristics and housing needs; evaluation of resources and opportunities available to address current and future housing needs; analysis of potential constraints on meeting the City's housing needs; a review of the City's accomplishments during the previous planning period; and updated policies and programs intended to address the City's housing needs for the period through 2029. Additionally, the Housing Element discusses how the City's land use and zoning regulations and programs will accommodate the City's Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA), which is the number of housing units expected to be needed for the next planning period (2021-2029), and includes a list of suitable sites to accommodate housing at various levels of affordability. The Project area covers the entire City of Beverly Hills since the Housing Element addresses housing conditions throughout the City. The City Council will also review an addendum to the Initial Study/ Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the Project. The revised Housing Element document is available at: www.beverlyhills.org/housingelementupdate.

The revisions to the Housing Element have been made in response to the comments provided in letters from the state Housing and Community Development Department (HCD), and primarily consist of changes to the policies and programs in the Housing Plan, such as the addition of greater details and specific timelines, the addition of more information on local and regional trends and data within the Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing (AFFH) section, and extensive revisions to the sites inventory to add criteria to determine suitable sites and realistic capacity of these sites to accommodate housing units. In addition, more information and analysis has been added regarding potential sites for adaptive reuse/conversion mixed use projects and research to support this trend.

Suit Alleges Property Manager's Illegal Entry **Into Woman's Beverly Hills Apartment Let Dog Get Hit** By Car

A Beverly Hills landlord is being sued for their alleged involvement in the death of a tenant's emotional support dog, according to the lawsuit.

The suit alleges that the emotional support dog was left to die by the side of a road after being hit by a car when the property manager showed an apartment

to prospective tenants on a few minutes' notice, despite not having permission.

According to the suit filed on Nov. 16, the dog, Roxy, was frightened by the strangers and sprint- Roxy and Shannon ed from the Rexford Flats

apartment at 450 South Rexford Drive and was immediately struck by a vehicle. It is further alleged that the property manager subsequently picked Roxy up, dropped her at the side of the road, and left her dying there, the lawsuit states.

Several days later, the landlord attempted to evict the tenant, Shannon Sokolow, despite her rent being all paid up through the end of her lease, the lawsuit states.

"Shannon suffers from anxiety and depression, and Roxy lowered her anxiety, helped calm and relax her, and enhanced her social engagements and interactions," plaintiff's attorney Camron Dowlatshahi. "Since Roxy's death, she has had to go through trauma therapy to cope with losing her best friend and emotional support."

The lawsuit accuses Shiva Mehrdad, the property manager, and the brokerage and property management companies that employed Mehrdad, of negligence, trespass, breach of contract and violation of Sokolow's right to quiet enjoyment of her apartment.

Mehrdad did not respond to a request for comment in time for the Weekly's deadline.

Last year, Haddish was also arrested on suspicion of DUI in suburban Atlanta.

City Council to Consider **Labor Agreements**

The City Council will consider the memoranda of understanding (MOUs) with the city's six non-sworn employee associations: the Management & Professional Association, Supervisors Association, Confidential Employees Association, Safety Support Association, Municipal Employees Association and Municipal Employees Association Part-Time Unit at the Dec. 5 meeting. During that meeting, the Council will also consider proposed amendments to the Executive Compensation Plan.

In accordance with state law, the City participates in labor negotiations with its employee associations. The results of the negotiations process are written agreements or contracts reached between the City and the City employee associations. These agreements are commonly referred to as MOUs.

The MOUs have been ratified by each of the employee associations and are subject to adoption if approved by the City Council. Negotiations with the groups were completed in mid-October. The proposed MOUs cover salaries and benefits for a three-year term for all six employee associations

Per the City's Civic Openness in Negotiations (COIN) Ordinance, an independent fiscal analysis was conducted for each MOU. The fiscal analyses and proposed MOUs are posted on the City's website at beverlyhills. org/negotiations.

There are nine represented employee associations within the City of Beverly Hills. The following association MOUs are currently not up for negotiations until 2025: The Beverly Hills Police Officers' Association, Police Management Association and Firefighters' Associa-

Tell us about getting your start in theatre on the Beverly High stage.

Beverly was a big part of my development. My best friend David was very into theatre and I was into music. I sang in the Madrigal Singers [under the direction of] Joel Pressman, who died about ten years ago. He was the leader of the Madrigals for decades and I was very lucky to have him as a teacher. He had a big impact on me and gave me a lot of confidence and a lot of trust. I was in the fall play

and the spring musical a couple of times. There were very good [drama] teachers there, [such as] Herb Hall, all of whom I worked with and had a really good time with. There was also a critical mass of really talented and dedicated students in that period. It was just a cool time to be there in the mid 1990s and it definitely gave me a real sense of passion and professionalism. I think those theatre can do that no are the two things I took mainly from

my time in Beverly.

The teachers really gave us a chance to see people who had been in the profession and were really modeling what it meant to take this work seriously, but also a kind of passion and joy. That was very meaningful to me because I felt very passionate about these things, but I didn't know if it was okay to show that. That had a big impact on me wanting to study theatre at college and grad school.

You are directing an off-Broadway production of Pericles in Feb. Tell us about that.

This is with a theatre company that I founded called Fiasco Theater. We are based in New York, but we don't have a home [or] building. Whenever we want to do a show, we usually partner with a much larger theatre that has their own space that's excited about our work and wants to showcase our stuff as part of their season. This is our second time partnering with Classic Stage [Com-

pany]. We were there about six years ago with another Shakeproduction. speare There's a new artistic director there now, and she saw a workshop production that we did a year ago, and she [was] very excited about it and wanted to put it in her season. I think one of the cool things about the way our work is received in New York is that we're also sort of known as an acting company. That's what our theatre is basically – an acting ensemble led by actors. We just do the stuff that we're drawn to [and] that we're passionate

about. I think we've gained a reputation in New York as a theatre company that does really joyful and really creative productions of Shakespeare in particular. This is the first new Shakespeare production we've done in several years. So it's really fun for us to get back into looking at those plays again.

What do you like most about directing Shakespeare?

It's got it all. Each moment is a new opportunity where something completely different is happening. Shakespeare is so great about mixing different tones together, different ideas, [and] different language. There's just so much going but the rewards are so tremendous. I like directing Shakespeare because I feel like every time you do, you're given a chance to really say what you believe theatre fundamentally is. Every time you can kind of share that with an audience. I think Shakespeare puts us back in touch with something fundamental that theatre can do that no other art form can.

Have you noticed that audiences are more receptive to live theatre post **COVID?**

I would say it's been a mix. Some audiences are so hungry and delighted to be back and so happy to be sharing space again. It really demonstrated an ongoing passion and need for live theatre. I think other audience members sort of got addicted to being at home, as we all did. It's been harder for the theatre world more broadly to get audiences, donors, philanthropists, and subscribers back. That's been a challenge for theatres nationwide. But we're very lucky that our Fiasco audience here in New York and our producing partners have stayed and recommitted to being on this journey with us.

Your father, Michael Steinfield, was the Beverly Hills public librarian in the 1990s and early 2000s. Tell us about that.

That's why we moved there. I grew up mostly in Boston, and [my] dad was running the [The Public Library of Brookline]. When I was 13, the summer before eighth grade in 1992, he got the job at Beverly Hills. I remember they flew us out there when he was a finalist and they put us in the Beverly Hills Hotel. I was lying there in a robe thinking 'This is pretty great.' My dad joked that one of the reasons he thought it would be okay moving out there, even though it's tough to move across the country, is that the two things I was most excited about at the time were playing tennis and playing the guitar. Obviously, LA is a pretty good place to be if you like to play tennis all year round and be in the center of the music world and play guitar. The truth is that it was a pretty smooth transition for

me. I can't say that I ever fully understood California, and whether I fully felt comfortable in LA. But I really did have a great experience there.

I think my dad did some really meaningful things at the library. He created a great afternoon performance series and expanded the collection. He gave lots of people opportunities to work there. He fought very hard to keep the library free for people who live out of the district. I think there was some sort of concert in the wake of the LA riots in the mid 1990s. But I actually conducted a concert that Mr. Pressman was unavailable to conduct. But the Madrigals and I think a gospel choir, maybe from LA, sang and the event was actually hosted in the Beverly Hills Civic Center. My dad was really involved in a lot of those community events as well, and worked very closely with the Friends of the Library. Sometimes I would get to go in there either before it opened or after it closed and be in the library when nobody was there. That was always cool. Some of my classmates were not clear on what public institutions were. So they would always say, 'Hey, your dad owns the library, right?' He also knew [the late Beverly High Principal Ben Bushman]. He was a great guy.


Tell us about your family.

My wife, Kate, is an educator. She's the lower school principal at an independent school here in New Jersey. We've been married for about 15 years. We have an 11 year old son named Leo who is awesome. He's also into tennis and music. So we live in New Jersey, but my work is in New York.

What do you want audiences to take away from Pericles?

One of the things about working on Shakespeare is that no matter what's going on in the world, it always feels like the play you are working on is about that stuff. Given the amount of horror and conflict in the world, I want people to take away a sense of hope, a sense of the impossible. I want audiences to have an experience of something spiritual and miraculous that perhaps feels like it's gone missing.

What are some of your goals as the incoming BHUSD Board of Education president?

I want to continue to have a united and unified board that is working towards [common] goals. One thing that I feel I have pushed pretty strongly for and want to continue to [address], is our difficulties with math and [enhancing] our performance on state assessments. When you think about the State of California, it's pretty big and there are a lot of different types of communities. The fact that there's a rapid fall in performance that not even that many of us are meeting state standards, is a huge concern. As a united board [that] is charged with giving direction and feedback [with] the wonderful educators and leaders we have, we can begin to turn it around.

Operationally, I am really thrilled that the Joint Powers Agreement has been [approved], and I think we've never had a better relationship with the City than we do right now. I want to continue to leverage that and work with the city [to achieve] that goal.

I've had [concerns] in the very recent terrible time in history [regarding] weeks the massacre on Oct. 7. [The surge] in anti-Semitism [and] the general climate that we continue to be [within] our schools, families, [and] communities [create] fear, anxiety, [and] uncertainty. There are questions among parents as to how we, as educators, are to navigate systems that we are all sion, the topics [stemming] from this horrific act and the atrocities that

are going on. It's obviously a very complex situation that involves many different disciplines in terms of our learners, and it involves many different layers [of our] community.

I'm always singing the praises of our town and [acknowledge] how fortunate we are in this day and age. But it is also important to make sure that our whole community recognizes that we are stronger and happier when everyone feels safe and secure. It cannot just be - I am only concerned for this fraction of the families or I'm only fighting for this population. I entered into this profession to embrace all types of families [and] viewpoints. In [fostering respect and support for] all, not just between the kids but also among families and educators - we become a much more diverse, stronger, and secure community. As [members of the] board, we [serve as] stewards for these types of messages. As we [face] this terrible time in history with the conflict in the Middle East, [I want to make sure] that we continue to be role models as adults on how to navigate conflict, strongly rooted perceptions, opinions, and belief systems that we are all faced with.


You are a child psychologist by profession. Tell us about that.

When I was in Boston at Harvard Grad-

uate School, I had to

make a decision as to whether I wanted to do therapy with children and deal with emotions and motivations, or [if] I wanted to [pursue] educational psychology. I found a wonderful nexus of both academics and developmental psychology and I have been a school psychologist for about 12 years now. Of course since the pandemic, one simply can't avoid the emotional issues that children are facing. Even though I am an educational psychologist by trade, I certainly navigate a lot of those issues. I am very vigilant in our own community about anxiety, depresdistractibility, and challenges that our own students are

facing given post-pandemic times, as well as the conflict in the Middle East.



Albuquerque is about 20 miles south of a town called Corrales. That is actually where I grew up. [About] 50 years ago, New Mexico was a very primitive state. In the [1960s], my parents thought that they had had enough of New York City and Boston. When they came out for the first time ever, they could not believe the

blue skies, that everything was one story, and just the general ease of living. That's where they laid down their roots and all [of our] family members from the East Coast followed suit. We were sort of pioneers in that regard. I always felt like I was a transplanted New Yorker.

When I was working in an inpatient psychiatric unit for adolescents in Boston,

I realized, first of all, it was a very difficult job because there was a lot of sadness in seeing children who actually had to be locked up. That plus the darkness, cold, and everything that comes with winters in the Northeast, I wanted to go back west, but I didn't want to go back to my hometown. I wanted to explore things I hadn't

seen [and] decided to go to Los Angeles. I came up [here] without a job, without anything, [and] without knowing anyone. I went to an Internet cafe and I found a rental [that] looked so nice and sunny. So I headed there, and then subsequently I learned about how amazing Beverly Hills is. [I soon came to realize that] all the stereotypes I had heard growing up- everyone is super rich-no one is down to earth-that those are just stereotypes and they're not true. I learned [that]

Beverly Hills is a very educated, well-resourced town, [that is] predominantly Jewish, and has a lot to offer. So in 2004, I purchased my first house in Beverly Hills. I've been there ever since and I can't complain. It's very different from New Mexico in the Wild West. But at the same time, it has the blue skies that I desperately need.

BHUSD construction has been ongoing and will continue for several years. Can you give us an update on that?

We're really excited that in the fall of next year, we will be going into a brand new El Rodeo after several years. That's

probably our biggest milestone to date. New turf and fielding has been laid out for Hawthorne. We are actively looking for how we want to make use of Hawthorne, because when a lot of the students finally migrate to El Rodeo, the incoming students [at] Hawthorne will be relatively few in number. So we have a lot of space and a lot of decisions to make. At this time, we

haven't finalized those decisions. But one idea is to make it a dedicated early childhood center. So we are really looking at that. I know that B3 and B4 at the high school are coming along, and I think those are expected to be finalized shortly. We are anticipating taking the old Lasky offices and moving them to Hawthorne and deciding what to do with Lasky at that point. We will hold on to it, but we will look at developers for different options in terms of revenue producing for the school district.

How would evaluate the job Superintendent Michael Bregy is doing?

I think he's doing an exceptional job. If you start at the very basics, everything he does is 100% in good faith. He has a youthful spirit and manages to spend an incredible amount of time, energy, and fore-

thought concerning all district matters. He's a hands-on fellow and was amazing when we had the fear of the catastrophic rains. He remained calm [and] made a very wise decision not to close schools. The challengthat can be done when es he has faced with some of the drama in our school district have been hard but he has managed it well. He is good at making relationships, works well with his cabinet, [and] definitely understands fiscal and construction matters. Most importantly, [he

excels as a] leader with his team to make sure that they take care of these different aspects of our school district.

What advice has outgoing Board of Education President Noah Margo given

[When] parents [approach] you with lots of problems or questions, [it's important to convey] that they understand that our job is not HR. [Instead, we function] as stewards from a much [broader], macro perspective. So we need to offer guidance accordingly.

What is one thing you would like to accomplish by this time next year?

Since the pandemic, we as school stewards can no longer think about mental health and social emotional learning as icing on the cake or a luxury that can be done when math, english, and science are finished. We have reached a point in society where mental health issues have become very front and center. In fact, one of the greatest achievements we have accomplished is the recent opening of the [BulldogAid Wellness Center], which is at the middle school. I think we're one of the only districts that not only has a high school dedicated mental health center, but also the middle school. That sends a large and important message, which is that even kids who present as seemingly normal in our traditional understanding of that, really could be suffering in a lot of ways. In a year's time, I would love to see that we are seamlessly offering all students support and help and those who are identified as needing much more intense [assistance] feel accepted and supported.

It is disappointing to me that we have so many offerings for our students, so many pathways as we call them [but] it seems that there is a good percentage of students who don't necessarily take advantage of those. It's hard to say why, but it would be great if these [pathways] became [more] attainable for all of our students [so] they would take advantage of these amazing offerings. [That way we] have a better sense of what they want to do for college or as a post-secondary education. [By fostering this], our community can once again embrace the notion of really striving for four year colleges, the value of planning, and making your mark in terms of where you go after high school.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-O-2884

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AUTHORIZING THE BEVERLY HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT'S MILITARY EQUIP-MENT USE INVENTORY IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7071

The City Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2021 the State Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 481 ("AB 481"), adding sections 7070 et seq. to the Government Code, requiring law enforcement agencies to obtain approval from their governing body before acquiring military equipment, as de fined by Government Code section 7070(c); and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7071 requires law enforcement agencies to obtain approval from their governing body by an ordinance adopting a military equipment use policy, at a regular meeting held pursuant to open meeting laws, prior to taking certain actions relating to the funding, acquisition, or use of military equipment; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2022, City Council adopted its military equipment use ordinance, Ordinance No. 22-O-2859, approving the Beverly Hills Police Department's Military Equipment Use Policy ("Policy 706") and Military Equipment Use Inventory; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2023, City Council approved the Beverly Hills Police Department's request to add additional items to the approved Military Equipment Use Inventory; specifically seven new drone models (for a total of 20 additional drones); and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2023, City Council authorized the Beverly Hills Police Department's new Military Equipment Use Inventory (Ordinance No-23-O-2875) and renewed its military equipment ordinance, Ordinance No-23-O-2876); and

WHEREAS, the Beverly Hills Police Department currently possesses equipment that qualifies under the definition of "military equipment" in Government Code section 7070(c), and wishes to continue to use such equipment in a responsible manner to ensure the safety of the community and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Beverly Hills Police Department seeks to add to its existing Military Equipment Use Inventory by permanently acquiring thirteen Brugger & Thomet ("B&T") semi-automatic carbine firearms identified in the attached Beverly Hills Police Department Military Equipment Inventory ("Military Equipment Inventory"), for the purpose of protecting the safety of officers residents and visitors in the City of Beverly Hills in high-risk situations.

NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds that all of the facts set forth in the Recitals above are true and correct.

Section 2. Legislative Findings. Pursuant to Government Code Section 7071, the City Council considered the adoption of this Ordinance at a regular, public meeting on November 7. 2023, and based on the facts set forth above. the Agenda Report, the information provided to the City Council at the public meeting, and the record thereof which is incorporated by this reference, the City Council hereby determines and makes the following findings:

A. The military equipment identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department's Military Equipment Inventory are necessary because there is no reasonable alternative that can achieve the same objective of officer and civilian safety for the reasons identified in the Military Equipment Inventory; and

B. The military equipment identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department's Military Equipment Inventory will safeguard the public's welfare, safety, civil rights, and civil liberties for the reasons identified in the Military Equipment Inventory; and

C. The military equipment identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department's Military Equipment Inventory are necessary because there are no cost effective alternatives; and

D. Prior military equipment use complied with Beverly Hills Police Department Policy 706, or if prior uses did not comply with the accompanying military equipment use policy, corrective action has been taken to remedy nonconforming uses and ensure future compliance.

Section 3. Pursuant to Government

Code Section 7071, the City Council hereby authorizes the Beverly Hills Police Department to acquire the thirteen B&T semi-automatic carbine firearms identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department's Military Equipment Inventory, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance, or its application to any other person or circumstance. The City Council declares that it would have adopted each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof be declared invalid or unenforce-

Section 5. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and this certification. together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

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
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
