Pro-Gaza Public Comment over Flag Display Sparks **City Council Reaction**

A pro-Gaza public comment was made at Tuesday's City Council meeting over an approved flag display that will honor each life lost on Oct. 7.

At Tuesday's Study Session, the City Council finalized details whereby one flag for each life lost is displayed, with each flag being representative of the nationality of the individual.

The Consulate General of Israel's Office first presented the concept of a flag display to Mayor Julian Gold in Oct. Given that there were approximately 1,400 lives lost on Oct. 7, there would be approximately 1,400 flags installed, with the Consulate General's Office providing the final number and nations to be represented.

Mark Elliot, who is also the founder of Beverly Hills Renters Alliance, suggested that the Council also honor the lives lost in Gaza as a result of Israel defending itself against ongoing attacks by Hamas.

"I don't support terrorists in any form. But I also stand against the indiscriminate war in Gaza. The likes we have not seen since the US waged war in Iraq and before that the cross bombing in Vietnam and Cambodia," Elliot said. "Can't you also recognize innocent lives lost in Gaza? Where is the resolution from the City Council recognizing the estimated 15,000 lives lost in Gaza? Where is the sentiment among this Council about the 5,000 children's lives lost? Where will the City put 15,000 flags of the Gazans [who died]? I stand with those who call out human rights abuses and war crimes."

Towards the end of the City Council meeting, each councilmember made statements condemning the rise in anti-semitism throughout the nation.

die Fenton is working to elect two new

Councilmembers that he claimed would be the "hidden hand of influence."

"The real problem is the hidden hand of influence wielded by special interests that will fight mightily to keep in place our current council's pro-growth agenda," Elliot wrote in the letter. "My concern is that Fenton and Gold will continue to influence city business through their chosen candidates and endorsements."

Elliot further alleged in that letter that the Firefighters Association endorsement of candidate Mary Wells is "less about Wells herself" but more so that the Council can "run this city for the benefit of themselves and special interests."

"Is there some anti-growth machine that we should also look out for? Perhaps the Elliot machine," Gold said. "I think Mr. Elliot owes the public an apology. There is a way to disagree without these offensive, unnecessary, and false personal attacks."

Elliot stated in his letter that voters should pay close attention to who receives endorsements.

"I know for a fact that at least one current candidate has been endorsed by Elliot. I would ask him, that candidate, to please denounce and repudiate Mr. Elliot's remarks. And I would ask the same of all the candidates in the next Council race. We are early on in the race. Let us hope Mr. Elliot is not setting the tone on how candidates will treat each other. We are better than that," Gold said

Beverly Hills Police Make Arrests of Robbery Suspects

The Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) have identified suspects who were potentially involved in numerous additional crimes throughout the region after coordinating with surrounding agencies.

From July through Oct. 2023, residents of Los Angeles County and Orange County were plagued by a string of armed robberies involving several armed suspects. The robberies primarily targeted individuals for their luxury watches and jewelry, with an additional connection to a home invasion robbery in the City of Brea.

After making several robbery and gun related arrests in Beverly Hills, BHPD detectives realized that the suspects were potentially involved in numerous additional crimes throughout the region and began coordinating with surrounding agencies, including the Santa Monica Police Department (SMPD), Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department West Hollywood Division (LASD West Hollywood), Los Angeles Police Department Robbery-Homicide Division (LAPD RHD), LA IMPACT, and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF).

BHPD detectives and partner agencies identified the suspects responsible for six robberies throughout Los Angeles County. This effort resulted in the execution of numerous search warrants at locations across Southern Calif. and Flagstaff, Ariz. BHPD Detectives successfully recovered property for two of the victims related to a Beverly Hills robbery.

The search warrants yielded a wealth of evidence linking the suspects to the crimes and provided leads for the ongoing investigation. The evidence included six guns, stolen luxury watches, jewelry, and other pertinent materials.



calming treatments that would assist in a transition from arterial streets to residential streets in an effort to slow speeds and reduce cut-through traffic, according to the staff report. They did not support traffic calming devices that resulted in more impacts to residents of the corridor, such as diverters that would restrict vehicle movements.

The police department indicated support, including traffic circles, and suggested it be implemented in a way that discourages cut-through traffic on a neighborhood-wide level.

The fire department indicated support, including traffic circles, on Clifton Way, as it is not a primary emergency response route.

hosted a booth at the Farmers' Market on March 2. Additionally, city staff organized a popup event on March 25, in an effort to demonstrate what traffic calming features requested by the community could look like.

City staff installed a traffic circle at Clifton Way/Le Doux Road and curb extensions at Clifton Way/Stanley Drive and invited the community and emergency responders to test the infrastructure.

Residents confirmed that vehicles use Clifton Way and Le Doux Road to bypass arterial streets, leading to speeding and congestion during peak hours, according to the staff report. Most residents thought that the calming options would help address these issues. Generally, residents liked the curb extensions because they would narrow the roadway and slower speeds.

Several residents expressed concerns that the devices, especially traffic circles, may worsen congestion by limiting the number of vehicles moving through an intersection during peak hours.

Representatives from the Fire Department reported no issues around the circle due to the 20-foot travel lane widths on either side and were able to make a complete U-turn. They also noted that in the event of an emergency, they would travel on Wilshire Boulevard or Burton Way.

After the March 2023 traffic calming demonstration, the project team distributed an online survey. The majority indicated they observed that the devices slowed vehicles while still being easy to move through intersections. Most respondents also indicated support for a mix of curb extensions and traffic circles along the corridor; a pedestrian/ bicycle signal at Wilshire Boulevard/Le Doux Road; and a six month demonstration of traffic calming devices between Robertson and La Cienega Boulevards.

City staff proposed the segment of Clifton Way between Robertson and La Cienega Boulevards because it includes multiple blocks between two major streets that are likely to contribute to speeding cut-through traffic.

The draft demonstration design includes traffic circles at Clifton Way/ Arnaz Drive and Clifton Way/Le Doux Road. It also includes curb extensions at Clifton Way/Hamel Drive, Clifton Way/Willaman Drive, Clifton Way/ Carson Road, and Clifton Way/Stanley Drive to discourage speeding/cutthrough traffic and shorten pedestrian crossing distances.

The City Council was set to discuss an appeal of the Planning Commission's decision approving a Historic Incentive Permit and Density Bonus Permit to allow the rehabilitation of an existing building and the construction of a new third story at the property located at 9884 South Santa Monica Boulevard, at their Tuesday meeting. However, the appeal was rescheduled and is expected to take place at the Jan. 23 meeting.

On July 26, Michael Tenner, on behalf of The Peninsula Hotel, filed a timely appeal of the Commission's decision. The Council has set the hearing date for next month so that the applicant and appellant have enough time to hopefully come to a resolution without City involvement.



BHPD CATCHES ALLEGED **SERIAL KILLER WANTED** FOR HOMELESS MURDERS

Suspect is Accused of Killing Three Homeless Men in Los Angeles

By Danielle Berjikian

The suspect wanted in the three fatal shootings of homeless men in Los Angeles was identified as a man who was arrested by the Beverly Hills Police Department last week in connection with the murder of a San Dimas resident, who was shot during a follow-home robbery.

Officials previously sounded the alarm about a killer targeting homeless people. They described the suspect they were seeking as a man seen driving a dark-colored sedan.

Last Thursday, Beverly Hills police arrested Jerrid Joseph Powell during a traffic stop. Police identified Powell's vehicle, leading to the recovery of the weapon used in the crimes and subsequent arrest by BHPD officers.

Approximately 24 hours following the murder in San Dimas, the suspect vehicle was identified by Automated License Plate Readers and was located in a coordinated response with the Real Time Watch Center, police dispatch, and BHPD patrol officers as it drove through

the City.

Following

the arrest, evi-

dence discov-

ered during the continued investigation revealed the arrestee likely responsible for the deaths of the three homeless men.

Powell is accused of killing the homeless men over a four day period, on Sunday, Nov. 26, and the following Monday and Wednesday.

Los Angeles Police Chief Michel Moore identified the victims as Jose Bolanos, 37, who was found dead near the intersection of 110th Street and Vermont Avenue in South Los Angeles; Mark Diggs, 62, who was shot and killed the following Monday at the 600 Block of



Mateo Street, downtown near the L.A. River: and an unnamed 52-year-old man who was found dead around 2:30 a.m. on the following Wednesday near Avenue 18 and Pasadena Avenue.

Moore said that each victim was shot while asleep or in the process of lying down.

On the Tuesday between the second and third killings, Powell is alleged to have trekked to San Dimas and killed a county employee during a home invasion. He is suspected of killing Nicholas Simbolon, who is a father of two.

Los Angeles County Sheriff Robert Luna said last Thursday that it appeared Powell had followed Simbolon home from an electric vehicle charging station 12 miles from his house, according to NBC. After Simbolon pulled into his garage, the attacker robbed Simbolon before shooting him and fleeing, according

No motive has been identified in the killings of the homeless individuals.

The RTWC was established in June 2022 during the term of then Mayor Lili

Bosse. It is a network of approximately 2,400 CCTV cameras, 50 Automated License Plate Readers (ALPR) placed in strategic locations, and a drone (Hawkeye).

"Our main goal was to reduce our times for calls for service and interdict criminal activity. The bottom line is we always want to keep crime down in [Beverly Hills]," said Chief Mark Stain-

Within the first year of the RTWC being established, it assisted in the arrest of 62 individuals and the recovery of 110 stolen vehicles.

"We know there's controversy out there about the usage of this system." Luna said, "but let me tell our community something. If we did not enter that plate into the system, this individual that we believe is responsible for at least four murders may have [still] been out there and reoffended."

Lieutenant Reginald Evans did not respond to a request for comment.

Powell was charged with four counts of murder, one count of residential robbery and one count of being a felon with a firearm. The defendant also faces special circumstances of committing multiple murders and murder in the course of a robbery, as well as personal use of a firearm, the District Attorney's office announced

The suspect made a brief appearance in court Monday, but at his public defender's request, his initial arraignment was rescheduled to Jan. 8. He will remain held in jail on no bail.

If convicted of all charges, Powell faces a potential sentence of life in prison without possibility of parole.

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
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
