

"City Council Candidate Forums" [Issue #1272]

I am writing to respond to the comments made by Tom Roberts. His comments pertained to architectural issues in the city. As a current candidate for Beverly Hills City Council and a former Architectural Commissioner (and Chair of that Commission), I feel compelled to respond:

First, Mr. Roberts says he has engaged with the "top 4 candidates running for City Council." How Mr. Roberts was able to determine who these four candidates are is a mystery. No formal declaration has been made and there is no polling data as to which candidates comprise the top four. Regardless of whatever methods Mr. Roberts used to derive his "ranking," I wish he had raised his questions with me, as I am the only candidate running who has ever served on the architecture commission.

He attended my kickoff coffee, where I discussed issues related to the city's built aesthetics, so he should have known I am uniquely qualified to answer his questions. Also, if he attended the Municipal Candidate Forum he would have heard my open statement where it talks about the importance of having good architecture. This is important since he complains none of the candidates understand the various architectural issues facing our city. Actually, one candidate does: me.

The fountain at Wilshire and Santa Monica was restored by the landscape architectural designer Mia Lehrer, Matt construction and in conjunction with the city architectural team and City Architect. When the restoration was completed, the fountain was beautiful and we could see all the different colors. If it is currently not displaying like that it could be a malfunction, and the issue should be raised directly with the City Architect Team or Public Works.

Mr. Roberts also criticizes the Architecture Commission for approving the Edward Durrell project on the corner of Wilshire and Santa Monica, and wrongly states that the Commission unanimously approved that project. I was a member of the Architecture Commission when that project came up for approval. If Mr Roberts happened to review the record of the meeting (it is recorded) he would realize that the ONLY Commissioner who voted AGAINST the changes was me. I did not approve it and I was a NO vote all the way.

Precisely because I appreciate the architectural heritage that this building brings to our city, I did not believe that making a hole in the ground for the proposed sculpture was appropriate. These are exactly the issues that Mr Roberts

mentioned in his column. If only he would have reached out to me, we could have had a discussion on this matter. It would be better to review the record of commission meetings before writing statements that are not accurate, and before misrepresenting my voting record.

City Council Denies Review on 9229 Wilshire Boulevard **Project**

The City Council rejected a request that would have reviewed the Planning Commission's approval of a development plan review and density bonus

permit for the construction of eight-story mixed-use development project with ground floor commercial uses and 56 residential units at 9229 Wilshire Boulevard, at its Tuesday meeting.

Six of the residential units would be

reserved for very low-income households. The project site is an approximately 20,665 square foot lot located on the northwest corner of Wilshire Boulevard and North Maple Drive, within the City's C-3 Commercial and Mixed-Use Overlay Zones. The Commission's approval included waivers, as permitted by State Density Bonus Law, to accommodate the provision of the six proposed affordable housing units.

The waivers include the following:

- Building Height: Increased the overall building height from 45' to 83'-11", inclusive of rooftop restrooms;
- Number of Stories: Increased the number of stories from three to eight, inclusive of rooftop restrooms; and
- Rear Setbacks: Reduced the rear building setback from 6' to 0'

As part of the Planning Commission's review of the project, the Commission evaluated whether the project met the

findings for a development plan review, which they determined it did and voted 5-0 to approve the project.

The decision before the City Council was limited to whether to call the item up for review at a future public hearing. The Council was not being asked to make any evaluation or assessment of the merits of the project.

Many residents voiced their concerns regarding privacy, a lack of parking for the property, security, construction impacts, safety, and more. The City Council ultimately did not bring the project up for review due to constraints by state law.

Burglary Suspect Falls Off Ladder Into Pool

Drone footage posted on Instagram by Beverly Hills Police showed a burglary suspect falling into a pool after attempting to flee from officers by escaping through a backyard.

David Verdun, 36, broke into the home on Jan. 6. While climbing a ladder in an attempt to escape, he fell and landed in the pool.

Video showed Verdun jumping out

of the residence through a window. He then grabbed a ladder and attempted to climb a backhouse.

The ladder subsequently fell into the pool along with the suspect.

Verdun was attempting to flee when he heard police coming. He was arrested following the incident.

City Council to Discuss ADU Ordinance

At its March 11 meeting, the City Council is expected to discuss a draft ordinance on accessory dwelling unit (ADU) regulations in single family residential areas.

In recent years. state laws regarding ADUs have been updated to encourage production amid the state-declared housing crisis. These laws have generally changed to increase the number and size of ADUs permitted by-right on any residentially

zoned property in all jurisdictions. A draft ordinance has been prepared to update the Municipal Code.

On Aug. 10, 2022 a community meeting on ADUs was held in order to receive feedback about appropriate regulations to facilitate the development of ADUs. The feedback received generally focused on the following:

• A strong interest to develop ADUs that exceed 16' in height, particularly south of Santa Monica Boulevard, in order to accommodate a two-story structure;

• Support for greater height to build above garage structures;

• Request for flexibility on landscape requirements in the front yard to be able to accommodate parking in that location;

• Concerns about privacy, noise, and shade; and questions about fees, property assessment implications, and permit parking.

As part of the Housing Element process, the City conducted an online survey for feedback on developing ADUs. Respondents indicated that they would be interested in developing an ADU on their property in order to gain additional space and for property value, and were mostly likely to rent it to a family member at reduced or no rent, or a tenant at market rate, or use it at a guest house.

The State legislature also adopted additional regulations that cities must allow for the development of ADUs. This includes that the minimum height that cities must allow is 16' in any area. However, if the lot is located within a half mile walking distance of a major transit stop, the minimum height requirement is 18'.

A DRAFT ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE TO REGULATE ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS AND JUNIOR ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS, AND FINDING THE ORDINANCE TO BE EXEMPT UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

In recent years, state laws regarding accessory dwelling units (ADUs) have been updated to encourage ADU production amid the state-declared housing crisis. These laws have generally changed to increase the number of ADUs and size of ADUs permitted by-right (through a ministerial building permit process) on any residentially-zoned property in all jurisdictions in California. A draft ordinance has been prepared to update the City of Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) regulations pertaining to ADUs, which is both consistent with state law ADU regulations, and reflects direction provided by the Planning Commission during public study session discussions that occurred in 2022 and 2023. On January 25, 2024, by a unanimous vote (4-0), the Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills adopted a resolution recommending that the City Council approve the draft ordinance. The draft ordinance includes, but is not limited to amendments to the BHMC that would:

•Repeal and replace the existing ADU code sections [BHMC §10-3-409; §10-3-603.5; §10-3-702.5; §10-3-803.5; §10-3-902.5; §10-3-1002.5; §10-3-1102.5] with a new Article 50 (Accessory Dwelling Units and Junior Accessory Dwelling Units) in Title 10, Chapter 3 (Zoning) of the BHMC to comprehensively regulate single- and multi-family ADU development consistent with state law, including local standards beyond state law minimums;

•Amend the Definitions section [BHMC §10-3-100];

•Create a discretionary review path for ADUs located on any residential property developed with a single-family residence to allow ADUs that do not conform to the proposed by-right objective standards. [BHMC §10-3-3600].

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The draft ordinance was assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. Pursuant to §15282(h) of the CEQA Guidelines and §21080.17 of the California Public Resources Code, the adoption of an ordinance regarding accessory dwelling units to implement the provisions of Government Code §65852.1 and §65852.2 is statutorily exempt from CEQA requirements. As a result, staff recommends the City Council find that the draft ordinance is exempt from any further review under CEQA.

The draft ordinance includes the following amendments to the municipal code that would:

- Repeal and replace the existing ADU code to comprehensively regulate single- and multi-family ADU development consistent with state law, including local standards beyond state law minimums;
- Add language to various residential development standard code sections.
- Create a discretionary review path for ADUs located on any residential or mixed-use property that does not conform to the proposed objective standards.

The Planning Commission also provided a recommendation that the City Council adopt a draft ordinance to amend municipal code regulations pertaining to ADUs.

Planning Commission to Discuss Alternative Parking Facility for Chanel

The Planning Commission is expected to discuss an informational report on the six-month operation of the alternative parking facility for Chanel that was approved for the property located at 400-408 North Rodeo Drive, at its Thursday meeting.

On August 8, 2019, the Planning Commission approved the construction of a three-story commercial building with rooftop uses and a permit to allow an alternative parking facility.

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that the parking be reviewed by the Planning Commission after six months and one year of commencement of the use. The condition further states that if the Planning Commission determines the modified parking is insufficient, the applicant shall be required to make arrangements to provide sufficient parking.

The parking is provided through a combination of existing in-lieu parking spaces previously approved for the two properties, including 40 parking spaces, a small surface parking lot located at the southeast corner of the property, consisting of five parking spaces, and a subterranean parking level that includes an alternative parking facility of 39 parking spaces, for a total of 84 parking spaces provided.

According to information provided by the applicant, the highest use for the alternative parking facility during Jan. 2024 occurred Sundays through Thursdays with a daily average of 13 vehicles; Fridays and Saturdays had a daily average of seven vehicles. The daily range for the same month was three to 22 vehicles with a weekly range of 75 to 88 vehicles. For the entire month, the alternative parking facility provided parking for a total of 336 vehicles.

According to the staff report, the facility is operating as intended and is sufficient for the purpose of satisfying the project's parking requirements.

City Council Approves 9884 South Santa Monica Project

The City council approved the modified project and denied a related appeal, which allows the project to move forward through the City's architectural review and building permit processes, for the property located at 9884 South Santa Monica Boulevard, at its

Tuesday meeting.

The City Council previously discussed an appeal of the Planning Commission's decision approving a Historic Incentive Permit and Density Bonus Permit to allow the rehabilitation of an existing building and the construction of a new third story at the property.

The Council ultimately denied the appeal and approved the project, but placed several additional restrictions on the project.

On July 26, Michael Tenner, on behalf of The Peninsula Hotel, filed a timely appeal of the Commission's decision. The Council extended the hearing date so that the applicant and appellant had enough time to hopefully come to a resolution without City involvement.

The existing commercial building, known as the "Darrow Office Building," was built in 1946 and was designed by John Lautner and Douglas Honnold, architects listed on the List of Master Architects.

The applicant is expected to rehabilitate the building and original architectural features that were designed by Lautner. The applicant also intends to construct a new third story addition over the existing building to provide additional office space on the property and an outdoor terrace that would face South Santa Monica Boulevard and Charleville Boulevard. The new third floor addition would increase the existing height of the building by approximately 15'-3", from a height of 23'-9" to a proposed height of 38'-0".

The appeal petition listed the following reasons for the filing of the appeal:

- Project materials submitted do not accurately convey the realistic impact the project will have on the Appellant's property.
- The project increases the size of an office building while unlawfully reducing on-site parking.
- The project's loading area is inadequate and blocks all on-site parking

spaces.

- The loading area is inadequate and blocks all on-site parking spaces.
- The project creates a sizable roof deck pushed up against the appellant's villas.
- The site's potential city landmark eligibility is not adequately

justified.

The Council placed several additional conditions on the project in order to offset any adverse impacts to the neighboring property. This includes a requirement of bringing the project back for review if there are more than three confirmed violations, no amplified sound on the roof, and no rental by a third party on the third floor, among others

Partial Crescent Drive Closure to Begin February 26 for Vanity Fair Event

Vanity Fair will be returning to Beverly Hills to host its post-Academy Awards Party on the 400 block of North Crescent Drive, adjacent to City Hall, on the evening of Sunday, March 10, and partial street closures will begin on Feb. 26.

As crews begin work to assemble the tent on North Crescent Drive between North Santa Monica Boulevard and South Santa Monica Boulevard, the 400 block of the street will be closed beginning Monday, February 26 at 10 p.m. to Thursday, March 14, reopening by 10 p.m.

All businesses on North Crescent Drive are accessible during the closure. Motorists are urged to use alternate routes. Access remains open to local parking garages.

Additionally, on event day beginning at 3 p.m. Sunday, March 10 to 2 a.m. Monday, March 11, the following roads surrounding the North Crescent closure will be impacted.

North Cañon Drive between North and South Santa Monica Blvd. will be closed. Eastbound lanes on South Santa Monica Boulevard starting at Civic Center will be impacted, with lanes closed from Rexford Drive to North Cañon Drive. Detours will be in place routing traffic North and South on Rexford Drive. North Santa Monica Boulevard Westbound lane closures will be in place from Rodeo Drive to Rexford Drive.

through Feb. 29.

Service providers that offer vital health and welfare services to the most vulnerable populations in the community are encouraged to apply. Vulnerable populations include homeless people, disabled, elderly, and other other groups. Grants will also be considered for organizations who provide unique cultural arts programming for the Beverly Hills community.

LA Marathon Returns March 17

The 39th Annual Los Angeles Marathon "Stadium to the Stars," presented by ASICS, will take place Sunday, March 17, 2024. Athletes from all 50 states and more than 67 countries will race through the streets of Beverly Hills for miles 16 and 17 before ending at the Avenue of the Stars in Century City.

"Once again, the City of Beverly Hills is pleased to open our streets to runners from around the globe," said Mayor Julian Gold. "We love participating in this special event which brings so much of the community together and is also an opportunity for visitors to explore our city and the great restaurants and shops after the race as well."

Proceeds from the 2024 race will go toward The McCourt Foundation, an organization dedicated to enhancing the lives of patients and families affected by health-challenges within the neurology community and beyond.

Major road closures and parking restrictions on Sunday will be in effect in the City from 5 a.m. to 1 p.m. and include the following:

- Doheny Dr. closed from North Santa Monica Blvd. to Burton Way
- Burton Way closed from Doheny Dr. to South Santa Monica Blvd.
- South Santa Monica Blvd. closed from Rexford Dr. to Rodeo Dr.

- Rodeo Dr. closed from South Santa Monica Blvd. to Wilshire Blvd.
- Wilshire Blvd. closed from Rodeo Dr. to South Santa Monica Blvd.
- South Santa Monica Blvd. closed from Wilshire Blvd. to Moreno Dr.

There will be a detour in effect on the western border of Beverly Hills, at Wilshire Blvd. and North Santa Monica Blvd, as well as at Moreno Drive and South Santa Monica Blvd. until 6 p.m. Access to all local businesses will be maintained.

Beverly Hills Police and message boards will direct vehicles around the marathon route. Wider regional closures for the route will be in effect from as early as 3 a.m. until 6 p.m.

2023 Financial Contributions Released for City Council Election

Ten candidates are currently vying for two open seats on the Beverly Hills City Council and the race is coming to an end on March 5. Each candidate submits several documents that are available for review, including financial reports and their Candidate Statements. The Campaign Financial Statements for 2023 and part of 2024 have been released and information regarding outside contributions and spending are publicly available.

The City Council recently increased the voluntary expenditure ceiling for elections from \$80,000 to \$100,000; and increased the individual contribution limit for candidates who accept the voluntary contribution limit from \$450 to \$500 per contributor or entity.

Craig Corman is nearly entirely self-funded with \$68,797 out of \$69,272

coming from personal loans for 2023. Corman has loaned his campaign a total of \$5,453 in the first three weeks of 2024 for a total of \$6,478. He has spent \$30,975 for total expenditures made in 2023 and \$19,385 for 2024.

Corman is the only candidate who did not accept the spending limit. Subsequently, he may only accept contributions of \$125 per person.

Alissa Roston raised the most out of any of the 10 candidates, with \$38,384 total contributions received, and \$9,000 being from loans for 2023. Her total expenditures were \$25,895. Roston raised \$12,579 in the first three weeks of 2024 with none of that being from personal loans. She also spent \$3,030 in the first three weeks of Jan. Some contributions include \$450 from Andrea Spatz, \$150 from Michael Blumenfeld, \$180 from Michael Libow, and \$250 from Public

Works Commissioner John Millan.

Mary Wells has raised a total of \$28,276, with \$25,000 being from personal loans for 2023. Her expenditures total \$12,797 for 2023 and \$1,289 for the first several weeks of 2024. Some donations received include \$500 from former Mayor Barry Brucker, \$300 from Judie Fenton, and \$250 from former Treasurer Eliot Finkel.

Russell Stuart's campaign has received \$1,000 from loans out of a total of \$9,683 for 2023, and spent a total of \$2,194. For 2024, he loaned himself \$1,000 in the first few weeks of Jan. with contributions totaling \$4,283. He has spent a total of \$3,101 so far in 2024. Some contributions received include \$500 from former Board of Education member Lisa Korbatov, \$500 from Robert Schwab, and \$500 from Bobby Saadian

Hamid Omrani has loaned himself \$100 out of \$2,500 total raised. However, his campaign form only covers the last two weeks of 2023.

Tiffany Davis has raised a total of \$1,010 for the last two months of the year, and raised a total of \$1,280 for the first few weeks of 2024.

Myra Demeter raised a total of \$25,114, with \$10,000 coming from loans for 2023. She raised a total of \$12,318 for the first three weeks of Jan.,

with \$10,000 being from personal loans. Her total expenditures were \$11,291 for 2023 and \$6,693 for 2024. Some donations include \$500 from Gary Ross, \$300 from former Board of Education member Herb Young, and \$100 from former commissioner Sandra Aronberg.

Out of \$8,380 for total contributions received, Sharon Persovski loaned herself \$8,000 for the period covering Nov. 2023 through Jan. 2024. Out of that, she has spent a total of \$8,123. Some donations include \$150 from Darian Bojeaux, \$180 from Michael Libow, and \$50 from Health and Safety Commissioner Cathy

Nooshin Meshkaty did not file a form for 2023, but has raised a total of \$12,059 for the first several weeks of 2024, with total expenditures at \$12,335, and no personal loans. Some donations include \$100 from County Supervisor Lindsey Horvath, \$500 from Jennifer Yadidi, and \$249 from former Rodeo Drive Committee President Kathy Davoudi Gohari.

Robin Rowe has filed no campaign forms with the city and has previously said he will not be accepting any donations.

Burton Way Green Street and Water Efficient Landscape Project Officially Opens Feb. 28

Beverly Hills will officially celebrate the completion of its Burton Way Green Street and Water Efficient Landscape Project with a special Ribbon Cutting Ceremony that will take place on Wednesday, February 28th at 11 a.m. at the mini park located on the southeast corner of Burton Way and Rexford Drive.

"Burton Way is the first of many Green Streets our City will have as we move toward adopting a more environmentally conscious infrastructure. This is critical for our water conservation efforts and our broader City sustainability goals," said Mayor Julian Gold.

The project marks the City's first Green Street that is intended to prevent polluted urban runoff from reaching Santa Monica Bay and will serve as Beverly Hills' water efficient garden model. This new Burton Way Median is expected to save approximately 5 million gallons of water annually.

The project incorporates infiltration swales, native water efficient plants, and a one million gallon underground reservoir that will store treated urban runoff to irrigate the new landscape. The design layout features 16 unique plant species arranged to highlight the city's public art pieces.

The project received approximately \$6.7 million from grant funding from Measure W- Safe Clean Water Program and the Department of Water Resources





Plaintiff, GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES IN-SURANCE COMPANY ("Plaintiff GEICO") hereby alleges as follows

 Plaintiff GEICO is, and at all times herein mentioned was, a corporation qualified to do business in the State of California as an insurance carrier.

. Defendant SGAEL NIDHI, ALSO KNOWN AS SHOURYA NIDHI ("Defendant NIDHI"), is now, and at all times herein mentioned was. an individual residing in the City of Beverly Hills, County of Los Angeles, State of California

- 3. Plaintiff is ignorant of the true names and capacities of defendants sued herein as DOES 1-100 and therefore sues these defendants by such fictitious names. Plaintiff will amend this complaint to allege their true names and capacities when ascertained. Plaintiff is informed and believes, and thereon alleges, that each of the fictitiously named defendants is responsible in some manner for the acts and omissions alleged herein. and that Plaintiff's damages, as alleged herein, were proximately caused by their conduct. Plaintiff is further informed and believes, and thereon alleges, that at all times mentioned, each of the defendants, including those fictitiously named, was the agent and employee of each of the other defendants and, in doing the things hereinafter alleged, was acting within the course and scope of such agency and with the permission or consent of each of the other defendants.
- 4. This Court is the proper Court because the acts that give rise to this action occurred in Los Angeles, California and Defendant now resides in this Court's jurisdictional area. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

5. From the Summer of 2022 through October 31, 2023, Defendant NIDHI was an employee of Plaintiff GEICO. Defendant NIDHI was an Engineer II on Plaintiff GEICO's Data Engineering team. As a software developer for GEICO, Defendant NIDHI had access to confidential and valuable data and information that, if compromised, could severely harm Plaintiff's business.

6. On August 25, 2023, a new GEICO issued laptop (serial number 6KZWZH3) was shipped to Defendant NIDHI to replace his GEICO issued laptop (serial number 6QL70J3). Both of these devices were Dell 5560's. Instructions were sent to Defendant NIDHI on returning the old laptop to Plaintiff GEICO. On October 5, 2023, Defendant NIDHI shipped a laptop back to Plaintiff GEICO however it was not the GEICO laptop. This laptop was a Dell 5530, was missing screws from the bottom of the case and had an out of box Windows image on it. Plaintiff GEICO thereafter demanded Defendant NIDHI return the correct GEICO laptop and returned the incorrect laptop back to Defendant NIDHI.

7. On October 11, 2023, Plaintiff GEICO received another laptop from Defendant NIDHI. This laptop was a Dell 5560 with the serial number on the case of 6KZWZH3. When GEICO attempted to sign into the returned laptop, GEICO discovered by checking the motherboard that the laptop was reporting the serial number as BQDKZH3, which does not match any of the GEICO issued laptops and was not issued by Plaintiff GEICO. 8. Plaintiff GEICO is informed and believes and based on its investigation alleges that Defendant NIDHI intentionally removed the GEICO hard drive from the GEICO issued laptop and attempted to replace it with another hard drive, which he installed in the laptop he returned to GEICO.

9. Plaintiff GEICO is informed and believes based upon its investigation of the laptop returned from Defendant SIDHI that Defendant SIDHI cloned the GEICO issued hard drive and copied confidential GEICO data for improper use on a personal device. This action taken by Defendant SIDHI is against GEICO's security policies and compromises GEICO's 10. On October 31, 2023, Defendant NIDHI's employment with GEICO was terminated. On November 1, 2023, GEICO sent a third party investigator to Defendant NIDHI's residence in an attempt to recover the GEICO equipment in Defendant NIDHI's possession. This attempt was unsuccessful.

11. As an employee of Plaintiff GEICO, Defendant NIDHI was provided certain equipment to perform his job tasks, including a laptop. As part of his employment with Plaintiff GEICO, Defendant NIDHI had access to proprietary and confidential data and information which Defendant NIDHI is believed to have stored on the hard drive of the laptop provided by Plaintiff

GEICO. Upon termination of his employment,

demand was made by Plaintiff GEICO to Defendant NIDHI that he immediately return all Plaintiff GEICO's property, including the laptop and hard drive. Defendant NIDHI has at all times herein failed and refused to return

said property to Plaintiff GEICO.

12. As an employee of Plaintiff GEICO, Defendant NIDHI agreed to, among other things, abide by the following provision: "All information regarding GEICO's business is an asset of GEICO. An asset is anything of commercial value. For example, personal and laptop computers, smart phones, USB flash drives and tape backups are types of physical assets. Information assets include, but are not limited to, data regarding personnel, payroll, computer systems, marketing, merchandising, customers, products or vendors. That data may be in any form, including paper documents, email, faxes, voicemail messages and stored electronic data. Information assets must be protected by all individuals who have access to them and should be used only as part of authorized GEICO business. Thése assets, in part, are what make GEICO profitable. Failure to protect information assets may cause grave and irreparable damage to GEICO. All GEICO information assets will be classified, and asset owners will set the classifications for those assets according to the GEICO Data Classification Policy.

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

(Claim and Delivery as against all Defen-

13. Plaintiff realleges the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 12, inclusive, hereinabove, as though set forth in full herein, and incorporates them into this cause of action by reference.

14. Plaintiff seeks the recovery of the following property: laptops and hard drives provided to Defendant NIDHI while employed by Plaintiff GEICO for use of Defendant NIDHI during his employment as well as any copies, or "clones" of such hard drives or any data extracted from such equipment or hard drives. Defendants, and each of them, have intentionally, willfully and unlawfully retained said property and failed to return said proper-

ty to Plaintiff GEICO on demand.

15. Plaintiff seeks to recover damages for the value of the claimed property, and for the detriment proximately caused by the use of data contained on the hard drive and/or sharing of said data with individuals and/or business entities.

16. At all times herein mentioned, Plaintiff GEICO was, and still is, entitled to the possession of said property and Defendant NIDHI has refused and continues to refuse to

return said property.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

17. On or about October 31, 2023, at Los Angeles, California the value of said property is unknown. The property is described as laptops and hard drives, and any clones made thereof or any other data copies from said hard drives, which contain confidential, proprietary information and data concerning Plaintiff GEICO's business, business practices and other confidential business information, the value of which is unknown. If shared with individuals or entities, Plaintiff believes that such sharing will cause serious and detrimental harm and damages to Plaintiff's

18. At all times relevant herein, Plaintiff GE-ICO demanded the return of the above-described property. On or about October 31, 2023, Defendant NIDHI wrongfully and without Plaintiff's consent refused to surrender possession of said property. Defendants have been, and now are, in wrongful possession of the property in violation of Plaintiff GEICO's right to immediate and exclusive possession. 19. During, and as a proximate result thereof, Defendants' wrongful possession and detention of the property described above, Plain-tiff GEICO has suffered damages according to proof for the loss of the above described property, including time, energy and costs incurred in pursuing recovery of the property described above, including but not limited to, attorney fees, in an amount not as yet ascertained but which exceeds the jurisdictional minimum of this court and which will be proven at time of trial.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

(Conversion against all Defendants)

20. Plaintiff realleges the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 19, inclusive, hereinabove, as though set forth in full here-in, and incorporates them into this cause of action by reference.

21. At all times herein mentioned, Plaintiff GEICO was, and still is, entitled to the pos-

session of the subject property.

22. At all times relevant herein, Plaintiff GE-ICO demanded the immediate return of the above-mentioned property but Defendant NIDHI failed and refused, and continues to fail and refuse, to return the property to Plain-

23. Defendants, and each of them, refused to return the above-mentioned property to Plaintiff GEICO and converted the same to their own use.

24. As a proximate result of Defendants' unlawful conversion, Plaintiff GEICO suffered and continues to suffer damages which are the natural, reasonable, and proximate results of the conversion all to Plaintiff's damage in an amount not as yet ascertained but which will be proven at time of trial.

25. Between the time of Defendants' conversion of the above-mentioned property to their own use and the filing of this action, Plaintiff GEICO expended both time and money in pursuit of the converted property described above, including but not limited to, attorney fees, in an amount not as vet ascertained but which exceeds the jurisdictional minimum of this court and which will be proven at time of trial.

26. In committing the acts alleged herein, Defendants and each of them have acted willfully, fraudulently, maliciously, oppressively, despicably, and with conscious disregard of the rights of Plaintiff GEICO, and with the express intention to vex, annov, harass, and injure Plaintiff and Plaintiffs' business. Plaintiff GEICO is thus entitled to recover from Defendants punitive and/or exemplary damages in an amount according to proof at the time

THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION (Violation of Penal Code § 496(a) as against all Defendants)

27. Plaintiff realleges the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 26, inclusive, hereinabove, as though set forth in full herein, and incorporates them into this cause of action by reference.

28. California Penal Code Section 484(a) states in pertinent part that: "Every person who shall feloniously steal, take, carry, lead, or drive away the personal property of another, or who shall fraudulently appropriate property which has been entrusted to him or her, or who shall knowingly and designedly, by any false or fraudulent representation or pretense, defraud any other person of money, labor or real or personal property, or who causes or procures others to report falsely of his or her wealth or mercantile character and by thus imposing upon any person, obtains credit and thereby fraudulently gets or obtains possession of money, or property or obtains the labor or service of another, is guilty of theft.

29. California Penal Code Section 496(a) provides that: "[e]very person who buys or receives any property that has been stolen or that has been obtained in any manner constituting theft or extortion, knowing the property to be so stolen or obtained, or who conceals, sells, withholds, or aids in concealing, selling, or withholding any property from the owner, knowing the property to be so stolen or obtained, shall be punished by imprison-

30. California Penal Code Section 496(c) provides that: "[a]ny person who has been injured by a violation of subdivision (a) . . . may bring an action for three times the amount of actual damages, if any, sustained by the plaintiff, costs of suit, and reasonable attorney's fees.

With willfull knowledge that they were not entitled to possession of the abovedescribed, Defendants knowingly and willfully have concealed and continue to conceal and withhold said property from Plaintiff GEICO in violation of the California Penal Code.

32. Defendants are thus guilty of stealing said property from Plaintiff GEICO and have failed and refused, and continue to fail and refuse, to return said property to Plaintiff despite Plaintiff's immediate demand for its return. Defendants continue to refuse to take any actions that would assist Plaintiff to recover said property with the full knowledge that said property was obtained by theft as alleged herein. These actions by Defendants, and each of them, constituted a knowing and willful violation of subdivision (a) of California Penal Code Section 496.

33. Additionally, as a result of the acts of Defendants and each of them, Plaintiff was forced to retain the services of legal counsel and has incurred legal fees and costs

34. Pursuant to California Penal Code Section 496(c), Plaintiff brings this action and seeks three times the amount of actual damages and all reasonable attorney fees.
WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays for judgment

against Defendants and each of them as fol-

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION:

1. For possession of the property described above;

2. For any and all damages caused by Defendants' unlawful use of data contained on the subject property, in an amount according to proof at trial, including but not limited to damages caused to Plaintiff's business and the indemnification of any and all damages caused by the use of any data improperly shared or used by Defendants or any third

3. For an order of this Court ordering the issuance of a Writ of Possession authorizing the Los Angeles County Sheriff to seize said personal property from the unlawful possession of Defendant and return said property to Plaintiff forthwith;

4. For an immediate restraining order restraining Defendants from distributing, sharing, uploading, copying or in any manner using the data contained on the subject property:

5. For indemnification of any and all damages caused by the uploading, sharing, copying or use of the data by Defendants or any other unauthorized person or entity;

6. For damages for time, energy and costs incurred in pursuing recovery of the above described property, including but not limited to, attorney fees, according to proof at time of trial;

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION:

1. For damages in an amount according to proof at trial for the value of the property and data unlawfully converted according to proof at time of trial;

2. For interest at the legal rate on the foregoing sum pursuant to California Civil Code Section 3336;

3. For damages suffered as a direct and proximate result of the unlawful conversion, and for all sums reasonably expended in pursuing the recovery of said sum according to proof at time of trial;

4. For damages for time and money properly expended in pursuing the recovery of said sum according to proof at time of trial, and 5. Punitive and exemplary damages accord-

ing to proof at time of trial. THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION:

 For treble damages and attorney fees pursuant to California Penal Code Section 496(a)

ON ALL CAUSES OF ACTION:

 For costs of suit herein incurred, and
 For such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
