#### LA Tenants Union To **Protest Magbit Annual** Gala

The Magbit Foundation is holding its 2024 Gala tonight, April 4 at the Beverly Hilton and the Los Angeles Tenants Union and the K3 Tenant Council have announced on social media that they plan to protest the event.

"Stop Gentrification, Stop Genocide! Zionist landlords on Thu, April 4 will

be gathering at the annual gala of the Magbit foundation to fundraise for the Israeli Defense Forces and further Israeli's occupation [sic] and its genocidal war against the Palestinian people. Slumlords Ethan and Elliott Sassouni of Green Mountain Properties and Dora Nazarian, family members of the slumlords behind K3 Holdings, Nathan and Michael Kadisha, sit on and lead the board of the Magbit foundation, an organization that has already raised over \$1.4 million to support Israel's genocide, directly sending funds to IDF combat units, an occupying force that has leveled Gaza and killed at least 33,000 Palestinians since Oct," the Los Angeles Tenants Union wrote on Instagram.

Funds from the gala are intended to go to humanitarian aid to Israelis in need, security forces, and medical organizations and mental health support services, according to Magbit's website.

"Across the world, we face displacement, the slumification of our communities, rent hikes, evictions, gentrification, violence and settler colonialism, facing different levels of the same class war. Support our Palestinian comrades by striking at imperialism from within the belly of the beast, where gentrification in LA by Zionist landlords like the Sassounis and Kadishas helps sustain and fund Israeli occupation and genocide abroad," the union added.

#### **Traffic and Parking Commission to Discuss Proposed Decorative Crosswalk Installation**

The Traffic and Parking Commission is expected to discuss, and possibly make a recommendation, on the implementation of a proposed decorative crosswalk installation, at its Thursday meeting.

The Complete Streets Plan guides the installation of new crosswalks and upgrades to existing crosswalks. This policy states that decorative crosswalks may be considered with the use of colors, textures, and patterns to promote streets as engaging places.

According to a city staff report, as community members have requested decorative crosswalks on a number of occasions, city staff is proposing to move forward with a study to determine if this can increase drivers yielding to pedestrians.

The crosswalk policy follows Federal and State guidance on decorative crosswalks, which includes the following:

• Creative crosswalk treatments may only be considered at intersections where a marked crosswalk exists.

• Decorative elements may be added only between the continental bar markings.

• Creative crosswalk treatments cannot obscure or interfere with regulatory crosswalk markings.

• Only locations where pavement is in good condition shall be considered.

The city has proposed to study decorative crosswalk installations at Rexford Drive in front of City Hall and Civic Center Drive/Third Street.

"Both proposed test locations are prominent places in the Civic Center area of Beverly Hills that experience high volumes of pedestrian traffic, including residents, employees, and tourists. Additionally, both locations have a history of driver non-compliance in yielding to pedestrians. Staff feels these two intersections would be ideal as study locations to determine if decorative crosswalks improve pedestrian safety and could be expanded citywide in commercial and/or residential areas," according to a city staff report.

The city has proposed that the style of the crosswalks be a "rainbow"

The proposed timeline for the study is June 1-30, to coincide with National Pride Month and to incorporate the installation into the "BH Pride" programming.

Installation of decorative crosswalks on Rexford Drive in front of City Hall and Civic Center Drive/Third Street, including a before/after video analysis of driver yielding rates, is estimated to cost \$5,000-10,000.

#### Traffic and Parking Commission to Discuss Active Adult Mobility Program

The Traffic and Parking Commission is expected to discuss the active adult mobility program to provide feedback on ways the city can improve transportation services for older adults in the community, at its Thursday meeting.

The city kicked off the program in Feb. to cater to the transportation requirements of elderly residents who may not drive as often. This program is evaluating the existing senior services by engaging with older adults. The aim is to ascertain whether adjustments are necessary to existing services or if new transportation options should be introduced.

The current services primarily consist of various transit options depending on their needs.

The Dial-A-Ride Shuttle provides free shared-ride transportation for residents who are at least 62 years old or have disabilities of any age. The shuttle transports residents to any location within the city and most medical facilities adjacent to the city, such as UCLA Medical and Cedars-Sinai. Services include medical trips, grocery store trips, recreational trips, and Monday Roxbury park trips.

The city's partnership with Ambiance Transportation provides trips during weekend and evening hours, or to destinations outside the service area. Rides are provided by an Ambiance or Lyft vehicle.

Beverly Hills residents 62 years and older or residents with disabilities are eligible for a 28-day discounted bus pass for \$7.00.

Access Services, Inc. is also a county-

#### City to Celebrate National Bike Month in May

The city will be celebrating National Bike Month in May and is expected to engage in several events and activities.

Throughout the month, the city will be promoting the "Make Every Ride Count" commuter challenge. This is intended to create more bike-friendly streets by encouraging residents to download the "Love to Ride" app, track rides and biking accomplishments, and provide feedback on bike trips to be eligible for prizes all month long.

The city is expected to kick-off National Bike Month with a galaxy-themed community bike ride suitable for all bicycling abilities. This family-friendly event will begin with free safety inspections and minor bike repairs on a first come, first served basis. Participants who decorate their bicycles will receive an "out of this world" prize. Costumes are highly encouraged.

On May 8 the city will promote National Bike and Walk to School Day, where students and families across the U.S. bike, walk, or ride to school on this day. On Sunday, May 19, the farmers' market will host a free bike repairs and used bike collection. Non-profit Walk 'n Rollers will be on-site collecting bicycles to be fixed up and distributed to children and adults without the resources to purchase bikes on their own.

#### 31 Applications Received for Community Assistance Grant Funding

A total of 31 applica-

tions have been received from organizations interested in receiving Community Assistance Grant Funding, according to a city staff report.

This past funding cycle, 25 organizations were awarded grant funding for services that targeted seniors, homelessness, food insecurity, physical and mental health, culture, and other needs.

To qualify, an applicant must be, or partner with a 501c3 organization and be offering vital services and/or programming that addresses a specific unmet community need.

This year, city staff proposed a slightly modified process, dividing organizations into two groups and excluding one of them from consideration. The first group consists of organizations offering vital services to the community that cannot be duplicated by city staff. Failure to provide these services could lead to significant unintended consequences for residents. The city will engage in contractual agreements for these services, billing based on hours utilized, separately and independently from the regular process.

There are five critical service providers that will be moving towards direct contracts with the city, according to a staff report, based on services rendered for the upcoming fiscal year. These organizations include Jewish Family Services Los Angeles, Beverly Hills CPR, People Assisting the Homeless (P.A.T.H.), Step Up on Second, and Bet Tzedek. The anticipated total amount to contract with these five organizations for Fiscal Year 24/25 is \$1,065,000.

The second group of organizations, comprising the majority of grantees, offers a General Social Service Program aimed at enhancing the community's quality of life by providing services that are not currently available elsewhere. These services are non-urgent, meaning

there are no serious consequences if they are temporarily unavailable. Additionally, this group includes a few organizations that offer cultural arts programs. These organizations will participate in the Community Assistance Grant Fund (CAGF) process.

Additional criteria and metrics sought during the application process and quarterly reporting will include a focus on direct referrals for services originating from Beverly Hills residents or staff. This emphasis ensures that the grants ultimately serve the community.

The sum total of grant requests is \$2,073,499.

#### City Council Approves Amended Joint Powers Agreement with Waste Management Authority

The City Council approved an amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement with the Los Angeles Waste Management Authority, at its March 11 meeting.

The Los Angeles Area Integrated Waste Management Authority, also referred to as the Los Angeles Regional Agency, is a consortium of 18 cities in Los Angeles County.

The entity serves as a regional agency whose mission is to promote environmental responsibility and compliance with state-mandated recycling programs.

The agency compiles and files the annual waste diversion report to Cal-Recycle on behalf of its member cities. The annual waste diversion report is required under several state laws related to waste reduction and recycling.

The agency is also now required to report on organics recycling and has amended and restated the existing agreement to reflect the required reporting and compliance monitoring related to organic waste recycling, and CalRecycle.

The advantage to the single agency is that it submits its annual report as a single entity, rather than as individual cities or jurisdictions, which is believed to save the city time and money.

The City pays an annual membership of \$0.24 per disposal ton, ranging from \$9,000 to \$10,000, which includes reporting cost.

#### City to Kickoff Spring 2024 Transportation Safety Campaign

The city has kicked off the 2024 transportation campaign and will promote the spring message "I respect bicyclists and give them space when passing."

The city has previously completed various safety campaigns as part of events or projects that focused on transportation. For example, in 2019, city staff produced the Bicycle and Pedestrian Awareness Campaign meant to bring attention to traveling safely as cyclists and pedestrians.

This year's campaign incorporates quarterly messages derived from the calls to action established in the 2023 campaign themes. The aim is to broaden the reach of the messaging strategies beyond those employed in the previous year.

In addition to traditional channels, the campaign will also utilize unconventional platforms like elevator clings, A-frames, streetlight banners, window decals, and more.

Under the campaign slogan – Traffic Safety Starts with Me – this campaign aims to teach all road users how to travel safely and keep each other safe on streets. The calls to action will feature first-person messages in an effort to help inspire residents on how to make safer behavior choices when driving.

The winter message was, "I respect pedestrians and give them time to cross." The spring message is, "I respect bicyclists and give them space when passing."

"When passing a cyclist that is using the full travel lane, pass cautiously and always give at least three feet between your car and the person riding. If you cannot give at least three feet, change travel lanes to pass or remain behind the cyclist. These actions give cyclists enough space to avoid any debris in the roadway and help create a more comfortable riding experience," according to a city staff report.

tribution of child pornography.

Gad, whose therapist license expired in Nov. 2023, is free on \$250,000 bond. He is expected to be arraigned on May 3 in United States District Court in downtown Los Angeles.

According to the indictment, on Dec. 2, 2021, Gad knowingly distributed child sexual abuse material involving a pre-teen via the internet and which had been shipped in interstate commerce.

Court documents previously filed state that in the fall of 2022, law enforcement became aware that Gad, who maintained a Beverly Hills office for his therapy practice, had engaged in sexually explicit online chats with someone he believed was a 13-yearold girl, but who in fact was an undercover law enforcement officer. In Oct. 2022, Gad al-

legedly drove more than 180 miles from Beverly Hills to San Luis Obispo to a public park, an arranged meeting site where he believed he was to meet the "girl." Law enforcement conducted a traffic stop, arrested Gad and seized several digital devices.

A search of Gad's devices led to evidence of Gad's distribution of child sexual abuse material, as well as communications with suspected minors and internet searches related to sex with minors, the affidavit alleges.

The San Luis Obispo County District Attorney's Office previously charged Gad in state court. That case was dismissed so Gad could be charged in federal court. According to The Dai-

ly Beast, Glad charged \$750-per-session. If convicted, Gad

ways. would face a mandatory minimum sentence of five years in federal prison and a statutory maximum sentence of 20 years in federal prison.

#### **Fentanyl Trafficker Who Moved to Beverly Hills** Found Guilty of Drug and **Money Laundering**

A federal jury found Paris Carter guilty of conspiracy to distribute 400 grams or more of fentanyl and 100 grams or more of acetyl fentanyl and conspiracy to commit money laundering, United States Attorney Eric G. Olshan announced on March 12.

Carter, 34, formerly of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, moved to Beverly Hills where he rented two separate homes at costs of \$10,000 and \$14,500 per month.

Evidence introduced during the trial established that, between Jan. 2017 and Feb. 2018, Carter arranged for the illegal importation of multiple kilograms of fentanyl and acetyl fentanyl directly from China and then distributed those drugs throughout the Pittsburgh region. Using the proceeds of his drug trafficking, Carter moved to Beverly Hills and also leased three vehicles-two Bentleys and a Mercedes Benz.

As part of his money laundering activity, Carter used other individuals to initiate financial transactions in their names to pay for the drugs obtained, according to the Department of Justice. Carter also provided drug proceeds to seven other individuals who used these funds to purchase cashier checks that he then used as downpayments on his cars, which he arranged to lease in the name of his aunt and co-defendant, Tamara Carter, whom the jury acquitted at trial.

"Paris Carter flooded the Pittsburgh area with substantial quantities of fentanyl from China and lived large on the proceeds, moving to Beverly Hills and driving multiple Bentleys," said Olshan. "Now, he faces a minimum sentence of 15 years' imprisonment. We thank our law enforcement partners at the U.S. Postal Inspection Service and Pennsylvania State Police for their critical partnership in holding one of our region's most significant fentanyl distributors accountable for his crimes."

During trial, the Court also was informed that Carter had previously been convicted in the Western District of Pennsylvania of possession with the intent to distribute heroin, for which he was sentenced to 37 months in 2011.

Judge Horan scheduled sentencing for June 28. The law provides for a maximum total sentence of at least 15 years and up to life in prison, a fine of \$20.5 million, or both.

According to the 2023 Calif. Statewide Public Opinion Survey, more than 74 percent of drivers surveyed said that distracted driving because of texting was their biggest safety concern. In 2021, there were at least 140 people killed in distracted driving traffic crashes in Calif.

Under current law, drivers are not allowed to hold a phone or electronic communications device while operating a vehicle, even when stopped at a red light. Using a handheld cell phone while driving is punishable by a fine, and violating the hands-free law for a second time within 36 months of a prior conviction for the same offense will result in a point being added to a driver's record.
